## VILLANOVA TEAM AWARDS

### JIM JONES AWARD

The Jim Jones Memorial Award, initiated in 1967, is given annually to the Villanova lacrosse player who best exemplifies loyalty, courage, and dedication, not only in athletic competition, but in everyday life. The honor is named after Jim Jones ('64) who played lacrosse and gave his life for his country in Vietnam.

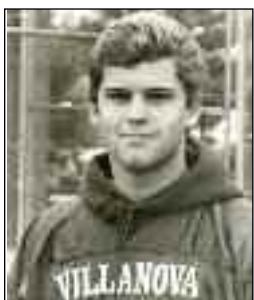
