### TOP STORIES

• Villanova racked up its 200th Pavilion win on Friday night with a 78-60 triumph over Albany. The 'Cats now own a 200-54 (.787) mark inside the Pavilion since it opened on Feb. 1, 1986 and have captured 16 in a row in their on-campus home. VU was a perfect 11-0 in the Pavilion in 2007-08. Its last loss on the court came to DePaul, 73-65, on Jan. 6, 2007.

• Senior swingman Dwayne Anderson, who was so instrumental in the Wildcats' late-season charge to the NCAA Tournament, has been sidelined indefinitely by a stress fracture in his left foot. The injury was revealed in an MRI taken on Thursday afternoon and evaluated by team orthopedist Dr. Rob Good.

• Balance was the name of the offensive game for the Wildcats on Friday evening as its six leaders in minutes played - Dante Cunningham, Antonio Pena, Scottie Reynolds, Corey Stokes, Reggie Redding and Corey Fisher - all scored in double figures.

• With its win over Albany, Villanova improved to 22-7 (.759) in the month of November in the tenure of head coach Jay Wright.

• The hectic early pace continues for the 'Cats as they host Niagara on Wednesday night (ESPN) in the first of four games in the Philly Hoop Group Classic.

# 2008-09 MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

## A Steady Start

Twice this season, Villanova has played before a live audience. And on both occasions, the Wildcats announced a significant injury to one of its senior linchpins that same day.

Shane Clark underwent arthroscopic surgery on his right knee on Nov. 6, hours before Villanova played its exhibition game at the Wachovia Center against Northwood. Then on Friday the word came that Dwayne Anderson's lingering soreness in his left foot was owed to a stress fracture.

So with two key cogs out of the lineup, Villanova brought a shortened bench into its opening night encounter with Albany. Yet in spite of the adversity, VU grabbed the early advantage against the Great Danes and built a 40-24 halftime lead. Albany shaved the edge to 11 at two points in the second half but could get no closer.

"This was a good start for us," stated Villanova head coach Jay Wright. "I want to give Albany credit. I have been on the other side of this matchup, being the coach of a mid-major team. Albany battled us tough. They were physical and we only beat them by three on the glass.

"We have work to do but we got Frank Tchuisi some time and Casiem Drummond more time. It's going to be that kind of a season. We have to find a way to play with these eight guys. I think we can do it but it's not pretty right now."

Villanova improved to 81-8 (.910) all-time in season openers and posted its 18th consecutive home opening victory.

## Reynolds Wrap

With 1,042 points in his first two seasons on the Main Line, junior guard Scottie Reynolds has already made an imprint on Villanova Basketball. He stands at No. 48 on the school's all-time scoring chart and is at 1,055 points after the season opener.

Reynolds was named a pre-season All BIG EAST selection last month. On Nov. 7, it was announced that he is one of 50 players nationally included on the Wooden Award Preseason list.

On Friday evening he supplied 13 points - all in the second half - to go with six assists and only one turnover in the Wildcats' 78-60 victory over Albany. Ironically, it marked the third time in three seasons that the product of Herndon (Va.) High School has begun the season by contributing 13 points.

One of Reynolds' strengths is his ability to get to the free throw line. In 69 career games, Reynolds has attempted four or more free throws 49 times. In those 49 games, Villanova is 35-14 (.714). He was 3-of-3 at the stripe in the win over Albany.

Last season Reynolds helped nurture young guards Corey Fisher and Corey Stokes after he benefitted from the guidance of former 'Cat guard Mike Nardi in 2006-07. Reynolds became the primary point guard for Villanova late in the season. He scored 92 points in the Wildcats five postseason games last season - an average of 18.4 ppg.

Reynolds also added a pair of steals to his stat line against the Great Danes. His next steal will be the 100th of his career.

## Cunningham's Court

He has been a fixture in the lineup since his freshman campaign of 2005-06, when he helped Randy Foye, Kyle Lowry, Allan Ray, Jason Fraser and friends make an appearance in the Elite Eight. Already the 6-8 native has played 102 career games in a Villanova uniform and logged 2,591 minutes.

"Dante has become a great leader in this program in the same fashion that Mike Nardi, Curtis Sumpter, Randy Foye and Allan Ray were," states Wright. "He takes pride in that and also has become a more confident offensive player. I think he is one of the best defensive players in the country and he tends to be underrated for that. He defends any position."

Cunningham helped set an early tone against Albany, teaming with Antonio Pena to score the 'Cats first 18 points of the game. He finished with 13 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the field to go with six rebounds, three assists and one steal.

With 541 career caroms, Cunningham enters 2008-09 ranks 37th on the school's all-time list. Joe Crews (544 caroms) stands ahead of him at No. 36 on that list. His 116 career steals place him at No. 22 all-time.

Cunningham says he is ready to handle the extra burden created by the loss to injury of his classmates Anderson and Clark.

"Our strength and conditioning coach (Lon Record) did a great job getting us prepared for the season," Cunningham stated. "It's not like he knew this would happen but we have worked hard every day, getting up and down the court as hard as we can."

## Dwayne is Derailed

Anderson, who averaged 9.7 points and 7.0 rebounds per game after he was inserted into the starting lineup on Feb. 9, 2008, learned there is a stress fracture in his left foot on Nov. 13, one day before the start of his senior campaign.

“(Dwayne) has been complaining about it getting worse and worse and then in the Northwood game he just didn’t look like himself,” stated Wright. “He came back and practiced until Thursday when we got the MRI and found out for sure. We aren’t sure how long it’s going to be but we know it’s not good right now. It’s just going to be a matter of time.”

## Speaking Frankly

The injuries to Clark and Anderson have nudged the door open a bit for classmate Frank Tchuisi. The native of Cameroon notched a career-high 11 minutes in the season opening victory over Albany. He added two points and three rebounds.

“We got some good minutes out of Frank,” noted Wright. “He can help us.”

Prior to Friday evening, Tchuisi had logged 59 career minutes in 30 games.

## Introducing Russell

One of the newest members of the Wildcats, junior Russell Wooten made his college debut against Albany, picking up one rebound.

## Polling Data

Villanova enters the 2008-09 campaign ranked No. 23 in the Associated Press poll and No. 25 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll. The Wildcats last entered a season ranked in both polls in 2005-06, when they opened at No. 5 in each.

Last season, Villanova began the campaign receiving votes and then entered the Associated Press poll in the first regular season entry at No. 24. The ‘Cats spent a total of 10 weeks ranked in the AP poll in 2007-08, peaking at No. 17 on Jan. 8. They fell out of the AP poll on Jan. 29.

## Opponent Observations

Albany head coach Will Brown took note of the Wildcats after his squad fell at the Pavilion on opening night.

“We were kind of a deer caught in the headlights for the first 10 minutes,” Brown said. “Our energy was good but their pressure and size and their length bothered us quite a bit. They were very aggressive, more so than I anticipated them being defensively. I was very impressed and it was tough for us to recover.

“They spread the floor so well and Scottie Reynolds and Fisher are so good off the bounce that the big guys just have to stay out of their way. They make the big guys look good and if you don’t help off of the big guys the guards will finish at the rim. They are good. I like Jay’s team. They will go deep in the NCAA Tournament if they stay healthy.”

### 'Cats Sign Trio of Standouts

A trio of nationally prominent seniors have inked national letters of intent to attend Villanova University in the fall of 2009, it was announced today. The group includes forward Isaiah Armwood from Montrose Christian Academy (Rockville, Md.); guard Maalik Wayns of Philadelphia's Roman Catholic High School and power forward Mouphtaou Yarou, a native of Benin in the republic of West Africa who also attends Montrose Christian Academy.

ESPN.com ranks the class as No. 2 in the nation.

"We are as excited about this class as any we have brought to Villanova," stated head coach Jay Wright. "This group offers us a unique combination of frontcourt and backcourt talent with exceptional skill and incredible character. The loyalty each of these young men has shown to our program through this process is heartwarming to all of us in the Villanova Basketball Family."

Armwood, 6-8, is a versatile forward who has been a fixture for national prep powerhouse Montrose Christian Academy. He averaged 12 points and eight rebounds as a junior before being sidelined by a left knee injury. It is expected that he will be a key performer in his final prep season for Montrose. He is listed as the No. 35 ranked prospect on ESPNU's Top 100 list.

"Isaiah is an athletically gifted wing player who has played four years for coach Stu Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy," stated Wright. "He has been well-schooled in the fundamentals. We expect him to make an immediate impact at Villanova with his quickness and athleticism."

Wayns is a 6-1 guard who averaged 22.4 points, 5.1 assists and 4.8 rebounds per game as a junior at Roman Catholic High School. Last summer, he represented the United States as a member of USA Basketball's 18-and-under team that competed in Argentina. He is ranked by espn.com as the No. 22 senior in the country.

"Maalik Wayns is the leader of this class," said Wright. "He was the first one of this group to commit to us and he encouraged his friends Isaiah and Moof' (Yarou) to join him at Villanova. Maalik will be the next in the line of great Villanova guards. We're so proud to have another Roman Catholic Cahillite with us on the Villanova campus."

Rounding out the group of fall signees is Yarou, a 6-9 power forward

who in a short period of time in the United States has emerged as one of the nation's most coveted big men - the No. 27 rated senior prospect in the nation according to espn.com. He enjoyed a breakthrough summer on the AAU circuit and will play this season for Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy.

"Moof' is as skilled a power forward as any frontcourt recruit we have had at Villanova," Wright stated. "He is very intelligent, extremely hard working and will be playing for a legendary coach this season in Stu Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy. Moof' will make an immediate impact on our team with his rebounding and shot blocking ability."

### Philadelphia Big Five

The Big Five has been part of the Philadelphia basketball scene since 1955 and the City Series will again be a part of Villanova's schedule. The Wildcats, who have won or shared the city crown in each of the past four seasons, will play four games against their local rivals in December. The list includes:

### Happy at Home

Villanova will play home games at three sites in 2008-09: the Pavilion, Wachovia Center and Wachovia Spectrum.

The Wildcats have played before a sellout crowd of 6,500 at the Pavilion for 83 consecutive regular season games. The last time they failed to do so came during a snow storm in December of 2000.

Villanova is 39-4 (.907) in the building on Ithan Avenue since 2005. It is now 200-54 (.788) all-time in the Pavilion. Since the start of the 1994-95 season, VU is 138-22 (.863) in the Pavilion. The 'Cats are 68-12 (.850) in Pavilion home games under Jay Wright.

The Wildcats will host three BIG EAST games at the Wachovia Center in Philadelphia this season, beginning on Jan. 10 (Louisville). VU then returns to the Center on Feb. 7 against Syracuse and Feb. 28 when it welcomes Georgetown to the building. Villanova has averaged better than 19,000 in attendance in its Center games since 2005.
