

2008 New Mexico Setters & Libero Camp

Friday, July 18th- Sunday, July 20th

Setters will be trained in every aspect of setting, from technique to strategy. Liberos will be taken through several series of ball control drills, proper technique in serve receive and defense. Groups will be split up according to skill level. Included in your fees will be 6 sessions, you will receive a fun and knowledgeable group of coaches, your own UNM volleyball, a Lobo Volleyball t-shirt, and a full-time certified trainer. All sessions will be held in the Johnson Center on main campus. You have the opportunity to experience college life as a resident in the dorms. As a resident, all of your meals will be paid for while participating in the camp. As a commuter, you will arrive and depart each day of camp (meals will be provided between sessions). Check in: 12:30-2:00 p.m. on Friday. Check out: Noon on Sunday.

Housing and Meals

Resident campers will stay in a dormitory on the UNM campus. The girls will stay two to a room; roommate requests will be accommodated if possible. Please include your roommate request on your camp application and please coordinate with your roommate to do the same. Camp staff will provide 24-hour supervision in the dorms. Resident campers will eat breakfast, lunch and dinner in the La Posada dining hall or in Johnson Center. All commuter campers will be provided lunch and dinner on Friday and Saturday of camp.

A nonrefundable \$75 deposit will hold your spot in the camp until July 1st, when full payment is due.

Facilities

All sessions will be held in the University of New Mexico's Johnson Center, located on Main Campus.

Parking

Parking is available in the parking structure, just south of Johnson Center for an hourly fee on the weekdays. UNM parking services will be ticketing on the weekdays from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. in the UNM lots. On Saturday and Sunday, you are free to park in all lots.

Medical Coverage

All participants must have their own medical insurance through their family policy or some other source that will serve as their primary coverage. Registrations will not be accepted if the medical release and insurance form is not filled out in its entirety. Each camper must complete the attached medical release section on the application when registering by mail. A full-time certified trainer will be on site to treat any and all injuries. Specific medical needs can be discussed with the trainer upon check-in.

Meet the Staff



Head Coach

Jeff Nelson is entering his second year as the Lobo's head coach and is extremely excited to kick off the 2008 Lobo Summer Camp schedule! Nelson comes to New Mexico after four successful seasons at the University of San Francisco in which he guided the Dons to their first NCAA appearance in 2003. Coach Nelson is no stranger to the Southwest as he served eight years as the head coach for Texas Tech. He led the Red Raiders to five 20 win seasons and 5 NCAA appearances during his tenure. In 2007, he guided the Lobos to their first winning season in 12 years. Jeff has coached numerous All-Americans, All-Region and All-Conference student-athletes at the collegiate level. As a prep coach, twenty-one of his former club athletes received Division I scholarships, while three were selected as Junior National Team members and five were named High School All-Americans.



Steve Hendricks is in his second year as assistant coach for the Lobo's volleyball program. Hendricks played four years at Ball State University where he competed in three NCAA Final Fours. He began his coaching career while being a student-athlete and helped lead Muncie Burriss High School to the Indiana State Championship and the Munciana Volleyball Club to a fifth place finish at the USA Junior Olympics. Following his playing career, he began coaching at the college level and has stints at Tennessee, Notre Dame and the University of San Francisco. Returning to the prep ranks in 2004, Hendricks coached the Celtic Force VBC to the 17's USA Junior Olympic National Championship.



Assistant Coach Jackie Bernardin is in her 2nd year of coaching at UNM, assisting with every facet of the program with a concentration on back row defense and on-court training. Bernardin captured an unprecedented three consecutive WCC Defensive Player of the Year honors during a record-setting career at the University of San Diego. One of the top back row specialists in league history, Bernardin departed USD owning the program digs record with 1,402 in just three seasons. Bernardin is the Lobos Summer Camp Coordinator.

Little Lobos Camp

Monday, June 16th – Friday, June 20th
9:00 a.m. – Noon

The Little Lobos Camp is open to all children who will be entering kindergarten through 5th grade next fall. Included in your \$125.00 registration fees are five days of instruction, fun, supervision, your own UNM volleyball, a Lobo Volleyball t-shirt, and a full-time certified trainer. The coaching staff will cover the basic individual skills including passing, setting, hitting and serving. The clinics will also provide the campers an opportunity to experience team skills and play.

A nonrefundable \$50 deposit will hold your spot in the camp until May 15th, when full payment is due. If registering after May 15th, you must pay the full amount.

2008 Individual Skills Camp: Grades 5-8

This camp is offered to children entering 5th through 8th grade in the fall. Players will receive small group instruction and will have opportunities to utilize their skills in competitive settings. Players of ANY skill level are invited to attend. Come and brush up on your skills before your school season starts! For your fees, you will receive your own UNM volleyball, a Lobo Volleyball t-shirt, and a full-time certified trainer. Lunch will be provided.

A nonrefundable \$75 deposit will hold your spot in the camp until May 15th, when full payment is due. If registering after May 15th, you must pay the full amount.

2008 Adult Skills & Play Camp

This camp is open to all adults who are interested in learning more about the game of volleyball, refining your skills, and competing in a structured environment. For your \$60, enjoy three nights of instruction on setting, passing, hitting, serving, serve reception, defense, court coverage, tactical knowledge and strategy during game play. There will be competitive drills as well as full games. On the last day of camp please join the UNM coaches for a social gathering.

2008 New Mexico Volleyball Advanced Skills Camp

Grades 7-12

Monday, July 14th – Thursday, July 17th

This camp is offered to girls entering 7th through 12th grade in the fall. Players will receive small group instruction and will have opportunities to utilize their skills in competitive settings. Players of all levels can learn and improve their skills and gain confidence in competitive game play. The coaching staff stresses individual and team play, while concentrating on the fundamentals of setting, passing, hitting, serving, serve reception, defense, and court coverage. Along with focusing on fundamental skills, coaches also focus on the tactical knowledge of a particular position and strategy during game play.

You have the opportunity to experience college life as a resident in the dorms. As a resident, all of your meals will be paid for while participating in the camp. As a commuter, you will arrive and depart each day of camp (meals will be provided between sessions). For your fees, you will receive a fun and knowledgeable group of coaches, your own UNM volleyball, a Lobo Volleyball t-shirt, and a full-time certified trainer. All sessions will be held in the Johnson Center on main campus.

Resident Campers and Commuter Campers will check in from 12:30 to 2:00 before the first session at 2:00 p.m. on July 14th. Resident campers will check out on July 17th at noon. Commuter campers will check in before each morning session and check out after each night session with a designated coach.

Resident campers will stay in a dormitory on the UNM campus. The girls will stay two to a room; roommate requests will be accommodated if possible. 2008 New Mexico Volleyball Cherry & Silver Team Camp

Friday, July 25th – Sunday, July 27th

This camp is designed for high school teams looking to compete at a high level prior to their preseason training. The camp will begin on July 25th and finish by noon on July 27th. On the first two days of camp, your team will have a training session in the morning or afternoon with your team's own UNM camp coach who will lead your team through drills. Then you will compete in pool play in the evenings. After two rounds of pool play, teams will be seeded in two separate brackets: Cherry & Silver for a single elimination tournament on the 27th. A winner will be crowned in each division. Included in your fees are a minimum of 8 matches, a Lobo volleyball t-shirt and two camp clinics. Coaches- you must bring your own balls for sessions, warm-ups, and games.

Lodging and Meals

For teams that are traveling great distances, the MCM Elegante will be our host hotel. Please contact Shannon Mullan and ask for the UNM Volleyball rate.

Registration Procedure

To reserve your team's spot, coaches must fill out the Application Form along with a non-refundable \$100 deposit. The non-refundable deposit is included in the total cost of camp and will hold your position as a registered team until July 1st, 2008. Each player and coach must fill out their own application form, including the medical release and waiver, along with their payment for camp. The full payment for the camp must be received by July 1st, 2008 from each team. Following July 1st, the fees for the camp increase by \$25 for a total of \$115 for players and a \$150.00 team entry fee. One check per team is greatly appreciated.

Coaches: Please organize your team's applications and medical releases and send them in as a group. Any additions or substitutions must be received two weeks prior to the first day of camp. The team composition may be a minimum of 7 players and a maximum of 12 players. Please make copies of the Application Forms before registering your team. A confirmation packet will be mailed to you following the receipt of your application and payment.

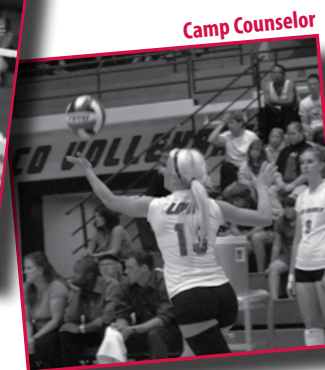
