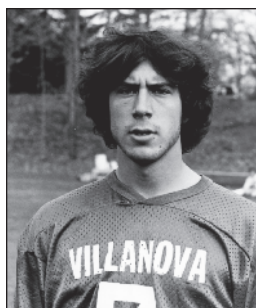
B. JOSEPH TOFANI AWARD
