## 2007 Season Recap

The University of New Mexico men's soccer team put together another stellar campaign in 2007, claiming the program's fourth consecutive Mountain Pacific Sports Federation title. The Lobos capped the 10-win mark for the 16th time in school history with a 12-5-2 overall record, including 7-1-2 in MPSF action. New Mexico also advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven seasons. The Lobos are 61-12-10 since the start of the 2004 season and their .795 winning percentage is the highest in the NCAA during that span.

UNM started slow out of the gates, failing to score in a pair of exhibition losses to No. 11 Notre Dame (-0-3) and No. 8 Indiana (0-1) in Fort Wayne, Ind. UNM went on to drop its season opener for the first time since 2000 with a 3-1 loss at Akron. The Lobos rebounded with a 3-1 win against Hartwick at Akron's Westfield Cup Tournament.

The Lobos also lost its home opener to Loyola Marymount 1-0 on Sept. 7. After a 1-0 win over Cincinnati and a 1-0 loss to No. 24 Washington, New Mexico found itself sitting at 2-3-0 five games into the season. UNM had also dropped two games at the UNM Soccer Complex, something it had not done since the 2001 season. However, an impressive 2-1 win over No. 9 and defending NCAA Champion UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 16 sparked a streak of eight matches without a loss. UNM's only other regular season setback came at UNLV in a 2-1 misstep in double-overtime.

New Mexico's eight-match winning streak included a two-game non-conference tear through California. The Lobos dropped Cal-State Northridge 4-0 and No. 12 San Francisco 2-0 to end the non-conference schedule.

MPSF action began with a 1-1 draw against Denver, followed by four straight wins. UNM outscored league opponents 14-3 through the first half of the conference season. After the 2-1 defeat at UNLV, New Mexico posted wins over Sacramento State (3-0), San Jose State (5-1) and Air Force (2-0), setting up the regular season finale at Denver. The Pioneers (10-4-4, 6-1-3 MPSF) were in a position to clinch the MPSF title with a win over New Mexico, while all the Lobos needed to do was tie the final match of the regular season. Senior Mike Graczyk posted his school-record 30th career shutout in the contest, giving the Lobos another MPSF trophy.

New Mexico was once again sent on the road in the first round, despite having a better record and ranking than their first round destination for the second year in a row. The Lobos traveled to UCLA where they stumbled in a 1-0 defeat. It was the first time UNM had been knocked out of the first round in six trips to the NCAA Tournament.

New Mexico individuals racked up postseason honors, led by junior Chris Wright who was named the 2007 MPSF Player of the Year. Five Lobos earned all region recognition while nine were named to the All-MPSF team. UNM had two Academic All-Americans making it one of only two programs in the country with at least one Academic All-American each year since 2003. Graczyk was drafted by the Colorado Rapids in the MLS Supplemental Draft following the season.

**LOBOS ADVANCE TO NCAA TOURNAMENT FOR SIXTH TIME:** UNM made its sixth appearance in the NCAA Tournament in school history this season. All of UNM's postseason bids have come since the 2001 campaign. UNM fell at UCLA 1-0 in the first round, marking UNM's first opening round exit in six trips to the NCAA Tournament. The Lobos are now 7-4-2 in NCAA Tournament action.

**UNM WINS SIXTH LEAGUE TITLE IN PROGRAM HISTORY:** Posting a 7-1-2 mark in MPSF action, the Lobos won their sixth league title in school history. All of UNM's league trophies have come since the 2001 season. UNM is 41-7-6 in MPSF action in six seasons under current head coach Jeremy Fishbein.

**LOBOS BOAST HIGHEST WINNING % SINCE 2004:** The University of New Mexico men's soccer team boasts the highest winning percentage in Division I over the last three years. The Lobos are 61-11-11 (.801) since the start of 2004. Only UC Santa Barbara (65-20-9), Maryland (62-18-10) and Wake Forest (67-18-10) have more wins than the Lobos over the last four years. Here is a look at the top teams in the nation based on winning percentage since 2004.

**WRIGHT NAMED MPSF PLAYER OF THE YEAR:** Junior Chris Wright was named the 2007 Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Player of the Year. Wright led the league in goals (12) and scoring (28 points) this season. He was twice named the MPSF Player of the Week during the regular season. Wright is the third Lobo to win the MPSF Player of the Year honor, joining Jeff Rowland (2004) and Andrew Boyens (2004 and 2006). Boyens and Rowland were co-Players of the Year in 2004 and Boyens won the award again in 2006.

**LOBOS TIE SCHOOL RECORD WITH FIVE PLAYERS ON THE ALL-REGION TEAM:** Five members of the University of New Mexico men's soccer team were named to the All-Far West Region squad, tying for the most on an all-region team in one season in school history. Seniors Mike Graczyk and David Gualdarama, junior Chris Wright and sophomores Zach Tierney and Simon Ejdemyr were all honored for their play in the 2007 season. Wright and Tierney were second team honorees while Graczyk, Gualdarama and Ejdemyr were named to the third team.

**NINE LOBOS EARN ALL-MPSF RECOGNITION:** Joining 2007 MPSF Player of the Year Chris Wright on the All-MPSF first team are sophomore defenders Simon Ejdemyr and Zach Tierney. A glaring omission from the first team was senior keeper Mike Graczyk, who earned second team honors. Despite leading the league in g.a.a. (0.74) and shutouts (6) for the third year in a row, Graczyk did not earn a spot on the first team. Not only was he not on the first team, he was the third keeper listed on the All-MPSF squad that was voted on by the league's coaches. Also on the second team for UNM were seniors Diego Barrera and David Gualdarama. Three Lobos earned honorable mention All-MPSF recognition, including senior Joey Vitagliano, junior Jack Smithson and sophomore Stephen Brown.

**ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN STREAK CONTINUES:** Junior Chris Wright and sophomore Simon Ejdemyr both earned ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American honors this season. Wright earned a spot on the first team while Ejdemyr was named to the third team. The Lobos have now had at least one representative on the squad each year since 2003. Only Maryland has had at least one student-athlete honored each year during that same stretch.

**WRIGHT 17TH IN THE NATION IN GOALS...WINS MPSF SCORING TITLE:** Lobo junior Chris Wright, the 2007 MPSF Player of the Year, secured the MPSF scoring title with 28 points on 12 goals and four assists. He was 19th in the NCAA in points per game (1.47) and 13th in the nation in goals per game (0.63).

**BARRERA LEADS MPSF IN ASSISTS:** Lobo senior Diego Barrera recorded eight assists on the season to lead the MPSF in that category. His 0.42 assist-per-game average ranked 34th in the nation for the second team All-MPSF honoree.

**GRACZYK AMONG NATION'S LEADERS IN G.A.A.:** UNM senior keeper Mike Graczyk posted a 0.744 goals-against-average in 2007, ranking 25th among NCAA Division I goalies.

It is the third consecutive season Graczyk ranked in the top-25 in the nation in g.a.a. His career 0.676 g.a.a. is the lowest in school history. Graczyk's 30 career shutouts is also a school record.

**LOBO DEFENSE RANKED IN THE TOP-25 AGAIN:** UNM posted an MPSF leading 0.710 goals-against-average in 2007, ranking 25th in the NCAA. It is the fourth consecutive season the Lobo defense has ranked in the top-25 in the NCAA.

**LOBO OFFENSE RANKED 14TH IN THE NATION:** New Mexico averaged 2.00 goals per game in 2007, ranking first in the MPSF and 14th in NCAA Division I.

**LOBOS TOUGH AT HOME UNDER FISHBEIN:** The Lobo men's soccer team has posted a 24-2-1 mark in Mountain Pacific Sports Federation action at the UNM Soccer Complex under head coach Jeremy Fishbein. The only two losses at home under Fishbein came against UNLV (2-0 on Oct. 18, 2003) and San Jose State (3-2 (OT) on Oct. 16, 2005). UNM has won 86% of their matches overall in six years under Fishbein at the UNM Soccer Complex, posting a 45-5-5 mark in his tenure.

**IN THE RANKINGS:** The Lobos finished the season No. 27 in the final CollegeSoccerNews.com Top-30 of the season. New Mexico has now been ranked for 51 consecutive weeks, dating back to the start of 2004.

**NEW MEXICO IS STRONG WITH A LEAD:** The Lobos are tough to beat when scoring first or leading at the half. In head coach Jeremy Fishbein's tenure, New Mexico is 75-3-7 when finding the back of the net first and 47-1-2 when holding a halftime lead. The last time UNM surrendered a lead and lost the match was at UNLV on Nov. 3, 2007, in a 2-1 OT loss to the Rebels. The only time the Lobos lost a match when leading at the half was a 3-2 loss to the Spartans in the finals of the 2003 MPSF Tournament Nov. 16, in Sacramento, Calif.

**2007 SENIOR CLASS TIES FOR MOST WINS:** The Lobos 2007 senior class tied for the most wins in a four-year span with a 61-12-10 record. Blake Danaher, Mike Graczyk, David Gualdarama, Diego Barrera and Joey Vitagliano made up the 2007 class. The 2005 group also won 61 games in their four years, posting a 61-16-8 mark.

**FIVE LOBOS NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT:** Seniors Mike Graczyk and Joey Vitagliano, juniors Mike Porter and Chris Wright and sophomore Simon Ejdemyr were named to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VI team. In order to qualify, a student-athlete must have at least a 3.2 cumulative grade-point-average and be a significant contributor on the team. Each of these five players are now eligible for Academic All-American. Wright was a second team Academic All-American selection last season.

**NEW MEXICO NINTH IN THE NCAA IN HOME ATTENDANCE:** UNM averaged 2,080 fans per game at the UNM Soccer Complex in the 2007 season. A total of 18,723 spun the turnstiles in nine home games this season, ranking ninth in average attendance in the NCAA. The Lobos were 6-2-1 in the nine home games in 2007. UNM has ranked in the top-15 in attendance each year since the 2001 season. The Lobos 3,629 average in 2005 is still a single-season NCAA record for average per game in a season.

**EIGHT LOBOS NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-MPSF:** The University of New Mexico men's soccer put eight players on the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation All-Academic squad. In order to qualify for Academic All-MPSF a student-athlete must have a 3.0 or better cumulative grade point average, be at least a sophomore academically, must have completed one full academic year at the institution prior to the season for which the award is being received and must have competed in fifty

## HEAD COACH JEREMY FISHBEIN



Fishbein is in his 15th year as a college head coach and his sixth at UNM. The Cincinnati, Ohio, native currently holds a 183-85-23 (.668) record that includes seven years at Fort Lewis College in Durango, Colo., two seasons at the University of the Incarnate Word in San Antonio, Tex., and five years at UNM. His record at New Mexico stands at 87-25-13 (.748). He was introduced as the Lobo's fourth coach in July 2002 after the retirement of Klaus Weber. Fishbein, 41, played college soccer for Richmond and Cincinnati before graduating from UC-Santa Barbara in 1989. He is married to Alicia Meraz, a former tennis player UNM. The couple has two daughters, Alisa (6) and Gabriela (3).

### NSCAA HONORS UNM FOR ACADEMIC WORK:

The Lobo men's soccer team earned the NSCAA Team Academic award for the fifth straight season in 2007 after posting above a 3.0 team grade-point-average. Seniors Mike Graczyk and Joey Vitagliano and junior Chris Wright were named to the NSCAA West Region Scholar-Athlete team while Wright was a second team national Scholar-Athlete selection.

### LOBOS NOT A GOOD HOST FOR DEFENDING

**CHAMPS:** UNM's 2-1 win over No. 9 and defending NCAA Champion UC Santa Barbara Gauchos marks the second time in four years a defending champion has left the UNM Soccer Complex with a loss. New Mexico also dropped No. 1 Indiana at home on Sept. 19, 2004, 1-0 in double-overtime.

### GRACZYK ETCHED HIS NAME IN THE LOBO RECORD

**BOOK:** With a 4-0 win over Cal State Northridge, senior keeper Mike Graczyk became UNM's all-time leader in shutouts with 27 in his career. He passed his predecessor Andrew Weber who played nearly every minute in goal from 2001-04. Graczyk finished with 30 career shutouts. His 0.676 career g.a.a. is also the lowest in school history. Graczyk was been the primary keeper from 2005 to 2007 and played all but 30 minutes this season. He is also in second place on the career wins list with 45. Weber holds the Lobo record with 50 career wins in goal.

### LOBOS PICKED TO WIN MPSF TITLE...AGAIN:

The coaches around the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation selected UNM as the preseason favorite to win the MPSF in 2007.

Lance Rozeboom is a freshman who began his collegiate career in January after graduating early from Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Anders Selander, a Swedish youth international and former youth teammate of current Lobo Simon Ejdemyr, comes to UNM from Ulrichehamn, Sweden. Mark Geria, an alumni of the prestigious Australian Institute of Sport, joins the Lobos after stints with the Australian U-23 Olympic team player pool. Five other high school players will join the Lobo program in the fall, including Travis Campbell, Justin Holmes, Seth Neben, Masashi Shibuya and Gary Weisbaum.
