## THIS WEEK IN PANTHER WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

The Panthers travel to Seattle to take part in the Basketball Travelers Husky Classic. UNI will take on Miami (Ohio) on Saturday, then will face either St. Louis or Washington on Sunday.

### PANTHERS HEAD TO SEATTLE FOR HUSKY CLASSIC

The University of Northern Iowa women's basketball team will head west in search of its first win of the season. The Panthers (0-3) will face Miami (Ohio) in the opening round of the Basketball Travelers Husky Classic on Saturday at 2:30 p.m. On Sunday UNI will play either St. Louis or Washington.

The Panthers have been led this season by a pair of seniors, Tara King and Jessie Biggs. In her last outing, King scored a career-high 38 points, ranking third in the UNI single-game scoring records. King has averaged 33 points per game in the last two contests, and she is averaging 23.7 points per game this season. Biggs led UNI with a career-high 22 points in the season opener, and is averaging 17.3 points per game.

The Basketball Travelers Husky Classic field is full of new faces for the Panthers, as UNI will meet Miami for the first time. The Panthers have never played Washington, and have only played St. Louis four times before with the last meeting coming on Jan. 17, 1994.

The Red Hawks (1-2) enter the tournament after dropping their last two contests. Miami fell 90-89 to Robert Morris on Nov. 12 and 80-51 to Northwestern on Nov. 17.

Amanda Jackson leads Miami with 18.3 points per game. Jenna Schone is averaging 11.7 points per game for the Red Hawks.

St. Louis enters the tournament with a spotless 4-0 record. The Billikens have earned wins over Akron, Chicago State, Tennessee State and UT-Martin. The Husky Classic will be the first road test for SLU. St. Louis has four players scoring in double figures, Tyler McIlwraith (16.8 ppg), Katie Paganelli (14.8 ppg), Theresa Lisch (14.5 ppg) and Amanda Kemezys (13.5 ppg).

The Husky Classic will be the first time this season that Washington will play on its home court. Washington has dropped its last two contests, losing at Marquette 78-61 and at Purdue 88-64. The Huskies will play at Eastern Illinois on Tuesday.

Head Coach Tony DiCecco

12th Season  
166-151 Career Record

Tony DiCecco has delivered success for more than a decade as the head coach of the University of Northern Iowa women's basketball team. As the chancellor of the Missouri Valley Conference coaches, he was named MVC Coach of the Year in 2005.

In 2005-06, DiCecco led the Panthers to a third-place MVC finish and the school's third WNIT appearance.

DiCecco guided the 2004-05 Panthers, who were picked to finish sixth in the MVC, to a record-breaking 20-win season and a second-place finish. Not only is he the winningest coach in the program's history, he has amassed 42 percent of the program's victories in only 33 percent of games played. Under DiCecco, the UNI women's basketball program has gone above and beyond all expectations.

DiCecco, in his 12th season as UNI's coach, has made his mark as the most successful women's basketball coach in University of Northern Iowa history. He has brought stability and a winning attitude to a program that had seen little of both prior to his arrival in the 1995-96 season. DiCecco has had 27 players named to MVC Academic All-Conference teams.

DiCecco is a 1971 graduate of Upper Iowa University in Fayette, Iowa, where he played collegiate baseball. He arrived at UNI from Creighton University, where he served as an assistant coach for six seasons. During his tenure at Creighton, the Lady Jays compiled a 122-52 record, including two regular-season Western Athletic Conference (WAC) championships, one WAC Tournament Championship and two NCAA tournament appearances.

Prior to his arrival at Creighton, DiCecco was the head girls' basketball coach at Montezuma High School in Montezuma, Iowa. He compiled a 306-69 record, including eight conference, 10 sectional and two regional championships. His teams made two Iowa State Tournament appearances.

In addition, he served as the head girls' softball coach from 1974-86 at Montezuma and coached at West Central High in Maynard, Iowa from 1971-73. His 1973 team finished third in the Iowa State Softball Tournament. He taught physical education and social studies at a variety of levels at both Montezuma and West Central.

DiCecco, a native of Niagara, N.Y., resides in Cedar Falls with his wife of 36 years, Kristi.

## LAST TIME OUT

The University of Northern Iowa women's basketball team could not hold on to a 13-point second-half lead as Iowa State rallied to come away with an 80-74 overtime win in the McLeod Center opener on Monday.

UNI senior Tara King led all scorers with a career-high 38 points. The Ottumwa, Iowa, native finished 15-of-24 from the floor, setting new career highs for both field goals made and field goals attempted. Senior Jessie Biggs and Megan Keefe also scored in double figures for the Panthers, adding 17 and 16 points, respectively. King, Biggs and Keefe combined to score 71 of UNI's 74 points, with freshman Lindsey Swanson being the only other Panther to score in the game.

The Panthers led through most of the first half, and built a seven point lead when Keefe hit a three at 13:56 that made the score 16-9. Iowa State chipped away at the lead, and the Cyclones tied the game at 20-20 when Lyndsey Medders connected from three with 9:35 left in the half. The Panther stayed within four points of the Cyclones, and a free throw from King with 28 seconds on the clock tied the game at 27. A pair of free throws from Rachel Pierson gave ISU a 29-27 lead with three seconds left in the half. The Panthers pushed the ball up the floor, and an ISU defender tipped the ball out of bounds with .7 seconds remaining. Sarah Larsen found Biggs at the three-point line with the inbounds pass, and her shot fell true to put UNI up 30-29 with the break.

The teams traded baskets and one-point leads until a three from Biggs put UNI up 35-33 with 18:33 to play. That was the beginning of a 9-0 run by the Panthers that included a layup and free throw from King and a set of three free throws from Biggs that put UNI up 42-33 with 16:32 remaining. The Panthers went up by double figures for the first time when Keefe hit a turn-around jump shot that gave UNI a 54-43 lead.

King was 6-of-8 from the floor and scored 15 points through the first 13 minutes of the second half. Her jump shot with 7:26 to play put the Panthers up 60-47, giving UNI its largest lead of the game.

Iowa State scored on four of its next five possessions to cut UNI's lead to 64-58 with 3:22 to play. Heather Ezell connected on threes on consecutive ISU trips to bring the Cyclones to within two, 66-64 with 2:17 to play.

Biggs brought it back to a two-possession game with a jump shot with 1:45 remaining. Pierson scored two unanswered layups for Iowa State to tie the game at 68 with 43 seconds to play.

The Cyclones rebounded UNI's missed jump shot with 20 seconds remaining, giving ISU a chance at the final shot. Medders went up for the shot with 5 seconds remaining, but Biggs came up with a block. Pierson grabbed the offensive board, but her shot did not fall, sending the game into overtime.

Keefe scored on UNI's first possession of the extra period, but Ezell answered on the Cyclone end to tie the game at 70. King gave the lead back to UNI with a jump shot with 3:06 left in overtime, but a three from Ross put ISU on top, 73-72 with 2:45 to play. UNI came up empty-handed on its next two trips, and ISU took advantage with baskets from Medders and Pierson that gave ISU a five-point lead, 77-72 with 54 seconds left. A pair of free throws from Biggs brought UNI back to within three, but the Panthers were unable to completely close the gap.

## IRON WOMAN

Jessie Biggs has started the last 77 games for the Panthers. If she starts the first 23 games this season, she will surpass former Panther and current associate head coach Allison (Starr) Pohlman for record consecutive starts (96). Biggs has 80 total starts, and if she starts every scheduled game this season, she will move to third on the career games started list with 107. With 91 games under her belt, Biggs is 27 games away from tying Amy Swisher for most games played in her career. UNI has 27 games remaining on its schedule, including the first round of the MVC Tournament.

## SHE'S ON FIRE!

Senior Tara King has been nearly unstoppable in UNI's last two games. Against Weber State on Nov. 17, King led all scorers with 28 points, and she set a new career high with 38 points against Iowa State on Nov. 20. King shot a combined 23-45 (51 percent) from the floor, and she was 5-11 (45 percent) from three-point range. Besides points, King set career highs for field goals and field goal attempts against ISU.

## NOT TO JINX HER, BUT...

Jessie Biggs has connected on her last 21 free throw attempts. Biggs is a perfect 17-17 from the stripe in 2006-07, and she made her final four free throws in the 2005-06 season. Biggs' last free-throw miss came at 13:53 in the first half at Kansas in the first round of the WNIT on March 16, 2006.

## UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY

The Panthers are not used to a losing streak as long as the current three-game streak. UNI has not lost three straight games since December 2004, when the Panthers fell to Iowa, Iowa State and Northwestern in consecutive contests. This

is the first time UNI has started 0-3 since the 2003-04 season, when UNI started 0-4.

## CAREER EFFORT

Tara King's 38 points against Iowa State on Nov. 20 overshadowed a career night for junior Megan Keefe. Keefe set career highs for points (16), field goals (7), field goal attempts (14), and minutes (39) in the loss to Iowa State.

## 'BIGG' NIGHT

Senior Jessie Biggs had a career night at Minnesota on Nov. 10. The Ottumwa, Iowa, native shot 8-of-16 from the floor and was a perfect 6-of-6 from the free-throw line to lead all scorers with 22 points. Biggs also led the Panthers in rebounds with eight and assists with six.

## SUPER SENIORS

UNI's three seniors enter the season with plenty of experience. The trio of Jessie Biggs, Tara King and Sarah Larsen have started a combined 148 games in their careers. The three accounted for more than half of UNI's point total a year ago, combining for 32.5 points per game. The Panthers have won 51 games with Biggs, King and Larsen on the roster, putting them 18 wins shy of becoming the winningest class in UNI history.

## CHANGE OF PACE

For the first time in four seasons, the Panthers will take to the court without 6-7 center Cassie Hager. To adjust to life after the MVC's all-time blocked shots leader, the Panthers will install a new style of play that relies less on a half-court offense and more on up-tempo, fast break scoring. The style will be more conducive to UNI's guard-heavy roster, and the shooting range of forwards Tara King and Megan Keefe will help open up the offense.

The Panthers have three sets of high school teammates on their roster. Seniors Jessie Biggs and Tara King played together at Ottumwa High, sophomore Kristyn Ferris and freshman Danielle Wubbens both played at Charles City High, and freshmen Lindsey Swanson and Nicole Clausen both played at Denison-Schleswig.

### CONNECTING FROM THREE

The Panthers' two returning forwards also represent the two most accurate three-point shooters from last season. Senior Tara King and junior Megan Keefe finished first and second on the team in three-point shooting percentage in 2005-06. King led the MVC with 47.7 percent (42-of-88) shooting from behind the arc, and Keefe shot 12-of-28 (42.9 percent) from three-point range.
