TOP STORIES

• The Wildcats picked up their 32nd straight win at their on-campus Pavilion home on Wednesday night, defeating Drexel 77-58. VU is 4-0 at home this season and 3-0 in neutral court duels.

• Tonight marks the first of two appearances Villanova will make this season at the Verizon Center. VU returns on Feb. 6 to face BIG EAST rival Georgetown on its home court. The Wildcats are 6-1 (.857) all-time against the Hoyas at the Center, with the loss coming in their most recent appearance, a 55-53 defeat on Feb. 11 2008.

• It was announced on Tuesday that freshman forward Mouptaou Yarou has tested positive for the Hepatitis B virus.. He is being treated by team physician Dr. Frank Furman and there is no time table for his return to action.

• Despite playing without four of its starters from its 2009 NCAA Final Four squad, Villanova's defense has remained strong in the early going. None of VU's seven opponents have converted more than .404 of their field goal attempts and the Wildcats are holding foes to a .366 overall field goal percentage. Drexel converted just .310 of its field goal attempts on Wednesday.

• This game kicks off a stretch of four straight away from home for Villanova. Next up are a pair of Philadelphia Big Five clashes. On Wednesday, the 'Cats meet Saint Joseph's at the Palestra (9:00 p.m./ESPN2) and then face Temple on Dec. 13 at the Liacouras Center (3:00 p.m./CBS College Sports).

Downed the Dragons

The memory of Drexel's last visit to the Pavilion was real to only a select few of the current Wildcats. Of those in uniform on Wednesday night, only Scottie Reynolds had been on the floor when Drexel tripped up Villanova 81-76 on Dec. 9, 2006.

But coach Jay Wright remembered and he made sure his Wildcats understood the threat Drexel could pose.

"We talked about that a lot," stated Wright.

In Wednesday night's collision, Villanova's defense set the tone early. The Dragons did not score for the game's first 9:41 and that was the only reason a slow start at the offensive end did not hinder the Wildcats. When Drexel sank its first basket, Villanova was up 10-0.

But Taylor King sank three triples near the end of the first half to ignite the Villanova offense and by intermission the Wildcats held a 34-18 lead. That advantage would grow as large as 26 points after the break and Villanova cruised home to a 77-58 win.

"I thought this was our best defensive effort so far," stated Wright. "Drexel's guards sliced us up a few years ago and we did a good job on them this time."

Indeed, starting guards Gerald Colds and Jamie Harris were a combined 0-of-17 from the field.

Reynolds Wrap

Senior All-American candidate Scottie Reynolds continues to build a portfolio that ranks with some of Villanova's legendary performers.

The product of Herndon (Va.) High School - not far from the Verizon Center - has 1,717 career points. He currently stands 12th on the school's all-time points list and is within 20 points of Larry Hennessy (1,737) in 11th place. Gary Buchanan holds down 10th place (1,799).

The Wildcat guard filled the stat sheet in the win over Drexel, scoring 14 points, grabbing eight rebounds, and handing out six assists.

He now has 399 assists in his career and is alone in 13th place all-time. He needs just six more to move past assistant coach Chris Walker (404) into 12th place. He could become only the third player in school history with at least 1,700 points and 400 assists, joining Kerry Kittles and Randy Foye in that category.

This is Reynolds' third visit to the Verizon Center as a Wildcat. As a freshman he scored 16 points to key a 56-52 win over Georgetown. Then, he tallied 24 points as a sophomore against the Hoyas. He averages 20.0 ppg in those visits.

The BIG EAST Coaches selected Reynolds pre-season first team all-conference and he is one of 50 players on the Wooden Award Watch List.

Fish Facts

Last season, Corey Fisher became the first Wildcat to be named BIG EAST Sixth Man of the Year. In 2009-10, he's moved into the starting lineup and enters the contest against Drexel as the club's third leading scorer at 11.9 ppg.

In his last two outings, Fisher has recorded 10 steals. He averages 2.1 spg.

One of the keys to Fisher's success is his ability to get to the free throw line. Through six games he has attempted 54 from the charity stripe, an average of 7.7 attempts per outing and is converting .741 from the line.

Maurice Matters

As a redshirt in 2008-09, Maurice Sutton practiced but never played in a game. With the arrival of a touted recruiting class, the 6-11 redshirt freshman didn't draw much pre-season attention.

Things, though, have changed. The absence of Mouphtaou Yarou due to hepatitis B has created an opening on the interior and this native of Largo, Md., has seized it.

Sutton has started each of VU's last four games and has been a factor in each of them. On Wednesday he added three more blocked shots to his total - he has eight in the last two games - and chipped in with three rebounds and two points. He is averaging 4.0 points and 4.4 rebounds per outing.

Antonio's Adjusted

No Wildcat has been more consistently productive through the early stages of 2009-10 than junior forward Antonio Pena. On Wednesday night he established a new career high with 19 points and posted his fourth double-double of the campaign with 11 rebounds.

Pena spent the first half of 2008-09 as a starter before giving way to then senior Shane Clark in January. But with the departure of three key frontcourt veterans from last season, including D.C. area products Dwayne Anderson and Dante Cunningham (now with the Portland Trailblazers), Pena has responded to the challenge.

The native of Brooklyn, N.Y., is connecting on .582 of his attempts from the field and has already made 45 trips to the free throw line, converting 30 (.667). He is averaging 13.4 points and 10.6 rebounds per game.

Taylor Made

Taylor King has made his presence felt in his first season as an active member of the rotation after transferring to the Main Line from Duke in 2008. The 6-6 California native has quickly settled into the role of sixth man and thrived there.

His impact was on display on Wednesday night. With the Wildcats struggling to locate an offensive groove, King rode to the rescue with hustle and some timely 3-pointers. He was 4-of-6 from beyond the arc and finished with 16 points and five rebounds in 23 minutes of activity.

King is 14-of-29 (.483) from beyond the arc thus far.

Two Sign Letters

A pair of high school senior standouts have inked national letters of intent to join the Villanova Wildcats in the early signing period. Guard James Bell, 6-5, of Montverde (Fla.) Academy and forward Markus Kennedy, a 6-9 Philadelphia native who is currently enrolled at Winchendon (Mass.) Academy, have signed letters of intent and will enroll at Villanova in the fall of 2010.

Bell is a dynamic wing player who has excelled at Montverde Academy playing for coach Kevin Sutton. ESPN lists Bell as the No. 43 senior in the class of 2010.

"James is a great athlete from an outstanding program at Montverde Academy," stated Wright. "His coach, Kevin Sutton, has done a terrific job teaching James the game and we are excited to have him join us. James is a tough, athletic guard who will add another dimension to our team."

Kennedy is from Philadelphia and emerged as a coveted prospect over the last two seasons playing prep basketball in the state of New Jersey. He is now at the Winchendon School, where he will soon begin his senior season.

"Markus is a Philly guy and he brings us interior size and toughness," stated Wright. "One of the things we came to appreciate about Markus is his understanding of the game. We believe Markus can be an outstanding rebounder at this level and a skilled offensive player in the post. We're thrilled to have another Philly guy in our family."

Balance Beam

Villanova enters action against Maryland with no single player averaging more than Reynolds' 13.9 points per game. But what the Wildcats lack in gaudy individual numbers, they make up for in distribution.

Five VU players, including Reynolds, Fisher, Antonio Pena, Stokes, and King average in double figures in scoring. Seven different team members have scored in double figures in a game this season, with Maalik Wayns having poured in 16 against Penn and Cheek dropping in 10 in the win over La Salle.

The balance can be seen in other categories as well.

Five different Wildcats average 4.0 rebounds a game or better on the season. That list includes Pena (10.6 rpg), King (6.6 rpg), Stokes (5.0 rpg), Sutton (4.4 rpg) and Yarou (4.0 rpg).

"If we're going to have a good team, we've got to be balanced," stated Wright. "We have to have an inside game - that's where 'Tone (Pena) really helps us. We have to have a drive game and a 3-point shooting game."

Nine different Wildcats average double figures in minutes played through seven games.

Redding Out for Semester

One of the Wildcats' two returning starters from their 2009 NCAA Final Four team, senior guard Reggie Redding, will not be in uniform for the Wildcats during the first 10 games of the regular season as the result of a violation of the university's student code of conduct.

Redding, a Philadelphia native who averaged 7.1 points and 4.9 rebounds per contest as a junior, is eligible to return at the end of the university semester on December 18. The Wildcats face Fordham at the Izod Center in New Jersey on Dec. 19.

Philadelphia Big Five

The Philadelphia tradition known as the Big Five is underway in 2009-10 with a full round-robin slate of games.

Villanova earned the outright City Series crown with a 4-0 mark in 2008-09 and has been at the top of the Big Five standings, either in tandem with a rival or alone, for each of the past five seasons.

The 'Cats are 2-0 in Big Five action with November wins over Penn (103-65) and La Salle (81-63) at the Pavilion.

In addition, Villanova defeated another Philly neighbor, Drexel, 77-58, in a meeting between the two schools at the Pavilion on Dec. 2.

Polling Data

This week Villanova moved up one place in both the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll and the Associated Press poll to No. 3 in the nation. This marks VU's highest regular season ranking since February of 2006, when the 'Cats reached No. 2 in the nation.

Pavilion Power

Villanova has made the most of its campus home, the Pavilion since it opened on Feb. 1, 1986. The Wildcats own an all-time mark of 215-54 (.799).

The Wildcats have captured the last 32 games played in the building on Ithan Avenue. The streak began on Jan. 17, 2007 with a 102-87 win over Notre Dame and included a perfect 13-0 mark in 2008-09.

Villanova is 83-12 (.873) in the Pavilion in the Jay Wright era, which got underway in the 2001-02 campaign. It is 153-22 (.874) in the Pavilion since the start of 1994-95.

Wildcats in the Spotlight

Villanova will once again be in the national spotlight in 2009-10, with a minimum of 20 regular season appearances on national television, including two on CBS and six on ESPN. In addition, the 'Cats will be five times on ESPN Regional Television, which airs locally on My 17 in Philadelphia.

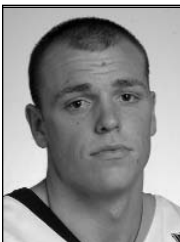

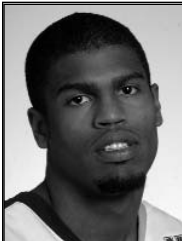
