The University of New Mexico athletics department would like to welcome members of the media to their coverage of the New Mexico women's basketball team. We hope this media guide will be useful in your coverage of the Lobos.

In order to assure your seat on press row in University Arena, we ask that you request credentials well in advance.

Media Credentials

Media representatives planning to cover games should contact Assistant Media Relations Director Brook Brandenburger in the media relations office at (505) 925-5854. The media will have a credential left for them at the ramp or ticket office located at the southwest corner of University Arena.

Practice / Interviews

The New Mexico women's basketball practices are closed to the media. Members of the media are asked to contact the media relations office for specific interviews and open practice times. Generally, practice is scheduled from 12:30 - 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

To arrange interviews with student-athletes, please contact Brook Brandenburger in the media relations office at least 24 hours in advance so that a time mutually beneficial to both parties can be arranged. Most interviews will take place following practice in The Pit.

Media Will Call

Media passes which are not mailed may be picked up at the ramp or ticket office located at the southwest corner of University Arena.

The will call window opens 90 minutes before tipoff. Identification is required to pick up credentials or tickets.

Working Media Locations

The working press and radio locations are on the east and west sides of The Pit. Television cameras may shoot game footage from either the north or south baselines. Media will be assigned seats with a seating chart available in the media room and at the end of press row. The media may file from courtside or from the media room.

Game Day Media Services

Pregame packets including notes, statistics, programs with rosters and media guides will be available in the press room and at mid ramp. Halftime and final boxscores, plus a running play-by-play will be provided.

Postgame Interviews

The New Mexico postgame locker room is closed to the media. Following the game, New Mexico coaches and players will be available for interviews in the Pete McDavid Lounge after a brief cooling down period (usually 10 minutes). Interview requests should be directed to Brook Brandenburger.

Radio/Television Broadcast Space

Requests for live radio and television broadcast space and credentials should be made to Brook Brandenburger, telephone, (505)-925-5854.





The University of New Mexico women's basketball team gets extensive media coverage on a daily basis with two large newspapers (*Albuquerque Journal* and *Albuquerque Tribune*), a school newspaper (*Daily Lobo*), numerous radio outlets, including flagship station 610 KNML-AM The Sports Animal, and three television stations covering the beat.

Lobo women's basketball players are briefed on the proper techniques of handling media interviews. The experience of being a New Mexico women's basketball player and working with the media actually becomes a classroom-setting in the arena of public speaking on and off the basketball court. The interaction is healthy and pays dividends later in life.
