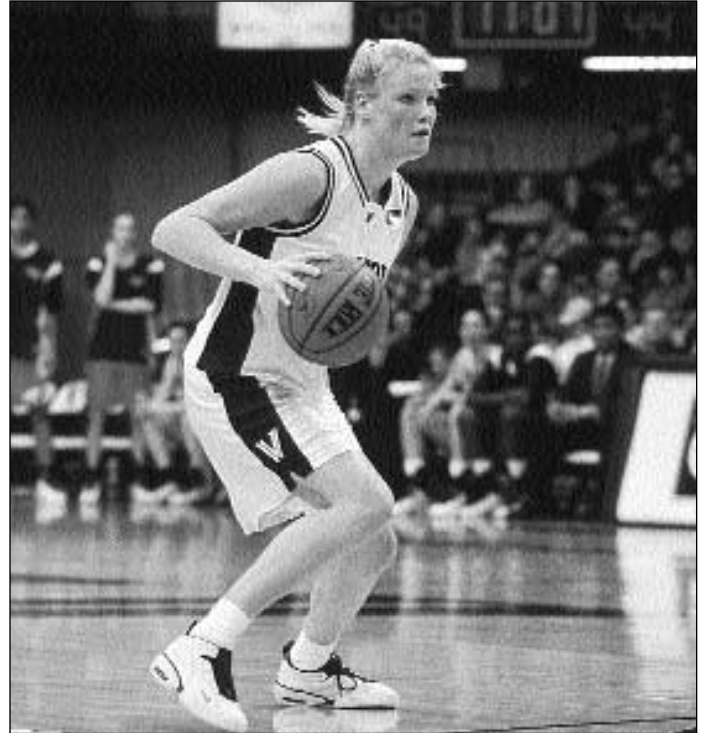

VILLANOVA: Co-captain...Outstanding three-point shooter who possesses good athleticism...Will be one of the team's top performers in 2002-03...Will start at small forward and see playing time at the two-guard spot.

JUNIOR SEASON (2001-02): Started all 29 regular-season games; Averaged 10.5 ppg., 3.8 rpg., 1.7 apg., and a team-leading 1.5 spg., in 31.4 minutes per game...Played 30 minutes at Penn State and scored 15 points on 5-of-6 shooting from three-point range and grabbed two rebounds...Named MVP of Fairfield University Shehan Classic. FRESHMAN SEASON (1999-00): Played in all 29 regular-season games, starting 10 times...Averaged 5.9 ppg., 4.3 rpg., and 1.4 apg., and 1.0 spg., in 22.8 mpg...Scored 18 points and tallied to boards and two assists off the bench in her first collegiate game on Nov. 20 against Penn State...The 18 points is the most by a Villanova women's basketball player in a collegiate debut...Shot six-of-12 from the field, two-of-two from three-point range and four-of-four from the foul line against the Nittany Lions...Registered four points and five rebounds in win over Fairfield...Netted 18 points, seven rebounds and two assists versus Cal State Northridge...Missed her first free throw attempt and then made 12-straight from the foul line against Cal State Northridge...Played just 11 minutes versus Nevada due to illness and tallied three rebounds...Recorded six points, six rebounds and two assists in win at Temple...Registered two points, two rebounds, a steal and a block versus St. Joseph's...Tallied four points, six rebounds, one assist, one block and two steals versus George Washington...Made first career start versus Drexel and had four points, two rebounds, three assists, two blocks and two steals...Logged 28 minutes against Mt. St. Mary's and tallied five points, five rebounds, two assists and a steal...Grabbed a career-high eight rebounds and a tallied a career-best four assists versus Providence...Had best game of her young career versus Penn with a career-high tying 18 points on 7-of-12 shooting (4-of-6 from three-point range) to go with seven

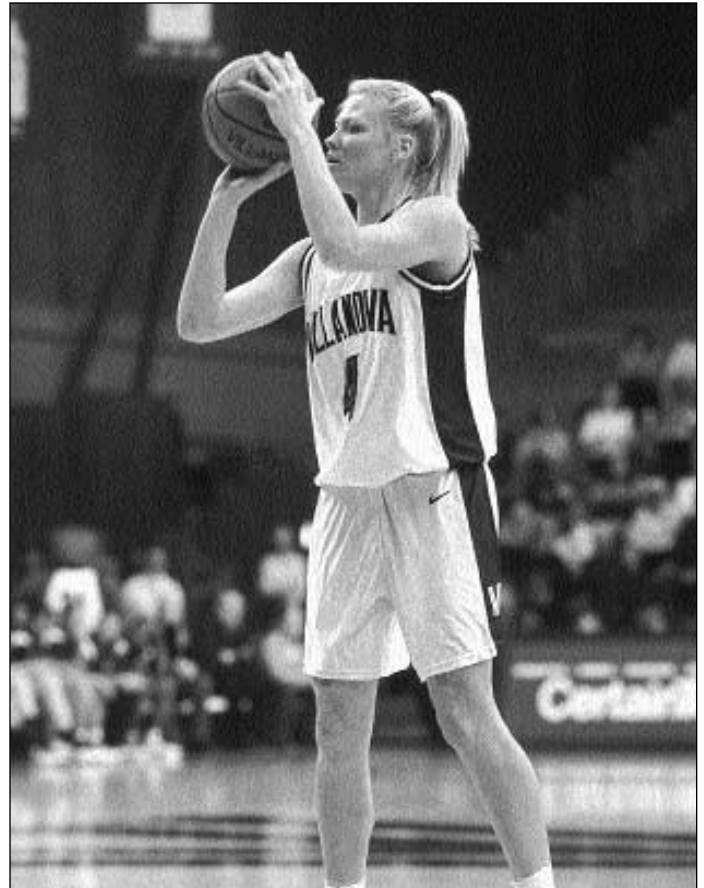

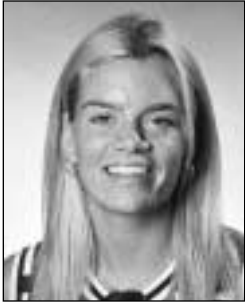

VILLANOVA: Co-captain...Pre-season first team All-Big East selection... Outstanding three-point shooter who plays with great intensity...Tenacious defensive player with good rebounding ability...Enters the season needing 41 three-point field goals in Big East Conference games to set the league record for career triples for just conference games.

JUNIOR SEASON 2001-02: Started 19 of the 24 games she played in; Missed seven games with a broken foot; Named first team All-Big East Conference...Averaged a team-best 13.6 ppg., 3.1 rpg., 2.7 apg. and 1.2 spg., in 31.4 minutes per contest...Scored a game-high 23 points on 9-of-18 shooting from the field and 5-of-9 from three-point range to go with four rebounds, four assists and three steals in win at No. 19 Penn State...Named to the All-Tournament Team of the Fairfield University Shehan Classic. Tallied five points, four rebounds, three assists, two blocks and a steal in the first round versus Quinnipiac. Had 15 points, three assist, two steals and an assist versus Harvard in the championship game...Registered eight points, three assists, two rebounds, two steals and a block in win over LaSalle...Scored nine points on 3-of-7 shooting and 3-of-4 from the foul line to go with four rebounds, two assists and a block in a loss to Temple...Suffered a broken right foot early in the second half in loss to St. Joe's.
