THIS IS THE MOUNTAIN WEST

From its inception in 1999, the Mountain West Conference has been committed to excellence in intercollegiate athletics, while promoting the academic missions of its member institutions. Progressive in its approach, the MWC continues to cultivate opportunities for student-athletes to compete at the highest level, while fostering academic achievement and sportsmanship. Now in its seventh year, the MWC has been assertive in its involvement with the NCAA governance structure and has taken a leadership role in the overall administration of intercollegiate athletics.

The Mountain West Conference is noted for its geographic diversity. Some of the most beautiful terrain and landscapes in the nation can be found within Mountain West Conference boundaries, including the majestic Rocky Mountain range, which borders four MWC schools (Utah, BYU, Air Force and Colorado State). The high plains of Wyoming (elevation 7,220 feet – the highest Division I campus in the nation) contrast with the desert city of Las Vegas (the fastest growing metropolitan area in the West) and the Pacific Ocean locale of San Diego State. The southwestern flavor of New Mexico complements the western heritage and culture of Fort Worth, Texas, home of the MWC's newest member, TCU.

MWC WELCOMES TCU

The MWC navigated through the changing landscape of intercollegiate athletics when it announced in January 2004 that TCU would become the league's ninth member beginning with the 2005-06 athletic season. As realignment swept through several NCAA Division I conferences, the MWC remained focused in its mission and objectives, strengthening its membership for the road ahead. Founded in 1873, TCU will participate in all 19 Mountain West Conference sports. The Horned Frogs have captured 16 conference championships the last four years, and their athletic tradition reaches back to their first season of football in 1897.

EXPOSURE

Through the league's first six years, excluding institutional local packages, 574 football, volleyball, men's basketball and women's basketball events have aired on television, with 116 football games and over 100 men's basketball contests broad-

cast nationally. Currently in the final year of a seven-year deal with ESPN, the MWC has remained steadfast in its mission to promote the league's athletic events to national and regional television audiences.

With the advent of an in-house production entity in 2001, the MWC assured itself of a wide-range of television exposure for volleyball and women's basketball. In fact, the MWC is the only conference to have televised all contests from its volleyball and women's basketball championships each of the past five years. The Conference network includes a combination of over-the-air cable affiliates and local outlets throughout the Rocky Mountain region and western United States.

A new era begins in the fall of 2006 as College Sports Television (CSTV) becomes the official television partner for

the Conference. The MWC forged a potential 14-year agreement with CSTV, giving the fastest-growing independent cable network exclusive rights to Mountain West Conference football and men's basketball, plus coverage for all other MWC sports. With a "fans first" focus, CSTV has assured that MWC constituents will see more MWC sports at more convenient times and in more media platforms than ever before.

The agreement incorporates all Conference-related media and marketing rights, including all television, national over-the-air and satellite radio, video-on-demand, and online and broadband rights. The multi-media partnership also includes Mountain West TV, the first-ever regional sports network dedicated solely to an intercollegiate athletic conference.

EDUCATION INITIATIVES

Not only is the MWC committed to the highest academic standards for its member institutions, the league also launched an education initiative utilizing the platform of college athletics to provide a relevant teaching resource for Kindergarten-through-8th grade students. This web-based learning program is available to every public and private, elementary and middle school in the seven-state MWC region, impacting more than 6.5 million students. Designed by Learning Through Sports, Inc., "Kid's College" captivates and motivates children using their favorite sports with Mountain West teams and mascots reinforcing skills taught in the classroom.





- June 2, 1998 - Reaffirmed the intention to form a new conference that would begin preliminary operation January 1, 1999 in preparation of the 1999-2000 seasons.
- July 1, 1998 - Established an executive committee to facilitate the transition. Named Dr. Al Yates, Colorado State University President, chair. Also named Dr. Merrill Bateman of BYU and Dr. Carol Harter of UNLV to the committee.
- October 15, 1998 - Named Craig Thompson Commissioner of the Mountain West Conference.
- October 26, 1998 - Named the new league the Mountain West Conference.
- December 4, 1998 - Selected Colorado Spring, Colo. as the headquarters for the Mountain West Conference office.
- January 4, 1999 - The Mountain West Conference opened with Craig Thompson, Commissioner and Betty Warren, Director of Operations.
- January 10, 1999 - The new Mountain West Conference logo was unveiled.
- February 1, 1999 - Reached a seven-year agreement with ESPN, Inc., giving ESPN exclusive national and regional television rights to football and men's basketball, and the women's basketball championship game.
- April 26-28, 1999 - Mountain West Conference administration and Joint Council members gathered for first conference meeting in San Diego, Calif.
- May 20, 1999 - The Mountain West Conference and AXA/Equitable Liberty Bowl announced a three-year deal that will match the champions of the Mountain West Conference and Conference USA in the Memphis bowl game beginning in 1999.
- June 1, 1999 - The 12-member full-time staff began operations in Colorado Springs headquarters.
- June 7, 1999 - Named Dr. Philip Dubois, University of Wyoming President, Chair of the Board of Directors for 1999-2000 academic year. Announced three-year BB/FB agreement with the city of Las Vegas.
- July 1, 1999 - Conference beings official operation.
- January 30, 2004 - MWC announces that TCU will become the ninth member of the conference beginning with the 2005-06 member.

CRAIG THOMPSON

COMMISSIONER

In the ever-changing world of intercollegiate athletics, Craig Thompson is poised to make sure the Mountain West Conference assumes its proper place within the Division I-A ranks. As the MWC embarks on its seventh season of athletic competition, Thompson enters his eighth year as the league's commissioner.

In the six-plus years at the helm of the Mountain West Thompson has been instrumental in negotiating nearly \$230 million in television revenue. Thompson has guaranteed greater levels of television exposure for all MWC sports in the years ahead with the advent of the league's partnership with College Sports Television (CSTV). A new era begins in the fall of 2006 as CSTV becomes the official television partner for the Mountain West Conference. Thompson spearheaded the

league's potential 14-year agreement with CSTV, giving the fastest-growing independent cable network exclusive rights to Conference football and men's basketball, plus coverage for all other MWC sports. The agreement incorporates all Conference-related media and marketing rights, including all television, national over-the-air and satellite radio, video-on-demand, and online and broadband rights. The multi-media partnership also includes the MWC Television Network, the first-ever regional sports network dedicated solely to an intercollegiate athletic conference.

Prior to his current role, Thompson served as the commissioner of the Sun Belt Conference for nearly 12 years and as the only commissioner of the American South Conference prior to the leagues merger in 1991.

During his 12 years at the Sun Belt, Thompson supervised the operation of the Division I conference that sponsored 14 championship sports for eight institutions. While in New Orleans, he spent the majority of his time addressing national trends and challenges in intercollegiate athletics, television exposure, issues relating to conference membership and promoting corporate involvement. In 1997-98, the Sun Belt instituted a comprehensive sportsmanship policy, which earned Thompson designation as a 1998 Sports Ethics Fellow by the Institute for International Sport. Under Thompson's leadership, the Sun Belt was active in expansion as it continued to strengthen its posture nationally, adding Florida International University and the University of Denver.

Thompson continues to be active on the national level in intercollegiate athletics, holding many prestigious NCAA posts. In June 1995, Thompson was selected to serve on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee and was appointed Chair of the committee in July 1999, completing his term September 1, 2000. The committee is responsible for the policies, procedures and administration of the annual NCAA Tournament, including selection of at-large teams and the development of the championship bracket. At the time, Thompson was just the 11th commissioner to have been named to the committee.

During his career, Thompson has served as a member of the Executive Committee and the Director's Cup Committee of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA), as well as the governing NCAA Council and various Council subcommittees. He has also played a prominent role in hosting numerous men's and women's NCAA postseason basketball tournaments in St. Louis, Atlanta, New Orleans and Denver.

Prior to its merger with the Sun Belt, Thompson served as the first and only commissioner of the American South Conference, which boasted an NCAA champion in women's basketball during its first year. The American South also gained immediate national cable television exposure on ESPN and sent numerous teams into NCAA postseason play during the conference's four-year history.

Preceding his move to commissioner, Thompson served four years as the Director of Communications for the Metro Conference in Atlanta. While at the Metro, he directed the communications operations and administered conference championship events. Thompson originated the Metro Conference Sportswriters and Broadcasters Association, began a weekly radio program with over 300 affiliate stations, and originated a weekly satellite video program involving all Metro institutions. He also took on administrative duties such as coordination of officials, scheduling of tournament and regular-season play, and handling legislative rules interpretations.

The Iowa native spent his formative years in Minnesota and graduated from the University of Minnesota with an undergraduate degree in journalism. Following graduation, Thompson spent two years as assistant sports information director at Kansas State University, earning numerous CoSIDA publication awards. He then spent three years as director of public relations and promotions for the NBA's Kansas City Kings.

Thompson and his wife, Carla, reside in Monument, Colo., and have two children, Ted and Emma.
