THE LAST TIME OUT

The NIU women's basketball team posted its first victory of the season in convincing fashion, defeating Western Illinois University, 70-48, on the road Tuesday night.

The Huskies (1-1) fell behind 11-10 early in the contest, but rattled off a 19-2 run to a 29-13 lead with 8:48 left to play in the first half and never looked back. Sparked by the defense, NIU caused 12 Westernwind (1-1) errors in the first half and capitalized, scoring 18 points off WIU turnovers. NIU forced 25 Western turnovers for the game and scored 25 points off them.

The three-point shooting from junior Kylie York (Fishers, Ind./Hamilton Southeastern) and senior Jessie Wilcox also keyed the Huskie run. Wilcox came off the bench and went off, shooting 4-7 from three-point territory in the first half, while York went 2-5 from beyond the arc in the half. Both finished in double figures with York scoring 11 points and Wilcox leading the Huskies with a game-high 16 points, 14 coming in the first half.

The Huskies' inside game was also solid, outrebounding Western Illinois, 41-32, and outscoring the Westerwinds in the paint, 26-18. Center Ebony Ellis (Joliet, Ill./Joliet Township) finished with 10 points, while forward Mauvolyene Adams led both teams in rebounding with a career-high 13 boards and added four points.

TOURNEY TIME

Northern Illinois has a 3-1 record in tournament play the last two seasons. The Huskies went 1-1 at least season's Hawkeye Challenge (Dec. 8-9, 2007) and won the Mildred and Roger L. White Tournament hosted by Northwestern (Dec. 1-2), going 2-0.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

The Huskies have never faced the other three teams in the Seton Hall Classic.

THE TEAMS

Northern Illinois enters the Seton Hall Classic on a high note, defeating Western Illinois, 70-48. Three Huskies finished in double figures with Jessie Wilcox leading the way with 16. UMBC posted an 89-60 victory over George Mason Wednesday night. Seton Hall enters their tournament with a 2-0 mark and defeated Caldwell, 93-44, Monday night. Wagner is also 2-0 heading into the tourney after defeating Army 59-58 in the season opener and beating NJIT, 82-73, Tuesday night.

THE COACHES

Carol Owens begins her fourth season as head coach of NIU's women's basketball team, posting a 42-48 record. Phil Stern of UMBC owns a 67-112 mark with the Retrievers, Wagner's head coach Gela Mikalauskas has a 188-207 record in 14 years with the Seahawks, while Phyllis Mangina has a 328-333 with Seton Hall.

FOR THE RECORD

- In 51 years of women's basketball at NIU, the Huskies have posted a 549-530 record for a winning percentage of .508.

HOME SWEET HOME

- The Huskies are 253-158 all-time at home and are 25-13 under Carol Owens in DeKalb. Northern Illinois has posted a 44-34 record since moving into the Convocation Center Nov. 22, 2002.

AMERICAN WOMAN

- NIU head coach Carol Owens led Team USA's U18 National Team to the gold medal at the FIBA Americas U18 Championship for Women in Buenos Aires, Argentina, posting a 5-0 mark after defeating Argentina, 81-37. It is the third straight gold medal Owens has captured, but her first as head coach. She was an assistant coach on the USA Basketball's Under 19 Women's Basketball Team that captured the gold at the 2007 FIBA U19 World Championship in Bratislava, Slovakia, and also took home the gold at the FIBA Americas U18 Championship in Colorado Springs, Colo. in the summer of 2006 as an assistant on Team USA's Under 18 Women's Team.

STILL WORKING THE BOARDS

- NIU head coach Carol Owens has emerged as one of the leaders in her profession. Not only has she served as a coach on three national teams, but she currently sits on the board of directors on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association and the Black Coaches & Administrators.

HELLO MY NAME IS

- Carol Owens hired Heather Oesterle as the Huskies' newest assistant coach. Oesterle brings with her a wealth of experience of Mid-American Conference basketball. She comes to Northern Illinois after spending the past five seasons at MAC East foe Miami (OH). During her five years in Oxford, the RedHawks posted an 80-72 record, won two MAC Championships (2004 & 2008), and made two postseason appearances.

WELCOME TO THE PACK

- NIU welcomes four new members to the floor this year. Marke Freeman, who sat out last season per NCAA transfer regulations, begins her first full season with the Huskies this year. She is joined by three freshmen, Sarah Rogers, Courtney Shelton and Tenisha Wilson.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- The Huskies are 296-372 all-time on the road and are 17-34 under Carol Owens away from the Convocation Center.

DIALING LONG DISTANCE

- The Huskies have two players that are in the top 10 in the NIU record for three-point field goals made in a career. Junior Kylie York is fourth on the list with 129 threes made in three seasons. She's 61 shy of No. 3 and 92 from No. 1. Senior Jessie Wilcox sits in seventh with 98 and is 16 away from passing Charbea Haller who is in sixth with 113.

WHERE THERE'S A WILCOX THERE'S A WAY

- Senior Jessie Wilcox enters the 2008-09 season 303 points away from 1,000 for her career. Her career-high for points scored in a season is 304. She finished last year with 248, but missed four games due to injury and two others that were cancelled.

- Wilcox scored a season-high and game-high 16 points at Western Illinois (11/18/08). She turned in 11 double-digit scoring performances last season, including two 20-point efforts. She has 33 career double-figure games with her career high of 24 coming at home against Miami (OH) (2/3/07).

- Wilcox led the team in assists last season with 92 and dished out a career-high eight assists at Miami (OH) (1/26/08). She has 223 for her career and needs 45 more to crack the list of NIU assist leaders.

FEEL THE SENSATION

- Kylie York is the Huskies' top-returning scorer from last season's squad. The junior from Fishers, Ind. scored 305 points last year, averaging 10.9 points a game. She also led the Huskies in free throw percentage going 28-31, shooting 90.3 percent from the charity stripe.

- York posted her first double-digit scoring performance of the season at Western Illinois (11/18/08) scoring 10 points. She turned in 15 double-digit scoring efforts last season and has 21 for her career, including three 20-point performances.

- York came up four three pointers shy of breaking the Huskies' single-season mark for threes made in a season. York made 77 in the Huskies' shortened 2007-08 season. Denise Dove holds the top spot with 80 made during the 1988-89 season.

- She made a career-high seven treys en route to posting a career-high 27 points in the Huskies' 77-74 victory over Miami (OH) (1/26/08). It was one of seven games she led the Huskies in scoring.

DOUBLE E

- Ebony Ellis posted her first double-double of the season in the Huskies' game with IUPUI. She finished the contest with 15 points and 14 rebounds. It's her third double-double of her career. She had two double-doubles last season, scoring 17 points and grabbing 11 rebounds against Central Michigan and scoring 16 points and hauling in 16 boards against Kent State (2-13-08) He 16 rebounds against Kent State was a career high.

- Ellis posted back-to-back double-digit scoring performances for the first time in her career. She had 15 against IUPUI (11/14/08) and scored 10 points at Western Illinois (11/18/08). She turned in five double-figure scoring efforts last season, scoring a career-high 17 points against Central Michigan (1/15/08), hitting on a career-high eight field goals.

- Ellis leads the Huskies in rebounding with 21 boards. She led the Huskies in rebounding last season with 164, averaging 5.9 boards a game. She also led the Huskies in rebounding in 11 games last year.

- Ellis blocked a career-high five shots against Iowa (12/8/07) in her first career start. She played a career-high 34 minutes in that contest. She led the Huskies in blocked shots last year with 25.

MS. SMITH

- Becky Smith played in all 28 games for the Huskies last season, starting 19, and averaged 18.7 minutes a game.

- She posted two double digit scoring efforts, scoring a season-high 10 points against Miami (OH) (1/26/08) and Kent State (3/10/08) in the 2008 MAC Tournament and has four double figure games for her career.

- Smith blocked a career-high three shots against Northern Iowa (12/20/07) and dished out a career-high four assists against Buffalo (1-31-08).

WELTON'S WORLD

- Shari' Welton started 27 of 28 games for the Huskies last season, averaging 28.5 minutes a game.

- She led the Huskies in scoring in six games, posting a career-high 17 points at Bowling Green (2/9/08). Welton finished the season with 14 double digit scoring efforts, including a stretch a stretch of seven straight from 12/17/07 through 1/15/08.

- Welton posted her first career double-double and only one of the season in NIU's 60-59 victory over Western Illinois (11/15/07), scoring 10 points and grabbing a career-high 12 rebounds. She secured the feat on the final play of the game when she grabbed the winning rebound and scored the game-winning shot at the buzzer.

- She led the Huskies in steals with 29 in 28 games, including two three-steal games.

MAUVO-LOUS

- Sophomore Mauvolyene Adams scored a career-high 18 points against St. Joseph's (12/8/07) in the Hawkeye Challenge. It was one of three double-figure games for the forward from Bolingbrook, Ill.

- Adams grabbed a career-high 13 boards at Western Illinois (11/18/08). She is second on the team in rebounds with 18.

WLBK-AM (1360 khz), DeKalb

The Huskie Sports Radio Network includes five stations whose signals blanket the region. This fall, for the 19th consecutive year, WLBK-AM (1360) in DeKalb, serves as the flagship station. One of the pioneer AM outlets in the area, WLBK-AM first aired in 1947. [The other affiliate that will include WRHL-AM (1060) in Rochelle and WSEY-FM (95.7) in Oregon-Mount Morris.]

Home and away, Bill Baker handles the on-air duties for the Huskie Sports Radio Network. Baker, 59, begins his 28th year as the play-by-play voice of Northern Illinois women's basketball. He also handles radio play-by-play for Huskie football and men's basketball games.

Carol Owens embarks on her fourth season at the helm of Northern Illinois University's women's basketball team. In that time, she has built NIU into a contender in the Mid-American Conference and has been recognized by her peers as one of the top coaches in the country.

In recognition of that fact, Owens has been selected to coach four national teams, spending two years as an assistant before being asked to lead two others, and two professional organizations have selected her to serve on their board of directors. While those accomplishments are impressive, they are not surprising. From her days as a player at Northern Illinois, through the years she has spent working her way up through the coaching ranks, Owens' passion for basketball and drive for success has led her to this point.

Since taking over, Northern posted its first winning season in five years, going 19-12 in 2006-07 and advanced to the semifinals of the 2007 MAC Women's Basketball Tournament. In 2006-07, the Huskies broke several school records, including three-pointers made (236) and attempted (639) and NIU set the single-season mark for free throw percentage, hitting 78.9 percent from the charity stripe.

The success Owens has achieved has not gone unnoticed, and earning the respect of those in your field is the highest compliment any coach can receive. In 2008, Owens was named to the Board of Directors of both the Black Coaches Association and Women's Basketball Coaches Association.

Owens' national reputation has grown during her NIU tenure as she has twice been invited to serve as a coach with USA Basketball, beginning in April of 2006, when she was selected to serve as an assistant to DePaul's Doug Bruno on Team USA's FIBA Americas U18 Championship Team.

Owens spent the summer of 2006 in Colorado Springs, Colo. helping lead the red, white and blue to the gold medal. She was back on Team USA's bench in the summer of 2007, this time in Europe, coaching USA Basketball's Women's U19 World Championship Team. As they did the year before, Team USA cruised through the field and brought home the gold.

The powers that be in USA Basketball must have been impressed with what they saw from Owens because in March of 2008, they asked her to become head coach of the 2008 U18 World Championship Team. Owens led Team USA to gold, defeating Argentina, 81-37.

Owens has coached some outstanding players during her career, sending four to the WNBA. At Northern Illinois, her most famous pupil was Stephanie Raymond. The 20th overall pick in the 2007 Women's National Basketball Association Draft, Raymond is the first Huskie in school history drafted by the league. Her selection by the Chicago Sky topped off one of the best seasons by a Huskie in recent memory. Raymond closed out her career at NIU as the school's fifth-leading scorer, and set the school record for steals and assists in a game. She also set the school record for free throw percentage in a season (90.1 percent) and career free throw percentage (83.9 percent).

Raymond is just one of four players she's help send to the WNBA. During her tenure in South Bend, Owens' coaching focus centered on the development of Notre Dame's post players. Her most famous pupil, Ruth Riley (1997-2001), capped off her Irish days as the consensus National Player of the Year (2000-01) and earned All-America status. NIU Women's Basketball Falls to IUPUI in Season Opener

DEKALB, Ill.— The Northern Illinois University women's basketball team dropped its season opener, 72-58, to IUPUI Friday night at the Convocation Center.

IUPUI (1-0) forward Jernisha Cann led all scorers with 23 points and was one of three Jaguars in double figures. Janna Eichelberger finished with 15 and Nicole James added 10.

Huskie (0-1) center Ebony Ellis (Joliet, Ill./Joliet Township) turned in her third double-double of her career, leading NIU is scoring with 15 points and in rebounding with 14 boards. Marke Freeman also finished in double digits, scoring 16 points. Becky Smith (Janesville, Wis./Parker) had a solid night, adding nine.

Turnovers plagued the Huskies all night. NIU turned the ball over 26 times and IUPUI capitalized scoring 33 points off Huskie miscues. The Jaguars also had a strong inside game, outscoring the Huskies 38-32 in the paint and the IUPUI bench was productive, accounting for 31 points, while NIU's reserves added 20 points to the effort.

NIU Women's Basketball Posts First Victory of Season

MACOMB, Ill.— The NIU women's basketball team posted its first victory of the season in convincing fashion, defeating Western Illinois University, 70-48, on the road Tuesday night.

The Huskies (1-1) fell behind 11-10 early in the contest, but rattled off a 19-2 run to a 29-13 lead with 8:48 left to play in the first half and never looked back. Sparked by the defense, NIU caused 12 Westernwind (1-1) errors in the first half and capitalized, scoring 18 points off WIU turnovers. NIU forced 25 Western turnovers for the game and scored 25 points off them.

The three-point shooting from junior Kylie York (Fishers, Ind./Hamilton Southeastern) and senior Jessie Wilcox also keyed the Huskie run. Wilcox came off the bench and went off, shooting 4-7 from three-point territory in the first half, while York went 2-5 from beyond the arc in the half. Both finished in double figures with York scoring 11 points and Wilcox leading the Huskies with a game-high 16 points, 14 coming in the first half.

The Huskies' inside game was also solid, outrebounding Western Illinois, 41-32, and outscoring the Westerwinds in the paint, 26-18. Center Ebony Ellis (Joliet, Ill./Joliet Township) finished with 10 points, while forward Mauvolylene Adams led both teams in rebounding with a career-high 13 boards and added four points.
