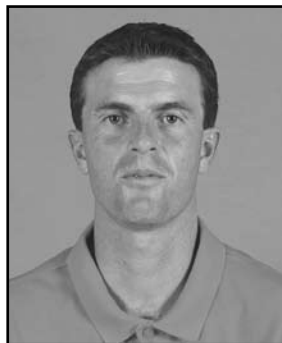

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Half Day Developmental Program: Boys Age 6-10

July 14-17/July 21-24 **9:00 am – Noon**

This program's main emphasis will be learning through FUN! Campers will play together in small-sided games, providing players as many touches as possible. All players will be taught the fundamental skills of the game along with basic team shape. Skill development, fun, and enthusiasm are shared throughout the week.

Campers will receive a Lobo/Nike T-shirt and must bring their own soccer ball.

Full Day Individual Program: Boys Age 11-16

July 14-17/July 21-24 **9:00 am – 3:30 pm**
[9-12 on Thurs.]

The goal of this program is to develop each camper into a more serious soccer player. Players of all levels will improve fundamental skills through dynamic activities and games in a stimulating and challenging environment. Players will be placed in groups according to age and/or ability. Mornings will emphasize individual skills and afternoons will concentrate on team tactics and games. Video and chalkboard sessions will be incorporated into the afternoons.

Campers will receive a Lobo/Nike T-shirt and a Nike ball.

High School Team

Residential Program: Boys High School Age

July 13-17 **Sun: 1:30 pm check in**
early check in available
Thurs: 12 noon Check out

This program is designed for teams looking to immerse themselves in a passionate soccer environment for an entire week. This program will emulate training and playing components of the collegiate soccer game with a focus on team play. Teams may request specific curriculum instruction from the Lobo Soccer Academy. All coaches will be professional soccer coaches and under the direct guidance of program directors. One coach and all team members will stay in the University of New Mexico student dormitories. Residential campers will stay in the UNM college dorms, eat three meals a day in the UNM dining facility, and have 24-hour supervision while attending camp.

Campers will receive a Lobo/Nike T-shirt and a Nike ball. All meals and housing provided.

Residential Elite Program: Boys Age 15-20

July 20-24 **Sun: 1:30 pm check in**
early check in available
Thurs: 12 noon Check out

The "Elite Program" is designed for the most serious and dedicated players with collegiate or professional playing aspirations. Campers who are entering the 10th grade through their freshmen year in college are invited. Mornings will consist of advanced technical and tactical sessions and will simulate UNM training sessions. Afternoons will involve team chalkboard discussions, video, quickness and speed enhancement training. The evening sessions will include match play. All sessions will be overseen by UNM coaches and will be very physically demanding! Residential campers will stay in the UNM college dorms, eat three meals a day in the UNM dining facility, and have 24-hour supervision while attending camp.

Campers will receive a Lobo/Nike T-shirt and a Nike ball. All meals and housing provided.

LOBO SOCCER PROGRAM

The Lobos have advanced to the NCAA playoffs six of the last seven seasons. In 2004 the Lobos played into the "Sweet 16" of the NCAA tournament. In 2005 the Lobos continued to make history by advancing to the NCAA National Championship. Head coach Jeremy Fishbein has seen to it that the Lobos maintain the highest academic standards with a 3.2 GPA or higher the last six seasons. All the while the Lobos have maintained their commitment to community service.



Lobo Soccer Facilities

All Academy programs will take place at the UNM South Campus Athletic Complex. The facilities include the premier playing and training facilities in the country, which are adjacent to classrooms, the UNM athletic training room, the Lobo weight room, and a state-of-the-art indoor facility. Directions to facilities will be mailed upon receipt of your applications.

Goalkeeping Academy

Professional goal keeping instruction will be offered for all campers. The morning session will include technical goal keeper training while afternoon sessions will incorporate goalkeepers into team training. Specific tactical sessions and fitness training are designed for goalkeepers.

Camp Equipment & What to Bring

Half Day campers will receive a high quality Lobo Soccer/Nike t-shirt and full day campers will receive a Nike Camp ball and Lobo Soccer/Nike t-shirt. All campers must bring proper playing equipment, extra socks/t-shirts, SUNSCREEN and lunch if applicable.

Medical Supervision

Qualified UNM athletic trainers will be present at all times during the duration of all programs. Trainers will care for minor injuries, sickness and ensure that all campers receive proper hydration. In case of an emergency, the UNM training room is located adjacent to the training fields.
