**Match Notes:** Match lasted 1:13 (doubles lasted :23) ... Notre Dame won its ninth in a row, improves to 25-1, and will face #29 Michigan on Saturday at 1 p.m. (ET) in the second round ... the Irish won 6-1 at Michigan on Feb. 15 ... Valpo concludes its season at 15-8 ... both teams earned automatic bids as conference champions ... ND advances to the round of 32 for the fourth consecutive year and will look to reach the round of 16 for the first time since 2001 (and sixth time overall) ... the Crusaders lost in the opening round for the second straight year after making their NCAA debut in 2005 ... Valpo had a six-match winning streak ended ... ND has won the doubles point in every match this season ... ND's Brook Buck has won seven straight in singles and has seven clinching wins this season ... ND's Kelcy Tefft has won six consecutive singles matches.
