2007-08 NEW MEXICO WOMEN'S TENNIS RECAP

The University of New Mexico women's tennis team collected 14 victories in the regular season and took only six matches to better its 2006-07 conference mark of 4-4. The Lobos played for a share of the regular season title in their final match but TCU proved too much for the tired Lobos. UNM ended the season in a tie for second with a No. 3 seed behind eventual MWC champion UNLV. The Lobos finished the season at 15-9 and 6-2 in the MWC.

Head coach Kathy Kolankiewicz completed her 23rd season at the helm of the New Mexico program with a 346-222 (.609) record. She continued her streak of leading every UNM squad she has headed to a conference tournament semifinal or better.

The 2008 spring season started with three home matches, all against top 40 teams including Northwestern, who ended the season in the No. 2 spot. The Lobos entered that match at 1-1 after upsetting then No. 38 Colorado, 4-3, by winning on four singles courts. The Wildcats brought a No. 7 ranking to Albuquerque and were the only non-conference team to sweep the Lobos. UNM ended the first part of the season with a 4-4 record.

The middle of the season was UNM's best effort, going 6-2 and improving to 10-6 overall. The Lobos defeated back-to-back ranked opponents, No. 66 Western Michigan 6-1 on March 2 and No. 67 Kansas State 5-2 on March 8. The three-match trip to Hawai'i finished at 2-1 with New Mexico collecting wins against Hawai'i and San Diego in the final non-conference matches of the season.

New Mexico began conference without then victories leader Sandra Zmak, but still managed a 4-0 blast. UNM continued its dominance over three MWC foes with a combined 41-0 mark against Air Force (12-0), Colorado State (18-0) and Wyoming (11-0).

The UNLV Rebels found a way to sweep the Lobos in both meetings, first in Las Vegas, 7-0, ranked No. 58 at the time. New Mexico and UNLV met again in the semifinals of the MWC Tournament with the Rebels ending the Lobos' season before handing TCU its first loss of the season in the finals to take the championship.

The 2007-08 team awards were handed out to the two seniors, Jennifer Ryba and Lucy Scott, junior Ola Abou-Zekry and the entire squad. Abou-Zekry led the team to one of the highest team GPAs ever at 3.66. She earned the highest cumulative grade point average award with a 3.96. Co-captain Ryba earned Most Wins (Singles and Doubles) with 40 en route to being named Most Improved Player. Co-captain Scott was honored with the Spirit Award for her senior season. The Most Valuable Player award went to "The Team." All-MWC hardware went to Abou-Zekry and Scott as a doubles team and Abou-Zekry in singles.

New Mexico Advances To MWC Semifinals: The University of New Mexico women's tennis team, the No. 3 seed, defeated the San Diego State Aztecs 4-2 on April 24 to advance to the semifinal round against No. 2 seed UNLV. UNLV punched their ticket to the finals with the 4-0 victory over the Lobos on April 25. New Mexico's season officially ended when their name was not called for a NCAA regional match.

Lobos Split Las Vegas Road Trip: New Mexico extended its win streak to five with a 4-3 win over San Diego State on April 4. Then UNLV handed the Lobos their first conference loss after four singles courts went to a third set to decide the match with UNLV prevailing on all courts for a 7-0 sweep on April 5.

Lobos Kick Off Conference 3-0: New Mexico had a perfect weekend in its first three matches of the MWC season. The Lobos had to play without sophomore Sandra Zmak after she injured her ankle and will be out the remainder of the season. On March 28, UNM swept Air Force 7-0 in Fort Worth, Texas. Wyoming fell to New Mexico 6-1 on March 29. The Lobos got victory No. 11 when they took down Colorado State 6-1 on March 30. UNM swept doubles play in all three matches and four singles courts saw perfection. Ola Abou-Zekry (1), Mackenzie White (2), Emma Hayman (4) and Jennifer Ryba (5) all went 3-0 during the weekend.

New Mexico Takes Two In Hawai'i: New Mexico won two of three matches during its trip to Honolulu, Hawai'i, March 17-20. The Lobos defeated Hawai'i 6-1 on March 17. They fell to Nevada 6-1 on March 18. After a day off, the Lobos swept San Diego on March 20.

Lobos Split Kansas Road Trip: New Mexico traveled to play road matches against both Kansas State and Kansas. In Manhattan on March 8, Kansas State, ranked No. 70, won at No. 2 doubles but the Lobos managed just their fourth win on the doubles court this season. The Wildcats scored two singles wins but New Mexico won the match 5-2. On March 9 in Lawrence, the Lobos were swept in doubles for the fifth time this season and could not bounce back, losing to Kansas 4-3.

New Mexico Improves Home Record: The Lobos hosted two nationally ranked teams and, in both, lost the doubles point but went on to win enough singles matches to win the dual. They improve their home record to 4-2. Against No. 59 Boise State on Feb. 29, the Lobos were swept in doubles but won five singles match for a 5-2 victory. Then on March 2, No. 66 Western Michigan won two doubles matches to take the 1-0 lead but the Lobos hit the singles courts hard, sweeping singles to kick March off with a win.

New Mexico Concludes Tough Road Trip: The Lobos traveled to Baton Rouge, La., last month to face No. 35 LSU and Louisiana-Lafayette. In the LSU match, No. 85 Sandra Zmak earned a point for the Lobos with a 6-4, 6-1 victory over Tiffany Tucker but LSU proved too much, winning the match 6-1. Against Louisiana-Lafayette, the score was tied at 2-all after the Lobos swept the doubles and Zmak won her second match of the weekend. Lafayette won two more singles to take the dual 4-2.

Lobos Beat Vandals: New Mexico defeated the Idaho Vandals 7-0 on Feb. 7. The Lobos won at both the No. 1 and 2 spots in doubles to go ahead 1-0 then swept the singles for the victory.

New Mexico Blows Away The Aggies: The Lobos took their first road trip of the season to play outdoors for the first time since mid-November in Las Cruces on Feb. 3. New Mexico had another first, it not only won the doubles point, but they swept the doubles. UNM went on to finish the sweep 7-0, winning all six singles. New Mexico increased its lead to 24-3 in the series against NMSU. The Lobos also increased the score in the Rio Grande Rivalry to 9-6.

New Mexico Upsets Colorado: New Mexico, ranked No. 67 at the time, defeated No. 38 Colorado 4-3. The Buffaloes swept the doubles point but the Lobos rebounded, winning four of the six singles matches to take the dual on Jan. 19.

The Lobos Take Two: New Mexico took two points from No. 16 Vanderbilt in the first match of the season on Jan. 18. This was the first time the Lobos earned two points off such a highly ranked team in the past few years. Vanderbilt won the dual 5-2 after winning the doubles point and four singles matches.

New Mexico Falls to No. 7: The Lobos fell victim to No. 7 Northwestern, the highest ranked opponent to ever visit Albuquerque. The Wildcats swept the match 7-0 on Jan. 26.

KATHY KOLANKIEWICZ

Head Coach

Dr. Kathy Kolankiewicz finished her 23rd season as the head coach of the University of New Mexico women's tennis

Below are some of Kolankiewicz's achievements at New Mexico:

- ITA Central Region Coach of the Year (1997, 1999, 2004)
- U.S.P.T.A. Southwest Coach of the Year (2003)
- Has taken the Lobos to a conference final or semifinal every year.
- Kolankiewicz captured her 300th career win in 2005
- Seven of the last 12 bids to the NCAA Championships (1996, '97, '98, '99, '00, '04, '06)
- Has led three singles players and four doubles teams to the NCAA Championships
- Had three players named All-America
- 2004 MWC regular season champions
- Had had two players named MWC Players of the Year
- Had a player named MWC Female Athlete of the Year and NCAA Woman of the Year

program. Through her leadership, the program has experienced both consistency and success throughout the years. Kolankiewicz has guided the Lobos to appearances in the NCAA Championships seven of the last 12 seasons. UNM has won 60 percent of its matches under Kolankiewicz, posting a 346-222 record. Between 1986 and 2008, Kolankiewicz took the women's tennis team to conference finals or semifinals every year. During those years, the Lobos received their highest ever national ranking, reaching No. 21 in 1996, 1999 and 2004.

Kolankiewicz is also responsible for coaching two of the greatest doubles teams to come out of the UNM program. Under the guidance of Kolankiewicz, the duo of Sandy Lukowski and Maja Kovacek became the first players in New Mexico women's tennis history to earn All-America honors after advancing to the semifinals at the 2004 NCAA Championships. The pair finished the season with a No. 5 national ranking. Kolankiewicz then went on to guide a second duo to All-America honors. Kovacek paired with Iva Gersic to automatically earn All-America honors after receiving a No. 4 seed in the 2005 NCAA Championships. The pair also achieved the highest ranking ever by a UNM tennis player at No. 2 as well as the highest postseason ranking at No. 4.

New Mexico has made its mark in the world of women's collegiate tennis, having finished with 20-plus wins four of the last 11 seasons and having been nationally for the past 13 years. Kolankiewicz has earned Central Region Coach of the Year three times in her career at UNM and has garnered WAC Coach of the Year (1997) and MWC Coach of the Year (2004) recognition.
