### Lobos beat Air Force and Wyoming!

The Lobos picked up Mountain West Conference wins over Air Force on January 31st and at Wyoming on February 11. Against Air Force, the Lobos jumped on the Falcons from the tip and beat Air Force 67-44. Three Lobos were in double figures including Jayme Jackson with 13, Porche Torrance also with 13, and Caroline Durbin with 11.

Up in Laramie, Wyoming, the Lobos picked up their first road win against the Cowgirls since 2005. Caroline Durbin lead the Lobos with 23 points, including 19 in the second half to lead the Lobos comeback. Durbin was 10-14 from the floor, and 3-4 from the three point line. Seniors Lauren Taylor, and Nikki Nelson went a combined 4-4 from the free-throw line in the last 47 seconds of the game to seal the 60-57 win!

## Caroline Durbin Earns Capital One Academic All-District Honors!!

Junior Caroline Durbin has been named to the Capital One Academic All-District Team. Durbin's 4.16 grade point average in business with a concentration in finance and accounting earned her a spot on the District VII first team. With this honor, Durbin becomes the first player to be named academic all-district since Julie Briody in 2007.

"I'm really honored to have gotten this award," Durbin said. "Our program and academic advisors are really serious about putting academics before athletics, which is really helpful for a student-athlete."



Durbin is currently leading the Lobos in scoring with an average of 15.8 points per game, ranking second in the Mountain West. She leads the conference with a three-point field goal percentage of .541, having made 40 threes in 74 attempts. Her .514 accuracy currently ranks the highest in UNM history for a single season, and her career 3FG% of .382 currently holds the no. 3 spot in the New Mexico record books.

This season, Durbin has scored in double figures in 21 of New Mexico's 23 contests and has lead the Lobos in scoring in 15 games. She has logged six 20-point performances including recording a new career high of 29 points against Wyoming on Jan. 14. Durbin is maintaining a .491 accuracy from the floor, ranking first on the team and third in the MWC. She averages four rebounds per game and is tied for second place on the team with 48 assists.

Obviously this is a huge honor for Caroline and for the program," head coach Yvonne Sanchez said. "She takes her academics very seriously, so obviously she deserves it. She is very dedicated in classroom and focused on everything that she does, she's a perfectionist, and it's awesome to have a kid who's dedicated and successful on the court and in the classroom."

First-team Academic All-District® honorees advance to the Capital One Academic All-America® Team ballot, where first-, second- and third-team All-America honorees will be selected later this month.

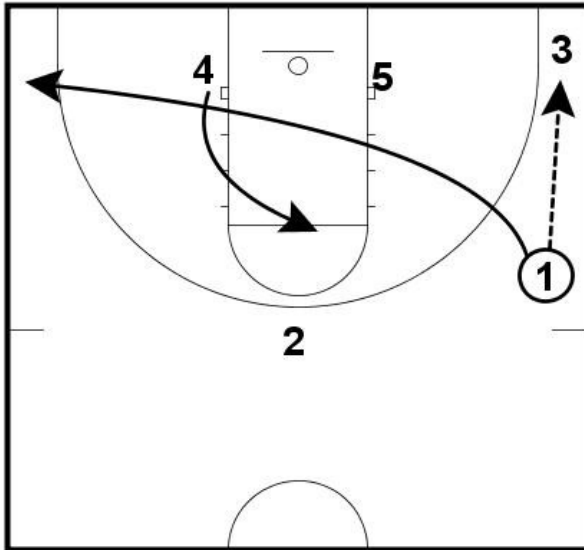

Corner (1 of 2)

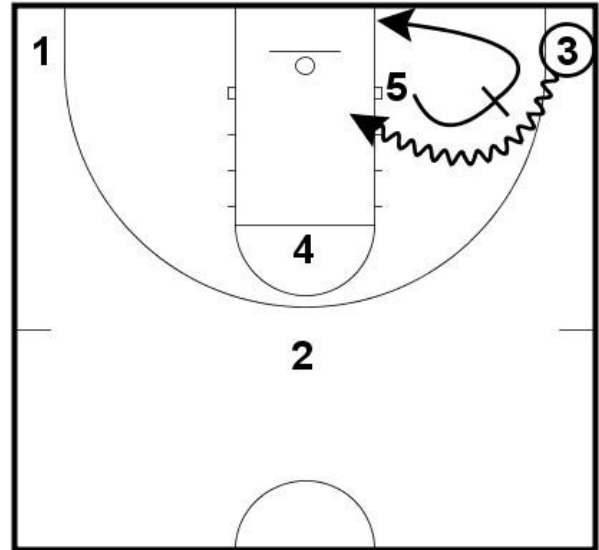
Los Angeles Lakers / Chicago Bulls
