

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

A \$75 administrative charge will be made for cancellations prior to June 1, 2009. The charge is \$35 for day camp cancellations. **AFTER JUNE 1**, tuition refunds, less a \$75 or \$35 administrative fee, will be made for **MEDICAL PURPOSES ONLY**. A **WRITTEN** request by a parent or guardian must be submitted along with a physician's letter of explanation and must be received prior to the start of camp. **REFUNDS WILL NOT BE ISSUED AFTER JUNE 1, 2009, FOR NON-MEDICAL REASONS**. In case of illness or injury during the camp week, pro-rated credits will be issued for the 2010 camp season.

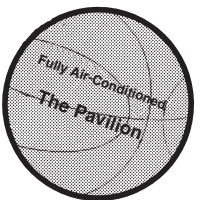

The Villanova University Women's Basketball Staff is proud once again to conduct a girls' basketball camp this summer. We use the fully air conditioned Pavilion, as well as the Jake Nevin Fieldhouse, the Butler Annex, and St. Mary's Gym. We also have outdoor courts that will be used throughout the camps. Also, we have the use of the new home of Villanova Basketball, the Davis Center for Athletics and Fitness. This fully air conditioned facility houses the basketball offices as well as practice facilities for both the men's and women's basketball teams.

Our dormitories are located within a few hundred yards of the Pavilion. Three meals a day will be served each day for our overnight and team campers. All commuter campers will receive lunch and dinner each day, while the day campers will have the option of bringing their lunch daily or going to the cafeteria for lunch.

Once again, we will run an offensive skills camp, an overnight and commuter camp, day camp, and a high school team camp. Our day camps are for girls entering 2nd through 8th grade. Anyone entering high school is not eligible to attend the day camp. Our high school team camp is open to teams entering 7th through 12th grade. The teams attend as a group and play together throughout the camp. The offensive skills, overnight, and commuter camps are for anyone entering 2nd through 12th grade.

CAMP PROGRAMS

OFFENSIVE SKILLS CAMP: This camp will run from 6:00 – 8:00 pm on Tuesday, June 23rd through Thursday, June 25th, 2009. This camp is for anyone entering 2nd through 12th grade. This camp will focus on shooting, passing, ball handling, movement without the ball, and one-on-one moves. Each camper will receive a camp t-shirt and basketball.

OVERNIGHT CAMP: This camp will begin on Saturday, July 11th, 2009. The camp is for anyone entering 2nd through 12th grade. Camper registration will begin at 2:00 pm, followed by team organization and dinner. After dinner, league play and camp drills will begin. Sunday and Monday, camp will run from 9:00 am to approximately 9:00 pm. All campers will receive three meals a day as well as housing in the Villanova dorms. The camp will end on Tuesday, July 14th, 2009 at approximately 11:30 am, following an awards ceremony. All campers will receive a camp t-shirt and basketball.

COMMUTER CAMP: This camp will begin on Saturday, July 11th, 2009. This camp is for anyone entering 2nd through 12th grade. Each commuter camper will receive dinner on Saturday, and lunch and dinner on Sunday and Monday. All facets of the commuter session are exactly the same as the overnight camp. The only difference between the two camps is the commuter camper does not stay overnight in the Villanova dorms. All campers will receive a camp t-shirt and basketball.

HIGH SCHOOL TEAM CAMP: This camp is for any team with players entering 7th through 12th grade. These teams (minimum of 8 players) sign up as a group and stay together for all camp activities. The team camp will be held from Friday, July 24th to Monday, July 27th, 2009. There is a special discount for teams. Please refer to the rates and tuition section of this brochure for these special rates. It is recommended that one of the coaches from each school works with their team while at camp. This gives the coach a head start on the high school season. If the coach is not available, or if a high school league does not allow this, then the camp will assign a counselor to work with the team. This team camp is very popular so we urge all schools to look into this as soon as possible. The team camp is limited to the first thirty-two teams that register.

DAY CAMP: Session I will run from Monday, July 13th through Friday, July 17th, 2009. Session II will run from Monday, July 20th through Friday, July 24th, 2009. These camps are for anyone entering 2nd through 8th grade. The camp will run from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm each day. All campers will have the option of bringing their lunch each day or going to the cafeteria for lunch. Please refer to the rates and tuition section for the cost of this lunch program. The camp will end on Friday at approximately 2:00 pm, following an awards ceremony. All campers will receive a camp t-shirt and basketball.

RATES & TUITION

MULTIPLE CAMP DISCOUNT: If a camper attends more than one camp, they may take \$25 off the enrollment fee of the second camp.

However, full tuition must be sent with the application if enrolling after May 15, 2009. Each applicant will receive a confirmation letter after they have registered. This letter will inform them of what time to arrive at camp, what to bring, the time of departure, and directions.
