**RHODE ISLAND REPORT:** The Rams enter Saturday's game with a 2-5 overall record and an 0-3 mark in the CAA. The team's two wins have come against Monmouth and No. 25 Brown. In its most recent outing, Rhode Island lost a 37-32 decision at Towson last Saturday.

In the game against the Tigers last weekend, the Rams scored the first nine points of the game but eventually fell behind, 30-12, early in the fourth quarter before mounting a late rally. Jimmy Hughes ran in for a two-yard score with 4:46 to play and Shawn Leonard caught a 30-yard touchdown pass from Derek Cassidy just over a minute later to pull Rhode Island to within 37-32. The Rams forced Towson to punt five plays later but then could only drive as far as the Tigers 29-yard line before turning the ball over on downs with 1:05 remaining.

Cassidy threw for 265 yards and two touchdowns, both of which were caught by Leonard. Cassidy ran for 70 yards and Leonard tallied 111 receiving yards on six catches.

For the season, Cassidy has completed 168-of-288 passes for 1,893 yards with 13 touchdowns and seven interceptions. Leonard has been his favorite scoring target with four touchdown receptions, while Brandon Johnson-Farrell leads the team with 41 receptions.

Rhode Island is averaging 340 yards of offense, but is allowing 420 yards per game to the opposition. Matt Hansen has been the team's defensive leader with a team-high 63 tackles, including six tackles for loss and three sacks. Hansen also leads the team with three forced fumbles.

**RAM HEAD COACH DARREN RIZZI:** A former All-American tight end at Rhode Island, Darren Rizzi returns to the program this season as head coach. He most recently spent the last six years on the coaching staff at Rutgers.

As an assistant coach for the linebackers and special teams from 2005-07, he helped the Scarlet Knights go 7-5 in 2005 and make their first bowl appearance since 1978. A year later, Rutgers had a program-best 11-2 record and was ranked as high as No. 7 in the nation along the way to its first-ever bowl game victory. The Scarlet Knights defense led the BIG EAST in both yards allowed per game and scoring defense. Rizzi coached the Rutgers running backs during his first three years with the program.

Rizzi came to Rhode Island with previous head coaching experience at Division II New Haven, where he returned to as head coach in 1999 after previously being an assistant coach for the Chargers from 1994-97. Rizzi went 15-14 in three seasons as head coach at New Haven, including an upset victory over Villanova in 2001 when the Chargers knocked off the 12th-ranked Wildcats.

During his collegiate career Rizzi walked on to the Rhode Island team in 1988 and still ranks fourth in school history in receptions and receiving yards, and fifth in touchdown receptions. He was named team captain in 1992 and a year later was a first team Yankee Conference All-Star and a consensus All-American.

Entering Saturday's game, Rizzi owns a career record of 17-19 in his fourth season as a head coach, including a 2-5 mark in his first season at Rhode Island.

**THE BOOK ON TALLEY:** Currently in his 24th season at Villanova, head coach **Andy Talley** can feel responsible for every facet of the Villanova football program, having started it from scratch in 1985. During his Wildcat career, Talley has registered a 159-99-1 record, making him the all-time winningest coach in Villanova history. His 28-year overall coaching record currently stands at 187-117-2. Throughout his tenure at Villanova, Talley has guided the Wildcats to six NCAA playoff appearances (1989, 1991, 1992, 1996, 1997, 2002), four conference titles and two Lambert Meadowlands Trophies. In 1997, Talley garnered the Eddie Robinson Award and the AFCA/GTE National Coach of the Year Award after leading Villanova to a perfect 11-0 regular season and the No. 1 ranking in the country for the last six weeks of the regular season.

**THE BYE WEEK:** Villanova returns to action this Saturday at Rhode Island after its second bye week of the season last Saturday. Dating back to the 1997 season, the Wildcats are 7-5 following a bye. Villanova has won three straight after a bye, including the 33-14 win over Lehigh earlier this season.

**CLOSING IN:** Villanova Head coach **Andy Talley** is three conference wins away from becoming the all-time winningest coach in the history of Colonial Athletic Association Football. The league has been in existence in one form or another since 1947. It was the Yankee Conference from 1947-96, the Atlantic 10 Football Conference from 1997-2006 and is currently the CAA. Talley currently has 95 all-time conference wins. Former New Hampshire mentor Bill Bowes leads the way with 97 victories.

**RENEWING ACQUAINTANCES:** For the first time in three years, Villanova and Rhode Island will meet on the gridiron. The two teams last played on Oct. 22, 2005, when the Rams tallied a 48-30 win at Villanova Stadium. Villanova's last trip to Kingston came in a 48-9 win on Oct. 30, 2004. Rhode Island plays in the North Division of the CAA, while Villanova is in the South Division. The conference schedule is set-up where you play all the teams in your division and three of the six squads in the opposite division. Villanova has dominated play over the years with Rhode Island as evidence by the 12-2 lead in the all-time series, including a 4-1 mark in games played at Rhode Island.

**WE KNOW HIM:** There will be a familiar face on the Rhode Island sidelines this Saturday. Current Rhode Island Associate Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator Joe Trainer coached at Villanova from 1997-2004. Trainer was Villanova's linebacker coach for three seasons and the team's defensive coordinator for five years. After his eight-year stint at Villanova, Trainer served three seasons as the head coach at Division II Millersville University.

**BAD MEMORIES:** Rhode Island is led by first-year head coach Darren Rizzi. The last time Villanova played against a Rizzi led team was in 2001 when Rizzi guided his Division II University of New Haven team to a 17-14 upset of No. 12 ranked Villanova. That Wildcat team would go on to finish 8-3 overall and tie for the Atlantic 10 championship with a 7-2 record.

**FCS COMPETITION:** Villanova's only loss this year came in the season opener at FBS opponent West Virginia. Dating back to last season, the Wildcats have won six straight games against FCS opponents. Going back to the last four games of 2006, Villanova is 15-3 versus FCS teams.

**BLOCK PARTY:** In the team's last outing at William & Mary, the Wildcats recorded two blocked kicks in the 38-28 victory. In the first quarter, junior linebacker **Osayi Osunde** blocked a 32-yard Brian Pate field goal attempt. In the second quarter, Villanova defensive end **Damian Kelley** blocked a William & Mary punt. This marks the first time since October 9, 2004, that Villanova has blocked two kicks in the same game. In that 2004 game, Villanova's Allyn Bacchus and Terrance Reaves each blocked a Northeastern extra point attempt. The last time Villanova blocked a field goal and punt in the same game came in a 45-3 win over Rhode Island on November 16, 2002. Villanova also had a field goal attempt and punt blocked. All total, there were four blocked kicks in the game.

**NOT SO SPECIAL:** Even though Villanova blocked two kicks and averaged 23.2 yards per kickoff return in the win at William & Mary, the Wildcats also had a few struggles on special teams as well. Villanova had a 38-yard **Joe Marcoux** field goal blocked, a Zach Ugarte punt blocked and the Wildcats allowed a 97-yard kickoff return for a touchdown. Marcoux had gone 41 straight field goal attempts without having one blocked before this game. He now has had two kicks blocked in 47 career attempts. The last time Villanova gave up a kickoff return for a score came at Rutgers on September 10, 2005. With having the punt blocked in the William & Mary game, the Wildcats have now had three punts blocked this year.

**REACHING 100 AGAIN:** Sophomore running back **Aaron Ball** enters play this Saturday at Rhode Island having reached the 100-yard rushing mark in his last two outings. In a 26-20 win over No. 1 Richmond on Sept. 27, Ball carried 18 times for 123 yards and a career-high two touchdowns. One of the two scores came on a career-best 63-yard rush. For his efforts in the Richmond game, Ball was named the CAA Offensive Player of the Week. The next week at William & Mary, Ball rushed a career-high 22 times for a career-best 137 yards and one score. In his last two games combined, Ball has registered 40 carries for 260 yards (6.5 yards per carry in the last two games) and three touchdowns. For the year, he has been credited with 83 rushes for 526 yards and five touchdowns.

**THE WHITNEY WAY:** Since taking over as the starting quarterback in the last two games, sophomore quarterback **Chris Whitney** has completed 34-of-49 (69.4%) for 362 yards to go with three touchdowns and one interception. In his last game at William & Mary, Whitney had a career passing day. He completed a career-high 20 passes in 27 attempts for a career-high tying 186 yards and a career-best three touchdowns. In his career, Whitney is 5-2 as the Wildcat starting signal caller.

**EXPECTED RETURN:** After missing three of the last four games due to an achilles injury, junior offensive lineman **Brian Brannigan** is expected to return to the Wildcat starting line-up this Saturday at Rhode Island. Brannigan suffered the injury in the season opener at West Virginia and missed the Lehigh and Penn games before playing in the Richmond contest. He aggravated the injury versus Richmond and was forced to miss the William & Mary contest. The big question surrounding Brannigan's return is if he will start at guard or center. His previous 24 career starts have been at guard, but he did see time at center in the Richmond game.



**STOPPING THE RUN:** Opponents have found it hard to run against the Wildcats this season. After five games, the Villanova defense has allowed just 456 rushing yards for an average of 91.2 yards per game and 3.4 yards per carry. The 91.2 average leads the CAA. New Hampshire ranks second giving up 115.4 rushing yards per contest.

**TOP CATS:** Entering play this Saturday at Rhode Island, the Villanova Wildcats lead the CAA in three team categories and three individual statistics.

**POINT PRODUCER:** Villanova senior kicker **Joe Marcoux** currently leads the CAA in three individual categories including scoring (8.4 points per game), field goals made (9) and field goal percentage (75.0%). After five games, Marcoux is 9-of-12 in field goal attempts and 15-of-16 in PATs for a team-best 42 points. Marcoux now has 177 career points which ranks him 12th on Villanova's all-time scoring list. With four more field goals, Marcoux will tie the school record for field goals in a season with 13. The record is currently held by Bill Hoffman in 1992 and Mark Kiefer in 1997.

**NEGATIVE YARDAGE:** Of Villanova's 29 tackles for loss this year, 10 have been recorded by senior defensive end **Greg Miller**. His 10 tackles for loss have resulted in negative 48 yards. Miller is having an outstanding senior campaign for the Wildcats. After five games, he has tallied 25 total tackles (third on team), 10.5 tackles for loss (leads team), 4.5 sacks (leads team) and two forced fumbles (tied for team lead).

**DOMINANT ENDS:** Villanova has received a strong contribution from its defensive ends this year. The trio of **Greg Miller**, **Tim Kukucka** and **Dave Dalessandro** has been dominant at times this year. After five games, these three have combined to record 54 total tackles, 18 tackles for loss, 7.5 quarterback sacks, four forced fumbles and one fumble recovery. By category, they have accounted for 75.0 percent of the team's sacks, 62.0 percent of the tackles for loss and 57.1 percent of the forced fumbles.

**FINDING THE END ZONE:** Two Wildcats scored their first career touchdowns in the team's last outing at William & Mary. Senior tight end **Steve Pimm** made his first career touchdown grab with a five-yard reception in the first quarter. Early in the second quarter, freshman running back **Lawrence Doss** registered his first collegiate score when he took a screen pass 15 yards into the end zone.

**YOUTHFUL WILDCATS:** On the current Villanova two-deep depth chart, there are nine freshmen or sophomores currently starting and eight true freshmen that appear on the depth chart.

**DOUBLE FIGURE RECEIVERS:** Entering play at Rhode Island, Villanova has four receivers who have double figures in receptions. Leading the way is senior **Phil Atkinson** with 22, followed by sophomore **Matt Szczur** with 19 receptions, junior **Brandyn Harvey** with 17 catches and sophomore **Angelo Babbaro** with 11 receptions.

**TEAM LEADERS:** The 2008 Villanova captains will be the senior defensive end duo of **Dave Dalessandro** and **Greg Miller**. This will be Dalessandro's second year in a captain role as he served as a tri-captain last season.

**VILLANOVA PICKED FOURTH:** Despite being ranked in the Top 25 in numerous pre-season national polls, the Wildcats were picked to finish fourth in the South Division of the CAA according to a poll of the league's head coaches and selected media members.

**ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNEES:** Two members of the 2008 Wildcats earned All-CAA distinction last year. Sophomore **Tim Kukucka** was a second team selection, while junior Osayi Osunde was a third team choice. Kukucka had 40 tackles, a team-high 12 tackles for loss and a team-best seven sacks last year, while Osunde led the 'Cats in tackles with 82. After five games in 2008, Osunde has 24 tackles and one interception, while Kukucka has 15 tackles, four tackles for loss, two sacks and one forced fumble.

**OVERTIME HISTORY:** During head coach Andy Talley's tenure, Villanova has played 13 overtime games and in those 13 contests are 9-4. The Wildcats have won seven of their last nine overtime games. Of the 13 overtime games, eight have been played at Villanova Stadium. Villanova is 1-0 this year in overtime (20-14 one overtime win at Penn on Sept. 20).

**ON THE RADIO DIAL:** All the Villanova football action this year can be heard on 950-AM ESPN Radio. This will be the third consecutive year that 950-AM will serve as the flagship station of Wildcat football. Play-by-play announcer Joe Eichhorn, who has been broadcasting Villanova football since 1988, returns to anchor the broadcasts. Joining Eichhorn for a 16th straight year is Ryan Fannon who will serve as the color analyst.

**PLAYING ON SUNDAYS:** There are five former Villanova Wildcats currently in the NFL. The five include running back **Brian Westbrook** (7th season with Philadelphia Eagles), wide receiver **Brian Finneran** (10th season in NFL, 9th with Atlanta Falcons), wide receiver/defensive back **Raymond Ventrone** (3rd season with New England Patriots), center **Christian Gaddis** (2nd season in the NFL, 1st with Cleveland Browns) and tight end **Matt Sherry** (rookie season with Cincinnati Bengals). Sherry injured his shoulder and is on the injured reserve list.



**CAA FOOTBALL TELECONFERENCE:** Every Monday from August 25-Nov. 17, the CAA will conduct a teleconference from 10 a.m.-12:10 p.m. with each of its head coaches. Every coach will have a 10-minute slot to discuss his team and answer questions from the media. Members of the media are strongly encouraged to participate in the questioning. ## 2008 GAME-BY-GAME RECAPS

### Game 1 No. 8 West Virginia 48, Villanova 21 Aug. 30, 2008 Morgantown, W. Va.

**MORGANTOWN, W.Va.**--Against a nationally-ranked FBS opponent, Villanova executed its game plan for much of the first half before succumbing to one of the most powerful offenses in the nation in a 48-21 defeat at the hands of No. 8 West Virginia before 60,566 at Milan Puskar Stadium. The Wildcats outgained the Mountaineers by a 399-354 edge in total offensive yards and won the battle of possession time in the game.

Junior **Antwon Young** threw for 218 yards and rushed for a touchdown and Villanova ran in all three of its scores on the afternoon. Sophomores **Aaron Ball** and **Chris Whitney** each rushed for a touchdown as well and the Wildcats finished with 133 net rushing yards.

Villanova ate up more than 11 minutes on the clock in the first quarter and held West Virginia off the scoreboard until there was just 2:04 left in the period. After the Wildcats drove to the Mountaineers 19-yard line, Young was sacked on third down for an initial loss of 15 yards. He fumbled on the play and Mortty Ivy recovered the ball and returned it 30 yards to the Villanova 24-yard line to set up a score.

In the second quarter, Young's three-yard touchdown run with 6:47 to play in the half capped a 12-play, 80-yard drive and pulled the Wildcats to within 14-7. However, Alric Arnett caught his second touchdown pass of the game just over two minutes later and Pat McAfee kicked a 52-yard field goal as time expired to make the score 24-7 at the half.

White threw for a career-high five touchdowns and 208 yards while rushing for 63 yards. Arnett caught four passes and Jock Sanders had eight receptions for 62 yards and a pair of scores. The Mountaineers did the rest of their work on defense, recording six sacks to cause a loss of 42 yards.

Young finished 17-of-33 and also had two interceptions, while Whitney was 4-of-4 for 48 yards to go along with a late one-yard touchdown run with two seconds left in the game. Villanova drove 78 yards on 15 plays for its final points of the contest.

On the defensive side of the ball, senior Darrel Young led the Wildcats with nine tackles and sophomore Ross Ventrone had eight stops. Sophomore Frederick Maldonado had six tackles and also picked off a pass.

**NOTES:** The Wildcats played against an FBS opponent for the 13th time since the program was restored in 1985 ... Villanova is 2-11 in these games, with the wins coming against Rutgers (2002) and Temple (2003) ... Today's game marked the first of the 13 meetings in which the Wildcats faced a nationally-ranked opponent.

## 2008 GAME-BY-GAME RECAPS

### Game 2 No. 21 Villanova 33, Lehigh 14 Sept. 13, 2008 Villanova, Pa.

**VILLANOVA, Pa.**--Senior **Joe Marcoux** was one of the keys to a strong special teams and defensive effort and Villanova defeated Lehigh by a count of 33-14 in its home opener at Villanova Stadium. The Wildcats drew 11,101 for their first home game of the season, which fell on Parents' Weekend on campus.

Marcoux kicked field goals measuring 44, 23, 44 and 22 yards in going 4-for-4 on field goal attempts. The two 44-yard kicks also set new career highs. After a scoreless first quarter, Marcoux kicked a 44-yard field goal in the first minute of the second quarter to open the scoring with 14:12 left in the half.

Less than three minutes later, junior linebacker **Osayi Osunde** returned the first of four Villanova interceptions 56 yards for a 10-0 lead. Marcoux kicked a 23-yard field goal midway through the quarter to make the score 13-0 and the Wildcats later scored 17 unanswered points after the Mountain Hawks had cut the deficit to 13-7 late in the half.

Junior **Aaron Ball** ran in a one-yard score with 1:33 remaining before the intermission to put Villanova ahead 20-7 at the break. Ball finished the day with 66 yards on 17 carries and the Wildcats outgained Lehigh 371-238.

In his second game back after missing the last five games of 2007 with an injury, junior quarterback **Antwon Young** threw for 231 yards and a touchdown, going 22-of-35 with one interception. Classmate **Angelo Babbaro** had five catches for 46 yards and ran 10 times for 55 yards.

A 44-yard field goal by Marcoux early in the third quarter and a 20-yard touchdown pass by Young to senior **Phil Atkinson** with 23 seconds left in the period stretched the Villanova lead to 30-7.

Mountain Hawk quarterback J.B. Clark threw a six-yard pass for a touchdown to Sekou Yansane with 12:28 to play to make the score 30-14 and Marcoux closed the scoring with a field goal with 5:38 left.

Clark threw for 200 yards but finished 20-of-43 and was intercepted four times. In addition to the 56-yard return for a score by Osunde, the Wildcats had interceptions from sophomores **Ross Ventrone** and **Frederick Maldonado** and senior **Salim Koroma**.

Yansane and Mike Fitzgerald each had five receptions for Lehigh and Matt McGowan ran for 29 yards and a touchdown on 12 carries. Tim Diamond had 14 total tackles (10 solo, four assisted) to lead all players and also finished with a 21-yard interception return, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.

## 2008 GAME-BY-GAME RECAPS

### Game 3 No. 19 Villanova 20, Penn 14 (ot) Sept. 20, 2008 Philadelphia, Pa.

**PHILADELPHIA, Pa.**--Backup quarterback **Chris Whitney** scored on a nine-yard run on the first possession of overtime as Villanova defeated local rival Penn, 20-14, at Franklin Field.

Penn blocked the extra-point attempt after Whitney scored, but the Quakers fumbled on their first play and Villanova's **Salim Koroma** recovered the ball to clinch the win for the Wildcats.

Villanova starting quarterback **Antwon Young** completed 16 of 26 passes for 172 yards and one touchdown, but also had four interceptions. Robert Irvin was 15-for-23 for 179 yards and a touchdown for the Quakers, who lost to the Wildcats for the seventh straight time since the series was resumed in 1999.

Penn led 14-7 on a 12-yard run by Michael DiMaggio with 9:56 left in the second quarter, but Villanova tied the score four plays later on a 38-yard pass play from Young to **Matthew Szczur**.

Neither team scored in the second half, although Villanova threatened on three occasions but was stopped by Penn's interceptions.

Whitney replaced Young late in the game and completed 1 of 2 passes for 10 yards and carried four times for 25 yards and a touchdown.

Villanova now has an 8-5 lead in the overall series, which started in 1905 - but the teams didn't play from 1912 to 1999.

## 2008 GAME-BY-GAME RECAPS

### Game 4 No. 19 Villanova 26, No. 1 Richmond 20 Sept. 27, 2008 Villanova, Pa.

**VILLANOVA, Pa.**--In its conference opener, No. 19 Villanova took the lead late in the first quarter and never looked back along the way to defeating a top-ranked opponent for the first time in school history. The Wildcats defeated No. 1 Richmond by a 26-20 count at Villanova Stadium.

Sophomore **Aaron Ball** ran for a career-high 123 yards and two touchdowns and senior **Joe Marcoux** matched a career high with four field goals to carry Villanova to its third straight win. The Wildcats had been 0-4 in their history against No. 1-ranked teams and had never played a top-ranked opponent at Villanova Stadium.

The Wildcats owned a 402-333 advantage in total offense thanks to their dominant running game, which produced a 226-83 edge in net rushing yards. Ball ran in for a three-yard score with 3:51 remaining in the opening period to give Villanova a 7-3 lead and then broke away for a 63-yard scoring run with 8:39 left in the second quarter to stretch the margin to 14-3. It was the first career 100-yard rushing game for Ball.

Later in the second quarter Joe Stewart caught an 8-yard touchdown pass from Eric Ward with 3:47 to play in the half to close the Spiders to within 14-10. The Wildcats preserved their lead by never returning the ball to Richmond in the half and Marcoux kicked a 21-yard field goal as time expired to send Villanova into the break with a 17-10 lead.

The Spiders did everything they could to get their offense going in the third quarter and held the ball for more than 11 minutes in the period. Richmond had two drives in the quarter that combined for 25 plays and 135 yards of offense but amounted to just a field goal. Andrew Howard converted a 35-yard attempt with 8:28 left in the period to make the score 17-13 but Marcoux answered with a 25-yard field goal less than four minutes later to bring the Wildcat lead back to a touchdown.

A drive by the Spiders that lasted 12 plays and went 75 yards wound up in Richmond turning the ball over on downs seven seconds into the fourth quarter. On its ensuing drive, Villanova consumed nearly seven minutes on the clock and capped a 15-play, 63-yard drive with Marcoux kicking a career-long 48-yard field goal with exactly eight minutes to play. The field goal was the sixth-longest in school history and Marcoux added a 29-yarder with 4:04 remaining.

The final rally attempt by the Spiders stalled late in the final period after Josh Vaughan ran in a seven-yard score to pull Richmond to within 26-20. The Spiders went 86 yards on 11 plays in just 2:45 but Brian Radford's onside kick went straight to Wildcat sophomore **Matt Szczur** at the Villanova 39-yard line with 1:13 left.

Sophomore quarterback **Chris Whitney** made his first start of the season after entering last weekend's game at Penn late in the contest. He threw for 176 yards on 14-of-22 accuracy with one interception and also gained 61 yards on the ground with 17 net rushing yards. Szczur, junior **Brandyn Harvey** and senior **Phil Atkinson** all had four receptions for the Wildcats, with Szczur accounting for a team-high 56 receiving yards.

Senior **Greg Miller** made eight tackles in the game, which included 5.5 tackles for losses totaling 23 yards. He was credited with 2.5 sacks and also forced a fumble, as did sophomore **Terence Thomas**. Thomas had 1.5 sacks and 10 total tackles while senior **Salim Koroma** led the team with 11 stops (four solo, seven assisted).

Villanova last played a No. 1-ranked team on October 1, 2005 when it was defeated 45-17 at New Hampshire. The last time any top-ranked squad played at Villanova Stadium was during the Wildcats undefeated regular season in 1997, when they spent part of the year as the nation's No. 1 team and reached the second round of the NCAA Championship before finishing the year with a 12-1 record.

## 2008 GAME-BY-GAME RECAPS

### Game 5 No. 14 Villanova 38, William & Mary 28 Oct. 4, 2008 Williamsburg, Va.

**WILLIAMSBURG, Va.**--Strong special teams play was complemented by an offense that was in top form in the first half and Villanova ran out to an early lead in an eventual 38-28 win over William & Mary at Zable Stadium. The visiting Wildcats scored the game's first 35 points and never looked back in winning their fourth consecutive game.

Villanova reached the end zone on five of its first seven possessions of the game and led 35-0 after sophomore **Chris Whitney** found classmate **Matt Szczur** for an 11-yard touchdown pass with 51 seconds remaining in the second quarter. The Wildcats scored 21 points off turnovers in the half thanks to scoring drives that began after a blocked field goal, fumble recovery and blocked punt.

With the ball in its hands during the opening half, Villanova was nearly unstoppable. Whitney completed 17-of-21 passes in the half for 163 yards and a pair of touchdowns, while also rushing in for a score. The Wildcats generated 297 yards of offense and converted on 6-of-9 third-down situations before the break, while the Tribe had just 139 yards of offense and were 0-of-6 on third downs.

Whitney opened the scoring with 7:42 left in the opening quarter when he threw a five-yard touchdown pass to senior tight end **Stephen Pimm**, who recorded his first career touchdown reception.

It was a half full of firsts before intermission and the game turned in the second quarter when Villanova had back-to-back scores just 49 seconds apart. True freshman running back **Lawrence Doss** caught his first career pass for a 15-yard touchdown with 12:52 left in the second quarter. On the second play of the next William & Mary drive, sophomore **Marquis Kirkland** forced a fumble that was recovered by classmate **Frederick Maldonado** and returned to the Tribe 32-yard line. From there, sophomore **Aaron Ball** rushed for a 32-yard touchdown on the first play of the ensuing Wildcat drive to spot Villanova a 21-0 lead.

The Wildcats blocked two kicks in the same game for the first time since 2004 and also recorded both a blocked field goal and blocked punt in the same game for the first time since 2002. The drive that ended with Pimm's touchdown began on a blocked 32-yard field goal attempt by junior **Osayi Osunde** that sophomore **Ross Ventrone** recovered. In the second quarter, junior **Damian Kelley** blocked a punt that was recovered by freshman **Mike Reynolds** at the William & Mary 18-yard line. Whitney ran in for a 1-yard score four plays later.

Despite the early surge, Villanova had to hang tough in the closing minutes of the game to win in Williamsburg for only the second time since 1997. Jonathan Grimes returned a kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown with 37 seconds left in the first half to make the score 35-7 and Michael Alvarado blocked a field goal attempt as time expired to give William & Mary a bit of momentum going into the second half. Scoring drives early in the third and fourth quarters eventually allowed the Tribe to score 21 unanswered points and pull to within 35-21 on R.J. Archer's 3-yard run with 11:50 left in the game.

After that score, however, the Wildcats consumed more than five minutes of clock during a 13-play drive that ended with a 23-yard field goal by senior **Joe Marcoux** with 6:15 remaining and restored a three-possession lead. Archer's six-yard run with 4:20 to play closed the scoring at 38-28.

Whitney finished 20-of-27 for 186 yards and two scores and Ball established a career high for the second straight game with 137 rushing yards. Whitney also ran for 60 yards on 19 carries, Szczur finished with a game-high seven receptions for 78 yards and senior **Phil Atkinson** caught five passes.
