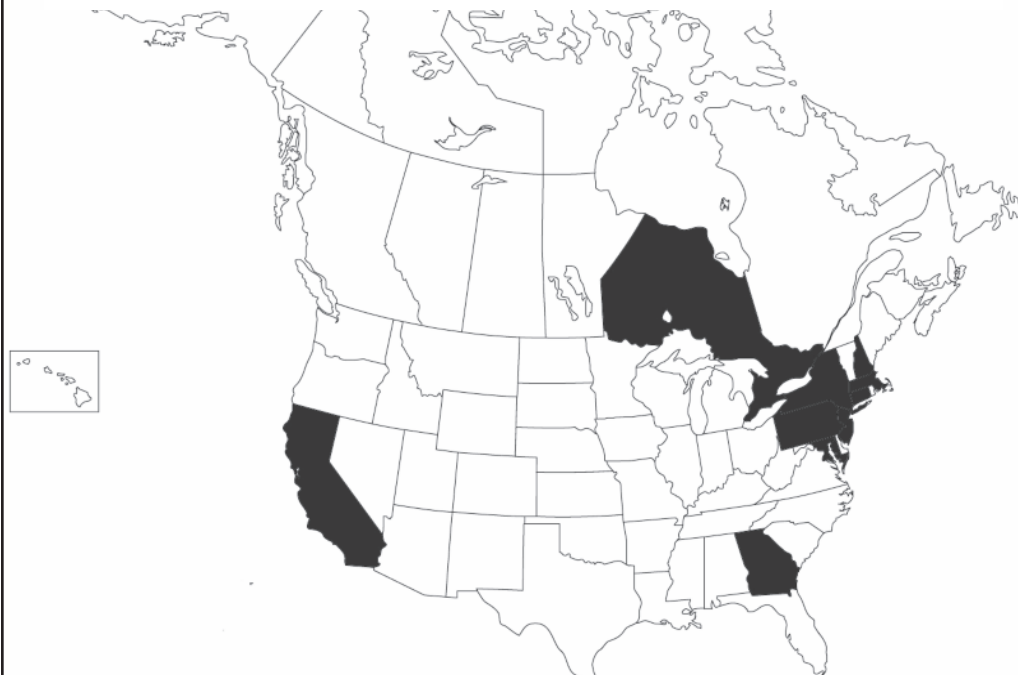

B. JOSEPH TOFANI AWARD

The 2003 season marked the inauguration of the B. Joseph Tofani Award, presented to the graduating senior with the highest grade point average. The honor is named after B. Joseph Tofani, a graduate of the class of 1935. As an engineering major, Tofani went on to work for Pennsylvania's Bureau of Reclamation and the U.S. Department of Agriculture, where he became a national leader in the water resources community.
