STORYLINES

- Coming off its largest win of the season, the Northern Illinois women's basketball team (7-11, 1-4 Mid-American Conference) wraps up a three-game homestand and opens cross-divisional play against Miami (Ohio), Sunday at noon.
- In their last outing, the Huskies were up by as many as 21 points (33-12 and 44-23) on Ball State before eventually beating the Cardinals by 11. The last time NIU led by that much was on February 2, 2010, when the Huskies led Ohio 39-18 at halftime of a 68-61 victory.
- In addition to looking for a second-straight MAC win, Northern Illinois has at least two reasons to want to beat Miami (Ohio). The RedHawks defeated NIU by 45 in last year's regular season meeting, 96-51. The teams later met in the first round of the Mid-American Conference Tournament, where Miami (Ohio) edged the Huskies, 67-66, to end NIU's season.

CAN'T MISS THIS

Marke Freeman's 30-point outburst against Ball State was the fifth time in her career she has hit the 30-point mark. Freeman's career-high is 36, which came in an overtime win against Buffalo. Perhaps the most impressive part of Freeman's scoring outbursts is that when she reaches 30 points, she is also averaging 7.8 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.4 steals per game. The Huskies are 3-2 when Freeman scores 30 points.

TIP-OFF

Huskies Welcome Miami (Ohio) Sunday

Coming off its largest win of the season, the Northern Illinois women's basketball team (7-11, 1-4 Mid-American Conference) wraps up a three-game homestand and opens cross-divisional play against Miami (Ohio), Sunday at noon.

The Series

NIU trails the all-time series with Miami (Ohio) 15-12. The RedHawks swept both games last season, including a first-round MAC Tournament meeting. The Huskies' hold a three-game winning streak in DeKalb, and Miami (Ohio) hasn't won at the Convocation Center since 2005.

Last Time - NIU 73, Ball State 62

Senior Marke Freeman scored 30 points and flirted with a triple-double, helping the Northern Illinois women's basketball team capture a 73-62 win over Ball State, Wednesday at the Convocation Center.

Freeman added nine steals and eight rebounds while matching her season high in points. She scored nine points in a row during a 15-0 first half run that put the Huskies up by 20 with 5:43 left in the first half.

While Freeman lit up Ball State, the Huskie defense kept the Cardinal offense grounded. BSU didn't score until more than six minutes into the game, and had only nine points over the first 14 minutes.

Northern Illinois went into halftime with a 38-19 lead. The Huskies held Ball State to 20.0 percent shooting and the Cardinals committed 15 first half turnovers leading to 13 NIU points. A physical game saw NIU go 16-of-22 from the free throw line in the opening period, and 21-of-30 overall.

The Cardinals briefly threatened a comeback. With NIU up 15 and just over six minutes left, Ty'Ronda Benning scored 11 straight points for the Cardinals, bringing her team to within eight with 2:19 left. The finals 139 seconds saw six fouls and five turnovers between the two teams, but Kim Davis made a lay-up off a press break and NIU made 4-of-6 free throws down the stretch to seal the win.

Davis totaled nine rebounds, six points and two steals. She played 35 minutes, by far the most of any NIU forward. Davis was tabbed with defending Emily Maggert, Ball State's leading scoring throughout who managed only seven points.

Courtney Shelton added 11 points, five rebounds, and five assists. Ebony Ellis tallied eight points and six rebounds despite playing only 18 minutes due to foul trouble.

Last Time Versus the Cardinals

In a game that saw nine ties and 13 lead changes, the Northern Illinois women's basketball team blinked first in a 67-66 loss at Miami (Ohio) in the first round of the Mid-American Conference Tournament at Millett Hall. The loss eliminated NIU from the MAC Tournament and ended the Huskies' year.

Mauvolyene Adams had one of the best games of her career. Adams scored 16 of her team-high 18 points in the second half, and had a career-high 18 rebounds, one shy of top-10 status in the Huskie record book. Adams has 12 offensive boards, and was unstoppable in the second half, hitting seven of NIU's first eight shots from the field. She added five steals and three assists.

While it was Adams that kept NIU rolling in the second, then-senior Kylie York got the Huskies off to a hot start. With her team down 13-6, York hit a trio of three-pointers to send NIU on a 9-2 run and tie the game at 15. In her final game in the Cardinal and Black, York finished the day with four three-pointers for 12 points.

Thanks to York's shooting, helped by a pair of three-pointers by Courtney Shelton (Rockford, Ill./Hononegah), NIU enter the locker room down just five, 39-34. That deficit was despite the RedHawks shooting 51.7 percent (15-of-29) from the field, while NIU hit just 38.7 percent (12-of-31) of its shots.

GAME NOTES

Freeman Reaches 1,000

Marke Freeman became the 26th member of Northern Illinois' 1,000-Point Club during the Huskies' game at Central Michigan. She now has 1,058 career points, 22nd-most in Huskie history. With her 30-point performance against Ball State, Freeman leapfrogged fellow Huskie point guards Denise Dove and Kelly Sue Miller. She is now 34 points behind Lindsay Secrest for 21st.

The redshirt senior is in only her third season on the court with the Huskies after transferring from Florida A&M. She is the first player to reach the scoring milestone in just three seasons since Stephanie Raymond scored her 1,000th point in 2005-06. Raymond was the 20th pick in the WNBA draft one year later.

Chasing 1,000

Ebony Ellis is 151 points off from 1,000, and would need to average 12.6 ppg in NIU's 13 guaranteed games to reach a grand. Ellis averaged 12.0 points per game last season, despite battling a foot injury for the bulk of the year, and, is averaging 10.7 points per game this season. If Ellis joins Freeman in the esteemed club, it would be the first time two Huskies passed the milestone in one season since Kristan Knake and Jennifer Youngblood did so in the 2002-03 season.

Three's Company

NIU stands as the most accurate three-point shooting team in the MAC, and the third-best three-point shooting team in the nation. The Huskies have hit 40.4 percent of their attempts

from distance, including knocking in 4-of-5 (80.0 percent) and 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) against UNI and SIU, respectively.

On the Mark-e

Marke Freeman ranks fifth in the nation in three-point shooting, hitting 47.2 percent of her threes. She has hit 34-of-72 attempts, including a 3-for-3 night at UNI and a 4-of-4 game against Northwestern.

Failure to Launch

Toledo's offense managed only 42 points against a stifling NIU defense. It was the fewest points allowed by the Huskies since a 68-42 win over Central Michigan in 2006. It was the fewest points given up to an opponent in a loss since a 42-27 defeat to Wisconsin in 1974.

Defense Locking On

The Huskies are beginning to get the hang of Kathi Bennett's signature "pack" defense. NIU has held opponents to 40 percent shooting eight times this year. The Huskies are 4-4 in those games. NIU has limited its opponents to less than 40 percent shooting in all but two MAC games, with league opponents shooting just 37.7 percent against the Huskies.

'Big' Win

NIU's win over Ball State was a big win because it snapped a five-game slide for the Huskies. But the 73-62 victory also tied for biggest win by margin: 11 points. NIU beat Loyola by 11, but the Huskies' five other wins have all come by single digits.

Shooting Stars

The Huskies were white hot from the field against UNI, hitting 59 percent (23-39) of their field goal attempts. NIU's 39 total attempts were the fewest since Dec. 20, 2007. That day, also in a game against UNI, the Huskies shot 19-of-38 (50.0 percent) in a 61-46 win. It was also the second time Northern Illinois has shot at a better than 50-percent clip this year – the Huskies hit 52 percent of their field goals against WIU.

NIU had only one shooting game above 50 percent in the previous three years.

Boards-Per-Inch

Marke Freeman, at 5-foot-5 the shortest player on the court for the majority of the UNI and Loyola contests, grabbed 12 rebounds in each game, tying her career-high. That's an incredible 2.2 rebounds per foot of height. Freeman ranks 18th in the MAC in rebounding with 5.8 per game, and is the shortest player in the top-20.

Freeman Adds Another 30-Point Game

Marke Freeman's 30-point effort against Ball State was the fifth such game in her career. Freeman went 10-of-14 from the field, and 10-of-11 from the free throw line, and added eight boards and nine steals. Her career high came in a 36-point effort against Buffalo, and she also owns a 33-point game versus Ball State and a 30-point game at EMU.

Ellis Rebounds Into Top-10

With 10 boards against Toledo, Ebony Ellis moved into the top-10 on NIU's career rebounds list. She has now totaled 750, 10th most in NIU history (Paula Wick, 9th, 760). Ellis is on pace to become only the ninth Huskie to pass 800 career boards.

Assist-Rebound Duos

Against Eastern Michigan, Marke Freeman became the 16th Huskie to reach 250 assists in her career. It marks the first time in four years that a member of both the NIU 250-Assist Club and 600-Rebound Club have played on the same team. Ellis passed 600 boards last year. The last pair to play together as members of the two clubs were Kristin Wiener (629 career rebounds) and Stephanie Raymond (497 career assists) in 2006-07.

Breakout Again

Courtney Shelton surprised with her sophomore campaign, going from 3.5 to 27.6 minutes and 0.2 to 4.5 points per

game. She's made an equally impressive junior jump. Shelton is averaging career-highs of 9.3 points, 2.8 assists and 2.3 rebounds per game. Her season has been highlights includes a perfect 7-for-7 night from the field with 21 points and a buzzer-beating, game-winning half-court shot against Southern Illinois, and a 29-point game in which she scored 12 points in 46 seconds against Western Michigan.

Points Off Turnovers Key

NIU is 6-2 when scoring more points off turnovers than its opposition, and 1-9 when outscored in that category. The loss to Bradley was the only game this year in which NIU outscored its opponents off turnovers, but lost. The Huskies' widest margin came against George Washington, when NIU scored 19 points off Colonial miscues, while GW scored only seven off of Huskie turnovers.

Slow Dancing

The Huskies' 46 points against Southern Illinois were the fewest scored by an NIU team in a win since Feb. 15, 2003, when the Huskies beat Akron 45-42.

No Threes Necessary

Northern Illinois defeated Western Illinois, 73-65, without hitting a three-pointer. The Huskies only took three shots from behind-the-arc, two by Marke Freeman and one from Brittney Callahan. It was the first time since Dec. 18, 2003 NIU won without a made three. That day, NIU beat St. Louis, 67-61.

Rock 'n' Road

The Huskies went 3-2 to start the season with every game

coming away from the Convocation Center. The away record is the best road start since 2006-07, when the Huskies also opened 3-2 in away/neutral games. That year, NIU finished 9-9 on the road and 19-12 overall. This year's team is currently 4-8 away from the Convo, having played 10 of its first 11 games away from home.

New Sensation

Redshirt sophomore Kim Davis, who did not play competitive basketball in 2009-10, is the Huskies' third leading scorer and second-best rebounder. Davis is averaging 7.7 points per game, while shooting 42.6 percent from the field, and is tallying 6.8 rebounds per game. She posted has posted two double-doubles this season, including a 12-point, 13-rebound effort at Central Michigan.

Davis played her freshman season as a walk-on at Eastern Michigan, where she started 10 games and played in 24 contests. She left the team after her freshman year to transfer to a school that was closer to her home of Evanston, Ill. Davis ended up at NIU, where she attended classes but was not a part of the basketball team. Bennett discovered Davis after Huskie freshman Jenna Thorp went down with an injury in the summer, and convinced Davis to join the Huskies.

Eight Ball

Ellis is currently averaging 8.9 points and 7.9 rebounds for her career. If she lifts her career rebounding average slightly, she will be the first player to average at least 8.0 and 8.0 for a career since Jennifer Youngblood put up 12.4 points and 8.6 boards per game from 2000-04.
