

## VILLANOVA BASEBALL UPDATED NOTES FOR SEMIFINAL GAME

Addition to Game Notes for Friday, May 23

- In today's game, Villanova will play...
    - Its 58<sup>th</sup> game of the season, extending a team record for games in a season set yesterday vs. Seton Hall
    - In the BIG EAST Championship semifinal round for the first time since 1997 (reached championship)
    - Its 37<sup>th</sup> all-time game in the BIG EAST Championship (18-18)
    - Louisville in a playoff game for the second time this season and third time overall
    - On four consecutive days for the first time this season
    - Its 16<sup>th</sup> game in the state of Florida this season (this is the fourth trip to the Sunshine State)
  - Derek Shunk and Dan Terpak are the only Villanova players who have started every game this season. They set team single-season records yesterday by playing in their 57<sup>th</sup> games of the season. Shunk also has a single-season record 223 at-bats this season.
  - Derek Shunk is the first Villanova hitter in the last decade with at least 80 hits in a season. He has been on a tear of late, including the following:
    - Batting .381 (85-223) for the season
    - Seven straight multi-hit games during which he is batting .581 (18-31)
    - Riding a career-best 14-game hitting streak during which he is batting .483 (29-60)
    - Hitting .460 (64-139) over his last 37 games and has hit safely in 35 of the 37 games
    - Currently hitting .692 (9-13) in three BIG EAST Championship games
  - Previous meetings between Villanova and Louisville in the BIG EAST Championship
    - 2007: Louisville 3, Villanova 1 (Game 1)
    - 2008: Louisville 14, Villanova 3 (Game 6)
  - The following individual and team records have been broken or tied this season:
    - TEAM: Games played in a season (57) – breaks the record of 56 games set in 1995 and tied in 1997
    - TEAM: Triples in a season (20) – ties the single-season record set in 2006
    - TEAM: Stolen bases in a season (98) – breaks the record of 89 set in 1997 and tied in 2007
    - INDIVIDUAL: Games played in a season (57) – Derek Shunk and Dan Terpak broke record yesterday
    - INDIVIDUAL: At-bats in a season (223) – Derek Shunk, broke previous record of 216
    - INDIVIDUAL: Games played in a career (215) – Derek Shunk, broke previous record of 202
    - INDIVIDUAL: At-bats in a career (826) – Derek Shunk, broke previous record of 719\*
    - INDIVIDUAL: Hits in a career (290) – Derek Shunk, broke previous record of 242
- \* Ryan Arcadia has also broken the previous career at-bats record; his current total is 735 at-bats
- **Wesley Borden** broke out of a recent slump with two hits and three RBI in Thursday's win over Seton Hall. Borden entered the game in an 0-for-14 skid and had just two hits in his previous 28 at-bats (.071) before going 2-for-5 in Thursday's win. Borden's season average dropped more than 40 points during the stretch and he entered the game batting .260 for the season. Borden's batting average was over .300 for a good portion of the second half of the season. For the season he is batting .265 with a .370 on-base percentage and a .426 slugging percentage. He has started 47 of the team's 57 games behind the plate.
  - Yesterday's win gave Villanova 30 wins in a season for the 10<sup>th</sup> time in hits history and the first time since 2004. It is the third time in seven years since **Joe Godri** became head coach that the Wildcats have won at least 30 games. In his seven seasons as head coach, Godri has now recorded six seasons with more than 25 victories and at least a .500 record, including five straight seasons with such marks.
  - **Bill Hoffman** and **Brian Streilein** each have two complete games this season, including one complete game shutout apiece. These are the only four complete games thrown by Villanova pitching all season and represent two of the pitching staff's three shutouts. All four of these complete game efforts have come in the last nine team games.
  - Villanova advances to the semifinals of the BIG EAST Championship for the first time since 1997, when it played in the championship game. The Wildcats did not make the conference tournament from 1998-2006 before returning last season. This marks the sixth time in its 11 BIG EAST Championship appearances that Villanova has won at least two games in the tournament.

## VILLANOVA IN THE BIG EAST CHAMPIONSHIP

## All-Time Results

### Appearances

Villanova is making its 11th appearance in the BIG EAST Championship this season and its second consecutive appearance after a 10-year drought. The first nine of the team's tournament berths came between 1987 and 1997. During that span, 1992 and 1994 were the only years the Wildcats did not qualify for the conference tournament.

### History of Success

The Wildcats have advanced through to the championship game in five of their 10 previous trips to the BIG EAST Championship, including most recently in 1997. Villanova won the BIG EAST Championship in 1989 and 1991 to qualify for the NCAA Tournament, while the team finished as the league runner-up in 1987, 1988 and 1997. Overall, the Wildcats have an all-time record of 18-18 (.500) in the BIG EAST Championship, including the three games so far this year. Villanova is now in the semifinals for the first time since 1997.

### Repeat Performances

Villanova is one of five teams in the tournament field this season that qualified for last season's conference championship. The other returning teams are St. John's, Notre Dame, Louisville and USF. The three new teams to the field are Cincinnati, Seton Hall and West Virginia. Both Cincinnati and West Virginia are back in the tournament after a one-year absence, while Seton Hall is making its first appearance since winning the title in 2001.

### Spot in the Record Books

When the Wildcats won their second BIG EAST title in 1991, they did so by winning four straight games after losing their opening game in the tournament to Providence. Villanova is one of just four teams in the history of the event to win the championship after losing its opening game. The other teams were Providence (1995), Connecticut (1993) and St. John's (1988).

### Common Opponents

The majority of Villanova's games in the BIG EAST Championship -- 36 total -- have been played against just three different teams. The Wildcats are 7-6 against St. John's in the conference tournament, as the Red Storm account for more than one third of the games Villanova has played in the BIG EAST Championship. The Wildcats have also faced Seton Hall seven times (3-4) and Providence five times (3-2).

### Uphill Battle

Villanova will have its hands full against the other teams that make up this year's BIG EAST Championship field. During the regular season, the Wildcats were a combined 3-12 (.200) against the other conference tournament qualifiers. The three wins came against St. John's, Louisville and University of South Florida. Villanova was swept in series against Seton Hall and Notre Dame, while it did not play either Cincinnati or West Virginia.

The good news is that recent history will be on the Wildcats side. Last year, Connecticut was the No. 8 seed in the conference tournament and advanced all the way to the championship before narrowly bowing out to league champion Rutgers, 7-6. Along the way, the Huskies rebounded from a 2-1 loss to St. John's in their opening game at the tournament to post four straight wins. The lowest seed in the tournament has reached the championship game in three of the last four seasons, including Connecticut last season, Pittsburgh in 2005 and Boston College in 2004. The 2004 and 2005 tournaments were the last in which only four teams qualified for the championship.

### Postseason Tournament History

The BIG EAST Championship is just one postseason tournament in which the Wildcats have had success. Villanova competed in the NCAA East Regionals in 1989 and 1991 after winning the conference title. The 1989 team won three games in the NCAA Tournament and came within one win of advancing to the College World Series. The Wildcats also played in the NCAA Region II playoffs five times between 1952-1961 and in the ECAC South Division playoffs in 1980 and 1981.

**HEAD COACH JOE GODRI:** In his seventh season as head coach, **Joe Godri** has led his Villanova teams to at least a .500 record in five of his first six seasons and is guaranteed to do so once again this year. The Wildcats have now won 30 games three times under Godri's leadership. Villanova won the 2005 Liberty Bell Classic and since the beginning of the 2004 season the Wildcats own a record of 69-34-1 (.668) against teams from Pennsylvania and New Jersey. During the same period of time, Villanova is also 94-42-2 (.688) in non-conference competition.

Godri's career accomplishments were noticed after the 2006 season, when he was chosen to the selection committee for the USA Baseball collegiate National Team. The Wildcats have had at least one player drafted in each of the last six Major League Baseball First-Year Player Drafts, while several others have gone on to have success in professional leagues overseas. Villanova players have been well-recognized at the conference and national levels during Godri's tenure. Wildcat players have been named All-Big East on 14 occasions, and two players have garnered All-America honors.

Entering today's game against Louisville, Godri has a career record of 189-175-3.
