TOP STORIES

- Four Marquette starters (Jerel McNeal, Wesley Matthews, Dominic James and Lazar Hayward) combined for 75 points to lift the Golden Eagles past Villanova 79-72 on New Year's Day at the Bradley Center. It marked the first time in 21 outings, dating back to 2007-08, that the Wildcats saw four or more opposing players score in double digits. The last team to do it to Villanova was none other than Marquette, back on Feb. 25, 2008 at the Wachovia Center.
- After scoring 17 points in four games from Dec. 9-22, sophomore guard Corey Fisher has found his offensive groove of late. Fisher dropped in 44 points last week, including 23 points in a win over Temple and 21 in the defeat at Marquette. The product of St. Patrick's High School in New Jersey has upped his scoring average to 10.8 ppg.
- Tonight marks Villanova's first ever appearance at the Prudential Center in Newark, N.J. The Wildcats were 8-12 (.400) against Seton Hall at its former home in the Meadowlands. This is Seton Hall's second season in the Prudential Center, which opened in the fall of 2007.
- Villanova plays its first BIG EAST home game this Saturday at the Wachovia Center in South Philadelphia when it hosts Louisville at noon (ESPN/ESPN 950 Radio).

Marquette Prevailed

Four years have passed since Marquette entered the BIG EAST Conference and Villanova has come to know well the potency of the Golden Eagles, particularly its group of now senior guards (Dominic James, Wesley Matthews and Jerel McNeal). After Villanova rallied to win 72-67 in 2005-06 at the Pavilion, the Golden Eagles have taken the last three meetings, including the most recent, a 79-72 triumph on New Year's Day.

"I think we just played a great team with veteran guards," noted Jay Wright afterwards. "If you weren't playing against them, they would be fun to watch. They just controlled the game.

"Veteran guards win in college basketball. Those guys are big-time."

The last three meetings, including two at the Bradley Center and another at the Wachovia Center, have been remarkably similar. Marquette won at home in 2006-07 (80-67), on the road in '07-08 (85-75) and again at home last week.

The Golden Eagles have averaged 81.3 points in those meetings and were 28-of-68 from beyond the arc (.411). That's an average of 9.3 triples per meeting surrendered by the 'Cats against Marquette since 2007. James has averaged 20.0 ppg, McNeal 17.6 ppg, and Matthews 11.3 ppg in that stretch.

"We didn't play badly," stated Wright. "Obviously there are things we can improve on. Turnovers hurt us. (But) guards like that are going to be very successful. I love their team."

The teams meet again on Feb. 10.

Reynolds Wrap

Offensive fireworks have been a Scottie Reynolds trademark since he came to Villanova in 2007. But for much of this early season his contributions have come in a wide range of areas that haven't always included points.

Reynolds contributed 15 points in the loss at Marquette, including 3-of-8 from beyond the 3-point arc.

But points aren't the only measure of Reynolds' enhanced role in 2008-09.

With 58 assists - an average of 4.1 apg - Reynolds leads the Wildcats. His ratio of 58 assists to 32 turnovers is a marked improvement over his sophomore campaign (113 assists, 107 turnovers).

On the season Reynolds is 30-of-79 (.380) from beyond the 3-point arc and is 53-of-63 (.841) at the line. He sank the free throws that allowed the Wildcats to rally to a Big Five win over Saint Joseph's on Dec. 11.

Reynolds did not attempt any free throws against the Golden Eagles and that's usually not good news for the Wildcats. In 78 career games, Reynolds has attempted four or more free throws 56 times. In those games, Villanova is 41-15 (.732).

Midway through his third college season, Reynolds has scored 1,241 points - an average of 15.0 per game. He now ranks 36th all-time in scoring at Villanova and needs 23 points to move past Jack Devine into 35th place.

Reynolds was named a pre-season All BIG EAST selection. On Nov. 7, it was announced that he is one of 50 players nationally included on the Wooden Award Preseason watch list.

Dante's Inferno

Over the course of his first three seasons, Dante Cunningham has been one of Villanova's most dependable defenders, rebounders and leaders. His offense, though, has typically taken a backseat to that of such gifted scorers as Reynolds, Randy Foye, Kyle Lowry, and Curtis Sumpter.

But in 2008-09 Cunningham has moved to the forefront as a major offensive weapon.

"Dante has developed into a confident scorer," said Wright. "We have to find more ways to get him the ball."

Already this season the 6-8 product of Silver Spring, Md., has twice been named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll and was most valuable player of the Philly Hoop Group Classic. He has reached double figures in scoring of 16 of his last 17 games dating to last season.

Cunningham was a cornerstone again for Villanova at Marquette, scoring 16 points to go with eight rebounds on New Year's Day.

This season, the 6-8 forward is 95-of-169 (.562) from the field. He is presently averaging 12.1 shots per game, up from a 7.5 attempt per game average last year. His 958 career points have moved him within range of 1,000.

Cunningham also leads VU in rebounding at 7.6 rpg. He now has 638 career caroms. He is presently tied for 23rd place all-time with Wildcat legend Bob Schafer on the school's all-time rebounding list.

Scoring and rebounding aren't the only areas where Cunningham is moving up the school's all-time lists. He now has 140 career steals, good for 15th place.

Defensive Details

Villanova has leaned on its defense in capturing 12 of its first 14 games this season. Marquette's 79 point outburst represent the most points the Wildcats have surrendered this season, exceeding the previous high by 11 points. It was the most points scored against VU since the quarterfinals of the 2008 BIG EAST Tournament when Georgetown defeated VU 82-63, a stretch of 16 games.

In seven of its 14 contests, VU has held the opposition to 59 points or less. The Wildcats begin the week ranked fourth overall in points allowed in the BIG EAST, trailing only West Virginia (56.2 ppg), Georgetown (57.4 ppg), and Pitt (57.9 ppg) at 59.1 ppg.

One area of concern is beyond the 3-point arc. Villanova ranked near the bottom of the BIG EAST in that category for much of 2007-08 and was as low as 15th in February before improving down the stretch. Marquette sank 10-of-24 (.411) from deep last Thursday and VU's foes are conencting on .340 of their attempts for the season.

The Wildcats have been hurt by the triple in two of their last three games, dating back to a Dec. 22 victory over Navy. The Midshipmen were 14-of-28 (.500) from deep, though the 'Cats prevailed 78-68. VU was much better against Temps, limiting the Owls' to 4-of-14 shooting from deep (.286). Then came the damage at Marquette.

VU's foes have drained 28-of-66 (.424) from outside the arc in the Wildcats' last three outings.

A Fish Called Corey

Sophomore Corey Fisher was the *Newark Star Ledger's* 2007 New Jersey Prep Player of the Year and has been a force of late. The 6-1 Fisher is coming off a breakthrough week to close out 2008. After tying a career high with 23 points in a victory over Temple, he followed that with a 21-point, five rebound effort against Marquette.

His 13-of-22 effort from the field helped earn him his first Philadelphia Big Five player of the week award.

"Corey is coming," stated Wright. "It's no surprise. He's really starting to play defense better and that's what really helps."

Stokes Strokes

Fans in this part of New Jersey are familiar with another former prep standout from the area, sophomore Corey Stokes. The 6-5 swingman has continued to blossom as a dangerous wing scorer in his second season on the Main Line.

Stokes picked up 10 points at Marquette and ranks third among the Wildcats in scoring at 11.3 ppg. He has started all but one game this season and that was owed to a sprained left thumb.

When Stokes is in the offensive flow that's usually good news for Villanova. Last season the Wildcats were 6-2 (.750) when the 6-5 guard from Bayonne, N.J. reached double figures in points.

This year, VU is 7-2 (.777) when Stokes reaches double digits in points. That's a two-season mark of 13-4 (.765).

'Cats Sign Trio of Standouts

A trio of nationally prominent seniors have inked national letters of intent to attend Villanova University in the fall of 2009, it was announced today. The group includes forward Isaiah Armwood from Montrose Christian Academy (Rockville, Md.); guard Maalik Wayns of Philadelphia's Roman Catholic High School and power forward Mouphtaou Yarou, a native of Benin in the republic of West Africa who also attends Montrose Christian Academy.

ESPN.com ranks the class as No. 2 in the nation.

"We are as excited about this class as any we have brought to Villanova," stated head coach Jay Wright. "This group offers us a unique combination of frontcourt and backcourt talent with exceptional skill and incredible character. The loyalty each of these young men has shown to our program through this process is heartwarming to all of us in the Villanova Basketball Family."

Armwood, 6-8, is a versatile forward who has been a fixture for national prep powerhouse Montrose Christian Academy. He averaged 12 points and eight rebounds as a junior before being sidelined by a left knee injury. It is expected that he will be a key performer in his final prep season for Montrose. He is listed as the No. 35 ranked prospect on ESPNU's Top 100 list.

"Isaiah is an athletically gifted wing player who has played four years for coach Stu Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy," stated Wright. "He has been well-schooled in the fundamentals. We expect him to make an immediate impact at Villanova with his quickness and athleticism."

Wayns is a 6-1 guard who averaged 22.4 points, 5.1 assists and 4.8 rebounds per game as a junior at Roman Catholic High School. Last summer, he represented the United States as a member of USA Basketball's 18-and-under team that competed in Argentina. He is ranked by espn.com as the No. 22 senior in the country.

"Maalik Wayns is the leader of this class," said Wright. "He was the first one of this group to commit to us and he encouraged his friends Isaiah and Mough (Yarou) to join him at Villanova. Maalik will be the next in the line of great Villanova guards. We're so proud to have another Roman Catholic Cahillite with us on the Villanova campus."

Rounding out the group of fall signees is Yarou, a 6-9 power forward who in a short period of time in the United States has emerged as one of the nation's most coveted big men - the No. 27 rated senior prospect in the nation according to espn.com. He enjoyed a breakthrough summer on the AAU circuit and will play this season for Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy.

"Mough' is as skilled a power forward as any frontcourt recruit we have had at Villanova," Wright stated. "He is very intelligent, extremely hard working and will be playing for a legendary coach this season in Stu Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy. Mough will make an immediate impact on our team with his rebounding and shot blocking ability."

Philadelphia Big Five

Villanova wrapped up the Philadelphia Big Five City Series coronation with a 62-45 victory over Temple on Dec. 29. The Wildcats were 4-0 against local rivals Penn, Saint Joseph's, La Salle and Temple and have taken 18 of their last 19 in City Series action. Since Jay Wright was named head coach in 2001, Villanova is 25-7 (.781) against its Big Five rivals and picked up its third 4-0 City Series slate in the last four seasons and seventh all-time.

Happy at Home

Villanova will play home games at three sites in 2008-09: the Pavilion, Wachovia Center and Wachovia Spectrum.

The Wildcats have played before a sellout crowd of 6,500 at the Pavilion for 90 consecutive regular season games. They now own a 23-game winning streak at the Pavilion dating to January of 2007.

Villanova is 46-4 (.920) in the building on Ithan Avenue since 2005. It is now 207-54 (.793) all-time in the Pavilion. Since the start of the 1994-95 season, VU is 145-22 (.868) in the Pavilion. The 'Cats are 75-12 (.862) in Pavilion home games under Jay Wright.

The Wildcats will host three BIG EAST games at the Wachovia Center in Philadelphia this season, beginning on Jan. 10 (Louisville). VU then returns to the Center on Feb. 7 against Syracuse and Feb. 28 when it welcomes Georgetown to the building. Villanova has averaged better than 19,000 in attendance in its Center games since 2005.

VU hosts Villanova hosts Pitt at the Spectrum Jan. 28. The battle with the Panthers will be the final college basketball game in the 41-year

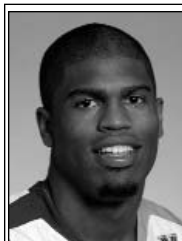
