**NEW HAMPSHIRE REPORT:** The Wildcats enter today's game with a 4-0 overall record and a 1-0 league mark after opening CAA play on the road last Saturday with a 57-7 win over Towson. The win moved New Hampshire up to No. 5 in this week's national rankings.

In the win over Towson, the Wildcats got two touchdowns from their defense on interception returns and another from special teams on an 81-yard kickoff return.

For the season, New Hampshire is averaging 37.0 points per game while giving up just 12.8 points per game to its opponents. The Wildcats are balanced offensively with an average of 178.8 passing yards and 174.2 rushing yards per game.

Junior quarterback R.J. Toman is 41-of-71 for 461 yards and three scores, with senior tight end Scott Sicko and junior running back Sean Jellison the leading targets with 12 and 11 catches, respectively. Jellison leads the ground game as well with 59 carries for 250 yards and three touchdowns.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE HEAD COACH SEAN MCDONNELL:** In his 11th season as the head coach of the Wildcats, Sean McDonnell has a career record of 74-50 (.597) at the school entering Saturday's game.

Last season, McDonnell led New Hampshire to a 10-3 overall record, including a 6-2 mark against CAA opponents. The Wildcats reached the second round of the Division I Football Championship while making their fifth consecutive playoff appearance. During the five-year streak, New Hampshire has become the only program in CAA history to reach the playoff quarterfinals in four consecutive seasons.

McDonnell has recruited players to come to New Hampshire such as 2005 Walter Payton Award winner Ricky Santos and wide receiver David Ball, who broke Jerry Rice's collegiate touchdown record with 58 scores. McDonnell was named the Eddie Robinson 2005 National Coach of the Year, when the Wildcats went 11-2.

## 2009 Game Notes

**25th ANNIVERSARY:** Villanova head coach **Andy Talley** is celebrating his 25th season on the Main Line in 2009. During his Wildcat career, Talley has registered a 170-110-1 record, making him the all-time winningest coach in Villanova history. His 29-year overall coaching record currently stands at 198-119-2. Throughout his tenure at Villanova, Talley has guided the Wildcats to seven NCAA playoff appearances (1989, 1991, 1992, 1996, 1997, 2002 and 2008), four conference titles and two Lambert Meadowlands trophies. In 1997, Talley garnered the Eddie Robinson Award and the AFCA/GTE National Coach of the Year Award after leading Villanova to a perfect 11-0 regular season and the No. 1 ranking in the country for the last six weeks of the season.

**CLOSELY CONTESTED:** Over the years, the Battle of the Wildcats between Villanova and New Hampshire has been a closely contested series. Heading into Saturday's game, Villanova owns a slim 10-8 advantage in the all-time series with New Hampshire.

**TOP 10 MATCH-UP:** For the second straight year, the game between Villanova and New Hampshire will feature two teams in the Top 10. Villanova enters play ranked No. 2 this week, while New Hampshire is No. 5. Last year when the two teams met in Pennsylvania, Villanova was ranked No. 6 and New Hampshire was No. 8.

**IT'S BEEN A WHILE:** Villanova will be playing at New Hampshire's Cowell Stadium for the first time since 2005 when the Wildcats travel to Durham this Saturday. Villanova is 5-4 all-time at New Hampshire. In its last visit to Durham, No. 1 New Hampshire registered a 45-17 win over Villanova.

**PLAYING THE BEST:** Villanova is in the midst of a grueling three-game stretch. Last week, the Wildcats tallied a 28-17 home win over No. 5 William & Mary. For the second straight week, Villanova will play the No. 5 team in the nation when the Wildcats travel to New Hampshire this Saturday. Next week, Villanova plays at No. 13 James Madison. There are six CAA teams ranked in the Top 25 this week. In addition to Villanova, New Hampshire and James Madison, Richmond is No. 1, William & Mary is No. 8 and Massachusetts is No. 12.

**LEAVING TOWN:** For the first time this year, Villanova will play a game outside of Philadelphia. In addition to playing three home games, the Wildcats played at Temple and at Penn in the first five weeks of the season. Villanova will also play away next Saturday when the Wildcats travel to Harrisonburg, Va., to take on the James Madison Dukes.

**NORTHERN EXPOSURE:** Villanova is in the South Division of the CAA, while New Hampshire is in the North Division. The conference schedule is set-up where each team plays every school in its own division and three of the six teams in the opposite division. Entering play this Saturday at New Hampshire, Villanova has won six of its last seven versus North Division opponents. The Wildcats are 1-0 this season against the north with a 56-7 win over Northeastern in week four.

**STRONG BEGINNING:** The Wildcats are 5-0 for the first time since 2003. That 2003 team started 6-0 before finishing 7-4 overall and 4-4 in league play.

**WEEK IN AND WEEK OUT:** For the 15th straight week, Villanova finds itself ranked in the Top 10 in the *Sports Network* Top 25. This is the fourth longest active FCS streak in regards to being in the *Sports Network* Top 10. Appalachian State leads the way with 54 consecutive weeks in the Top 10 followed by Northern Iowa at 35 and Richmond at 24.

**CAA SUCCESS:** In the last 12 CAA games, the Villanova Wildcats are an impressive 11-1. Villanova won its final two league games in 2007, went 7-1 last season in conference play and are currently 2-0 this year.

**DOING WELL:** Dating back to the last four games of the 2006 campaign, Villanova is 25-5 against FCS (formerly I-AA) opponents. In addition, the 'Cats have won 16 of their 18 games against FCS programs.

**GUARDING THE END ZONE:** Entering play on Saturday at New Hampshire, the Villanova defense has allowed just two touchdowns in the last 12 quarters of play. After giving up just a field goal at Penn on Sept. 19, Villanova yielded one touchdown in a win over Northeastern on Sept. 26. Last week, William & Mary managed just one touchdown against the Wildcat defensive unit.

**ACTING DEFENSIVE:** If the statistics are any indication, Saturday's game between Villanova and New Hampshire will be a defensive battle. New Hampshire enters play with the top rated defense in the CAA for overall games at 12.8 points per game, while Villanova is second with a scoring defense average of 13.6 points per contest.

**POSITIVE PITTS:** The player of the game for the Wildcat defense last Saturday was sophomore cornerback **James Pitts**. In his team's 28-17 victory, Pitts recorded a career-high 15 tackles (13 solo), one fumble recovery (20 yard return), a tackle for loss and a pass break-up. The pass break-up resulted in an interception in the end zone on a third and goal play. After five games, Pitts has 30 total tackles (fourth on team), a team-high tying two interceptions and three tackles for loss. Pitts has four career interceptions in just five career starts.

**TERRIFIC TERENCE:** Junior linebacker **Terence Thomas** continues to be a consistent performer for the Villanova defense. Thomas has started every game of his Villanova career and will be making his 30th consecutive start this Saturday at New Hampshire. Last Saturday against William & Mary, Thomas established a career-high with 14 total tackles. This was his second double digit tackle game of the season. In week three at Penn, Thomas was credited with 10 tackles. He currently leads the Wildcats in tackles with 34.

**DOUBLE DIGIT TACKLERS:** Three different Wildcats posted double digit tackle games in last Saturday's win over No. 5 William & Mary. All three individual totals were career-high tackle efforts. Sophomore corner **James Pitts** led the way with a career-high 15 stops, including 13 solo tackles, junior linebacker **Terence Thomas** totaled a career-best 14 tackles and junior linebacker **Marquis Kirkland** had a career-high 11 tackles.

**FREDDY PITCHES IN:** The three double digit tacklers weren't the only Wildcats to establish a career-high in tackles last Saturday versus William & Mary. Sophomore safety **Fred Maldonado** registered a career-high eight tackles to go with 1.5 tackles for loss and a sack.

**TAKE YOUR PICK:** The top two teams in interceptions in the CAA will face one another this week when Villanova and New Hampshire meet in Durham. New Hampshire leads the league in picks with 10 with Villanova right behind in second with nine. New Hampshire has returned three of its 10 interceptions for touchdowns. Villanova has had at least one interception in four of the five games this season. The Wildcats are led in this category by safety **Ross Ventrone** and corner **James Pitts** who have two interceptions each.

# 2009 Game Notes

**APPROACHING 100:** Entering play on Saturday at New Hampshire, senior wide receiver **Brandyn Harvey** has 99 career receptions and is just one catch shy of 100 career grabs. Harvey will become the 20th player in school history to record 100 career receptions. His 1,475 career receiving yards ranks him 13th in school history. Harvey currently leads the 2009 Wildcats in receiving with 22 catches for 326 yards and three touchdowns.

**LIMITED ACTION:** For the second time in three weeks the Villanova offense did not spend a lot of time on the field. In last week's win over William & Mary, the Wildcats ran just 52 offensive plays for 283 total yards. Two weeks earlier, Villanova ran 50 offensive plays for 187 yards in a win at Penn. After five games, Villanova is averaging just 61 plays per game and 359.2 yards of total offense per contest. Despite a low number of offensive plays, Villanova ranks second in the CAA in first downs with 99.

**GAINING GROUND:** Villanova continues to be an outstanding rushing offense. The Wildcats are averaging 205.2 rushing yards per game which ranks second in the CAA. James Madison is the league's top rushing team with an average of 212.5 rushing yards per contest. Villanova's best rushing performance of the season came against Northeastern on Sept. 26 when the 'Cats registered 410 yards rushing on 53 carries for an average of 7.7 yards per carry.

**CARRYING THE LOAD:** The Villanova rushing attack is led by junior quarterback **Chris Whitney**. After five games, Whitney leads the team in rushing with 307 yards on 63 carries (4.9 yards per rush) and two touchdowns. His best effort of the year came against Lehigh when he rushed for a career-best 130 yards. Whitney will be making his 21st career start this Saturday at New Hampshire. In his first 20 starts as Villanova's starting quarterback, Whitney has led the Wildcats to an impressive 16-4 mark. Whitney has never lost to an opponent with a sub-500 record and all four of his losses have come against teams ranked in the Top 15 nationally. In addition to his rushing stats, he has also completed 55-of-82 for 652 yards to go with six touchdowns and one interception.

**MULTIPLE TARGETS:** In last week's win over William & Mary, Villanova quarterbacks **Antwon Young** and **Chris Whitney** combined to complete 13-of-17 for 169 yards and one touchdown. Eight different players combined to account for the 13 receptions. Junior wideout **Matt Szczur** led the way with three catches for 26 yards.

**THE STORY ON SZCZUR:** Junior wide receiver **Matt Szczur** ranks in the top three in two statistical categories in the latest CAA statistics. He leads the league in kickoff return average at 31.4 yards per return and he ranks third in all-purpose yards per game at 116.2. Szczur is Villanova's second leading receiver with 12 catches for 98 yards and he is third on the team in rushing with 24 carries for 169 yards and two scores.

**MR. TOUCHDOWN:** Entering the 2009 season, fifth-year senior **Tony Canci** had never scored a touchdown during his Villanova career. After five games this year, Canci has five receptions with three of the five resulting in touchdowns. Canci had two receiving scores against Northeastern in week four. During his scholastic career at Sun Valley High School, Canci tied a Pennsylvania state record with eight touchdowns in a game.

**PERFECT PATS:** Redshirt freshman kicker **Nick Yako** leads the CAA in PATs with 22 made in 22 attempts. Yako is also 3-of-4 in field goal attempts but has not attempted a field goal in the last two games.

**PRE-SEASON FAVORITE:** In the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) pre-season predicted order of finish, Villanova and defending National Champion Richmond earned a first place tie to win the South Division with nine first place votes each. The two schools were also chosen as the co-overall champions of the league. New Hampshire was picked to win the North Division title.

**ALL-CONFERENCE ACCOLADES:** Four Wildcats were named to the pre-season first team All-CAA squad. On the offensive side of the ball, junior offensive lineman **Ben Ijalana** (Hainesport, N.J.) and junior wide receiver **Matt Szczur** (Erma, N.J.) earned first team All-CAA honors. Defensively, senior linebacker **Osayi Osunde** (Bloomsburg, Pa.) and senior defensive end **Tim Kukucka** (Wall, N.J.) garnered first team All-Conference acclaim.

**ALL-AMERICAN DISTINCTION:** Four Wildcats garnered pre-season All-American accolades by *The Sports Network*. Senior linebacker **Osayi Osunde** and junior offensive tackle **Ben Ijalana** were named to *The Sports Network* pre-season first team All-American squad, while senior defensive end **Tim Kukucka** and senior center **Brian Brannigan** were third team pre-season All-American selections.

**LEADING THE WAY:** The 2009 Villanova captains will be senior defensive tackle **Phil Matusz**, senior offensive lineman **Brian Brannigan** and senior linebacker **Osayi Osunde**.

**WEEK IN AND WEEK OUT:** Three junior members of the Villanova football team have started every game of their Wildcat career. Junior offensive tackle **Ben Ijalana**, junior offensive guard **Brant Clouser** and junior linebacker **Terence Thomas** will be making their 30th consecutive career start this week at New Hampshire. The trio started all 11 games as true freshmen, all 13 games a season ago and the first five games this season.

**A NUMBERS GAME:** Three Villanova starters have changed their uniform number this season. Senior linebacker **Osayi Osunde** has switched from No. 91 to No. 23, junior defensive back **Fred Maldonado** went from No. 39 to No. 2 and sophomore wideout **Norman White** changed from No. 87 to No. 8.



**ROSTER ADDITION:** Villanova added a player two weeks into pre-season camp when freshman linebacker **Angel Clybourn** transferred in from the University of Cincinnati. The 6-1, 220 pound Clybourn will be eligible to play for the Wildcats immediately. He is expected to be a reserve at linebacker. Clybourn is a native of Mays Landing, N.J. and a graduate of the Blair Academy.

**TOP OF THE LIST:** With his team's win over New Hampshire last November, Villanova head coach **Andy Talley** became the all-time winningest coach in the history of Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) football. Talley ended last season with exactly 100 career conference victories.

## GAME 1 RECAP: NO. 5 VILLANOVA 27, TEMPLE 24

**Sept. 3, 2009**  
**Lincoln Financial Field**  
**Philadelphia, Pa.**

**PHILADELPHIA, Pa.**--Redshirt freshman **Nick Yako** kicked a 32-yard field goal as time expired and Villanova completed a late comeback with a 27-24 victory over Temple in the inaugural Mayor's Cup game played at Lincoln Financial Field. The Wildcats trailed by 10 points in the middle of the fourth quarter before coming back to tally their third-ever win against a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent.

A six-yard pass from junior quarterback **Chris Whitney** with 1:24 to play tied the game at 24-24. On the fourth play of the ensuing drive by the Owls, junior strong safety **John Dempsey** picked off a pass at the 50-yard line and returned possession to Villanova. The interception was one of five turnovers gained by the Wildcats in the game.

Villanova started its final drive with 49 seconds left and began to set up for a field goal once the ball was in the red zone. Earlier in the quarter, the Wildcats comeback started when Yako kicked a 27-yard field goal with 9:58 to play that pulled Villanova to within 24-17. The Wildcats first-year kicker had a flawless collegiate debut with the two field goals and three extra points.

After the first field goal by Yako set Villanova up for an eventual game-tying possession, the Wildcats recovered a fumble on the seventh play of the next Temple drive. Dempsey forced a fumble on a first-and-10 play from the Villanova 30-yard line and junior linebacker **Marquis Kirkland** recovered the loose ball. The Wildcats took over at their own 35-yard line and the pass from Whitney to senior wide receiver **Brandyn Harvey** capped a 12-play drive that took 4:29 off the clock and ended with 1:24 remaining.

Whitney passed for a career-high 278 yards on 24-of-35 passing. After going 7-of-14 in the first half, he recovered to go 17-of-21 in the second half along the way to notching his third career game with at least 200 yards passing. Harvey caught nine of the completions for a career-high 142 yards and the game's biggest touchdown.

After a scoreless first quarter, the Owls got on the scoreboard first on a 25-yard field goal with 4:39 left in the first half. A 75-yard touchdown pass from Vaughn Charlton to James Nixon with just 1:01 remaining before the intermission sent Temple into the locker rooms with a 10-0 halftime lead.

In the second half, senior free safety **Ross Ventrone** returned a fumble 59 yards for a touchdown to get the Wildcats on the board just 52 seconds into the third quarter. It was the longest fumble return for a touchdown by a Villanova player in at least the last 12 years and was the second turnover gained by Ventrone in the game. He also registered his sixth career interception earlier in the contest.

Senior running back **Tony Canci** recorded his first career touchdown on a five-yard pass from Whitney with 22 seconds left in the third quarter. At that point the score was 17-14 in favor of Temple, but the Owls stretched their lead nine seconds in the final period on a 44-yard pass from Charlton to Michael Campbell.

Villanova began the season as one of eight teams from the powerhouse Colonial Athletic Association ranked in the top 25 of the preseason Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Coaches Poll. Tonight's win by the Wildcats marked the fourth straight season that a CAA team has defeated an FBS opponent. The CAA has had a representative in the FCS championship game in five of the last six years.

## GAME 2 RECAP: NO. 3 VILLANOVA 38, LEHIGH 17

**VILLANOVA, Pa.**--Led by an unstoppable ground game, Villanova (2-0) produced two 100-yard rushers and cruised to a 38-17 win over Lehigh (0-2) on Saturday night in its home opener at Villanova Stadium. The Wildcats ran for 310 yards and defeated the Mountain Hawks in their first home game for the second straight year.

Junior quarterback **Chris Whitney** ran for a career-high 130 yards and junior wide receiver **Matt Szczur** tallied his first career 100-yard rushing game to lead the Villanova offense. Whitney had 14 carries for 130 yards and a touchdown and also completed 11-of-16 passes for 106 yards and two scores.

Whitney ran in for a 21-yard score on the game's opening drive to get the Wildcats started, and Szczur broke free for a 75-yard run to the Lehigh two-yard line on the next drive to set up an eventual 29-yard field goal by redshirt freshman kicker **Nick Yako** that made the score 10-0 with 5:17 remaining in the first quarter.

Villanova stretched the margin to 24-7 at halftime and maintained their lead throughout the second half. Whitney threw touchdown passes to junior running back **Angelo Babbaro** and sophomore wide receiver **Norman White** in the game.

In addition to his 103-yard rushing performance, Szczur caught four passes for 35 yards and had a 16-yard kickoff return. Babbaro caught three passes for 40 yards.

Lehigh got on the board with 9:33 left in the second quarter on a 1-yard run by Jaren Walker that capped an 11-play drive. The Mountain Hawks managed just 55 yards on the ground as the Wildcats finished the game with a 417-252 edge in total yards. Starting quarterback JB Clark completed 20-of-31 passes for 130 yards and Chris Lum was 7-of-11 for 67 yards and a touchdown. Craig Zurn caught a game-high six passes for 72 yards.

A 10-7 lead for Villanova late in the second quarter quickly expanded when the Wildcats registered back-to-back touchdowns just 16 seconds apart. Babbaro caught a 13-yard pass from Whitney with 4:54 left in the opening half to finish a nine-play, 60-yard drive. On the next Lehigh possession, redshirt freshman **Marlon Johnson** returned a fumble recovery 19 yards for a touchdown with 4:38 left in the period.

Johnson's fumble recovery came on the only turnover of the game and marked the second straight game that Villanova returned a fumble for a touchdown.

In the second half, the Mountain Hawks scored first on a 41-yard field goal by Tom Randazza with 10:02 left in the third quarter. The Wildcats answered just over a minute later with a 39-yard scoring run from junior running back **Aaron Ball** and White had a 14-yard reception for a touchdown with 13:54 left in the fourth period. Ball finished with 57 yards on nine carries and the one score.

Lehigh scored the game's final points with 1:05 left on a 2-yard touchdown pass Chris Lum to Alex Wojdowski.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa.--Junior wide receiver **Matt Szczur** ran back the game's opening kickoff 87 yards for a touchdown and No. 2 Villanova then settled into a scrappy defensive battle against Penn at Franklin Field, eventually coming away with a 14-3 victory. The win marked the first time since 2003 that the Wildcats have won their first three games to open a season.

Szczur fielded Trevor Charlston's 57-yard kickoff to start the night at the Villanova 13-yard line and brought it all the way back for his second career kickoff return touchdown - both have come on the first play of a game. Redshirt freshman kicker **Nick Yako** kicked the extra point and then launched a 64-yard kickoff that the Quakers were only able to return to their own 23-yard line.

The immediate tally of points for the Wildcats and the stark difference in the opening possessions for each team - Penn gained just eight yards while going three-and-out on their first drive - certainly was not a harbinger of things to come, however.

Villanova wound up having possession of the ball for less than five minutes in the entire first quarter and would not score again until late in the third period. In the interim, the Quakers got their only points of the game on a 22-yard field goal by Andrew Samson with 12:46 left in the second quarter. The kick ended a 14-play, 66-yard drive that lasted nearly seven minutes and was indicative of Penn's ability to hold the ball throughout the game. Both teams had 12 drives on the night but the Quakers owned an edge of nearly 11 minutes in possession time.

As a result, the Wildcats ran just 50 offensive plays for a total of 187 yards. The team had averaged 387 yards of offense per game in its first two contests of the season. Penn didn't do much better against Villanova's equally opportune defense, running 62 plays and picking up 239 yards. Both sides committed two turnovers.

In the second half, senior quarterback **Antwon Young** threw a five-yard touchdown pass to senior wide receiver **Brandyn Harvey** with 3:34 remaining in the third quarter to expand the Wildcat lead and close the scoring for the night. This was the fourth straight year that the Quakers have not scored after halftime against Villanova.

Young needed only four carries to run for a game-high 36 yards in the defensive duel. His longest rush was a 24-yard run on 3rd-and-11 from the Wildcat 21-yard line on the play that culminated with Harvey's touchdown reception. Young also threw a 14-yard pass to sophomore wide receiver **Norman White** on the drive, which covered 10 plays and 78 yards in 3:47.

Villanova gained 128 yards on the ground as Young and Szczur shared carries with junior running backs **Aaron Ball** and **Angelo Babbaro**. Young and junior quarterback **Chris Whitney** each completed 3-of-7 passes on a night when the Wildcats totaled just 59 yards in the air. Whitney also threw the team's first interception of the season and lost a fumble.

Although its offense matches up with anyone in the country on just about any night, the Villanova defense matched Penn play-for-play in a typically stalwart game between the local rivals. The Wildcats sacked quarterback Keiffer Garton six times and accumulated 10 total tackles for loss. Senior defensive back **Ross Ventrone** picked off his second interception of the season and junior linebacker **Terence Thomas** set a career-high with 10 tackles and two sacks. Senior defensive end **Tim Kukucka** and junior **Mario Johnson** had two and 1.5 sacks, respectively, while Kukucka also registered a blocked kick.

## GAME 4 RECAP: NO. 2 VILLANOVA 56, NORTHEASTERN 7

**Sept. 26, 2009**

**VILLANOVA, Pa.**--Junior running back **Aaron Ball** ran for over 100 yards in the first quarter alone and No. 2 Villanova ran for a season-high 410 yards in a 56-7 win over Northeastern on Saturday afternoon at Villanova Stadium. The Wildcats improved to 4-0 for the first time since 2003 and won their conference opener for the third straight year.

Ball ran for 109 yards and a touchdown on just seven carries and six different players scored touchdowns for Villanova, which registered individual 100-yard rushing and 100-yard receiving performances in the same game for the first time since 2005 against William & Mary. Senior wide receiver **Brandyn Harvey** caught seven passes for 102 yards to join Ball as the '100-100' tandem in the game.

The rushing total for the Wildcats was their highest since 1991 and the third-highest single-game total in school history. Villanova has had just five games with even 300 yards rushing since 1999, but four of those games have come in the last seven outings dating back to last season.

On the third offensive play of the game, Ball ran 31 yards up the middle for a touchdown that got the Wildcats off and running. After the Huskies punted on their first possession, Villanova put together a 13-play drive in just 4:28 that culminated in a one-yard touchdown run by junior running back **Angelo Babbaro**.

The Wildcats extended their lead to 21-0 before the end of the first period when senior quarterback **Antwon Young** threw a one-yard pass for a touchdown to senior running back **Tony Canci** with 1:40 remaining in the period. Canci had two catches for 15 yards, both of which were touchdown receptions.

Whitney ran for 98 yards on 10 carries and completed 7-of-11 passes for 84 yards and one touchdown. Young was 4-of-6 for 58 yards and a touchdown and also ran eight times for 35 yards and one score. Six of the eight touchdowns for Villanova in the game came on the ground, including a pair of scores for sophomore running back **Lawrence Doss**, who ran for 36 yards on eight carries.

Late in the second quarter, Whitney threw a 14-yard pass to Canci for a touchdown that made the score 28-0 entering the intermission. Villanova had eight of its 12 drives result in a touchdown, with four of the scores coming on six plays or less.

Northeastern got on the board in the third quarter when Alex Dulski threw a 48-yard pass for a touchdown to Jordan Batts for the Huskies only points of the game. Dulski completed 16-of-31 passes for 138 yards, with Batts being the favorite target. Batts caught seven passes for 92 yards and the touchdown. Dulski was picked off three times as well, as the Wildcats increased their interception total to eight through the first four games.

Villanova resumed its quick pace of scoring just 32 seconds after the Huskies lone touchdown when Whitney ran in from 45 yards on the second play of the ensuing Wildcat drive. Young ran in for a one-yard score near the end of the quarter to stretch the margin to 42-7 after three periods.

## GAME 5 RECAP: NO. 2 VILLANOVA 28, NO. 5 WILLIAM & MARY 17

**Oct. 3, 2009**

**VILLANOVA, Pa.**--In a battle of top five teams on Saturday afternoon, No. 2 Villanova struck for a touchdown on the first offensive play of the game and went on to a 28-17 victory over No. 5 William & Mary at Villanova Stadium. The Wildcats won their sixth straight home game and improved to 15-1 on their home turf since the middle of the 2006 season.

Entering the game, it figured that something had to give between the Tribe defense and the Villanova running game. William & Mary had allowed a total of 27 yards on the ground in its last two games; the Wildcats ran for 410 yards in their last game. The answer was an improved passing game for Villanova, although the team still managed three rushing touchdowns on short yardage situations.

The Wildcats proficiency through the air set the tone, though. Junior quarterback **Chris Whitney** and senior wide receiver **Brandyn Harvey** connected for a 57-yard touchdown on the first offensive play of the game and Villanova never looked back as it improved to 5-0 for the first time since 2003. The Wildcats capitalized on two Tribe turnovers in the first half to take a 21-6 lead into the intermission.

A three-yard touchdown pass from R.J. Archer to Chase Hill with 4:18 left in the game and a successive two-point conversion from Archer to Rob Varno pulled the Tribe to within 28-17 in the waning minutes of the game, but Villanova recovered William & Mary's ensuing onside kick and held the ball until there was less than one minute remaining in the contest.

Whitney threw for 146 yards on 10-of-13 accuracy and also ran for 31 yards on 10 carries. Villanova converted only 3-of-10 third-down opportunities but still was able to get into good scoring position in the red zone. All three rushing touchdowns for the Wildcats in the game came on runs of five yards or less.

Junior wide receiver **Matt Szczur** ran in for a five-yard touchdown on the opening play of the second quarter to cap an 80-yard drive and later scored on a four-yard run in the third quarter that gave Villanova some breathing room with a 28-9 lead. His first running score ended a drive that started nine plays earlier following an interception by junior linebacker **Marquis Kirkland** in the end zone.

Late in the second quarter, junior running back **Angelo Babbaro** ran in from three yards with 1:53 left to finish a quick three-play drive that started at the Tribe's 29-yard line after sophomore defensive back **James Pitts** recovered a fumble and returned it 20 yards to set up the eventual score for the Wildcats. Pitts had also tipped the ball in the end zone that Kirkland intercepted earlier in the period.

Villanova's defense limited William & Mary to just a pair of field goals in the opening half. All-American kicker Brian Pate blasted a 44-yard field goal with 6:08 left in the half and made a 28-yard attempt as time expired.

The Tribe started the second half with the ball at their own 40-yard line after the Wildcat kickoff went out of bounds, but gained just 48 yards on a 15-play drive that consumed nearly half the third quarter and eventually led to a 29-yard field goal by Pate which made the score 21-9.

The response by Villanova after the third William & Mary field goal of the game was typical of how the game unfolded. The Wildcats drove 85 yards on 10 plays in under five minutes for another touchdown. Whitney threw a 31-yard pass to sophomore wide receiver **Norman White** and a 20-yard pass to sophomore **Mikey Reynolds** on the drive before Szczur's second touchdown run of the day.
