2007-5	ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS — RECRUITING CALENDARS — WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL — EVALUATION PERIOD IN CONJUNCTION WITH CHAMPIONSHIP	Adopted - Final	Immediate	In women's volleyball, to specify that evaluations may occur at one event conducted on the Sunday immediately following the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship, provided the event occurs within a 100-mile radius of the site of the championship.
2007-18	PERSONNEL AND RECRUITING — LIMITATIONS ON THE NUMBER AND DUTIES OF COACHES — RECRUITING COORDINATION FUNCTIONS — EXCEPTION — NONCOACHING STAFF MEMBER — AFTER NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT SIGNING OR OTHER WRITTEN COMMITMENT	Adopted - Final	2008-08-01	To permit a noncoaching staff member to make telephone calls to or receive telephone calls from a prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's parents, legal guardians or coaches) and prepare general recruiting correspondence (including electronic correspondence) to a prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's parents or legal guardians), provided the prospective student-athlete has signed a National Letter of Intent or, for those institutions not using the National Letter of Intent in a particular sport or for a prospective-student-athlete who is not eligible to sign a National Letter of Intent (e.g., four-year college transfer), the institution's written offer of admission and/or financial aid.
2007-29	RECRUITING — ENROLLED STUDENT-ATHLETE — PERMISSIBLE RECRUITMENT ACTIVITIES — TELEPHONE CONTACT INITIATED BY PROSPECTIVE STUDENT-ATHLETES	Adopted - Final	2008-08-01	To specify that an enrolled student-athlete may receive telephone calls made at the expense of a prospective student-athlete prior to July 1 following the completion of a prospective student-athlete's junior year in high school, provided there is no direct or indirect involvement by athletics department staff.
2007-30-C	RECRUITING — CONTACTS AND EVALUATIONS — MEN'S BASKETBALL EVALUATIONS — APRIL CONTACT PERIOD	Adopted, 60-Day Override Period	2008-08-01	To specify that evaluations of live athletics activities during the April contact period shall be limited to regularly scheduled high school, preparatory school and two-year college contests/tournaments and practices; and regular scholastic activities involving prospective student-athletes enrolled only at the institution at which the regular scholastic activities occur; further, to amend the April contact period to begin at noon on the first Thursday following the Men's Basketball Championship and continue through seven days following the initial date for the spring signing of the National Letter of Intent.
2007-32	RECRUITING — PERMISSIBLE RECRUITERS AND EVALUATIONS — HEAD COACH RESTRICTIONS — SPRING EVALUATION PERIOD — FOOTBALL — FBS	Adopted - Final	Immediate	In bowl subdivision football, to specify that the head coach shall not engage in off-campus recruiting activities during the April 15 through May 31 evaluation period.

2007-33-A	RECRUITING — COMMUNICATION DURING JULY EVALUATION PERIODS — AFTER NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT SIGNING OR OTHER WRITTEN COMMITMENT — WOMEN'S BASKETBALL	Adopted - Final	Immediate	In women's basketball, to permit an institution to communicate with a prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's relatives, legal guardians or coach) during the July evaluation periods, provided the prospective student-athlete has graduated from high school and has signed a National Letter of Intent (NLI) with the institution or for those institutions not using the National Letter of Intent in women's basketball or for those prospective student-athletes who are not eligible to sign the National Letter of Intent, the institution's written offer of admission and/or financial aid.
2007-35	RECRUITING — TELEPHONE CALLS TO PROSPECTIVE STUDENT-ATHLETES — PERMISSIBLE CALLERS — EXCEPTIONS — FACULTY ATHLETICS REPRESENTATIVE AND SENIOR WOMAN ADMINISTRATOR	Adopted, 60-Day Override Period	Immediate	To permit an institution's faculty athletics representative and senior woman administrator to return telephone calls to prospective student-athletes or his or her parents or legal guardians subject to any applicable limitations on the number of telephone calls that an institution may place to prospective student-athletes.
2007-37	RECRUITING — CONTACTS AND EVALUATIONS — TELEPHONE CALLS TO PROSPECTIVE STUDENT-ATHLETES — COLLECT AND TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE CALLS — EXCEPTION — WOMEN'S BASKETBALL	Adopted - Final	Immediate	In women's basketball, to permit institutional coaching staff members to accept collect and toll-free telephone calls placed by a prospective student-athlete and the prospective student-athlete's parents and legal guardians, provided the calls are not placed earlier than the date on which an institution may begin placing telephone calls to the prospective student-athlete.
2007-40	RECRUITING — CONTACTS AND EVALUATIONS — CONTACTS AFTER NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT SIGNING OR OTHER WRITTEN COMMITMENT — FOOTBALL — CONTACTS DURING SPRING EVALUATION PERIOD — FBS	Adopted - Final	2008-08-01	In bowl subdivision football, to specify that during the spring evaluation period, coaching staff members may make two contacts with a prospective student-athlete who has signed a National Letter of Intent (or, for those institutions not subscribing to the National Letter of Intent, after the prospective student-athlete's signed acceptance of the institution's written offer of admission and/or financial aid) at the prospective student-athlete's educational institution; further, to specify that any visit to the educational institution that includes only contact with a signed prospective student-athlete during the spring evaluation period shall be considered one of the institution's two permissible days at that institution.

2007-44	RECRUITING — OFFERS AND INDUCEMENTS AND TRYOUTS — USE OF ACADEMIC SUPPORT SERVICES/TRAINING-ROOM FACILITIES IN ALL SPORTS — VOLUNTARY SUMMER CONDITIONING IN FOOTBALL AND BASKETBALL	Adopted - Final	Immediate	To eliminate the requirement that a prospective student-athlete must have signed a National Letter of Intent (NLI) (or, for an institution that does not use the NLI, a written offer of admission and/or financial aid) in order to receive academic support services and use the institution's training room facilities; further to specify that a student who is enrolled in the institution's summer term prior to the student's initial, full-time enrollment at the certifying institution may be provided such services and, in football and basketball, participate in voluntary conditioning activities during the summer with an athletic department's strength and conditioning coach.
2007-45	RECRUITING — PRINTED RECRUITING MATERIALS — EXPRESS MAIL SERVICES — PRE-ENROLLMENT INFORMATION	Adopted - Final	Immediate	To permit an institution to use express mail delivery services to provide necessary pre-enrollment information to a prospective student-athlete, provided he or she has signed a National Letter of Intent or institutional financial aid agreement, or has been officially accepted for enrollment.
2007-47	RECRUITING — RECRUITING MATERIALS — ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSIONS — AFTER NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT SIGNING OR OTHER WRITTEN COMMITMENT	Adopted - Final	Immediate	To specify that after the calendar day on which a prospective student-athlete signs a National Letter of Intent (NLI), there shall be no limit on the forms of electronically transmitted correspondence sent by the institution with which the prospective student-athlete has signed; further, to specify that for an institution not using the NLI, or for a prospective student-athlete who is not eligible to sign the NLI, there shall be no limit after the calendar day on which the prospective student-athlete signs the institution's written offer of admission and/or financial aid.

2007-49	RECRUITING — TRANSPORTATION ON OFFICIAL PAID VISIT — COACH ACCOMPANYING PROSPECTIVE STUDENT-ATHLETE AND PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS	Adopted - Final	2008-08-01	To permit the parents or legal guardians of a prospective student-athlete to ride in an automobile driven by a coaching staff member for the purpose of providing ground transportation to a prospective student-athlete as part of an official visit.
2007-50-B	RECRUITING — OFFICIAL VISIT — COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS — EXCEPTION — NONTRADITIONAL FAMILY	Adopted, 60-Day Override Period	2008-08-01	To specify that if a prospective student-athlete is a member of a nontraditional family (e.g., divorce, separation), an institution may provide up to two additional complimentary admissions to the prospective student-athlete in order to accommodate the parents accompanying the prospective student-athlete (e.g., stepparents) to attend a home athletics event.
2007-51	RECRUITING — PUBLICITY — ANNOUNCEMENT OF ALL SIGNINGS — CELEBRATORY FUNCTIONS	Adopted - Final	Immediate	To permit an institution to conduct one formal press conference to announce the signed commitments of prospective student-athletes and to permit coaching staff members to attend functions designed to celebrate the institution's signees in the applicable sport and discuss prospective student-athletes who have signed commitments to attend the institution, including discussions with working media, provided the institution previously has released communications of the prospective student-athletes' commitments to attend the institution to media outlets.
2007-52	RECRUITING — U.S. SERVICE ACADEMY EXCEPTIONS — CONTACTS DURING SPRING EVALUATION PERIOD OF JUNIOR YEAR IN HIGH SCHOOL — FOOTBALL	Adopted, 60-Day Override Period	Immediate	In bowl subdivision football, to permit U.S. Service Academies to make in-person, off-campus contact with a prospective student-athlete during the spring evaluation period of the prospective student-athlete's junior year of high school, including contact at the prospective student-athlete's educational institution.
2007-53-B	ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS — RECRUITING CALENDARS — MEN'S BASKETBALL — MAY DEAD PERIOD	Adopted - Final	Immediate	In men's basketball, to establish a dead period beginning the day after the conclusion of the spring National Letter of Intent signing period to the day before the first permissible day to conduct institutional basketball camps.

2007-56	ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS — RECRUITING CALENDARS — MEN'S LACROSSE — NO LACROSSE EVALUATIONS IN JANUARY, SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER	Adopted - Final	Immediate	In men's lacrosse, to specify that lacrosse evaluations are not permissible from the day after the first Sunday in January through Martin Luther King, Jr. Day and from September 1 through October 31; further, to revise the men's lacrosse recruiting calendar, as specified.
2007-110	FINANCIAL AID — REDUCTION AND CANCELLATION DURING PERIOD OF AWARD — REDUCTION OR CANCELLATION NOT PERMITTED — INJURY, ILLNESS OR PHYSICAL OR MENTAL MEDICAL CONDITION	Adopted - Final	Immediate	To specify that institutional financial aid based in any degree on athletics ability may not be reduced or canceled during the period of its award because of an injury, illness or physical or mental medical condition.
2007-111	RECRUITING — CONTACTS AND EVALUATIONS — MEN'S BASKETBALL — SUMMER EVALUATION PERIOD — NONINSTITUTIONAL NONORGANIZED EVENTS	Adopted - Final	Immediate	In men's basketball, to prohibit evaluations at noninstitutional nonorganized events (e.g., pick-up games) during the summer evaluation period.
