Northern Illinois' Anne Mucci is the lone player in Northern Illinois history to score at least 40 goals and record at least 40 assists during her career. The NCAA's select list includes such

notable U.S. stars as Mia Hamm, (North Carolina), Kristine Lilly (North Carolina), Tiffany Milbrett (Portland), Danielle Fotopoulos (SMU/Florida) and Abby Wambach (Florida). Mucci finished her career with 43 goals and 43 assists for a total of 129 points. When her college career ended in 1998, Mucci was just the 23rd player in history to join the exclusive "40-40 Club." The holder of several NIU individual scoring records, a two-time All-MAC selection and 1998 MAC Player of the Year, Mucci was selected to the Huskie Athletics Hall of Fame in 2008.
