### TOP STORIES

- Stingy defense has been Villanova's calling card of late. In its last six outings, the Wildcats have surrendered an average of 56.7 ppg. Their opponents have connected on just 104-of-288 field goal attempts in that stretch (.361). On the year the 'Cats opponents average 63.9 ppg and connect on .417 of their field goal attempts.
- The Wildcats have won their first four games in February to continue a pleasant pattern. Villanova is now 17-3 (.850) in the month of February over the last three seasons (2005-07).
- This marks the second meeting of the season between Villanova and Georgetown. The two clubs met at the Verizon Center on Jan. 8 with the 'Cats emerging with a 56-52 victory over the Hoyas. Herndon, Va., native Scottie Reynolds scored 16 points to lead the 'Cats in his homecoming. Teammates Dante Cunningham, Dwayne Anderson and Ross Condon all hail from metropolitan Washington, D.C.
- Villanova will move quickly back into action when it travels to meet No. 12 Marquette at the Bradley Center (ESPN/7:00 p.m.) on Monday night. The 'Cats are currently in a stretch where they will play three times in six days, including Wednesday night's win over Cincinnati at the Pavilion.
- **RPI Details:** Entering this afternoon's game, Villanova ranks No. 16 in the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), with a strength-of-schedule rating of No. 7. Georgetown ranks No. 20 overall and No. 34 in strength-of-schedule. (based on espn.com InsideRPI report on Feb. 15)

## 2006-07 MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

### Cincy Story

On a frigid evening outside, the Villanova Wildcats turned to their trusted ally, rugged defense, to produce a methodical 64-48 victory over the Cincinnati Bearcats at the Pavilion on Wednesday.

Cincinnati spent the better part of Tuesday traveling as it attempted to dodge the winter blast in both Ohio and Pennsylvania. They Bearcats eventually reached Philadelphia late Tuesday.

The Bearcats sank two early 3-point field goals to build a 6-3 edge with 17:09 to go in the first half. But from that point forward, points became hard to come. Cincinnati did not score for the next 11:35, by which point Villanova had put together a 22-0 run to create a 25-6 lead.

By halftime, the lead was 34-17.

"They hit a couple of shots at the start," stated Villanova head coach Jay Wright. "But I felt like we were executing early. On the first play, even though it was a turnover, Curt (Sumpter) made a good read. Will (Sheridan) was there but just got it ripped out of his hands. But that is what we were trying to do."

Villanova stretched its lead to as many as 29 points in the second half before posting the 64-48 triumph.

"This was a good performance for us," stated Wright. "I have watched a lot of Cincinnati games. They play hard and tough on the road. This is the second game in a row where we have executed at the start."

### Curtis Sumpter Illuminated

The linchpin of the Villanova attack is senior forward Curtis Sumpter. He is nearing the end of what has been a remarkable five year journey on campus.

In January, Sumpter was plagued by two separate nagging leg injuries unrelated to his twice repaired left knee. The first was a right hamstring strained in early in the month that prevented him for practicing. The latter was a deep bone bruise suffered on Jan. 17 that caused him to miss one game and limited him in several more.

Lately, though, Sumpter has looked better to Wright.

"I think he is feeling as healthy as he has in a while," stated Wright. "I like the way he's moving."

Sumpter was limited to eight points, all in the second half against the Bearcats.

"The way they were playing Curt with double and triple teams," stated senior Mike Nardi, "he was making great decisions and getting other guys shots."

Sumpter has topped the 20 point mark ten times in 2006-07 and was named to this week's BIG EAST honor roll.

Says Wright: "Curtis is one of the most versatile players I have ever coached. He shoots, drives and defends from the perimeter. He can post up, rebound and block shots inside. He's a leader and a 'big game' player. He's one of the most respected young men on our campus. Curtis is a true All-American."

### Essential Nardi

Although he has spent much of his career in the shadow of headline grabbing guards, Mike Nardi's contribution to Villanova remains essential.

On Saturday, Nardi keyed Villanova's early surge that staked the Wildcats to a double digit lead. He hit his first five shots of the evening. By night's end he had dropped in 4-of-5 from beyond the 3-point arc for a team-high 16 points.

This native of Linden, N.J. has been one of Villanova's most reliable performers over his career. He now has started 117 times in 121 appearances and became the 49th player in school history to reach the 1,000 point barrier at Penn on Dec. 2 (he is now at 1,262 points). That leaves him in 35th place on the school's all-time list of scoring leaders.

In addition, the 6-2 guard is one of the more accomplished distributors in Villanova history. He now has 408 career assists, good for 12th place on the school's all-time list. His assist to turnover ratio is 109 to 52 and he averages 4.4 app.

Nardi has played the most minutes of any Wildcat - an average of 32.4 mpg.

"He's done everything we've asked of him," Wright told the Newark Star-Ledger. "We've asked him to groom a freshman guard (Scottie Reynolds), be a leader for 10 freshmen and sophomores, play 36 minutes a game, defend, rebound and also be the brains of our operation. And he has done all of it."

### Board Scores

In 2005-06 Villanova, with four guards under 6-4 in its starting line-up, battled each night to hold its own on the glass.

It's been a different story in 2006-07. The Wildcats have outrebounded the opposition 19 times in 25 outings thus far and are atop the BIG EAST in rebound margin. On the season, the 'Cats have averaged 36.4 rebounds per game while their opponents have averaged 29.8 rpg. There have been 10 times this season, including on Wednesday night against the Bearcats, when the Wildcats have outrebounded an opponent by double digits.

Villanova chalked up a 35-25 edge on the glass in the win over Cincinnati. Fifteen of those rebounds came at the offensive end. Six different Wildcats had three or more rebounds, led by Dante Cunningham's nine.

Four Wildcats average at least 4.2 rebounds per game on the season. They include Sumpter (6.9), Cunningham (5.6), Sheridan (5.1) and Shane Clark (4.2).

### Dante's Development

The maturation of sophomore forward Dante Cunningham into an offensive force has been one of the key story lines to the 2006-07 Villanova campaign.

To understand why one needs look no further than this: when Cunningham attempts four or more field goals in a game this season, Villanova is 17-2 (.895). When he has been limited to three or less, the 'Cats are just 1-5 (.167).

On Saturday Cunningham dropped in 3-of-7 from the field and was a perfect 5-of-5 at the line. The 6-8 forward is now 83-of-173 (.606) from the floor and 53-of-73 (.726) at the line. As a freshman, the 6-8 forward was 29-of-62 (.468) from the field and 13-of-33 (.394) from the free throw stripe.

As a rookie last season, Cunningham averaged 2.2 points and 4.0 rebounds per game mostly as a reserve. Despite those modest figures, a measure of the 6-8 sophomore's value was seen when he was selected as the Philadelphia Big Five Rookie of the Year for his contributions to a 28-5 unit.

Cunningham averages 8.8 ppg. and has been used as a sixth man in each of the last three outings.

### Reynolds Wrap

When the summary of Scottie Reynolds' Villanova career is ultimately written, the month of January 2007 may well be recalled as a turning point.

After 12 games of adapting to college over the campaign's first seven weeks, Reynolds put together an extraordinary month. In nine games he averaged 18.1 points and 4.0 assists per game. He was 20-of-47 (.426) from beyond the 3-point arc in that stretch and twice was named BIG EAST Rookie of the Week. In addition, he earned Sporting News and ESPN player of the week honors on Jan. 22.

In Villanova's first 12 outings this season, Reynolds attempted 75 field goals - an average of 6.2 per contest. In the last 12 games, including 10 in the BIG EAST, he has attempted 146 - 11.2 per contest.

Part of Reynolds' growth has come in his ability to get to the line. In his first 11 games this season, the 6-2 guard attempted 26 free throws - an average of 2.4 per game. In the 14 games since, he has been to the line 86 times (6.1 per game). Reynolds has converted his last 19 free throws and connects at an .848 clip on the season.

He averages 11.8 ppg, fourth among BIG EAST freshmen, after adding nine points, three assists and three steals in the victory over the Bearcats.

### Home Court Advantages

The Pavilion has been a most comfortable home for the Wildcats since opening on Feb. 1, 1986.

In 22 seasons, the 'Cats are 187-54 (.776) in the building on Ithan Avenue. They are 81-35 (.698) in BIG EAST action in the Pavilion and have sold out the last 69 consecutive regular season contests in the 6,500 seat venue. From 1994-95 forward, VU is 126-22 (.851) overall in the Pavilion.

Since Jay Wright assumed the head coaching reins in 2001, Villanova is 44-12 (.786) on its Pavilion floor. It is 25-4 (.862) in the arena since the start of 2004-05 with the losses coming to Georgetown (2005), West Virginia and Drexel (2006) and DePaul (2007). It had a 13-game winning streak against non-conference foes snapped when it fell to the Dragons 81-76 on Dec. 9.

Visitors to the Pavilion will note the construction in what formerly was the front parking area. Work has begun on the Intercollegiate Athletic Recreation Facility, which will house practice courts and office space for the men's and women's programs. The project is scheduled for completion in the fall of 2007.

The Wildcats also are hosting a school record five games this season at the Wachovia Center in Philadelphia. Villanova is 17-17 (.500) lifetime in the arena as host and 2-0 (1.000) in NCAA Tournament action in the building. The Wildcats are 2-1 at the Center in 2006-07, having defeated No. 23 Texas and Louisville and fallen to No. 7 Pittsburgh.

### Philadelphia Big Five Champs

Villanova wrapped up its second consecutive undefeated Philadelphia Big Five championship with a 56-39 triumph over Saint Joseph's at the Pavilion on Feb. 6.

The 'Cats opened Big Five play on Dec. 2 with a 99-89 win at Penn, their eighth consecutive victory in Big Five play. Villanova followed that with a 64-51 win at La Salle on Dec. 23. One week later, the 'Cats posted an 83-65 win over Temple to move to 3-0.

With the wins, Villanova improved its program-best Big Five winning streak to 11 games, one shy of the record set by Penn. VU last fell in the City Series on Dec. 2, 2004, when Temple edged it, 53-52.

Its top three scorers, Sumpter (.815), Nardi (.851) and Reynolds (.848) convert free throws at a rate of 80 percent or better. In addition, rotation regulars Shane Clark (.750), Will Sheridan (.745) and Dante Cunningham (.726) are all above the 70 percent mark.

### Clark Barometer

When Villanova has been at its best this season, 6-7 forward Shane Clark has usually been involved. The Wildcats are 12-1 (.923) when the native of Philadelphia scores nine or more points. They are 6-6 (.500) when he offers less.

After attempting only two 3-point field goals as a freshman in 2005-06, Clark has become a factor beyond the arc this season. He has converted 34-of-92 (.370) from deep thus far in the 2006-07 campaign.

"Shane is our Kyle (Lowry)," says Sumpter. "He comes in there, gets a big rebound or a big basket and gives us a lift."

The product of Cardinal Dougherty High School and Hargrave Military Academy averages 8.4 points and 4.1 rebounds a game. After serving as sixth man for the first 17 games of the season, Clark has started seven of the last eight for the Wildcats.

### That 70's Show

When it comes to points, the magic number for the Wildcats appears to be 70.

When Villanova has scored 70 or more points in 2006-07 it is 12-1 (.923). On those occasions when it fails to reach that number it is 6-6 (.500).

In BIG EAST games, the Wildcats are 3-0 when they reach 70 points and 4-5 (.444) when they fall below that number.

Points have been harder to come by since BIG EAST play began. In its 12 games in November and December, Villanova shot no worse than 40 percent from the field in any game and averaged 81 points per game.

Since conference play began the 'Cats have twice converted 50 percent or better from the field (wins over Notre Dame and Providence). In their eight other conference outings the 'Cats have not shot higher than .465 from the field.

### February Fun

Since opening the BIG EAST portion of its slate with one win in four outings, Villanova has posted some impressive numbers.

The Wildcats have won seven of their last nine games, including the last four in a row. They are 5-2 in BIG EAST competition, with the losses coming to No. 7 Pitt and No. 21 Notre Dame.

In February, the Wildcats have outscored the opposition by a margin of 63.8-52.2 (+11.5). They own a 39.5-28.0 (+11.5) rebounding margin and have five players averaging at least 7.5 points per game.

### Honoring its Past

The No. 11 black patch Villanova wears on its uniform honors the memory of Paul Arizin, who died in December at the age of 78.

Arizin enrolled at Villanova in 1946 but played only intramural basketball as a freshman. He was invited on to the squad as a sophomore and became the national player of the year in 1950. He then became a 10-time NBA All-Star and was named one of the league's 50 Greatest Players. His jersey and No. 11 are retired and hang in the Pavilion rafters.

The Wildcats lost another Villanova icon when former team chaplain (1978-2004) Father Bernard Lazor, O.S.A., died at the age of 81 on Jan. 14.

### Did You Know?

Villanova is 2-3 (.400) against the Top 25 in 2006-07.

The Wildcats own the No. 2 RPI in the BIG EAST entering weekend action (No. 17).

### Coming Attractions

Villanova signed three student-athletes in November who are scheduled to enroll in the fall of 2007.

Three talented guards have signed national letters of intent to attend Villanova University. The class includes 6-1 Corey Fisher of St. Patrick's (N.J.) High School; 6-0 Malcolm Grant of The Winchendon School (Mass.); and 6-5 Corey Stokes of St. Benedict's (N.J.) Prep.

"We are thrilled to have three more East Coast guards that are outstanding players and beautiful people join our family at Villanova," stated Villanova head coach Jay Wright in making the announcement on Nov. 14. "We are extremely impressed by the pedigree of these three guards. They all come to us from exceptionally strong and tradition-laden programs."

Fisher, a native of the Bronx, N.Y., helped lead St. Patrick's High School to the New Jersey Tournament of Champions title last March. He was a first team all-state choice by Newark Star Ledger after averaging 14.9 points and 4.2 assists per outing in 2005-06. Fisher hails from the same high school as current 'Cat senior Mike Nardi.

"Corey Fisher is extremely well-prepared for college basketball after playing for coach Kevin Boyle at St. Pat's," said Wright. "Corey is in the same mold as Mike Nardi, as he is both explosive and intelligent on the court."

Grant scored over 1,500 points in a decorated high school career at Brooklyn (N.Y.)'s Paul Robeson High School before enrolling at Winchendon this fall. As a senior at Robeson in 2005-06, Grant averaged 23.0 points, 2.6 rebounds and 2.0 assists per contest.

"Malcolm comes from a great high school program at Robeson where he was coached by Todd Miles and followed that this season in another great program at Winchendon, coached by Mike Byrnes," Wright stated. "Malcolm is a true point guard. He is crafty, tenacious and very charismatic."

Stokes was an integral component of another potent New Jersey squad in 2005-06, St. Benedict's Prep. He averaged 11.5 ppg as part of a balanced attack, connecting on 42 percent of his 3-point field goal attempts and joined Fisher on the first team all-state squad. One of Stokes' former teammates, sophomore Frank Tchuisi, is already a member of the Wildcats squad.

"Corey is probably one of the best shooters we have ever recruited at Villanova," said Wright. "He has also been very well coached by Danny Hurley at St. Benedict's Prep. Corey brings size, toughness and a great basketball IQ."

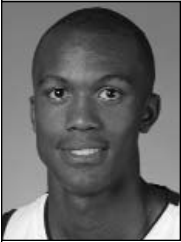

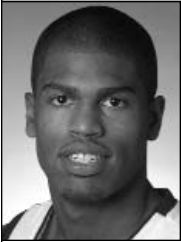
