OVERALL

The University of Northern Iowa baseball team finished with a 26-24 overall record, 9-15 in the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC). It recorded a five-game win streak near the end of the season, including a series sweep over Bradley. However, the Panthers were unable to secure an MVC tournament bid, falling one game short for the second consecutive season.

The MVC changed its weekend format to a three-game series, instead of the four-game structure of past seasons. This decreased UNI's conference schedule by eight games and also declared a winner of every series. UNI won three MVC series, taking at least two games from Illinois State, Creighton and Bradley. The Panthers placed senior LHP **Brandon Rinnan** (Urbandale, Iowa) on the second team all-conference. Junior catcher **Nate Trumm** (Dyersville, Iowa) and junior center fielder **Mark Frieske** (Spokane, Wash.) were MVC honorable mention selections.

Senior RHP/1B **Kory Kelchen** (Manchester, Iowa) broke into the school's all-time pitching records in his final season. He now is second all-time in career innings pitched with 274.1 bouts on the mound. He is preceded by Steve Beard (1993-95, 97) with 298.1 innings pitched. Redshirt freshman RHP **Bryan Westphal** (Dubuque, Iowa) now holds UNI's single-season record for appearances on the mound with 25. The previous mark of 22 was held by four individuals.

The Panthers also won the second annual Corridor Classic game in Cedar Rapids, defeating the Iowa Hawkeyes 9-7 in the annual event, and helped raise funds for the American Diabetes Association.

"As far as our season, at times it was frustrating," head coach Rick Heller said. "I am disappointed with how it ended at SMS. However, I am happy with the way we fought back from where we had positioned ourselves. Winning 26 games with the injuries we faced and the guys that were out even before the season started is a nice feat. Honestly, I am pretty happy with our effort."

SEASON/GBG RECAP

UNI started with a 17-game road swing during its first month of play. The Panthers took two games from Centenary College in Shreveport, La. UNI defeated the Gents 12-2 in the rubber game as 10 Panthers recorded a hit in the contest and redshirt freshman RHP **Jeff Hille** (Sauk Rapids, Minn.) gave up only one run in his first collegiate start. Then the team headed straight to Natchitoches (La.) to play Northwestern State to compete in the NSU Tournament. In the first game of the three-game round robin affair, junior LHP **Jake Hansen** (Council Bluffs, Iowa) pitched a nine-inning complete game shutout, striking out six Eastern Michigan batters. For his efforts, he was named MVC Pitcher of the Week Feb. 28. The Panthers fell twice that week to NSU, champions of the Southland Conference.

In Lubbock, Texas, UNI broke #22 Texas Tech's five-game win streak with a 9-7 victory. Junior shortstop **Pat Moran** (Rapid City, S.D.) went 3-for-4 with a triple and two RBIs. UNI fell 6-5 in game two of the series, despite redshirt freshman **Curt Bradley** (Columbia, Mo.) hitting the team's first home run of the season. The Panthers fell 11-5 in the rubber game.

UNI went 4-3 on its spring break trip in Bradenton, Fla. It lost to Kentucky (SEC) and then went on a four-game win streak, defeating Fairleigh Dickinson, Sacred Heart, Rhode Island and Bucknell. Kelchen struck out a career-high 12 batters and Moran had a career-high five hits and five RBIs against the Knights. Junior RHP **Zach Jevne** (Decorah, Iowa) pitched 7.0 innings against Sacred Heart and gave up only one earned run, striking out a season-high six batters. Trumm knocked his first home run of the season against the Pioneers and hit his second against Bucknell. UNI lost to Ohio State and Dartmouth before returning to the Cedar Valley.

The Panthers routed Clarke College 21-0 in their home opener on March 23. Redshirt freshman LHP **Aaron Jenkins** (Brooklyn Park, Minn.) struck out a career-high 11 Crusaders and UNI scored in every inning. Trumm went 2-for-2 with two RBIs, capping off his 11-game hit streak. Southern Illinois then swept the Panthers in the opening weekend of MVC

play in Carbondale, Ill. UNI recovered with two mid-week wins over Northern Illinois and Upper Iowa.

UNI won its longest game of the year against the NIU Huskies in the 15th inning, turning a triple play to end the game; freshman **Brett Douglas** (9), Moran (6) and junior **Andrew Farmer** (5) all assisted in the play. Freshman **Brett Featherston** (Epworth, Iowa) drove home the game-winning RBI in the top of the 15th and freshman RHP **Mark Bennett** (Cedar Rapids, Iowa) picked up the win.

The Panthers lost a heartbreaker in the first game of the series against Indiana State (April 1-3) at Riverfront Stadium, losing 5-3 in 10 innings. They picked up their first conference victory against the Sycamores in game two as Jevne pitched 8.0 innings with five strikeouts and Frieske tallied three RBIs.

UNI defeated Minnesota 2-0 in the teams' first meeting (April 6), giving up only five hits and scoring two runs in the seventh inning. The Panthers split with the Golden Gophers, losing 9-1 during the final week of the season. UNI faced Evansville April 8-10 in Indiana and lost three games to the Purple Aces, falling to 1-8 in the MVC.

The Panthers dropped a close game at Iowa City on April 12th to the Hawkeyes. Trumm and Frieske both went 3-for-4 in the 9-7 loss. The Panthers then took the teams' second meeting at the annual Corridor Classic, winning 8-6. Redshirt freshman **David Westergaard** (Sloan, Iowa) hit his first collegiate home run and Rinnan tallied his second save.

The Panthers shocked MVC tournament champion Wichita State, winning the first game of the series (April 15-17th). Westergaard hit the game-winning RBI in the bottom of the ninth to give UNI its first win over the Shockers since 2003. Game two was postponed overnight due to inclement weather and UNI lost 6-1. Jenkins went pitch-for-pitch with Mike Pelfrey in game three, but UNI still fell 3-1 to WSU.

Then, in non-conference action, the Panthers fell to Nebraska 7-4 at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa (April 20) and took a three-game series from North Dakota State (April 22-24). The weather also was a factor as wind, rain and even a few snow flurries blasted Riverfront during the final three home weekends.

The Panthers won their first MVC series against Illinois State (April 29-May 1), taking two games from the Redbirds at Riverfront Stadium. Hille pitched 7.0 innings in game one, striking out a career high, and UNI's top relievers - Westphal and Rinnan - closed out the game. The Panthers defeated ISU 7-1 in the rubber game as Douglas (St. Charles, Iowa) went 3-for-4 with a double and four RBIs.

The Panthers continued their winning ways in Omaha, Neb. against the MVC regular season champion, #29 Creighton (May 6-8). UNI 10-run ruled CU in eight innings, 17-7 in game one. It recorded the most hits (23) CU has given up since April 20th, 2003, also against the Panthers. The Panthers went on to win game two 9-5. Junior outfielder **Clayton Daniels** (Moulton, Iowa) had an outstanding weekend against the Bluejays. He hit .747, had seven RBIs and a home run in three games at the CU Sports Complex. Daniels was named MVC Player of the Week and Scholar Athlete of the Week for his efforts.

UNI won its final five games at Riverfront Stadium against South Dakota State and Bradley. The Panthers defeated the Jackrabbits 5-4 May 10. Westergaard hit his second game-winning RBI with two outs in the bottom of the 10th inning. The Panthers dropped SDSU 5-3 in the second game.

The UNI pitching staff compiled a 1.44 ERA in three games against Bradley (May 13-15), holding the Braves to only four runs. The Panthers swept their first MVC series since 2002 and moved into a tie for fifth place in the Valley. UNI 10-run ruled Bradley in game one; Hille threw his first complete game, pitching seven innings. The Panthers then won two pitchers' duals as Westphal picked up two wins in relief and Rinnan tallied two saves.

UNI played for the first time at Hammons Field in Springfield, Mo. against Southwest Missouri State (May 19-21). The Bears swept the Panthers and ended their MVC tournament hopes. UNI lost 8-7 in game one in 10 innings and then tallied only three runs in the following two games. The Panthers were exactly one game back from making the six-team MVC tournament. UNI finished tied for eighth in the MVC.

UNI lost five seniors: Kory Kelchen, Brandon Rinnan, Hans Frey, Jose Guzman and Eric DeJong. "We are really going to miss Kory Kelchen. He has been with us for four years and did a nice job for us down the stretch when we really needed it," Heller said. "Brandon Rinnan bounced back after having a tough junior year and found a new role. He is a big reason why we were able to win some games. I feel bad that Jose Guzman's senior season was hampered by an injury. I believe that if we would have had Jose the entire season, we really would have been in the tournament. It would have made a big difference in our ball club if Jose would have been able to stay healthy."

LOOKING AHEAD

The Panthers return a host of experienced pitchers and position players. Five returning starting position players will be seniors: Frieske, Farmer, Trumm, Moran and Daniels. There also were many newcomers that gained valuable playing time.

“Going into the summer, we are all very positive and optimistic about next year with the group of guys we have returning,” Heller said. “Hopefully, we can get some of the guys that were hurt and did not play at all back for next season. Recruiting has gone well and we are excited for next year. A lot of young guys, including position players, got valuable playing time this year. All of them were thrown into big roles. They handled it really well and improved as the season progressed.

“I think the group we have coming back for next year is a good group. Hopefully the seniors we have next year will be strong leaders for us. I know they were disappointed with how the season ended this year. I just think that everyone that is coming back is a team player and has a good work ethic. We should be set up to have a good year next year.”

The young pitching staff is a major positive for the UNI baseball team.

“Pitching was one of our biggest strengths as the season went on,” Heller said. “One of the biggest positives was how our pitchers developed and matured over the course of the season. A lot of young guys were forced into action early. Guys like Jeff Hille, Taylor Sinclair, Aaron Jenkins and Bryan Westphal all did a great job for us toward the end of the season. They were really the guys that were carrying us on the mound for the most part.”

UNI COACHES

UNI head coach **Rick Heller** (Upper Iowa '89) finished his sixth year at the helm of the UNI baseball squad. He has compiled a record of 166-173-1 as a Panther, 457-367-4 overall. In six years, he has transformed the Panthers into a conference contender in one of the most challenging leagues in the nation. Under Heller, the Panthers have made MVC tournament appearances three of the last five years, winning the title in 2001. Prior to UNI, Heller coached Upper Iowa to a 291-194-3 record in 12 seasons. He won three regular season Iowa conference titles and three tournament titles with the Peacocks. He also is a member of the Upper Iowa Athletic Hall of Fame, lettering in baseball, basketball and football as a student-athlete.

He is assisted by **Dan Davis** (Southern Illinois '95), **Ryan Jacobs** (UNI, '98), and graduate assistant **Marty Sutherland** (UNI, '02).

Junior outfielder Clayton Daniels hit .747 May 6-8th en route to becoming UNI's first MVC Player of the Week selection this season. He was a major element in the Panthers' 2-1 series win at Creighton. He also was named MVC Male Scholar Athlete of the Week.

He doubled his conference RBI total, tallying seven in two games, and did not strike out over the course of the entire weekend. Daniels went 4-for-4 with four RBIs and three runs in UNI's 17-7 victory on Friday. He had back-to-back four-hit games, recording three RBIs and his third home run of the season on Saturday to help the Panthers win the series. Daniels leads the Panthers with a .340 conference batting average. He recorded a 1.182 slugging percentage, hitting two doubles and a home run.

Daniels redshirted last season after transferring from Indian Hills Community College, where he hit .344 and racked up 28 home runs in two seasons.

MVC MALE SCHOLAR ATHLETE (March 7)

Junior catcher Nate Trumm was named Missouri Valley Scholar Athlete of the Week for Feb. 28-March 6. He hit .583 while collecting seven hits and an RBI in a three-game series at 22nd-ranked Texas Tech March 4-6. Trumm, who has a 3.19 cumulative grade-point average in marketing, went 3-for-5, scored twice and knocked in a run in the Panthers' 9-7 win over the Red Raiders on March 4.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK (Feb. 28)

Junior left hand pitcher Jake Hansen was named Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week for Feb. 21-27. The Council Bluffs native, in his second start after undergoing arm surgery, pitched a complete game shutout against Eastern Michigan Feb. 25. He allowed just six hits while striking out six in the Panthers' 4-0 win. In addition, the Eagles batted a mere .214 against Hansen.

HILL CONTROL

RHP Jeff Hille definitely had jurisdiction on the mound Friday the 13th. The Sauk Rapids, Minn. native pitched his first complete game against Bradley. He gave up a mere four hits and one run in 7.0 innings pitched. He served up 13 ground outs, including a 6-4-3 double play ball. Hille even struck out the final batter looking.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT

UNI's pitching staff had its best weekend outing of the season against Bradley. It tallied a 1.44 ERA and gave up only 15 hits in 25.0 innings last weekend. The bullpen did not allow a run and struck out 12 batters in 10.1 innings pitched. Bryan Westphal tallied two wins, while Brandon Rinnan picked up two saves.

BRUISE CONTROL

Junior Nate Trumm was hit by pitch on three consecutive plate appearances May 7 against Creighton. He was hit 15 times this season and is ranked fourth in the MVC. His overall on base percentage of .450 is ninth in the Valley and was upped by a .571 mark at Creighton.

HIT-TAGIOUS

Once the Panthers started hitting May 6, there was no stopping them. UNI recorded a hit in every single inning and recorded two five-plus hit innings. Five Creighton pitchers failed to contain the spread of hits, giving up 16 earned runs. At the end of the ambush, UNI had recorded a season-high 23 hits. The last time Creighton gave up that many hits was April 20, 2003, also against the Panthers.

TURF DREAMS

During head coach Rick Heller's tenure at UNI, the Panthers have won every series at Creighton. UNI has gone 9-2 at the CU Sports Complex. It won three games in 2001 and swept the series in 2003. The Panthers had won eight consecutive games in Omaha, Neb. until May 8, 2005. Prior to Heller's arrival, UNI was 20-2 at Creighton.

PAT AT THE PLATE

UNI's junior shortstop was seventh in the Valley with 44 RBIs. Pat Moran (Rapid City, S.D.) hit .308 with 11 doubles and two home runs. He hit .412 with runners on and was 9-of-14 with the bases loaded. Nearly half (19) of his RBIs have come with two outs.

DOUBLE DUTY FOR DOUGLAS

Freshman Brett Douglas hit like two people April 26-May 1. Coincidentally, his twin, Brett, was on the Panthers' roster but red-shirted. The St. Charles, Iowa native hit .545, starting four games in right field. Douglas went 3-for-4 against Illinois State May 1, producing more than half (4) of the Panthers' RBIs. He also assisted in two double plays over the weekend. He went 2-for-2 with an RBI against Iowa April 26 before being sidelined after a pitch hit his helmet.

FINALLY – A WIN ON SUNDAY

With the two games UNI won against Illinois State April 29th and May 1st, it was able to win its first MVC series since May 10, 2003 at Evansville, Ind. The Panthers split five series last year, but were unable to take the three games needed. UNI clinched the rubber game Sunday, something it had been unable to do all year.

RINNAN IS JUST RIGHT FOR LEFTIES

Only three left-handed batters mustered a hit off of senior Brandon Rinnan. The southpaw from Urbandale (Iowa) held lefties to a .143 batting average. Rinnan picked up his first save on April 24th against North Dakota State and his second two days later against Iowa. He also was clutch with two outs, only giving up three hits in 28 at bats. Rinnan led the Panther staff with a .70 ERA in 25.2 innings of work, striking out 23 and walking 15.

WINDY RIVERFRONT

The jet stream impeded the Panthers' non-conference weekend April 22-24, sending near freezing temperatures and harsh winds to Waterloo, Iowa. The UNI and North Dakota State squads battled not only each other, but 25-40 MPH wind gusts throughout their three-game series. The temps did not rise above 50 degrees, despite sunny skies.

DOUBLE WS

Redshirt freshmen David Westergaard and Bryan Westphal were the winning combination in April 15th's 7-6 victory over Wichita State. RHP Westphal entered in the top of the ninth, striking out one and serving up a ground out to strand Shockers on first and third. In the bottom of the inning, Westergaard worked out of a 0-2 count to hit the game-winning RBI and reward UNI with its first win over WSU in two years.

PITCH-FOR-PITCH WITH PELFREY

Southpaw Aaron Jenkins squared off in a pitcher's dual with national Player of the Year candidate Mike Pelfrey April 17th. The redshirt freshman pitched 7.1 innings against Wichita State, striking out five and granting only three walks. This was his longest appearance of the season; prior to this he had pitched a maximum of 5.0 innings three times. In Jenkins' last full inning, he struck out the side, two looking. Jenkins took a three-hit, one-run performance into the eighth inning.

ONE BAD INNING

Nearly half of UNI's losses came when its opponent went on a scoring run. In 11 games, including six MVC contests, the Panthers have allowed their opponent to put five or more runs on the board in one inning. UNI also averaged one error and one free pass to first base, either by walk or hit by pitch, in those innings.

GETTING 'FRIESKE'

Junior transfer Mark Frieske (pronounced Frisk-ee) was stationed as the lead-off hitter until April 2 when he was bumped into the nine-slot. Frieske (Spokane, Wash.) hit .500 in the hole during the final two games of the Indiana State series, tallying three RBIs. In the Panthers' first conference win, he plated one-third of UNI's runs. He was 3-for-3 with runners on third base, as well.

WHEW (9-6-5)

The Panther coaching staff could not have written a better ending to UNI's game at Northern Illinois March 29. In the bottom of the 15th inning, UNI led 4-3 after freshman Brett Featherston had hit a game-winning RBI single. NIU loaded the bases with no outs and lined a ball out to right-fielder Brett Douglas. Reacting quickly, Douglas jumped to catch the ball, threw to second and retired a runner scurrying to tag. Pat Moran then threw to third baseman Andrew Farmer, completing the triple play by appealing that the runner left early at third.

The last triple play recorded by the Panthers was a 5-4-3 on Feb. 29, 2000. Aaron McEachran started the play in the first inning of the 10-3 win over North Dakota.

NO MERCY

UNI nearly recorded its largest margin of victory in school history March 23. The Panthers defeated Clarke College in their home opener 21-0. The last time UNI shut out a team and scored more than 20 runs was in 1964 when it defeated North Dakota 22-0. UNI now has won by 20 or more runs four times in school history.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

Kory Kelchen was asked to step into various roles March 25-27 with the injury bug taking its toll on Panther starters. Kelchen started on the mound for a sidelined Jake Hansen Friday in the conference opener in Carbondale, Ill. and then played first base on Sunday. He was the only four-year member of UNI's squad. He led UNI offensively in the final game of the series, going 3-for-4 at the plate with a double. Kelchen tallied UNI's first hit of the game and its last, trying to spur a ninth-inning rally.

STREAKIN'

Junior catcher/designated hitter Nate Trumm recorded a hit in 11 consecutive games. The Dyersville (IA) native started the streak against Kansas State on Feb. 27 and it ended on March 25 at Southern Illinois.

2-FOR-2

Redshirt freshman Bryan Westphal picked up his first two collegiate saves in two days in Florida. He secured a 3-1 Panther victory over Sacred Heart on March 13, closing out the bottom of the ninth inning with 16 pitches and two strikeouts. The following afternoon the right-hander pitched 2.0 innings against Rhode Island and allowed just one hit in UNI's win.

A+ PERFORMANCE

With five games slated for five days in Florida, it was necessary that starting pitchers Kory Kelchen and Zach Jevne take charge on the mound. They both took their assignment very seriously and pitched overall 15 innings, allowing no earned runs and only five hits. RHP Kelchen donated 8.0 innings of work against Fairleigh Dickinson Saturday and struck out a career-high 12 batters. RHP Jevne struck out six and walked one Sacred Heart batter in Sunday's game.

MORAN HITS CAREER HIGH

Junior Pat Moran hit a career-high five hits against Fairleigh Dickinson (3/12), tallying five RBIs. He had totaled six multiple hit and multiple RBI games. Travis Welsch was the last UNI player to have five hits in a game against Indiana State March 23, 2002.

GOING

Rhode Island was unable to stop UNI on the base path March 14. The Panthers stole a season-high eight bases in just as many attempts. Nick Cameron, Nate Trumm and Brett Douglas each had two apiece, while Andrew Farmer and Pat Moran stole second one time. The season high previously was three in a game against Texas Tech.

GO LONG

Redshirt freshman Curt Bradley's fall season is spent on the football field as a receiver while in the spring he steps up to the plate for the UNI baseball team. The 5-9, 165-pounder may not look like he can hit one out of the park, but that is exactly what he did in the ninth inning against #22 Texas Tech. Bradley hit the Panthers' first home run of the season with a 0-1 count, shrinking the Raiders' lead by one. He has emerged as one of UNI's top utility men, playing outfield or second base on several occasions and pinch hitting and running in crucial situations.

FIGHTING TOUGH AT DAN LAW FIELD

March 4 marked the first time in two years that UNI had defeated a ranked team. The Panthers gave #22 Texas Tech its second loss of the season with a 9-7 win. Coincidentally, on March 2, 2003 the Panthers also took down a 22-ranked Texas Tech team 10-9 at Dan Law Field.

UNI DELIVERS A DOZEN RUNS TO RAIDER STARTERS

The Panthers took the Red Raiders' starting pitchers out of the lineup almost immediately March 4-6. Their starting rotation pitched a total of just 3.1 innings and gave up 12 earned runs to UNI. The Panthers tallied 10 overall hits and nine walks against the TTU starting three.

SLIPPING AND SLIDING

Despite slippery conditions, sophomore Ryan Norman caught seven fly balls in right field, one before it hit the wall and another on a diving play, against Northwestern State Feb. 26. He battled standing water in right field throughout the entire NSU Demon Classic.

CAUGHT YA

True freshman Jason Smith is a severe threat to opposing baserunners. The Souix Falls, S.D. native caught three Eastern Michigan runners trying to steal. Smith made the third out in the first two innings, throwing out a runner at second and one at third. He then caught another runner at second in the eighth inning. Smith was a two-time all-stater at O'Gorman High School and was voted Top Prospect from the Dakotas by *Baseball America*.

LEADING OFF

Senior Jose Guzman led the team in many categories at Centenary, including on base percentage (.706) and slugging percentage (.700). He not only batted .500 but got to first by any means possible. The El Monte, Calif. native recorded four walks and was hit by pitch three times Feb. 18-20. Guzman's effort at the plate paid off for the Panthers as he scored seven runs, 25 percent of UNI's trips home.

UNI KEPT GOING AND GOING . . .

The Panthers took batting practice during the third inning of the series' final against Centenary (Feb. 20). UNI tallied six hits, was hit by pitch twice and walked three times in the inning, as 10 players batted before the Gents could force a mere out. Eight Panthers crossed home plate and five batted twice before the onslaught was over.

SOUTHPAW HITS ZONE DOWN SOUTH

Junior left hand pitcher Jake Hansen was right on target in Shreveport, La. (Feb. 19). The Council Bluffs (IA) native recorded eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched and limited the Gents to only three hits and no runs. He tallied 92 pitches in his first outing of the season.
