BIG EAST Championship

Villanova is making its 10th overall appearance in the BIG EAST Championship, and its first since 1997. The Wildcats have advanced to the title game of the tournament in five of their nine appearances, including a championship game loss to St. John's 10 years ago. Villanova's two conference championships came in 1989 and 1991. Overall, the Wildcats are 15-15 (.500) all-time in the BIG EAST Championship. That mark includes a 5-4 (.556) record in the team's first game of the tournament in each appearance.

Series with Louisville

The Wildcats are 1-5 all-time against Louisville, with the only meetings between the teams occurring since the Cardinals joined the conference last season. Louisville swept a three-game series at Jim Patterson Stadium last season and took two of three from Villanova in Plymouth Meeting this year. The Wildcats won the opening game of that series 1-0 on an unearned run in the bottom of the ninth inning. Senior starting pitcher **Mike Loree (Gillette, N.J.)** pitched a four-hit shutout in that contest.

Villanova Update

Entering the conference tournament, the Wildcats are playing some of their best baseball of the season. After suffering a 10-1 loss to Temple on April 10, Villanova stood with just a 13-14 record and at that point was 3-6 in BIG EAST play. The Wildcats turned things on after that game, though, going 15-9 since then and producing a 9-9 record over the final six weeks of league games. Villanova won three of its last four and four of its last six BIG EAST series to claim its first postseason berth in 10 years.

The other two are Fordham (147th season) and Yale (143rd season). Villanova has an all-time record in baseball of 1,689-1,167-29 (.591).

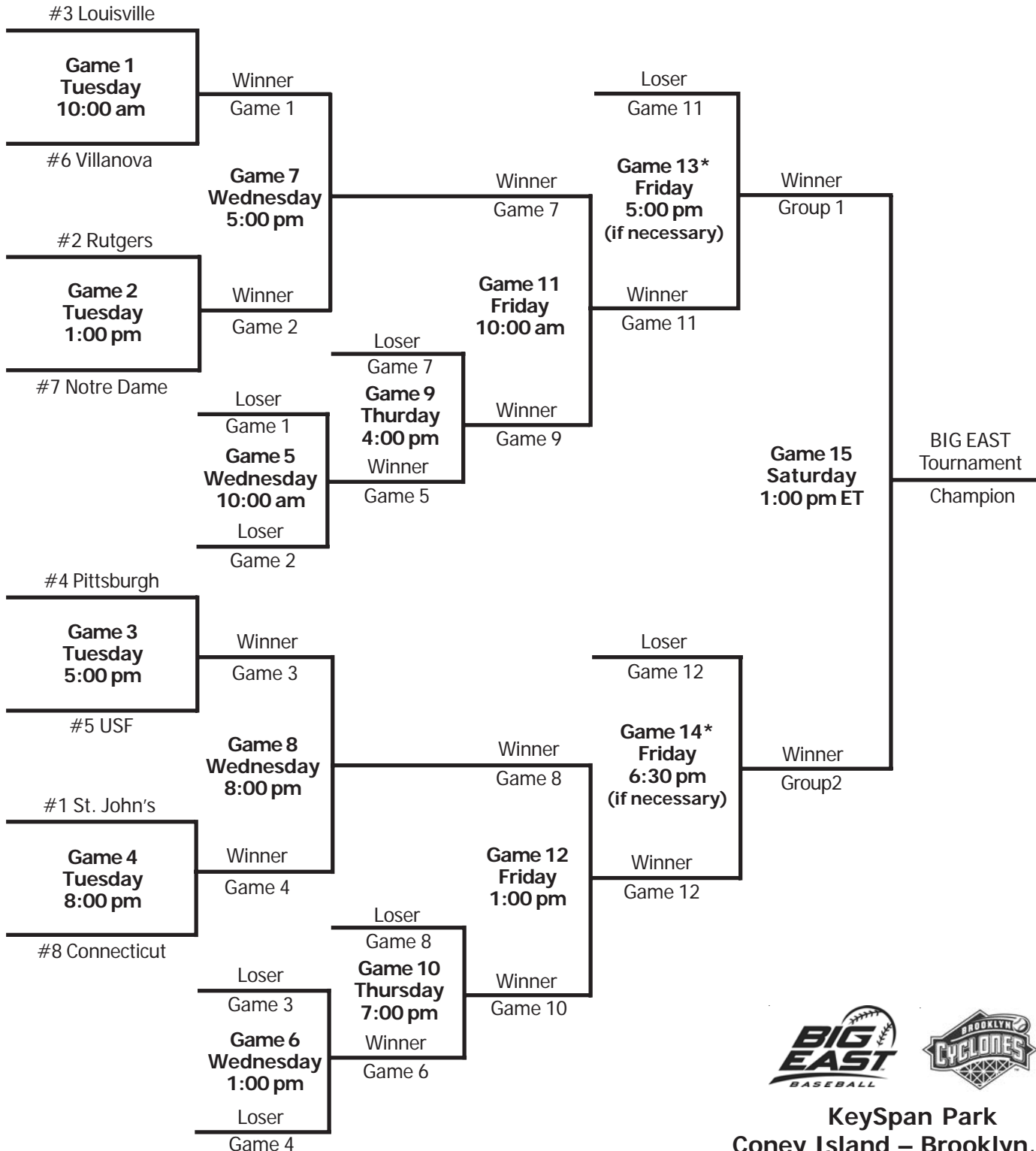

VILLANOVA IN THE BIG EAST CHAMPIONSHIP

All-Time Results

Appearances

Villanova will be making its 10th appearance in the BIG EAST Championship this season and its first since 1997. All nine of the team's previous tournament berths came between 1987 and 1997. During that span, 1992 and 1994 were the only years the Wildcats did not qualify for the conference tournament.

History of Success

The Wildcats have advanced through to the championship game in five of their nine previous trips to the BIG EAST Championship, including the most recent appearance in 1997. Villanova won the BIG EAST Championship in 1989 and 1991 to qualify for the NCAA Tournament, while the team finished as the league runner-up in 1987, 1988 and 1997. Overall, the Wildcats have an all-time record of 15-15 (.500) in the BIG EAST Championship.

New Faces

Villanova is one of just two teams in the tournament this season that were not in the event last year. Pittsburgh is the other team that earned a spot in 2007 after not qualifying a year ago. The Panthers did advance to the championship game in 2005, however.

Spot in the Record Books

When the Wildcats won their second BIG EAST title in 1991, they did so by winning four straight games after losing their opening game in the tournament to Providence. Villanova is one of just four times in the history of the event to win the championship after losing its opening game. The other teams were Providence (1995), Connecticut (1993) and St. John's (1988).

Common Opponents

The majority of Villanova's games in the BIG EAST Championship -- 30 total -- have been played against just three different teams. The Wildcats are 6-6 against St. John's in the conference tournament, as the Red Storm account for nearly half of the games Villanova has played in the BIG EAST Championship. The Wildcats have also faced Seton Hall six times (2-4) and Providence five times (3-2).

Long Time Coming

When Villanova takes the field for its game against Louisville in the first round on Tuesday, it will have played 487 games in between BIG EAST Championship games. The Wildcats last appearance in the conference tournament was a loss in the title game in 1997. It isn't as if Villanova, which featured a .549 regular season winning percentage this year, wasn't having any success since its last playoff appearance. Since last playing in the BIG EAST Championship, the Wildcats have gone 260-221-6 (.540) over the past 10 years, posting at least a .500 record eight times.

Godri Returns to Tournament

Sixth-year head coach **Joe Godri** will be coaching in the BIG EAST Championship for the first time this season but will actually be headed to the tournament with Villanova for the second time. Godri was an assistant coach on the 1991 team that won the league title. Each one of the Wildcats previous trips to the conference tournament came during the 15-year tenure of head coach George Bennett.

Postseason Tournament History

The BIG EAST Championship is just one postseason tournament in which the Wildcats have had success. Villanova competed in the NCAA East Regionals in 1989 and 1991 after winning the conference title. The 1989 team won three games in the NCAA Tournament and came within one win of advancing to the College World Series. The Wildcats also played in the NCAA Region II playoffs five times between 1952-1961 and in the ECAC South Division playoffs in 1980 and 1981.

HEAD COACH JOE GODRI: In his sixth season as head coach, **Joe Godri** has led his Villanova teams to at least a .500 record in four of his first five seasons. The Wildcats have won 30 games twice under Godri's leadership. Villanova won the 2005 Liberty Bell Classic and over the past three seasons the Wildcats own a record of 53-26-1 (.669) against teams from Pennsylvania and New Jersey. during the same period of time, Villanova is also 75-28 (.728) against non-conference competition.

Godri's career accomplishments were noticed after last season, when he was chosen to the selection committee for the USA Baseball collegiate National Team. The Wildcats have had two players drafted in each of the last five Major League Baseball First-Year Player Drafts, while several others have gone on to have success in professional leagues overseas. Villanova players have been well-recognized at the conference and national levels during Godri's tenure. Wildcat players have been named All-Big East on 12 occasions, and two players have garnered All-America honors.

Entering this weekend, Godri has a career record of 158-146-3 (.520).
