Villanova Football Game Notes

2011 Season

Game 11: Villanova (2-8) vs. Delaware (6-4)

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: Villanova head coach **Andy Talley** will be walking the Wildcat sideline for a 27th season in 2011. During his Wildcat career, Talley has registered a 190-115-1 record, making him the all-time winningest coach in Villanova history. His 31-year overall coaching record currently stands at 218-133-2. Throughout his tenure at Villanova, Talley has guided the Wildcats to nine NCAA playoff appearances (1989, 1991, 1992, 1996, 1997, 2002, 2008, 2009 and 2010), five conference titles, three Lambert Meadowlands trophies, three national semifinal appearances and the 2009 National Championship. He has twice earned the AFCA National Coach of the Year Award and in 1997 he won the Eddie Robinson Award which is given to the top coach in FCS football.

CLOSELY CONTESTED: Villanova and Delaware will be meeting for the 45th time on Saturday at PPL Park. The Wildcats own a slim 23-20-1 advantage in the all-time series.

RECENT SUCCESS: The Wildcats have had the upper hand in the series of late against the Delaware Blue Hens. Villanova has won five straight over the Blue Hens. Delaware's last win in the series came in 2005.

BATTLE OF THE BLUE PART V: Beginning in 2007, the annual Villanova-Delaware game became known as the Battle of the Blue. As part of this concept, the winning team will get to keep the Battle of the Blue trophy at its institution for the year and will be responsible for bringing the trophy to next year's game. The trophy consists of a football with a Villanova logo and the Wildcat shade of blue on one side and the Blue Hen logo and the Delaware shade of blue on the other side. The ball sits in a wooden platform and the scores of each game are engraved on the base of the trophy. Villanova has had possession of the trophy for all four years that the trophy has been a part of this rivalry game.

PLAYING AT PPL: Villanova and Delaware will play the first ever American football game at PPL Park this Saturday. PPL is the home of the Philadelphia Union who play in the MLS (Major League Soccer) which is the top professional soccer league in the United States. The stadium currently seats 18,500.

ABOUT THE BLUE HENS: Delaware enters play this week with a 6-4 overall record and a 4-3 CAA mark. The Blue Hens average 25.8 points per game and allow 20.4 points per contest. Delaware averages 346.0 yards of total offense per game (182.0 passing; 164.0 rushing) and give up 345.4 yards per contest (202.7 passing; 142.7 rushing). Sophomore running back Andrew Pierce is the Blue Hen go-to player on offense. He has 239 carries for 1,170 yards and 15 touchdowns. Junior Tim Donnelly is expected to start at quarterback this Saturday. In 10 games this season, he has completed 151-of-241 for 1,579 yards to go with 11 touchdowns and 10 interceptions. Donnelly's favorite target is junior Nihja White who has 43 receptions for 591 yards and four touchdowns. Defensively, junior linebacker Paul Worrirow leads the way with 87 tackles and a team-high eight tackles for loss. Sophomore corner Travis Hawkins has a team-high four interceptions.

DELAWARE RECAP: The Blue Hens are coming off a 24-10 home win over Richmond. Delaware raced to a 21-3 halftime lead and cruised to the victory. Led by sophomore Bernard Pierce, the Blue Hens ran for 249 yards. Pierce accounted for 215 rushing yards on 34 carries and two touchdowns. Quarterback Tim Donnelly managed the game for Delaware, completing 9-of-14 for 129 yards. Junior safety Ricky Tunstall led the Blue Hen defensive charge with seven tackles and two interceptions.

BACK TO WORK: After a bye last Saturday, Villanova returns to the field this week for the season finale against the Delaware Blue Hens. In the team's last outing, the Wildcats registered an impressive 35-17 win at Massachusetts. This snapped a four-game losing streak to the Minutemen and it was head coach Andy Talley's first-ever win at McGuirk Stadium in Amherst, Mass. Prior to the win, Talley was 0-7 all-time in games played at Massachusetts.

END OF THE ROAD: For the first time since 2007, Villanova's season will end with the regular season finale. Currently posting a 2-8 record, the Wildcats will not qualify for the NCAA playoffs for the first time in four seasons. This will also be the first time since 2005 and just the sixth time in the 27 year career of head coach **Andy Talley** that the Wildcats will finish below the .500 mark. Villanova had a record of 4-7 during that 2005 season and also finished with a losing record in 1993, 1994, 1995 and 2000.

FORCING TURNOVERS: Prior to the team's last game at Massachusetts on Nov. 5, the Villanova defense had forced just 11 turnovers in the first nine games of the season and the Wildcats owned a -11 turnover margin. In the 35-17 win at Massachusetts, Villanova forced six turnovers (3 int; 3 fumbles) and committed just one turnover. The Wildcats converted the six turnovers into 28 points.

PITTS PICKS: It was a career afternoon for senior corner **James Pitts** in Villanova's last game at Massachusetts. In the win, Pitts recorded three interceptions. Two of his three interceptions led to 14 Villanova points. For his efforts, he was named CAA Defensive Player of the Week. Pitts becomes the first Wildcat since Orin Solomon against New Hampshire on Oct. 30, 1990 to intercept three passes in a game. Pitts now has five interceptions on the year and 14 for his career. The five picks is tied for the lead in the CAA.

SECOND QUARTER SURGE: A big reason why Villanova was able to tally a 35-17 win at Massachusetts two weeks ago was due in large part to the team's play in the second quarter. Trailing 3-0 after one quarter of play, Villanova exploded for 28 second quarter points to take a 28-10 halftime lead. Prior to this, the last time Villanova scored 28 second quarter points was against Colgate on Nov. 29, 2008, in the first round of the FCS playoffs.

POLONY PERFORMS: True freshman quarterback **Chris Polony** is coming off two strong performances. In the last two games versus Maine and Massachusetts, Polony has thrown six touchdown passes and just one interception. In his last outing at Massachusetts, which was his third start of the season, Polony was 20-of-31 for 183 yards and three touchdowns. Against Maine on Oct. 29, he completed 10-of-20 for 198 passing yards to go with three touchdowns and one interception. Polony has played in six games with three starts this season and is 55-of-98 (56.1 percent) for 574 yards with seven touchdowns and four interceptions. His 198 passing yards against Maine are the most by a Villanova quarterback this season. The Wildcats have had three different quarterbacks start a game this year.

TWO TOUCHDOWN DAY: Redshirt freshman running back **Austin Medley** registered his first career two touchdown game against Massachusetts on Nov. 5. His first score came on a three-yard touchdown reception and his second touchdown came on a two-yard run. Medley is now tied for the team lead in touchdowns with five. A week earlier against Maine, Medley tallied his first career 100-yard rushing game with a career-best 17 carries for 100 yards and a score, becoming the first Villanova player this season to hit the century mark in rushing yards for a game. Medley reached the 100-yard mark thanks in part to two runs of 20 yards or longer and he has now tallied five rushes this season of at least 20 yards. Medley leads the Wildcats this season with 328 rushing yards and a 5.6 yards per carry average, while ranking second on the squad with 63 rushes. Medley is doubtful for the Delaware game with a foot injury.

CATCHING ON: Junior wideout **Dorian Wells** has led Villanova in receiving all season long. Entering play this week against Delaware, Wells leads the Wildcats with 36 catches for 435 yards and five scores. His latest score came on a 13-yard scoring reception in the team's last game versus Massachusetts. Two games ago versus Maine, Wells hauled in a 60-yard touchdown reception. This was the second time this season and third time in his career that Wells has caught a pass of longer than 50 yards for a touchdown. In a win over Penn earlier this year, Wells scored on a 54-yard catch and last season at Maine he registered a 73-yard touchdown reception.

Villanova Football Game Notes

2011 Season

Game 10: Villanova (2-8) vs. Delaware (6-4)

OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT: The young and inexperienced Villanova offense struggled through the first eight weeks of the season, but looks to have found its stride the last two games. Villanova has used a balanced attack the last two weeks to average 377.5 yards of offense, including 195.5 through the air and 181.5 on the ground. After 10 games in 2011, the Wildcats are averaging 290.9 yards of total offense per game (158.6 passing; 132.2 rushing).

FINDING FUMBLES: In Villanova's win at Massachusetts on Nov. 5, sophomore corner **Craig James** recovered two Minutemen fumbles. The Wildcats converted one of the two fumbles into a touchdown. James becomes the first Villanova player to register two fumble recoveries in a game since Terence Taylor did it versus Rhode Island on Oct. 30, 2004. Entering play this Saturday versus Delaware, James has 53 tackles, three pass break-ups and two fumble recoveries.

FIELD GOAL FORTUNES: One of the most impressive streaks of the past two seasons for Villanova was snapped two games ago versus Maine, when junior kicker **Mark Hamilton** went 0-for-2 on field goal attempts. Prior to the game, Hamilton had made 14 consecutive field goal tries and was 15-of-16 in his career, including going 9-of-9 this season leading up to the Maine game. The streak began last season against New Hampshire on November 13 and of the nine field goals Hamilton has made this season four have been from 40 yards or longer. Hamilton's streak ended on a tough day for kickers as the Wildcats and Black Bears played on a snow-covered and slick field. Entering play this week versus Delaware, Hamilton is 9-of-11 in field goals and 17-of-18 in PATs.

PERFECT PUNTING: In addition to his success on field goals, junior kicker **Mark Hamilton** has done an excellent job as Villanova's punter this season. He has punted 51 times for 2,156 yards (42.3 yards per punt) and has nine punts of 50 yards or longer. Hamilton has pinned the opponent inside their own 20-yard line 16 times.

BACK TO THE GRIND: After playing five straight Top 25 opponents, Villanova got a break in its last game when they played unranked Massachusetts. The Wildcats will play their sixth ranked opponent in seven weeks this Saturday when Villanova hosts No. 15 Delaware. The five previous Top 25 opponents included No. 11 William & Mary (Oct. 1), No. 6 New Hampshire (Oct. 8), No. 13 James Madison (Oct. 15), No. 21 Old Dominion (Oct. 22) and No. 8 Maine (Oct. 29).

ROOKIE EARNS RAVE REVIEWS: Freshman **Jamal Abdur-Rahman** continues to be more involved in the Villanova game plan each week. Abdur-Rahman turned in the best performance of his young career two weeks ago at Massachusetts. In the win over the Minutemen, he tallied 169 yards of all-purpose offense, including eight carries for 62 yards, six catches for 62 yards and his first career touchdown and one kickoff return for 24 yards. After 10 games, Abdur-Rahman is averaging a team-best 113.0 yards of all-purpose offense per game.

TOP CAT: Villanova is led on defense by true freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas**. Entering play versus Delaware, Lucas leads the Wildcats in tackles with 85 (48 solo stops) to go with 2.5 tackles for loss and two quarterback sacks. Lucas will be making his 11th straight start today.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION: Freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas** is one of 15 players who have been named to the inaugural Jerry Rice Watch List. The award is given to the most outstanding freshman in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Lucas has started all 10 games for the Wildcats and currently leads the team in tackles with 85 total stops, including 48 solo tackles. Lucas also has 2.5 tackles for loss and two quarterback sacks. A national panel of communications and media relations directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries will select the award winner after the regular season. Rice, who played in the FCS (then Division I-AA) at Mississippi Valley State, will present the award at the national awards banquet on Jan. 6 in Frisco, Texas.

YOUTHFUL WILDCATS: The 2011 Villanova Wildcats are one of the youngest teams that head coach Andy Talley has had during his 27-year Main Line career. In the team's last game at Massachusetts, Villanova played 18 first-year players, including 12 true freshmen, five redshirt freshmen and a transfer. Villanova started eight true freshmen and two redshirt freshmen in the game.

THREE YEARS OF SUCCESS: Villanova is coming off a three-year run where they tallied a 33-9 overall record, a 19-5 CAA mark, made three-straight NCAA playoff appearances, including consecutive trips to the national semifinals in 2009 and 2010 and captured the 2009 National Championship.

10 YEAR RUN: Over the last 10 seasons, the Villanova Wildcats are the winningest team in the CAA. From 2001 to present, Villanova has posted an 84-46 mark for a .646 winning percentage. In wins, Delaware is second with 83 victories, while Massachusetts is second in winning percentage at .625.

TOP OF THE LIST: Wildcat head coach **Andy Talley** enters play this afternoon versus Delaware as the all-time winningest coach in CAA history. Talley currently has 113 league victories and is the only coach in conference history to have 100 or more wins.

WHITE OUT: Head coach **Andy Talley** announced on Sept. 1 that senior wide receiver and co-captain **Norman White** will miss the 2011 season due to a Lisfranc injury of the left foot. White had a breakout year a season ago with 69 catches for 886 yards and 11 touchdowns. For his efforts in 2010, White was a first team All-CAA selection. He was a preseason first team All-CAA honoree this year. White will redshirt the 2011 season and return for a fifth-year in 2012.



A NEW LOOK: The Wildcats were hit hard by graduation along the offensive line as the team had to replace three starters this season. Two of the three starters included left tackle **Ben Ijalana** and left guard **Brant Clouser**. These two started all 53 games of their Wildcat careers. Ijalana was a second round draft pick of the Indianapolis Colts. The third offensive line starter lost from last year was junior right tackle **Chidozie Ekweozor** who suffered a season-ending knee injury in spring practice and is lost for the season.

TRANSFERRING IN: One of the team's three new starters along the offensive line is in his first year at Villanova. Starting left tackle **Bill Vogel** transferred to Villanova this summer from the University of Nebraska Omaha. Vogel played in eight games at Nebraska-Omaha last season after redshirting in 2009. Vogel has started all 10 games at tackle this season.

PLAYING ON SUNDAYS: Villanova currently has five players under contract in the NFL. The five include fullback **Darrel Young (Washington Redskins)**, safety **Ray Ventrone (Cleveland Browns)**, offensive lineman **Ben Ijalana (Indianapolis Colts)**, safety **Ross Ventrone (New England Patriots)** and wide receiver **Brandyn Harvey (Arizona Cardinals)**. Ijalana was a second round draft pick by the Colts in the 2011 NFL Draft. Harvey is a member of the Cardinal practice squad, while Ijalana is on the injured reserve list with a knee injury suffered in week four.

LEADING THE WAY: The 2011 Villanova captains will be senior wide receiver **Norman White** and senior defensive back **James Pitts**.

OVERTIME HISTORY: During head coach **Andy Talley's** tenure, Villanova has played 14 overtime games and in those 14 games the Wildcats are 10-4. The Wildcats have won eight of their last 10 overtime games. The team's last overtime game came in the 2010 regular season finale when the 'Cats tallied a 28-21 win at No. 1 Delaware.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa.--In the third installment of the annual Mayor's Cup game No. 14 Villanova lost by a score of 42-7 to Temple before a crowd of 32,638 in the season opener for both teams at Lincoln Financial Field. The attendance was the largest of the three games that the Wildcats and Owls have played in the Mayor's Cup series.

A young Villanova team leaned heavily on its newcomers in the first outing of the season, as the Wildcats had 17 first-year players see time on the field. The number included 12 true freshman and five redshirt freshmen.

One of the redshirt freshmen was quarterback **Dustin Thomas**, who accounted for his team's only points of the night with a four-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter. Earlier in the game Temple had set a tone with two touchdowns in the last seven minutes of the second quarter that forged a 21-0 margin at half-time.

In his first collegiate start Thomas ran 17 times for 59 yards and a touchdown while completing 11-of-25 passes for 109 yards. He also threw three interceptions and the Wildcats committed a total of four turnovers on the night.

The Owls scored on their first drive of the game and took a 7-0 lead on a 35-yard pass from Mike Gerardi to Deon Miller with 7:23 left in the first quarter. That remained the score until just after the midpoint of the second quarter but Temple running back Brandon Pierce scored on a pair of touchdown runs late in the opening half - the latter of which came with just 46 seconds remaining - to put the contest all but out of reach.

Villanova's biggest offensive play of the game came on the drive that took place right before the first touchdown run by Pierce. On a drive that started at the Wildcats own 31-yard line junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** threw a 44-yard pass that Thomas caught along the sideline while just managing to stay inbounds. The promising start to the drive did not lead to any further momentum, however, and Villanova eventually fumbled the ball away at Temple's 36-yard line on third-and-21.

Senior wide receiver **Mikey Reynolds** had a team-high five receptions for 51 yards and sophomore **Joe Price** had three catches for 39 yards. The Wildcats gained 122 yards on the ground and 153 through the air, with the 59 rushing yards by Thomas accounting for the team's game high mark. Senior running back **Lawrence Doss** ran seven times for 31 yards.

On the other side of the ball sophomore defensive back **Craig James** led all players with a game-high 10 tackles, including seven solo stops. True freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas** added nine tackles in the game.

Temple amassed 475 yards of total offense behind the production of Pierce, who ran 20 times for 147 yards and three scores. Gerardi completed 14-of-20 passes for 235 yards and two touchdowns, with Miller and Rod Streater both recording touchdown receptions.

TOWSON, Md.--Turnovers were a key story for the second straight game and No. 20 Villanova was defeated, 31-10, in its conference opener at Towson at Johnny Unitas Stadium. Three turnovers by the Wildcats led to 17 of the Tigers 31 points and Villanova fell behind 21-0 before getting on the board for the first time.

On the game's opening drive the Wildcats had marched 85 yards down the field on 10 plays to reach the Towson four-yard line. On second-and-goal from the six, however, a sack by the Tigers defense led to a fumble and Towson recovered at its own 19-yard line. The turnover led to a nine-play, 81-yard drive by the Tigers that put them up 7-0 with 5:44 remaining in the opening period.

Villanova was held off the scoreboard until the middle of the third quarter despite being in excellent scoring position on two of its first three drives. Late in the first period the Wildcats pinned Towson at its own four-yard line on a 51-yard punt by junior **Mark Hamilton** and forced the Tigers into going three-and-out.

Junior linebacker **Patrick Haggerty** then blocked a Towson punt and Villanova took over from the Tigers 18-yard line, but the Wildcats gained only five yards on three plays before missing a 28-yard field goal on the first play of the second quarter.

Towson finished the opening half with a 10-play drive that led to a touchdown with seven seconds remaining before intermission and went into the locker rooms with a 14-0 lead. In the third quarter, Villanova fumbled after an 18-yard reception by junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** and the Tigers drove 73 yards on their ensuing possession to stretch the margin to 21-0.

The only touchdown of the game for the Wildcats came with 6:30 to play in the third quarter when junior wide receiver **Kenny Miles** caught a five-yard touchdown pass from senior quarterback **Christian Culicerto** to make the score 21-7.

Culicerto completed 10-of-19 passes for 95 yards and his second career touchdown pass. He backed up redshirt freshman starter **Dustin Thomas** after Thomas was 10-of-13 for 84 yards through the air.

The final score wasn't indicative of the amount of total offense each team generated, as Villanova amassed 360 yards of offense compared to Towson's 416 yards. It was a good sign for the Wildcats to see 181 yards of offense on the ground, as senior running back **Lawrence Doss** ran for 71 yards on nine carries and redshirt freshman running back **Austin Medley** gained 57 yards on just three carries. Medley had two runs of 25 yards or more.

With 10:35 left in the game Hamilton kicked a 31-yard field goal to make the score 24-10 but the ensuing kickoff by junior **Nick Yako** was returned 85 yards and the Tigers needed just three plays to score the final points of the game on a three-yard scoring run.

Sophomore wide receiver **Joe Price** registered five catches for 46 yards to lead the Villanova receivers. Eight different players caught at least one pass on the evening for the Wildcats, with Doss, Wells and senior wide receiver **Mikey Reynolds** each tallying three receptions.

Defensively for Villanova a trio that included junior defensive backs **Eric Loper** and **Ronnie Akins**, as well as freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas** each made 10 tackles. Akins had four solo stops and six assisted tackles while also making an interception in the second quarter as the Wildcats defense netted their first take-away of the season.

GAME 3 RECAP: MONMOUTH 20, VILLANOVA 9

VILLANOVA, Pa.--In a game that did not feature a touchdown from either team until the middle of the third quarter Villanova eventually lost by a score of 20-9 to Monmouth in its home opener at Villanova Stadium. A near-sellout crowd of 11,817 on Parents' Weekend was on hand to see the Wildcats in their first of six home games this season.

Both teams had stagnant offensive performances in the first half and it was not until a 36-yard touchdown run by redshirt freshman running back **Austin Medley** with 9:32 left in the third period that there was a touchdown in the game. Medley gave Villanova its only lead of the game at 7-3 with his first career touchdown before the visiting Hawks went on to score 17 of the final 19 points in the last 18 minutes of the contest.

Medley picked up 53 yards on only seven carries and junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** recorded six receptions for 98 yards to lead the Wildcats offense. Senior quarterback **Christian Culicerto** entered the game during the second quarter and wound up throwing for 183 yards on 11-of-24 passing while also running 12 times for 34 yards.

Villanova was not without chances to put more points on the board in hopes of a fourth quarter rally but, despite running 26 offensive plays in the final period, gained only 75 yards in the fourth quarter and produced only two points on a team safety when a Monmouth player ran through the back of the end zone with 3:09 left to prevent the Hawks from having to punt from deep within their own territory.

Until the closing minutes of the third quarter Monmouth had been held to only three points on a field goal with 9:16 remaining in the second period. That changed with 2:23 left in the third quarter when Tristan Roberts caught a seven-yard touchdown pass from Kyle Frazier to give the Hawks the lead for good at 10-7.

In the fourth quarter Eric Spillane kicked his second field goal of the game, a 36-yard attempt, with 11:34 to play to make the score 13-7 and the Hawks sealed the outcome when Balial Sloan El broke away for a 44-yard touchdown run with only 1:12 left to make the score 20-9 and close the scoring for the day.

This contest marked the third straight game to begin the year in which the Wildcats were held scoreless in the first half. When the teams went to the locker rooms during the intermission Villanova had only five net yards of rushing and had gained just two first downs on 26 offensive plays.

In the second half the offense picked up for the Wildcats, at least in terms of the team's ability to pick up yards. Villanova wound up finishing with 301 yards of total offense thanks to getting a lift from Culicerto once he entered the game.

On the defensive end freshman safety **Joe Sarnese** had a game-high 10 tackles, including eight solo stops. Freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas** added eight tackles and a sack, while sophomore defensive end **Antoine Lewis** had a forced fumble and a fumble recovery to go along with six tackles.

GAME 4 RECAP: VILLANOVA 30, PENN 21

PHILADELPHIA, Pa.--In a home game at Franklin Field, Villanova held off Penn for a 30-21 victory, the 11th straight time that the Wildcats have beaten their nearby rivals in a series that dates back more than a century. Villanova secured the win thanks to a defense that returned two interceptions for touchdowns in the game, including a 26-yard return by junior defensive back **Ronnie Akins** with 12 seconds left that sealed the game's outcome.

Junior kicker **Mark Hamilton** kicked three field goals in the game for the Wildcats, including a 31-yard attempt with 5:59 left in the third quarter that gave Villanova the lead for good at 16-14. Senior cornerback **Jimmy Pitts** returned an interception 26 yards for a touchdown with 2:00 left in the third period to stretch the margin to 23-14.

In the fourth quarter Penn pulled to within 23-21 when Billy Ragone threw a 10-yard touchdown pass to Ryan Calvert with 10:01 remaining. However, the Quakers would later go three-and-out on their next possession and punted the ball back to the Wildcats with 5:42 to play. Villanova held the ball for over four minutes at the most critical part of the game and eventually punted the ball back to Penn with 1:21 left, when a 52-yard punt by Hamilton pinned the Quakers at their own four-yard line.

The special teams play, thanks in large part to Hamilton, matched the effort of the defense in the Wildcats first win of the season. By going 3-for-3 on field goals tonight Hamilton has now made nine consecutive attempts since last season and is 10-of-11 in his career. He also averaged 46.8 yards on six punts, with the late 52-yarder being the fourth time this season he has kept an opponent inside their own 20-yard line.

Hamilton scored the first Villanova points of the evening with 3:08 to play in the first quarter with a career-long 42-yard field goal. The score at that point was 7-3 in favor of Penn but in the opening minute of the second quarter senior quarterback **Christian Culicerto** threw a 54-yard touchdown pass to junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** for a 10-7 Wildcats lead.

In his first career start Culicerto was 12-of-20 through the air for 139 yards and a touchdown while also running for a net of 43 yards on 10 carries. Despite throwing an interception in the first quarter Culicerto otherwise settled down a Villanova offense which had committed 10 turnovers in the first three games. Following that interception in the first quarter the Wildcats did not turn the ball over again and then benefited from its defense taking the ball away three times.

Sophomore defensive lineman **Rakim Cox** had a big game on the defensive end with three tackles for loss, one forced fumble and a fumble recovery. Freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas** added a team-best nine tackles.

On the offensive end Villanova balanced its running and passing games throughout the entire contest. Wells finished the night with five catches for 70 yards and the long touchdown while senior wide receiver **Mikey Reynolds** added four receptions for 49 yards. Meanwhile, freshman running back **Kevin Monangai** ran for 54 yards on 12 carries and senior running back **Lawrence Doss** added 51 yards on 15 runs.

GAME 5 RECAP: NO. 11 WILLIAM & MARY 20, VILLANOVA 16

VILLANOVA, Pa.--A game that featured a combined five field goals, including three in the second half that accounted for the only points after halftime, ultimately resulted in a 20-16 defeat for Villanova at the hands of No. 11 William & Mary at Villanova Stadium.

Junior kicker **Mark Hamilton** extended a successful run by kicking three field goals for the Wildcats, who briefly led 16-14 early in the third quarter before the visiting Tribe kicked a pair of field goals that accounted for the game's final margin.

Hamilton has drilled six field goals in the last two games combined and dating back to last season has hit 12 consecutive attempts. He is 13-of-14 on field goal tries in his career. The scoring production on special teams and strong defense by Villanova has allowed the Wildcats to stay in the last two games despite just one offensive touchdown in both contests.

The game was a back-and-forth affair that featured five lead changes. Neither team ever led by more than four points and William & Mary secured the outcome by holding Villanova to just 200 yards of offense.

Drake Kuhn kicked a 34-yard field goal with 8:42 remaining in the third quarter to restore a 17-16 lead for the Tribe and then added a 23-yard attempt in the opening minute of the fourth quarter that made the score 20-16.

Meanwhile, the Wildcats had only two possessions in the fourth period, with those drives ending in a punt after going three-and-out early in the quarter as well as an interception with 3:13 remaining after Villanova had gone 60 yards on 11 plays and simultaneously consuming more than six minutes of clock time.

Senior quarterback **Christian Culicerto** was 15-of-24 for 132 yards, including a 15-yard touchdown pass to junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** that gave the Wildcats a 10-7 lead early in the second quarter. Wells finished the day with a game-high six catches for 59 yards.

William & Mary received touchdown runs of one yard and 22 yards from Jonathan Grimes, with each of those scores giving the Tribe the lead. His one-yard run with 2:17 to play in the opening period gave William & Mary an early 7-3 lead, while his 22-yard run with 5:49 left in the second quarter countered the Wells touchdown and gave the Tribe a 14-10 advantage.

Hamilton kicked a career-best 45-yard field goal with 1:39 remaining before halftime to pull Villanova to within 14-13 at the intermission, and then connected from 25 yards with just under three minutes into the third quarter. His first field goal, at the 7:21 mark of the first period, also was from 25 yards.

Three different Wildcats registered double digits in tackles, with junior safety **Ronnie Akins** making a game-high 11 tackles. Senior corner **Jimmy Pitts** and freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas** recorded 10 stops apiece.

Grimes led William & Mary by finishing the game with 31 carries for 137 yards and the two scores. The Tribe gained 173 yards on the ground and quarterback Michael Graham was 13-of-24 for 171 yards and an interception.

NOTES: Freshman linebacker **Joey Harmon** registered his first career interception, picking off a pass by Graham early in the second quarter ... Freshman running back **Jamal Abdur-Rahman** had a season-high 172 all-purpose yards, including four carries for 43 yards, one reception for 13 yards and four kickoff returns for 116 yards ... Hamilton also kicked three field goals in last week's 30-21 win over Penn ... His streak of 12 straight made field goals began at home against New Hampshire last season on November 13, 2010 ... He is 7-for-7 this season.

DURHAM, N.H.—Playing against a top-10 team on the road Villanova was beaten by No. 6 New Hampshire, 47-17, at Cowell Stadium. The strong offense of the host Wildcats put up at least 10 points in all four quarters along the way to the lopsided victory. Freshman running back **Kevin Monangai** provided one of the highlights for the visiting Wildcats, scoring his first career touchdown on a seven-yard run in the fourth quarter.

New Hampshire scored a touchdown on the first drive of the game, then fumbled and punted on its next two drives in the first quarter. Starting with a drive that began at the 5:47 mark of the first period, however, the Wildcats scored on eight of their next nine possessions to steadily build their lead.

Junior kicker **Mark Hamilton** kicked a 45-yard field goal in the second quarter and junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** caught a nine-yard touchdown pass just before halftime for Villanova, while Monangai tallied the final points of the day for the Wildcats on his scoring run with 7:52 remaining in the contest.

Monangai ran 18 times for 57 yards and the score and Villanova accumulated 150 yards on the ground for its second-highest rushing total of the season. Redshirt freshman running back **Austin Medley** ran for 40 yards on eight carries and three others had 10 or more yards rushing.

Freshman quarterback **Chris Polony** came into the game on the first Wildcats possession of the second quarter and wound up going 15-of-19 for 120 yards with a touchdown and two interceptions. Polony was able to find receivers open for short gains and Villanova matched a season high by having eight different players catch at least one pass.

Wells caught five passes for 36 yards, including his team-high third receiving touchdown of the season with 34 seconds left in the first half. Junior wide receiver **Kenny Miles** and freshman running back **Jamal Abdur-Rahman** each had three receptions.

New Hampshire quarterback Kevin Decker efficiently ran his team's offense both through the air and on the ground. Decker finished the day 23-of-32 for 395 yards and three touchdowns while also running six times for 46 yards and another score. His 66-yard touchdown pass to R.J. Harris with 3:27 left in the opening quarter made the score 15-0 and had the Wildcats on their way to the eventual victory.

On the defensive end for the visiting Wildcats, junior defensive end **Marlon Johnson** forced and recovered the first of two fumbles lost by New Hampshire. Senior cornerback **Jimmy Pitts** recovered the other fumble and finished the game tied for the team lead with eight tackles, including one tackle for loss. Freshman defensive back **Joe Sarnese** also had eight tackles and junior linebacker **Devon Bridges** forced the fumble that Pitts recovered.

NOTES: The two offensive touchdowns for Villanova in today's game are a season high ... The team had one offensive touchdown in each of the first five games of the year ... Hamilton matched his season and career high with his 45-yard field goal in the second quarter ... He has now made 13 consecutive field goal attempts and is 14-of-15 in his career ... Hamilton has made at least one field goal in each of his last three games and has had at least one attempt from longer than 40 yards in each of the three outings ... In today's game he also punted six times for 271 yards (45.2 average) and pinned New Hampshire inside the 20-yard line four times.

GAME 7 RECAP: NO. 11 JAMES MADISON 34, VILLANOVA 10

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Against a nationally-ranked opponent on the road for the second straight week, Villanova succumbed to a big second half by No. 13 James Madison and lost by a final score of 34-10 at Bridgeforth Stadium. The game was the third straight for the Wildcats versus a top-25 team.

Despite the appearance of the final score Villanova did not trail in the game until the middle of the third quarter, thanks to a strong defensive effort in the first half. Eventually, the Dukes scored 28 unanswered points in the game's last 23 minutes to go on to the victory.

Redshirt freshman quarterback **Dustin Thomas** returned to action after missing four games with an injury and threw a 25-yard touchdown pass to junior wide receiver **Kenny Miles** to put the Wildcats ahead 7-0 near the midpoint of the second quarter. Villanova also led 10-6 after junior kicker **Mark Hamilton** connected on a 41-yard field goal on the first series of the second half.

The first points for James Madison came on a 22-yard scoring run by Jordan Anderson – the first of three touchdowns he would score on the day – with 6:10 to play before halftime. The ensuing extra point was missed, however, and the Wildcats went into the break with a 7-6 lead.

Villanova started the second half with the ball and briefly extended its lead on Hamilton's field goal before the Dukes offense finally kicked into gear. Following the field goal, James Madison drove 73 yards on nine plays and Anderson ran in from one yard to give the Dukes a 13-10 lead with 7:32 left in the third quarter.

James Madison was off to the races from that point on. Dae'Quan Scott caught a 12-yard touchdown pass from Jace Edwards to make the score 20-10 and early in the fourth quarter Edwards hit Kerby Long for an 80-yard touchdown reception to put the game all but out of reach. Anderson scored his third touchdown on an eight-yard scamper with 4:30 to play.

The game was still within striking distance at 20-10 when the fourth quarter began with Villanova holding possession of the ball. After the Wildcats advanced the ball to the Dukes 19-yard line Thomas was sacked for a loss of 11 yards on second-and-six, bring up third-and-17 from the James Madison 30-yard line. Following two incomplete passes Villanova turned the ball over on downs.

Taking the ball over at their own 30-yard line, the Dukes were whistled for a 10-yard holding penalty and then gained no yards on a rushing attempt, bringing up second-and-20 from their own 20-yard line. That was when Edwards found Long for the big scoring play, though, which effectively sealed the game's outcome.

Thomas finished the day 11-of-24 for 127 yards and the touchdown pass to Miles, while also throwing two interceptions. He also carried the ball 12 times, including breaking away for a 26-yard run early in the fourth quarter.

Junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** was the leading receiver for the Wildcats with four catches for 25 yards, while freshman wide receiver **Clay Horne** had two receptions for 36 yards.

On the defensive end senior cornerback **Jimmy Pitts** registered his 11th career interception when he picked off Edwards just before halftime. Freshman linebacker **Joey Harmon** made six tackles, including 2.5 tackles for loss and a pair of sacks. Junior defensive back **Ronnie Akins** had a game-high 12 tackles and led three Villanova players that tallied at least 10 stops on the day.

NOTES: The field goal by Hamilton in the third quarter extended his streak of made attempts to 14 consecutive field goals ... He is 15-of-16 on field goals in his career, including a perfect 9-of-9 this season ... The streak of 14 consecutive successful attempts began against New Hampshire last season on November 13, 2010 ... Currently, Hamilton has made at least one field goal in four straight games and in each of those contests has drilled at least one attempt from 40 yards or longer ... Thomas was injured in the second game of the season at Towson on September 10 and had not played since then ... VILLANOVA, Pa.—In the first meeting ever between the schools Villanova lost by a score of 37-14 to No. 21 Old Dominion in the annual Homecoming Game at Villanova Stadium. The contest was the fourth in as many weeks for the Wildcats against a nationally-ranked opponent.

The momentum in the game went to the Monarchs early on, as Old Dominion scored on consecutive drives in the middle of the first quarter and then stretched a 13-7 lead after the opening period to a 30-14 margin by halftime.

For much of the game Villanova was haunted by a Monarchs defense which forced four turnovers, including an interception and three lost fumbles. Old Dominion scored three touchdowns and a total of 20 points off of turnovers in the game.

The points for the Wildcats came on a six-yard touchdown pass from redshirt freshman quarterback **Dustin Thomas** to sophomore wide receiver **Joe Price** and on a 20-yard touchdown run from redshirt freshman running back **Austin Medley**.

The touchdown reception by Price pulled Villanova to within 13-7 with 2:43 remaining in the first quarter. Early in the second period the Monarchs put together a 13-play drive that culminated in a Jarod Brown field goal to extend the Old Dominion lead to 16-7.

On the ensuing possession for the Wildcats a fumble on the first play of the drive turned the ball back over to the Monarchs at the Villanova two-yard line. Old Dominion ran in for a one-yard score three plays later to extend its lead to 23-7 and the Wildcats never got closer than nine points the rest of the way.

Despite the Villanova turnovers the Monarchs had only a very slight advantage in time of possession during the contest. The two teams combined to punt 13 times and accumulated more than 520 punting yards between them.

Thomas went 10-of-17 through the air for 82 yards and the touchdown pass to Price, who led the Wildcats with four receptions for 34 yards and the score. Both players have overcome significant injuries this season. Thomas returned to action last week after missing four games and Price was playing his first game today since suffering an injury at Towson in the second game of the year.

Freshman quarterback **Chris Polony** came in for Thomas in the third quarter and finished the game with a team-high 52 rushing yards on five carries. Medley had 10 carries for 30 yards, including his second rushing touchdown of the season with 2:44 left in the first half.

On the defensive end freshman linebacker **Dillon Lucas** led all players with 12 tackles (eight solo), while making one sack and breaking up a pass. Freshman defensive back **Jerry Miles** and junior linebacker **Devon Bridges** had eight tackles apiece.

Monarchs quarterback Taylor Heinicke completed 23-of-32 passes for 204 yards and two touchdowns while also finishing with 29 rushing yards and one score. Nick Mayers and Antonio Vaughan each had a touchdown reception and combined for 11 catches overall in the game.

GAME 9 RECAP: NO. 8 MAINE 41, VILLANOVA 25

VILLANOVA, Pa.—In the final on-campus home game of the season the heavy snow and wind was as big a part of the day as the game itself and Villanova lost by a final score of 41-25 to No. 8 Maine at Villanova Stadium. The field was blanketed with snow before the game started and heavy, wet snow and rain lasted throughout with the temperatures never getting past the mid 30's.

The visiting Black Bears traveled more than 500 miles south for the contest but still found the worst of wintry conditions affecting the game. Field goals and extra points were hard to come by due to the snow and slick field surface but Maine eventually scored three straight touchdowns from late in the second quarter through the middle of the third period to pull away from a 7-6 lead and built a 28-6 advantage.

Despite the conditions the 25 points put up by the Wildcats offense was a season high and there were plenty of positives to take out of the contest. Among them, senior wide receiver **Mikey Reynolds** caught a career-high two touchdown passes and redshirt freshman running back **Austin Medley** registered the first 100-yard rushing game of his career.

Medley scored on a five-yard run with 4:08 left in the first half to give Villanova its first points of the game. At that point the Wildcats trailed 7-6 – the point-after attempt by junior kicker **Mark Hamilton** stayed low and was blocked – but the Black Bears extended their lead on a 10-yard scoring run by Pushaun Brown with 1:49 left before the intermission and went into halftime with a 13-6 edge.

In the third quarter Arthur Williams went 80 yards on a catch-and-run with 9:38 left in the period and quarterback Warren Smith broke away for a 29-yard scoring run five minutes later as the Maine lead swelled to 22 points.

Villanova freshman quarterback **Chris Polony** threw three touchdown passes in the second half, the first of which was a season-best 60-yard completion to junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** which made the score 28-12 with 3:03 left in the third quarter. Both teams had two touchdown drives in the fourth quarter before settling on the final 16-point margin.

Polony, who briefly left the game during the second quarter after initially appearing to be injured, finished the day 10-of-20 through the air for 198 yards with the three touchdowns and one interception. He also ran for 34 yards and the Wildcats finished the day with a season-high 405 yards of total offense.

A nearly perfect balance between the passing game (208 total yards) and the rushing attack (197 yards) helped the Villanova offense get into gear. Medley ran a season-high 17 times for 100 yards and the score, including two runs of 20 yards or longer. On the receiving end, freshman tight end **Earnest Pettway** had a team-best three receptions, Wells finished with 73 yards and a score and Reynolds scored touchdowns on both of his catches in the game.

Defensively the Wildcats forced two turnovers and both sophomore defensive end **Antoine Lewis** and junior linebacker **Patrick Haggerty** recovered fumbles. Meanwhile, junior safety **Eric Loper** and freshman defensive back **Jerry Miles** each had seven tackles.

NOTES: It was 35 degree with heavy snow and rain when the game kicked off at 3:36 p.m. ... The wind chill dipped into the mid 20's by the end of the game ... The teams combined for 10 touchdowns but were only 5-of-10 on point-after tries, including both kicks and two-point conversions ... Medley has five runs of 20 yards or more this season ... Reynolds had one receiving touchdown in a game five times in his career before tallying two in the game ... The 60-yard touchdown pass from Polony to Wells was the second reception of 50 yards or longer for Wells this season and the longest pass completion for any Wildcat this year ... The weather conditions were a culpable factor in Hamilton missing field goal attempts of 22 yards and 27 yards to end his streak of 14 consecutive made field goals entering the game ... Redshirt freshman quarterback **Dustin Thomas** played one series in the second quarter while Polony was out ... He completed his only pass attempt for 10 yards and ran three times for 21 yards ... Villanova played its fifth consecutive game against a nationally-ranked league opponent.

GAME 10 RECAP: VILLANOVA 35, MASSACHUSETTS 17

Nov. 5, 2011

AMHERST, Mass.—Led by three interceptions from senior cornerback **Jimmy Pitts** and two recovered fumbles by sophomore cornerback **Craig James**, an incredible all-around effort by Villanova sent the Wildcats to an uplifting 35-17 victory over Massachusetts.

Villanova turned six turnovers by the Minutemen into 28 points and registered their first win at McGuirk Stadium in more than 30 years. The site was previously the only venue in CAA Football that Wildcats head coach Andy Talley had yet to win at and he led an opportunistic young team to his first victory in eight tries in Amherst.

The game turned quickly in the second quarter when three turnovers by Massachusetts in the span of just four minutes had Villanova on its way to scoring 28 points in the period en route to a 28-10 lead at halftime. Prior to the four-touchdown outburst in the quarter the Wildcats had scored more than 28 points in a game just once all season.

Big plays from the defense prevented the Minutemen from ever finding an offensive rhythm and the turnovers put Villanova in terrific field position offensively time after time. Seven of the 14 possessions for the Wildcats in the game started inside Massachusetts territory and the efforts of the offense and special teams matched the Villanova defense in the team's most complete game of the season.

Turnovers on consecutive offensive plays by the Minutemen in the second quarter got the ball rolling for the Wildcats, who converted each of those first two turnovers into touchdowns and took a 14-3 lead with 9:23 left in the opening half. Massachusetts never recovered from the momentum gained by Villanova on those first two scores.

Freshman quarterback **Chris Polony** threw three touchdown passes for the second straight game and redshirt freshman running back **Austin Medley** had both a rushing touchdown and a receiving touchdown to lead the team's offensive effort. Freshman running back **Jamal Abdur-Rahman** had equal totals of 62 yards both running and receiving, including a 30-yard reception for a touchdown.

Early in the second quarter junior linebacker **Devon Bridges** forced a fumble which James picked up at the Minutemen 13-yard line and four plays later a three-yard pass from Polony to Medley got the Wildcats on the board with a 7-3 advantage.

On the ensuing Massachusetts possession Pitts picked off a pass near midfield on the very first play from scrimmage and it took just three plays before Polony found Abdur-Rahman for a 30-yard run-and-catch scoring play.

Pitts struck again just three plays later, registering his second interception of the game in nearly the same exact spot as the first. This time the Villanova possession led to a two-yard touchdown run by Medley and the Wildcats pushed their lead to 21-3 with 4:37 left before halftime.

It looked like the Minutemen might gain some momentum back going into the intermission after a nine-play scoring drive trimmed the gap to 21-10 with 1:25 left before the break. Villanova still wasn't done, though, and once again got the ball in excellent field position after a personal foul against Massachusetts pushed the kickoff back to the 15-yard line.

Abdur-Rahman returned that kickoff 19 yards to the Wildcats 48-yard line and smart plays by the offense allowed for seven plays in just over a minute, culminating with a 13-yard touchdown pass from Polony to junior wide receiver **Dorian Wells** with just 14 seconds left in the period. Polony finished the day 20-of-31 through the air for 183 yards and the three touchdown passes.

In the third quarter the Minutemen scored first to get within 28-17 but just past the midpoint of the period a 17-yard run by Massachusetts abruptly ended when freshman free safety **Joe Sarnese** knocked the ball loose and James recovered.

Villanova did not score on its resulting possession but turned the ball over on downs at the Minutemen 12-yard line. Five plays later the third lost fumble of the game by Massachusetts was picked up by junior defensive end **Marlon Johnson** and senior running back **Lawrence Doss** eventually ran in for a seven-yard touchdown to close the scoring.
