Camp Consent/Waiver

If any illness, injury, or other condition or occurrence arises which, in the sole judgment of the Villanova Boy's Soccer Camp (VBSC) needs attention from medical service personnel (whether Physician, nurse, emergency medical technician, athletic trainer, paramedic, hospital, or other medical care provider), then I hereby give consent to any member of the staff of the VBSC to obtain such medical care for my child/ward as the staff decides is needed. I, further consent to and ratify, the signing of any releases by such staff member which required by any medical care provided. I hereby indemnify and hold harmless the VBSC and any and all staff members and employees of the VBSC from any and all costs, expenses, damages, or liability arising from any acts or omission of staff members and medical care providers in connection with the matters set forth in this document. I, understand and agree that as a condition of participation in the VBSC, my child/ward must be fully capable of administering to herself, without assistance, any medication (such as insulin, allergy shots, oral medication) that my child/ward needs or is required to take as a result of any condition existing as of the day prior to the day the camp session starts. I further understand and agree that any braces or protective devices used by my child/ward must be supplied by my child/ward. I hereby certify that I am the parent or legal guardian of the camper. I, hereby give permission for the staff of the VBSC to seek during the period of the VBSC appropriate medical attention for my child/ward and for the medical attention to be given and for my child/ward to receive medical attention in the event of accident, injury, or illness. I will be responsible for any and all costs of medical attention and treatment except for that covered by the VBSC's excess medical policy. I understand and acknowledge that the VBSC is a privately run sports camp, and is not operated by or through Villanova University. All campers must have their own medical insurance coverage. The camp provides only excess coverage after your insurance policy has been utilized. Campers will not be allowed to play unless the following information is submitted and the form signed by the parent/guardian of the camper. A health insurance and information form will be mailed to you upon receipt of your camp application (between May and July). I understand and agree that participation by my child/ward in the VBSC is at sole risk of my child/ward. I assume the risk. I hereby indemnify and hold harmless the VBSC from any and all costs, expenses damages and other liabilities arising from or by reason of my child's/ward's participation in the Villanova Boy's Soccer Camp.

The Villanova Boys' Soccer Camp is located on the beautiful campus of Villanova University. The campus is located a short distance from Philadelphia on the Main Line. The Soccer Complex boasts a 1200 seat capacity with two grass fields at the camp site. In early 2001 the University opened a brand-new locker room facility with a conference room and the capability of presenting lectures. The soccer facilities were also the home to several World Cup Teams during their stay in Philadelphia during 2003. The overnight campers will be housed in the Villanova University dormitories.

Villanova Men's Soccer Head Coach Tom Carlin is not only one of the top young coaches in NCAA Division I soccer; he is a proven leader. Tom is excited to bring his success and passion for the sport to Villanova Soccer Camp this year. The upcoming 2008 season will be Coach Carlin's first year as Head Coach of Villanova. In 2007, Coach Carlin was the Assistant Coach at Villanova and had an immediate impact

on the program. Carlin helped lead the Wildcats to the season's best start in history at 9-2, which included the biggest victory in Villanova soccer history beating number one nationally ranked Duke at Duke. The Wildcats were named the **Soccer Seven Team of the Year for their efforts.** Prior to arriving at Villanova in 2007, Carlin was the Associate Head Coach at Northwestern University from 2006-07. He helped Northwestern advance to the Elite Eight of the 2006 NCAA Tournament. Before his stop at Northwestern, he was the head men's soccer coach at Arcadia University from 2000-06. Carlin tallied a 99-23-9 record at Arcadia and led his teams to three conference titles and three NCAA Tournament appearances including an NCAA run to the Elite 8 in 2002. Carlin holds an "A" license from the United States Soccer Federation (USSF) and a Premier license from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA).

Carlin is known for his ability to develop players through proven coaching principles. He looks forward to helping this year's camp attendees improve in the area of technique and reach their individual goals...whether that be at youth or college level.



Ian Clerihew begins his first season as Assistant Men's Soccer Coach at Villanova in 2008. Coach Clerihew comes with a wealth of training expertise generated from his experiences as an Assistant Coach at Duke University and St John's University, an Associate Head Coach at Northern Illinois University, a Graduate Assistant at the University of Akron, and a Head Coach at Linfield College. At St.Johns, Clerihew helped guide the Red Storm to a 2006 Big

East title. At Linfield, he was named the Northwest Conference Coach of the Year. Clerihew has also been a part of the Olympic Development Program for Region IV. He holds a USSF "A" License.

Camp Philosophy

The goals of the Villanova Boys Soccer Camp are to teach, challenge and develop the enthusiastic, young soccer player in a competitive and fun environment. Our curriculum is based on age and ability level. Our professional staff is comprised of top collegiate coaches, club and high school coaches and collegiate players who are all here to help you reach your goals. We look forward to training you and your teammates!

Resident Camp/Commuter Camp (Ages 11-18)

College Prospect Camp (15-18)*

This camp is designed for players with high level club experience who want to train in a NCAA Collegiate Soccer environment. Advanced topics include technical functional training, zonal defending with a strong emphasis on the flat back four, tactical attacking schemes, and plyometrics with speed and agility training. The coaching staff will be comprised of the Villanova University Men's Soccer Staff and coaches from other top collegiate programs.

Elite Camp (15-18)*

This camp is designed for top level high school players who are preparing for the upcoming high school season. Topics include technical concepts, team defending with an emphasis on individual and small group defense, attacking patterns through small group tactics, and plyometrics with speed and agility training. The coaching staff will be comprised of the Villanova Men's Soccer Staff, coaches from other top collegiate programs, and top local high school and club coaches.

Developmental Camp (11-14)*

This camp is designed for the young, developing player. In a challenging and fun environment, training will include skill development, small group attacking and defending awareness, and plyometrics with speed and agility training. The coaching staff will be comprised of the Villanova Men's Soccer Staff/Players, and top local high school and club coaches.

*Campers may move from group to group. This will be determined by the Villanova Boys Soccer Camp Staff. Evaluations will be made on the first day of camp.

Junior Wildcat Full-Day/Half-Day Camp (Ages 5-10)

This camp is designed for the young, aspiring soccer player. The objective for this group is to appreciate the game and learn in an enthusiastic environment. Training will include basic skill development, individual attacking and defending awareness, and general fitness. The coaching staff will be comprised of the Villanova Men's Soccer Staff/Players, top local club coaches, and top collegiate players.

GOALKEEPING ACADEMY

Our special curriculum is designed to improve the psychological, tactical, technical and overall fitness side of the game. You will make strides through our goalkeeper only sessions and have the opportunity to demonstrate your skills in team games. Goalkeepers who desire to play in college will be a part of the Elite Goalkeeping Academy run by Villanova Goalkeeper Coach BJ Callaghan.

HOUSING AND MEALS

Campers will be housed at Sullivan Hall. All efforts will be made to meet roommate preferences. In case of unavailability, roommates will be assigned based on age. Rooming lists will not be made available prior to check-in.

Meals will be at Dougherty Hall. Breakfast will be the first meal of the camp on Wednesday, July 23rd. A welcome party picnic will be hosted by the Men's Soccer Camp staff on the first night of camp with prizes, trivia and ice-breaker activities.

Commuters will receive all the features of the over-night camp except over-night lodging and breakfast.

Full Day Campers will be responsible to bring their own bag lunch. Pizza and drinks will be available for lunch at an additional cost.

TEAM DISCOUNT

An organized team or group of 12 or more individuals are invited to attend the camp together and will receive a \$25 discount per player on the total cost. Coaches must supply the roster of team members in advance of registration. Campers who register prior to their team will not be refunded the \$25.00 balance.
