UPDATED PLAYER NOTES

Below are updated notes on some of the Villanova players. The starters listed are based on the starting lineup for the previous game and do not necessarily suggest the lineup for the current game.

Last Game's Starters

GK - #1 Jillian Loyden (Sr., 5-10, Vineland, N.J./Vineland High School)

Holds school record for victories (47), shutouts (36) and minutes (7,362:04); 12th in NCAA record book in minutes played; Played 93.7 percent of team's minutes in net; 1731:41, 0.52 GAA, .888 save pct, 11 solo shutouts; Hermann Trophy Watch List; Soccer America Preseason All-American; BIG EAST Preseason Goalkeeper of the Year

D - #23 Kayce Blandford (Sr., 5-7, Columbia, Md./Notre Dame Prep)

Starting right-side defender; Has been a starter all four years; One of the most unheralded players in the nation for her contributions to Villanova back line; Takes nearly all of the team's corner kicks, as well as throw-ins along the right side; Second on the team with four assists; Has scored one goal; Named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week (9/3)

D - #24 Kelly Eagan (Fr., 5-6, St. James, N.Y./Smithtown)

One of the top central defenders in the nation; All-America Candidate; Preseason All-BIG EAST Team; Has scored two goals, both game-winners in victories over Virginia Commonwealth (3-0) and Georgetown (1-0); BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week (9/24); Top Drawer Soccer Division I Player of the Week (9/24); Soccer Buzz Magazine Elite Feet Team of the Week (9/24); All four career goals have been game-winners, including three in 1-0 victories; BIG EAST Honor Roll (10/29)

D - #16 Laura Sylvester (Jr., 5-10, Broomall, Pa./Marple Newtown High School)

Has played some of the best soccer of her career during the second half of season; Started all 19 games for the team at central defender; One of the best on the team at clearing balls out of dangerous positions; Possesses the ability to jumpstart the attack when needed; Has a strong foot and has come into her own this season

D - #19 Jenna Gordon (Sr., 5-3, White Plains, N.Y./White Plains High School)

Starting left-side defender; Missed six games earlier in the season with a minor injury; Has returned to top form; Biggest strength is her speed; Can take a ball away from any opponent; Handles majority of the throw-ins along the left side; Had one of the best games of her career in win over Louisville; One assist on season.

M - #21 Melissa Murowski (Sr., 5-2, Warren, N.J./Watchung Hills Regional High School)

The heart and soul of the team; Sets an example with her spirit and work ethic both on and off the field; One of the most critical players to the Villanova team for her role of linking the back line to the front line; Helps out the defensive unit in key situations; Also used to jumpstart team's attack; Has one assist on the year

M - #2 Erin Hardiman (Jr., 5-7, Galloway, N.J./Absegami High School)

Coming into her own in third collegiate season; Owns two goals and three assists for seven points on the year; Completely ambidextrous; One of the team's best play-makers and most dangerous strikers; At her best when leading the attack from her defensive midfield position; Assisted on game-winning goal in win over Louisville

M - #3 Jessica Carnevale (So., 5-4, Princeton, N.J./West-Windsor Plainsboro High School)

One of the pleasant surprises on the Wildcats this season; Has improved from a steady freshman season to become one of the team's most potent midfielders; Has a knack for finding the back of the net; Fearless player on the ball with great vision of the entire field; Tenacious player; Has two goals, two assists and six points

M - #5 Kaley Guthrie (Sr., 5-7, Ogdensburg, N.J./Pope John XXIII)

Like classmate Stacia Hartung, is playing some of the best soccer of her career; Also one of the reasons for the switch to a 4-3-3 alignment; Has made five of her 15 starts at forward this season; Has three goals and two assists for eight points; Scored the game-tying goal against Seton Hall for her first career goal against a conference opponent; Possesses outstanding footwork and knowledge of the game

F - #11 Erin Byrnes (So., 5-8, Sayville, N.Y./Sayville)

Scored game-winning goal in 108th minute in win over Louisville; Tied for team lead with 13 points (four goals, five assists); Had three goals, three assists and nine points against St. Peters; Named BIG EAST and ECAC Offensive Player of the Week for that performance, which is tied for the most points in a game in the nation this season; Technical skills are among the best on the team; Quick player who is capable of being one of the top scorers in the BIG EAST; Leads the team with five assists on the season; The game-winning goal against Louisville was the third of her career and first this season

F - #15 Stacia Hartung (Sr., 5-7, Rochester, N.Y./Greece Olympia)

Having an outstanding senior season and is one of the reasons Villanova will at times switch to a 4-3-3 alignment with three forwards up top; Leads the team with three game-winning goals, including the lone score in win over Cincinnati; Tied for the team lead with five goals this season after scoring two her freshman year and none her sophomore and junior seasons; One of the team's leading attackers and playmakers; Has made 12 of her 17 starts at forward and five at midfield.

Other Key Players

M/F - #9 Justine Wollner (Fr., 5-7, Downingtown, Pa./Downingtown East)

Has quickly developed into one of the team's top midfielders; Can play forward when needed; Speedy player with good control of the ball; Has three goals and two assists for eight points; Registered two goals and one assist in win over St. Peters; Has earned three starts during the season

F - #10 Nicole Coia (Jr., 5-5, Simpsonville, S.C./St. Joseph's)

Top reserve and critical player for the team who has come off the bench in 14 of 18 games this season; Aggressive as a holding forward and tends to make her biggest impact soon after being inserted into games; Has scored one goal, which was the game-winner in 1-0 victory over Temple; Assisted on the game-winning goals in wins over Robert Morris and St. Peters

F - #13 Rachel Schuyler (Fr., 5-4, Cheshire, Conn./Cheshire)

WEEKLY NOTEBOOK

(November 1, 2007)

Postseason Bound: With victories over Louisville and Cincinnati in the final two games of the regular season, Villanova clinched a spot in the BIG EAST Championship for the seventh consecutive season. The Wildcats had their backs against the wall entering the final weekend of play but won both of their games by 1-0 scores to finish as the #4 seed in the National Division. Villanova has now qualified for the Big East Tournament 13 times in the 15 years the event has been held.

Continued Success: The win over Cincinnati this past Sunday was the 10th of the season for Villanova, which is already guaranteed to finish the season with a winning record. This will mark the ninth consecutive season that the Wildcats have had a winning record with at least 10 victories, and the 17th time in the program's 25-year varsity history. The current streak of seasons with a winning record and at least 10 victories began with the start of the 1999 season and Villanova owns an overall record of 117-47-27 (.683).

Making Something Out of Nothing: Through the first 19 games of the season the Wildcats have posted 13 shutouts, which is tied for the most in the entire nation this season. Only Virginia (13 shutouts in 17 games) has as many shutouts as Villanova does. The Wildcats have a team goals-against average of 0.49 which ranks seventh in the nation, while their shutout percentage is second best in the country. Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** has posted 11 solo shutouts this season and shared in two other efforts. In her career, Loyden has 36 solo shutouts and the team has a total of 43 shutouts in 83 games.

Loyden and Eagan Earn National and BIG EAST Recognition: Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was named to the Top Drawer Soccer National Team of the Week and sophomore defender **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** earned a spot on the Soccer Buzz Magazine Elite Feet Team of the Week, it was announced on Wednesday. The two players were instrumental in helping Villanova post 1-0 victories over Louisville and Cincinnati in the final two games of the regular season. The pair were also each named to this week's BIG EAST Honor Roll for their performances.

This week marks the third time this season that Loyden and Eagan have earned conference honors. Loyden has been named to the honor roll three times and Eagan twice. She was also named BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week on September 24.

Scoring First a Recipe For Success: A remarkable streak for the Wildcats reached and surpassed the century mark in last weekend's victories over Louisville and Cincinnati. Villanova posted 1-0 victories in each game to improve to 10-0 this season when it scores the first goal of a game. Scoring first has been an unbeatable formula for the Wildcats for the last nine years, as the team is unbeaten its last 101 games when it scores the first goal. Since November 13, 1999, Villanova owns a record of 96-0-5 (.975) when scoring first. The last loss for the Wildcats when scoring the first goal came to Boston College by a 2-1 score on November 2, 1999. Overall, Villanova is 120-3-7 (.950) under 11th year head coach Ann Clifton when it scores the first goal of a game. On the flip side of this stat, when the opponent scores the first goal, the Wildcats are just 13-58-9 (.219) since the beginning of the 1997 season.

Hartung Nets Game-Winner: In Sunday's 1-0 win over Cincinnati, senior **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)** scored the game-winning goal in the 31st minute of the contest. It was the fourth career game-winner and third this season for Hartung, who is enjoying an outstanding senior season. Hartung is tied for the team lead with five goals on the year and her three game-winners are the most on the team. Entering this season, Hartung had scored just two career goals, both of which came in her freshman season. As the Wildcats prepare for the start of postseason play, Hartung has career totals of seven goals, 10 assists and 24 points in her career.

Wildcats Rank Among Nation's Best: Through games of Sunday, October 28, Villanova ranks as a team near the top of several NCAA statistical categories. The Wildcats currently rank second in the country in shutout percentage, with 13 shutouts in 19 games (.684 percentage). In addition, Villanova ranks seventh in the country in goals-against average (0.485) and save percentage (.895).

Individually, senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** ranks among the best goalkeepers nationwide for the fourth straight season. Loyden currently ranks 10th in save percentage (.888) and 11th in goals-against average (0.52).

Division Success: When the BIG EAST Conference expanded to 16 teams before the 2005 season, the conference realigned to two divisions. Each league team plays an 11-game conference schedule, including one game against each of the seven teams in its own division and one game against four of the eight teams from the opposite division. This season the Wildcats had a 4-3-4 overall BIG EAST record, including a 4-1-2 mark against other teams from the National Division. Over the past three seasons, Villanova owns a record of 14-3-4 (.762) against teams from its division. The three losses have all come to Notre Dame. In fact, aside from a 1-14 all-time record against perennial national contender Notre Dame, the Wildcats combined all-time record against the other teams in its division is 35-16-10 (.656).

So Many Minutes: Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** has made a rapid move up the list of career minutes played in the NCAA record book. Entering Thursday's BIG EAST first round game against USF, Loyden has played 7,362:04 minutes in goal. That figure ranks 12th in NCAA history and Loyden needs to play just 137:56 more in the net to become the 10th player ever to reach 7,500 career minutes.

Shutout Story: With one more solo shutout, senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** will tie for second place all-time among Big East goalkeepers with 37 career shutouts. That would tie her with Lana Bannerman (2003-06) of West Virginia and put her behind only Bonnie Mitchell (1984-87) of Connecticut. Mitchell had 41.5 shutouts in her career, during a time when both solo and shared shutouts were counted in a player's record.

Creating Corners: During the regular season the Wildcats consistently were able to create offensive chances by drawing corner kicks. Villanova has taken 128 corner kicks this season for an average of 6.7 per game. Meanwhile, the Wildcats have limited the opposition to a mere 46 corner kicks for the year, an average of just 2.4 per game. In regular season BIG EAST games only, Villanova owned an edge of 66-36 in corner kick opportunities.

There have been four games this season in which the Wildcats did not allow the opposing team a single corner kick. Those contests were against Robert Morris, St. Peter's, Marquette and Cincinnati. Early in the season, Villanova produced a stretch of 225 minutes without allowing a corner kick.

In its game against Robert Morris on September 9, Villanova set a school record with 19 corners. That came within three of tying the NCAA single-game mark of 22, set by North Carolina State against Chowan in 1995. Additionally, the Wildcats had 15 corner kicks against Seton Hall on September 30, a total that was just one away from tying the single-game record for a BIG EAST Conference game.

Clifton's Cats: Villanova head coach **Ann Clifton** is currently in her 11th year at the school and is one of just four head coaches in program history. Clifton enters today's game with a record of 134-64-31 (.653) with the Wildcats and has led the team to the only five NCAA Tournament berths in program history. Villanova has posted at least a .500 record in every one of Clifton's seasons, including nine consecutive years with at least a .500 record and at least 10 wins. The team's longest run of success started in 2001, and since the beginning of that season Villanova has an overall record of 92-31-27 (.703).

NEWS AND NOTES

2007 Season

August 8 - Loyden Named to Preseason Watch List for Hermann Trophy

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was one of 46 players named by the NSCAA as initial candidates for the prestigious Missouri Athletic Club Hermann Trophy. The award is presented each year to the top women's and men's soccer player in the nation. The list will be trimmed to 15 semifinalists in November and then three finalists will be chosen in December in conjunction with the NCAA Women's Soccer College Cup.

"It is very impressive for Jillian to receive this accolade," Villanova head coach Ann Clifton said. "It is a prestigious honor for our program to have a player chosen as one of the top players in the country."

Loyden is a two-time BIG EAST Goalkeeper of the Year and last season became the first player in program history to earn first team All-America honors. Loyden has started every game of her collegiate career and currently owns a 0.68 career goals-against average. She is the Villanova all-time leader in victories, shutouts and minutes played, while ranking second in winning percentage, save percentage and goals-against average.

August 9 - Loyden and Egan Earn Preseason All-BIG EAST Honors

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was named the BIG EAST Preseason Goalkeeper of the Year, while she and sophomore defender **Kelly Egan (St. James, N.Y.)** each earned a spot on the league's preseason All-BIG EAST team.

Loyden has been named the BIG EAST Goalkeeper of the Year in each of the past two seasons and was a first team All-America choice in 2006. Meanwhile, Egan became the first freshman in team history to be named a first team All-BIG EAST selection a year ago, and was a finalist for Soccer Buzz Freshman of the Year honors.

August 16 - Wildcat Players Excel in Club and Youth Team Championships

During the summer season several Villanova players excelled in competition with their club and youth league teams. Three players advanced to national championship games in their respective leagues and two won national titles.

Freshman **Lindsey Haroutunian (Bloomfield Hills, Mich.)** played for the Bloomfield Force team that captured the Francis J. "Frank" Kelly Cup and won the US Youth Soccer National Championship in the U-18 Girls division in Frisco, Texas.

Sophomore **Samantha Moskal (Chantilly, Va.)** also traveled to Texas and reached a USYS national title game with her team, the PWSI Cardinals. The team advanced to the national championship in the U-19 division. Moskal was a starting defender for the Cardinals, who captured a Region 1 championship on the way to reaching nationals.

Sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)** won a national championship in the Super-20 League with her Parsippany (N.J.) Gazelles team. In Epping, N.H., the Gazelles won the title game 1-0 against Quickstrike FC (Newburgh, N.Y.) to avenge a loss to the Washington Freedom in the national tournament the year before. The Gazelles and Quickstrike had split two meetings during the season before Parsippany claimed the third meeting in the national championship game.

August 21 - Villanova Defeats North Carolina State in Exhibition Game

In its only preseason exhibition game, Villanova defeated North Carolina State 1-0 in a game played on the turf at nearby Eastern University due to a steady rainfall in the area. The game was scoreless for the first 87 minutes until senior **Kayce Blandford (Columbia, Md.)** scored with less than three minutes left. Blandford sent a ball in from the right side on a corner kick and the ball was never touched before settling into the goal. Villanova outshot the Wolfpack 14-7 in the game.

August 30 - Soccer America Announces Preseason All-America Team

An already impressive list of accolades for senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** grew by one item, as the Wildcat standout was chosen to the Preseason All-America team by Soccer America. Last season, Loyden was the first player in program history to earn NSCAA First Team All-America honors.

September 3 - Blandford Named BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week

Through the first two games of the season, Villanova posted a pair of 3-0 shutout wins against Lafayette and Virginia Commonwealth in its own home tournament. Senior **Kayce Blandford (Columbia, Md.)**, the team's starting right back, was a key part of the defensive effort that led to two shutouts and also was the team's leading point scorer. Blandford helped lead a back line that allowed only five total shots on goal in the two games. Offensively, she scored a goal and dished out two assists to lead the team with four points. Blandford was named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week for the second time in her career and first time since 2005.

September 7 - Family Ties All Around as Wildcats Visited Princeton

When Villanova traveled up Route 1 to take on Princeton on September 7, it was a familiar route for junior midfielder **Kristen Verbit (Newtown, Pa.)**. Verbit's father, Steve, is the defensive coordinator for the Princeton football team and has been a coach for the team for more than 20 years. Verbit recalled spending a lot of time on the campus while growing up and looked forward to playing a game there for the first time in her collegiate career. Making the experience even more meaningful is that the game was played in the Princeton football stadium due to renovations taking place on the soccer field.

The game featured a crowd several hundred strong that was nearly unanimous in support of the Wildcats. In addition to Verbit's connection to the school, Villanova sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)** is from Princeton and attended nearby West Windsor-Plainsboro High School. Verbit and Carnevale, in addition to the team's other four players from the state of New Jersey, had family and friends in attendance to root for Villanova. The Wildcats and Princeton wound up playing to a scoreless tie.

September 10 - Mabery Receives Spot on Weekly Honor Roll

After scoring all three team goals in a 3-1 victory over Robert Morris, senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** was named to the weekly BIG EAST Honor Roll for the first time this season. Mabery registered her second career hat trick in the game, including scoring the game's first two goals just 24 seconds apart. Her other career hat trick also came against Robert Morris, as she scored the first three goals of the game in a 5-0 victory last season.

Mabery had been the only Villanova player in the last five years to have a hat trick in a game until sophomore **Erin Byrnes (Sayville, N.Y.)** had three goals in a win over St. Peter's on September 11.

2007 Season

September 16 - Wildcats Celebrate First Annual Alumnae Day

On Sunday, September 16, in conjunction with that day's game against Temple, the Villanova women's soccer team celebrated its first annual Alumnae Day. Following the game a reception was held on campus for the former players and their families who were in attendance. The current team, coaches and staff from the athletic department joined in the celebration, which was a huge success. Villanova began its women's soccer program as a club sport in 1976 and the team elevated to varsity status in 1983. In its 25 years as a varsity sport, the program has registered 17 winning seasons, 17 years with at least 10 victories and eight postseason tournament appearances (five NCAA berths, three ECAC bids).

September 17 - Byrnes Rewarded After Career Day against St. Peter's

For the first time in five years, a Villanova player received BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Week honors. It took a special day from sophomore **Erin Byrnes (Sayville, N.Y.)** for the Wildcat forward to earn the award. In an 11-0 win over St. Peter's, Byrnes tallied a career-high nine points with three goals and three assists in the blowout win. She came off the bench to score once late in the first half and twice in the second half to register her first career hat trick. Byrnes was also named the ECAC Offensive Player of the Week for her efforts.

The nine points remain tied for the most by a player in a single game this season. That total also represents 69 percent of Byrnes point output for the season. She has tallied five other points on one goal and two assists in all her other games this season. Byrnes scored the game-winning goal in the win over Louisville.

September 21 - Loyden Sets Career Shutout Record

When senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** took over in goal for Villanova in 2004, big things were expected of her. In fact, she redshirted her true freshman season in 2003 so that she would have four years of eligibility once she took over in a starting role. All she has done in her time with the Wildcats is post more career games in which she has not allowed a goal (44) than games in which she has (36). With a 1-0 victory over Georgetown on September 21, Loyden posted her 30th career solo shutout to set a new Villanova career record. She surpassed the mark of 29 shutouts held by Chrissy Dolan (2000-03) and currently has 36 career solo shutouts to her credit. Loyden is the current BIG EAST leader in career solo shutouts and is moving up the all-time list of shutouts by BIG EAST goalkeepers.

September 21 - The .600 Club

The current run of success for the Villanova women's soccer team, which began with the program's first-ever NCAA appearance in 2001, is without question the longest and most significant in the program's history. However, success on the field is nothing new for the team, which has enjoyed 16 winning seasons and 16 years with at least 10 victories in its first 24 seasons as a varsity sport (since 1983).

On September 21 the Wildcats defeated Georgetown 1-0 for their sixth win of the season, and improved the overall program record to 265-169-49. That marked a winning percentage of **.600** in program history and at the time made Villanova one of just five BIG EAST programs with an all-time record of at least .600.

Entering play this week, the Wildcats own an all-time record of 269-172-53 and are at **.598** for an all-time winning percentage. Since the arrival of head coach **Ann Clifton** in 1997, Villanova's record is 134-64-31 (.653).

September 24 - Eagan Receives Player of the Week Honors

After the Wildcats posted a pair of shutout wins over Georgetown and Penn, sophomore defender **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** received numerous weekly awards for her play in the two games. Eagan was named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week and was chosen to the Soccer Buzz Magazine Elite Feet Team of the Week, while also being named the Top Drawer Soccer Division I Player of the Week.

Eagan scored her fourth career game-winning goal to account for the lone score in a 1-0 victory over Georgetown in the conference opener on September 21. She also led a defensive effort that allowed just nine total shots on goal in the two games.

In addition to the recognition for Eagan, senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was also named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll. It was an outstanding week for Loyden, who set a new school record for career shutouts with her 30th in the win over Georgetown. Against Penn, Loyden added to her new record with another shutout and also recorded her second career point when she assisted on the final goal of the game.

October 1 - Eagan Continues Steady Play

Sophomore defender **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** was named to the weekly honor roll by the BIG EAST Conference. Eagan continued her stellar defensive play in the two games last week, as she helped the Wildcats extend their shutout defensive streak to more than 487 minutes before a goal by Seton Hall in the second half of Sunday's game. Eagan marked highly-regarded forwards from Rutgers and Seton Hall in the two games while also being involved in every one of the team's offensive set pieces.

October 19 - Wildcats Have EPYSA Day at Game against Pittsburgh

Villanova celebrated the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association at its game against Pittsburgh on October 19. Although torrential rain before the game washed out a pregame and halftime promotion, the Wildcats still were joined at the game by the Marple Newtown Crush. This was the second time this season that Villanova has hosted local youth teams at a home game at the West Campus Soccer Complex.

October 23 - Second NCAA RPI Report Released

The second Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) report of the season was released by the NCAA on October 23. Villanova came in at No. 78 in the second report after being ranked No. 55 in the first RPI release. The NCAA calculates the RPI several times during the regular season and for the final time just before the NCAA Tournament.

The RPI is one of many indicators used by the NCAA during the selection process for the NCAA Tournament. Villanova is currently 4-3-3 against teams ranked in the top 100 of the RPI, including wins over No. 28 Louisville, No. 51 Georgetown and No. 59 Penn.

While the RPI takes into account a team's winning percentage, strength of schedule and opponents' strength of schedule, the first report of the season does tend to be strongly weighted to each team's actual winning percentage. The three factors then balance out in the remainder of the reports during the season.

October 29 - Loyden and Eagan Earn National and BIG EAST Honors

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was named to the Top Drawer Soccer National Team of the Week and sophomore defender **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** earned a spot on the Soccer Buzz Magazine Elite Feet Team of the Week, it was announced on Wednesday. The two players were instrumental in helping Villanova post 1-0 victories over Louisville and Cincinnati in the final two games of the regular season. The pair were also each named to this week's BIG EAST Honor Roll for their performances.

Game 1: Villanova 3, Lafayette 0

August 31 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior midfielder **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)** scored her third career goal in the game and the first since her freshman season. After the first game of the year, Hartung has three career goals and nine assists for 15 points. She missed part of her sophomore season due to an injury suffered midway through the year.

Villanova is 12-11-2 in season openers, including 7-6 in season openers at home. Since the arrival of head coach Ann Clifton in 1997, the Wildcats are 8-3-0 in season openers, including 6-0-0 at home. Villanova has won its season opener each year since 2001 and the streak of seven straight victories is a program best. The Wildcats have now opened the season with a shutout win in three straight seasons.

The Wildcats lead the all-time series with Lafayette by a 5-0-0 count, although this year's meeting was the first since 1993. Villanova has outscored the Leopards by a 24-3 margin in the five meetings.

The game marked the first time since 2003 that Villanova had no freshmen in the opening game starting lineup. Head coach **Ann Clifton** has seven seniors on her roster this season, which is the most since her initial Wildcat squad in 1997. All seven seniors were in the starting lineup for the game along with three juniors and one sophomore.

Game 2: Villanova 3, Virginia Commonwealth 0

September 2 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** earned her 40th career win in today's game to set a new career record at Villanova. The old record of 39 was set by Janel Schillig (1998-01).

Villanova showed off its improved depth in its first two games of the season, as all six of the teams goals were scored by a different player.

Sophomore **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** registered her third career goal in the game. It was also the third career game-winning goal for Eagan, who twice last season had the only goal in 1-0 Wildcat victories.

The Wildcats have an all-time record of 37-32-5 (.534) during regular season tournament play. That includes a 17-6-1 (.729) mark under head coach **Ann Clifton** and a 9-1 (.900) record in regular season tournament homes games. The only loss for Villanova in a home regular season tournament game came to Holy Cross on October 11, 1986 (lost 4-2).

Game 3: Villanova 0, Princeton 0

September 7 ~ Princeton, N.J.

Since **Ann Clifton** became head coach in 1997, the Wildcats are 5-5-6 in games played in the state of New Jersey.

Villanova is also 10-3-3 (.719) against teams from the Ivy League since 1997.

Game 4: Villanova 3, Robert Morris 1

September 9 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** recorded her second career hat trick by scoring all three Villanova goals in the game. Her other hat trick also came against Robert Morris, in a 5-0 win last season.

The goal by Robert Morris in the 27th minute ended the Wildcats shutout streak to start the season at 316:37. Villanova had posted shutouts in its first three games. The last time the Wildcats had a longer shutout streak to start a season was in 2003, when the team posted four straight shutouts to start the year and did not allow a goal for the first 378:01 of play.

Villanova set a school record by taking 19 corner kicks in the game. That came close to the NCAA record for a single game. The record is 22, set 12 years ago on September 7, 1995 by UNC-Wilmington against Chowan.

Game 5: Villanova 11, St. Peter's 0

September 11 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Villanova scored double-digit goals for the sixth time in team history and the first since an 11-0 win over Howard on October 27, 2002. The school record for goals in a game is 13, set against La Salle on September 17, 1986.

Sophomore **Erin Byrnes (Sayville, N.Y.)** scored a career-high nine points by notching three goals and three assists in the game. She had registered only one point on an assist through the first four games before totaling the nine points in this game. Byrnes came off the bench to score once late in the first half and then added the first two goals of the second half. It was the first career hat trick for Byrnes, who scored five goals and had one assist as a freshman last season.

UPDATE #1 (10/26): Byrnes and senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** are the only Villanova players to record a hat trick in the last five years, since Janessa Jeltema did it against Howard in an 11-0 win on October 27, 2002. Mabery's two career hat tricks came both came against Robert Morris in games played last season and this season.

UPDATE #2 (10/26): The 11 goals scored by Villanova and the nine points for Byrnes are tied for the most in the nation by a team or a player in a single game this season.

Freshman **Justine Wollner (Downingtown, Pa.)** scored the first two goals of her collegiate career. Wollner had previously recorded her first career point with an assist in a 3-1 victory over Robert Morris. Freshman **Rachel Schuyler (Cheshire, Conn.)** also recorded the first goal of her collegiate career.

The two goals for senior **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)** made this game the first multi-goal game of her collegiate career. It was the second career game with multiple goals for sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)**, who scored both goals in a 2-0 victory over Pittsburgh last season.

Game 6: Villanova 1, Lehigh 1

September 14 ~ Bethlehem, Pa.

Villanova allowed the opposition to score the first goal of the game for the first time this season. However, the Wildcats tied the game late in regulation and ended a streak of five straight losses in games where the opponent scored first. The stretch of five losses dated to the end of the 2005 season.

Although Villanova is 6-1-1 all-time against Lehigh, it is just 0-1-1 in the last two meetings. The Mountain Hawks defeated the Wildcats for the first time ever in 2005, winning 1-0 at the West Campus Soccer Complex.

Game 7: Villanova 1, Temple 0

September 16 ~ Villanova, Pa.

The Wildcats are 34-2-4 (.900) all-time against other Philadelphia Big Five teams. The losses came to La Salle in 2000 and Saint Joseph's in 2005.

Villanova celebrated its First Annual Alumnae Day with a reception after the game for the many former players who were in attendance. The University first fielded a women's soccer team as a club sport in 1976, and the program elevated to varsity status in 1983.

Game 8: Villanova 1, Georgetown 0

September 21 ~ Washington, D.C.

Villanova is 5-0-1 in its first BIG EAST game since 2002 and have now opened conference play against Georgetown in each of the last three seasons. Villanova claimed a 2-0 victory against the Hoyas last season at the West Campus Soccer Complex after playing to a 1-1 tie in 2005 at North Kehoe Field.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** set the Villanova career shutout record with her 30th career shutout in today's game. Loyden surpassed the mark of 29 shutouts held by Chrissy Dolan (2000-03).

Sophomore **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** scored her fourth career goal and fourth career game-winner in the game. Three of her four goals have come late in the second half of 1-0 Villanova victories to account for the game's lone score.

The goal in the 72nd minute of today's game was the latest in a game the first goal has been scored by the Wildcats or their opposition this season.

Game 9: Villanova 4, Penn 0

September 23 ~ Villanova, Pa.

The shutout in the game was the 100th for the Wildcats since the arrival of head coach **Ann Clifton** in 1997. The 100 shutouts in that time period rank fourth among all BIG EAST schools. Only Notre Dame, Connecticut and Marquette have had at least 100 shutouts since 1997.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** registered her second career point with an assist on the final goal of the game. Her long punt down field was played by sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)** and then kicked into the left side of the net by senior **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)**. Loyden also had an assist on a goal in a 5-0 win over Robert Morris last season.

Senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** scored her 29th career goal in the game and moved into sole possession of fifth place on the school's career list.

Villanova is 35-2-4 (.902) all-time against other Philadelphia Big Five schools.

Game 10: Villanova 0, Rutgers 0

September 28 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Villanova played to its second scoreless tie of the year, with the other coming against Princeton earlier in the month. The last time the Wildcats had more than two scoreless ties in a season came in 2003, when the team set an NCAA record with four scoreless ties. Two of those games came in the NCAA Tournament against Virginia and BYU. The mark of four scoreless ties in a season has since been tied by Michigan, in 2006.

Wildcat senior **Kaley Guthrie (Ogdensburg, N.J.)** played against her sister Erin, the goalkeeper for Rutgers, for the second time in their collegiate careers. The sisters first went against each other last season when the Wildcats and Scarlet Knights played to a 1-1 tie.

Villanova posted its fourth consecutive shutout in the game.

Game 11: Villanova 1, Seton Hall 1

September 30 ~ South Orange, N.J.

The Seton Hall goal marked the first time the Pirates have scored against the Wildcats since 2002. Villanova had posted four straight 1-0 victories (including two in overtime) each year between 2003-06. Seton Hall had not scored on the Wildcats in nearly 464 minutes of play.

The Wildcats also saw a shutout streak of 487:14 end with the Pirates goal. Villanova was last scored on by Lehigh in the second half of its sixth game of the season. The Wildcats had posted four straight shutouts since then.

The 1-1 tie with Lehigh was the only other time this season that Villanova saw the opposition net the first goal of the game. Since 1997, the Wildcats are just 13-58-9 (.219) when the opponent scores the first goal.

Villanova had 15 corner kicks in the game to come close to matching the league record for a conference game. The BIG EAST record for corner kicks in a conference game is 16, set by Notre Dame against Seton Hall on October 24, 1997.

Game 12: Marquette 1, Villanova 0

October 5 ~ Milwaukee, Wisc.

For the third time during the season, senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** broke a school career record when she surpassed the record for minutes played held by Janel Schillig (1998-01). Through the end of the game, Loyden had played 6,687:25 in goal to surpass Schillig's mark of 6,684:21. Loyden has already set program records for victories and shutouts this season.

The 11-game unbeaten streak that ended with the loss matched the second-longest in team history. The streak was similar to one which began the 2006 season, in which the Wildcats went 13-0-2 to start the season. That 15-game streak was a program record and also featured a team-best 10-game winning streak to start the season.

The other 11-game unbeaten streak in the team's history came during the middle of the 2002 season, during a stretch in which Villanova went 9-0-2. That year, the Wildcats finished the season with a 14-2-5 record and made what was the second of four straight NCAA Tournament appearances.

Game 13: Villanova 0, University of South Florida 0

October 7 ~ Tampa, Fla.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** tied her season high with eight saves in the game.

Villanova posted a shutout for the 11th time in its last 16 regular season BIG EAST games, dating back to the beginning of last season. The Wildcats have permitted only two goals to the opposition through the first five conference games of the season.

The scoreless tie marked the third for Villanova this season. The team record for 0-0 ties in a season is four, which came during the 2003 season. Four scoreless ties in a season also matches the NCAA record.

Villanova matched a program single-season high with its fifth tie of the season. The Wildcats had five ties in consecutive seasons in 2002 (14-2-5) and 2003 (15-5-5).

Game 14: Villanova 1, DePaul 0

October 12 ~ Chicago, Ill.

The Villanova goal scored by freshman **Patty Tierney (Churchville, Pa.)** at the 58:23 mark of the game ended a scoreless streak of 315:40 for the Wildcats. The team's last goal came early in the second half against Seton Hall. This was the longest scoreless streak for the Wildcats since 2004, when Villanova did not score in a span of 370:42 across five games

The Wildcats have posted 10 shutouts in 14 games this season and have a team goals-against average of 0.26.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** moved into a tie for third place all-time in the Big East with 34 career solo shutouts. She is tied with Michelle Lodyga (Notre Dame, 1989-92) and Saskia Webber (Rutgers, 1989-92). Next up is West Virginia's Lana Bannerman (2003-06) with 37 shutouts.

Game 15: Notre Dame 5, Villanova 0

October 14 ~ South Bend, Ind.

Villanova allowed multiple goals in a game for the first time this season.

After allowing two first-half goals, the Wildcats came out with a fury at the start of the second half and were even in shots for the second period against the Fighting Irish. Villanova took 13 shots in the second half after being credited with just one in the opening 45 minutes.

The score remained 2-0 until the closing minutes of the game when Notre Dame padded its lead with three late tallies before time expired.

Game 16: Villanova 0, Pittsburgh 0

October 19 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** moved into the NCAA record books when she surpassed 7,000 career minutes played in the first half of the game. Loyden finished the game with 7,087:25 career minutes and now ranks 16th in Division I history with that total. She is one of only 19 players to play at least 7,000 minutes in goal. Loyden would move up at least to 12th place all-time if she played every minute of Villanova's final three games of the regular season.

Villanova established a new program high with its sixth tie of the season. The team had previously registered five ties in both the 2002 (14-2-5) and 2003 (15-5-5) seasons.

The Wildcats now have four scoreless ties on the season, which matches the most in a single-season in the NCAA record books. The only two other times a team has had four scoreless ties in a season came in 2003 (Villanova) and 2006 (Michigan).

Game 17: West Virginia 1, Villanova 0

October 21 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** moved up to 15th place in the NCAA record book for minutes played. She has now played 7,177:25 in goal for her career.

The Wildcats have been outscored 8-3 in nine conference games and have scored just two goals in the last 790 minutes of play, including a current scoreless stretch of 321:37 .

West Virginia is the fourth ranked team (NSCAA poll) that the Wildcats have played this season.

Game 18: Villanova 1, Louisville 0 (2OT)

October 26 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Villanova is guaranteed to finish with a winning record this season and now needs just one more victory to have both a winning record and at least 10 victories for a ninth consecutive season.

The game-winning goal by sophomore **Erin Byrnes (Sayville, N.Y.)** was her first this season and the third of her career. It was her fourth goal of the year overall and moves her into a tie with senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** for the team lead with 13 points. Mabery has a team-best five goals along with three assists, while Byrnes has four goals and five helpers.

The Wildcats snapped a scoreless streak of 428:51 with the game-winning goal. Villanova's last goal had come in the second half of a 1-0 victory at DePaul on October 12.

The seven overtime games are one short of the team record of eight set in 2003. The six ties this season are already the most in a single-season in team history.

The Wildcats incredibly are now unbeaten in their last 100 games (95-0-5) when they score the first goal of a game.

This was only the eighth time in school history that Villanova has won a game in double overtime or later, and the first double-overtime win since a 1-0 triumph over LSU last season on September 10, 2006.

Villanova is 3-0 all-time against Louisville, including a pair of 1-0 victories in the last two seasons and a pair of overtime wins at the West Campus Soccer Complex. The first was a 3-2 win in overtime on October 9, 2005.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** moved into 12th place on the all-time NCAA list for minutes played by a goalkeeper. Loyden has now played 7,272:04 in net for her career.

Game 19: Villanova 1, Cincinnati 0

October 28 ~ Villanova, Pa.

The game-winning goal scored by **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)** was her third this season and fourth of her career. Her three game-winners this season are a team high.

Loyden added to her existing school records for victories (47), shutouts (36) and minutes played (7,362:04) with today's game. She moved within 137:56 of becoming only the 10th player in NCAA history with at least 7,500 minutes played.

With the win, Villanova guaranteed a ninth consecutive season with at least 10 victories and a winning record. This will mark the 17th time in the program's 25 years as a varsity sport that the Wildcats have achieved this feat. The team also clinched a BIG EAST Championship berth for the seventh consecutive season.

The Wildcats scored a first half goal for the first time since a 4-0 win over Penn on September 23. Since that contest, eight of the team's previous nine games before this one had been scoreless at halftime. The exception came at Notre Dame when the Fighting Irish owned a 2-0 lead on Villanova at the intermission.

The game against Cincinnati marked the final regular season home game for seven seniors, including goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)**, defenders **Kayce Blandford (Columbia, Md.)** and **Jenna Gordon (White Plains, N.Y.)**, midfielders **Kaley Guthrie (Ogdensburg, N.J.)** and **Melissa Murowski (Warren, N.J.)**, and forwards **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)** and **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)**. Entering the beginning of postseason play, this senior class owns 50 career victories.

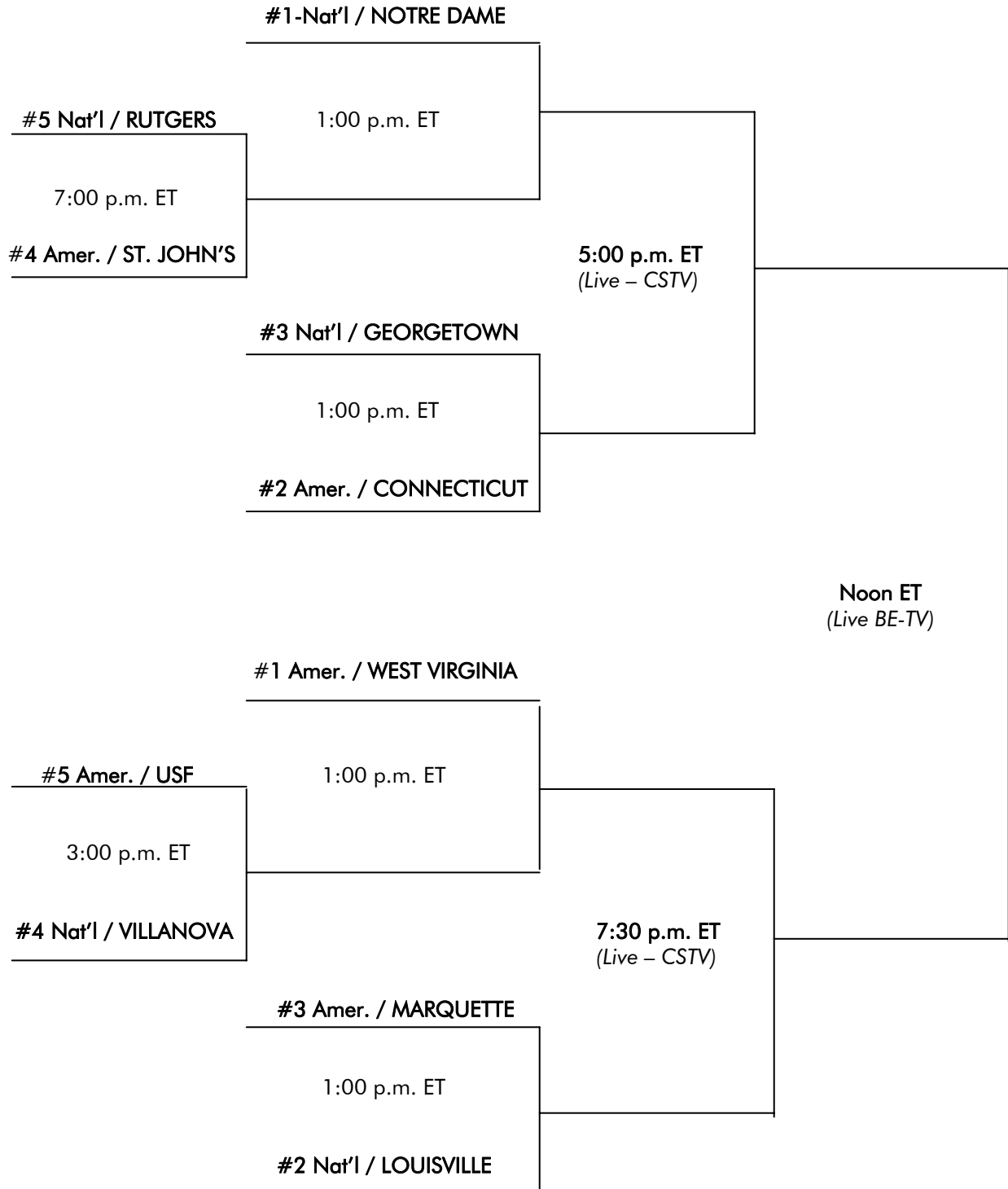
