## UPDATED PLAYER NOTES

Below are updated notes on some of the Villanova players. The starters listed are based on the starting lineup for the previous game and do not necessarily suggest the lineup for the current game.

### Last Game's Starters

#### **GK - #1 Jillian Loyden (Sr., 5-10, Vineland, N.J./Vineland High School)**

*Started 10 of 11 team games; 0.28 GAA and .932 save percentage; seven solo shutouts; Hermann Trophy Candidate; Lowe's Senior CLASS Award Candidate; Soccer America Preseason All-America; BIG EAST Preseason Goalkeeper of the Year; BIG EAST Weekly HONOR Roll (9/3, 9/24)*

#### **D - #23 Kayce Blandford (Sr., 5-7, Columbia, Md./Notre Dame Prep)**

*Starting right-side defender; Has been a starter all four years; One of the most unheralded players in the nation for her contributions to Villanova back line; Takes nearly all of the team's corner kicks, as well as throw-ins along the right side; Tied for the team lead with four assists; Has scored one goal; Named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week (9/3)*

#### **D - #24 Kelly Eagan (Fr., 5-6, St. James, N.Y./Smithtown)**

*One of the top central defenders in the nation; All-America Candidate; Preseason All-BIG EAST Team; Has scored two goals, both game-winners in victories over Virginia Commonwealth (3-0) and Georgetown; BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week (9/24); Top Drawer Soccer Division I Player of the Week (9/24); Soccer Buzz Magazine Elite Feet Team of the Week (9/24)*

#### **D - #16 Laura Sylvester (Jr., 5-10, Broomall, Pa./Marple Newtown High School)**

*Has played some of the best soccer of her career over the last several games; Started all 11 games for the team at central defender; One of the best on the team at clearing balls out of dangerous positions; Possesses the ability to jumpstart the attack when needed; Has a strong foot*

#### **D - #19 Jenna Gordon (Sr., 5-3, White Plains, N.Y./White Plains High School)**

*Starting left-side defender; Missed six games earlier in the season with a minor injury; Has returned to top form; Biggest strength is her speed; Can take a ball away from any opponent; Handles majority of the throw-ins along the left side; Assisted on game-winning goal in season opener versus Lafayette.*

#### **M - #21 Melissa Murowski (Sr., 5-2, Warren, N.J./Watchung Hills Regional High School)**

*The heart and soul of the team; Sets an example with her spirit and work ethic both on and off the field; One of the most critical players to the Villanova team for her role of linking the back line to the front line; Helps out the defensive unit in key situations; Also used to jumpstart team's attack; Has one assist on the year.*

#### **M - #2 Erin Hardiman (Jr., 5-7, Galloway, N.J./Absegami High School)**

*Coming into her own in third collegiate season; Last few games have been among her best; Owns two goals and two assists for six points on the year; Completely ambidextrous; One of the team's best playmakers and most dangerous strikers; At her best when leading the attack from her defensive midfield position; Will be used to help out at central defender from time to time.*

#### **M - #3 Jessica Carnevale (So., 5-4, Princeton, N.J./West-Windsor Plainsboro High School)**

*One of the pleasant surprises on the Wildcats this season; Has improved from a steady freshman season to become one of the team's most potent midfielders; Has a knack for finding the back of the net; Fearless player on the ball with great vision of the entire field; Tenacious player; Has two goals, two assists and six points.*

#### **F - #20 Nikki Mabery (Sr., 5-6, Phoenix, Ariz./Horizon High School)**

*Started all 11 games as the team's holding forward; One of the most dangerous goal scorers in the nation; Ranks fifth in school history with 29 career goals; Team leader this season with five goals and 13 points; Registered a hat trick in 3-1 win over Robert Morris; Also has three assists; A difficult matchup for any defense; Has 10 game-winning goals in her career; BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll (9/10).*

#### **F - #15 Stacia Hartung (Sr., 5-7, Rochester, N.Y./Greece Olympia)**

*One of the main reasons Villanova has switched to a 4-3-3 alignment with three forwards up top in last three games; Having a breakthrough senior season; Four goals this season are double the combined total of her first three collegiate seasons; Has one assist and is third on the team with nine points; Scored game-winning goals against Lafayette and St. Peter's; Starts at forward or midfield and is one of the leading attackers on the team.*

#### **F - #11 Erin Byrnes (So., 5-8, Sayville, N.Y./Sayville)**

*Made her third start of the season in game against Seton Hall; Looking to play with more consistence and aggressiveness against top opponents; Technical skills are among the best on the team; Quick player who is capable of being one of the top scorers in the BIG EAST; Second on the team with 10 points (three goals, four assists) this season; All but one of the points came in huge day against St. Peter's (nine points, three goals, three assists); The nine goals are tied for the most in the nation in a single game this season; Named BIG EAST and ECAC Offensive Player of the Week on 9/17 for her performance against St. Peter's.*

### Other Key Players

#### **F/M - #5 Kaley Guthrie (Sr., 5-7, Ogdensburg, N.J./Pope John XXIII)**

*Like classmate Stacia Hartung, is playing some of the best soccer of her career; Also one of the reasons for the switch to a 4-3-3 alignment; Has made two of her eight starts at forward this season; Has three goals and two assists for eight points; Scored the game-tying goal against Seton Hall for her first career goal against a conference opponent; Possesses outstanding footwork and knowledge of the game.*

#### **M/F - #9 Justine Wollner (Fr., 5-7, Downingtown, Pa./Downingtown East)**

## WEEKLY NOTEBOOK

(October 1-7, 2007)

**BIG EAST Accolades:** Sophomore defender **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** was named to the weekly honor roll by the BIG EAST Conference. Eagan continued her stellar defensive play in the two games last week, as she helped the Wildcats extend their shutout defensive streak to more than 487 minutes before a goal by Seton Hall in the second half of Sunday's game. Eagan marked highly-regarded forwards from Rutgers and Seton Hall in the two games while also being involved in every one of the team's offensive set pieces. This is the second straight week of awards for Eagan, who last week was named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week while also receiving honors from Top Drawer Soccer and Soccer Buzz Magazine.

**Conference First:** Senior forward/midfielder **Kaley Guthrie (Ogdensburg, N.J.)** scored her third goal of the season to account for the lone Villanova score in Sunday's 1-1 tie against Seton Hall. The goal was the first of her career to come in a BIG EAST game and her sixth career goal overall. After scoring one goal in each of her first three seasons with the team, Guthrie has found the back of the net three times already this season. Her other goals this year have come in victories over Lafayette and St. Peter's. Guthrie has started eight of 11 games for the season and has provided a spark to the team's front line.

**Near Record:** Through the first 11 games of the season, Villanova has done a good job of creating offensive opportunities with corner kicks. Earlier in the year, the Wildcats set a team record with 19 corner kicks in a win over Robert Morris. That was just three attempts shy of tying the NCAA record for a single game. More recently, in the game against Seton Hall on Sunday, Villanova took 15 corner kicks. That mark was just one away from tying the BIG EAST record for a conference game. The league mark of 16 was set by Notre Dame against Seton Hall on October 24, 1997. Through 11 games, Villanova is tied for the BIG EAST lead with 89 corner kicks.

**It Had Been a While:** Aside from netting the first score of the game, Seton Hall had another reason to celebrate the goal it scored against Villanova on Sunday. It had been five years and more than 463 minutes of play since the Pirates last notched a goal against the Wildcats traditionally strong defense. Since a 2-1 victory over Seton Hall in 2002, Villanova had posted four straight 1-0 victories in the series between the teams. That string included one game each year between 2003-06 and two contests that went into overtime. The Wildcats lead the all-time series with the Pirates 9-4-1 and have not lost to Seton Hall since 2000.

**So Many Minutes:** So far this season, senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** has already broken the school career records for victories and shutouts. Next up in her quest to rewrite the Villanova record book is the career record for minutes played. Currently, Loyden has played 6,597:25 in goal for the Wildcats, having started for the team since her freshman season. She needs to play another 86:56, just a few minutes short of one more whole game, to tie the school record of 6684:21 set by Janel Schillig (1998-01).

**Lining Up:** Through the first 11 games this season, Villanova has used 11 different starting lineups. However, the lineup from game to game has had always had at least seven of the same starters from the previous game. Of the 22 players the team has used this season, 19 have made at least one start. The only players who have started every game this season are defenders **Kayce Blandford (Columbia, Md.)**, **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** and **Laura Sylvester (Broomall, Pa.)** and forward **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)**.

**Pointing Ahead:** Senior forward **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** was credited with an assist on the game-tying goal in Sunday's 1-1 draw against Seton Hall. In doing so, she increased her career totals to 29 goals, 13 assists and 71 points. Mabery also had four shots in the game and now has 180 in her career. She continues to move up the school career lists in those categories. Currently, Mabery ranks sixth in Villanova history in career points, fifth in goals and third in shots. In addition, she is tied for fifth with 10 career game-winning goals.

**Making Something Out of Nothing:** Villanova has been scored on just three times through the first 11 games and leads the BIG EAST Conference in goals-against average and fewest goals allowed. The Wildcats have outscored their opposition by a 28-3 margin and are undefeated with an overall record of 7-0-4. So far this season, senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** has broken the school's career shutout record and the team notched its 100th shutout since the arrival of 11th-year head coach **Ann Clifton**. In addition, prior to allowing a goal to Seton Hall in Sunday's game, the Wildcats had registered 10 shutouts in their previous 13 regular season BIG EAST games.

**Extra Credit:** Villanova has already played four games this season that went to overtime, all of which ended in a tie. Last season the team only played five overtime games the entire season and three of them ended with a game-winning goal. The Wildcats scored in double overtime against both LSU and Seton Hall, while they were beaten in extra time by West Virginia. The closeness of their games is nothing new for the Wildcats, who played a school-record eight overtime games during their record-breaking 2003 campaign. In both 2002 and 2003, Villanova tied a school record with five ties. In those two seasons, the team had a combined winning percentage of .739 (29-7-10). The 2003 team (15-5-5) won a BIG EAST Championship and advanced to the Sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament. This year, the team is ahead of that pace, owning a winning percentage of .818 (7-0-4) through 11 games.

**Travel Time:** This week's schedule will take Villanova to two spots for the first time ever in the regular season. The Wildcats will visit Marquette and the University of South Florida for a pair of games against BIG EAST teams from the American Division (Villanova is in the National Division). Villanova did play at Marquette last season but the game came during the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Tournament. Sunday's game against USF will mark the first ever meeting between the programs. In all, the Wildcats will have to travel 2,738 miles for their two games this weekend. That includes 709 miles from campus to Milwaukee, another 1,086 miles from Milwaukee to Tampa, and the final 943 miles from Tampa back to the Main Line. In its first four road games this season (Princeton, Lehigh, Georgetown and Seton Hall), the Wildcats total round-trip miles traveled is just 554 miles.

**Polling Places:** Villanova continues to receive votes in the NSCAA/adidas national top 25 poll. The Wildcats are receiving votes this week in the poll, which is considered the official national poll. Villanova currently ranks No. 23 in the Soccer Buzz Magazine Top 30 and is receiving votes in the Soccer Times Top 25. As for a regional ranking in the Mid-Atlantic, Villanova is ranked fifth in the region by the NSCAA and fourth in the region by Soccer Buzz.

**Division Days:** This weekend marks the first of two league crossover weekends when teams from the American and National Division will face each other in BIG EAST play. Each team's 11-game conference schedule consists of games against the other seven teams in its division and four of the eight teams in the opposite division. Over the past two seasons, the National Division has fared well in these matchups by a slight margin. The teams from the National Division lead the teams from the American Division 28-25-10, including a record of 14-11-7 last season. In 2006, players from National Division teams accounted for 14 of the 22 spots on the first and second all-conference teams.

## NEWS AND NOTES

2007 Season

### August 8 - Loyden Named to Preseason Watch List for Hermann Trophy

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was one of 46 players named by the NSCAA as initial candidates for the prestigious Missouri Athletic Club Hermann Trophy. The award is presented each year to the top women's and men's soccer player in the nation. The list will be trimmed to 15 semifinalists in November and then three finalists will be chosen in December in conjunction with the NCAA Women's Soccer College Cup.

"It is very impressive for Jillian to receive this accolade," Villanova head coach Ann Clifton said. "It is a prestigious honor for our program to have a player chosen as one of the top players in the country."

Loyden is a two-time BIG EAST Goalkeeper of the Year and last season became the first player in program history to earn first team All-America honors.

Loyden has started every game of her collegiate career and currently owns a 0.68 career goals-against average. She is the Villanova all-time leader in victories and shutouts, while ranking second in winning percentage, minutes played and goals-against average.

### August 9 - Loyden and Egan Earn Preseason All-BIG EAST Honors

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was named the BIG EAST Preseason Goalkeeper of the Year, while she and sophomore defender **Kelly Egan (St. James, N.Y.)** each earned a spot on the league's preseason All-BIG EAST team.

Loyden has been named the BIG EAST Goalkeeper of the Year in each of the past two seasons and was a first team All-America choice in 2006. Meanwhile, Egan became the first freshman in team history to be named a first team All-BIG EAST selection a year ago, and was a finalist for Soccer Buzz Freshman of the Year honors.

### August 16 - Wildcat Players Excel in Club and Youth Team Championships

During the summer season several Villanova players excelled in competition with their club and youth league teams. Three players advanced to national championship games in their respective leagues and two won national titles.

Freshman **Lindsey Haroutunian (Bloomfield Hills, Mich.)** played for the Bloomfield Force team that captured the Francis J. "Frank" Kelly Cup and won the US Youth Soccer National Championship in the U-18 Girls division in Frisco, Texas.

Sophomore **Samantha Moskal (Chantilly, Va.)** also traveled to Texas and reached a USYS national title game with her team, the PWSI Cardinals. The team advanced to the national championship in the U-19 division. Moskal was a starting defender for the Cardinals, who captured a Region 1 championship on the way to reaching nationals.

Sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)** won a national championship in the Super-20 League with her Parsippany (N.J.) Gazelles team. In Epping, N.H., the Gazelles won the title game 1-0 against Quickstrike FC (Newburgh, N.Y.) to avenge a loss to the Washington Freedom in the national tournament the year before. The Gazelles and Quickstrike had split two meetings during the season before Parsippany claimed the third meeting in the national championship game.

### August 21 - Villanova Defeats North Carolina State in Exhibition Game

In its only preseason exhibition game, Villanova defeated North Carolina State 1-0 in a game played on the turf at nearby Eastern University due to a steady rainfall in the area. The game was scoreless for the first 87 minutes until senior **Kayce Blandford (Columbia, Md.)** scored with less than three minutes left. Blandford sent a ball in from the right side on a corner kick and the ball was never touched before settling into the goal. Villanova outshot the Wolfpack 14-7 in the game.

### August 30 - Soccer America Announces Preseason All-America Team

An already impressive list of accolades for senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** grew by one item, as the Wildcat standout was chosen to the Preseason All-America team by Soccer America. Last season, Loyden was the first player in program history to earn NSCAA First Team All-America honors.

### September 3 - Blandford Named BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week

Through the first two games of the season, Villanova posted a pair of 3-0 shutout wins against Lafayette and Virginia Commonwealth in its own home tournament. Senior **Kayce Blandford (Columbia, Md.)**, the team's starting right back, was a key part of the defensive effort that led to two shutouts and also was the team's leading point scorer. Blandford helped lead a back line that allowed only five total shots on goal in the two games. Offensively, she scored a goal and dished out two assists to lead the team with four points. Blandford was named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week for the second time in her career and first time since 2005.

### September 7 - Family Ties All Around as Wildcats Visited Princeton

When Villanova traveled up Route 1 to take on Princeton on September 7, it was a familiar route for junior midfielder **Kristen Verbit (Newtown, Pa.)**. Verbit's father, Steve, is the defensive coordinator for the Princeton football team and has been a coach for the team for more than 20 years. Verbit recalled spending a lot of time on the campus while growing up and looked forward to playing a game there for the first time in her collegiate career. Making the experience even more meaningful is that the game was played in the Princeton football stadium due to renovations taking place on the soccer field.

The game featured a crowd several hundred strong that was nearly unanimous in support of the Wildcats. In addition to Verbit's connection to the school, Villanova sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)** is from Princeton and attended nearby West Windsor-Plainsboro High School. Verbit and Carnevale, in addition to the team's other four players from the state of New Jersey, had family and friends in attendance to root for Villanova. The Wildcats and Princeton wound up playing to a scoreless tie.

### September 10 - Mabery Receives Spot on Weekly Honor Roll

After scoring all three team goals in a 3-1 victory over Robert Morris, senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** was named to the weekly BIG EAST Honor Roll for the first time this season. Mabery registered her second career hat trick in the game, including scoring the game's first two goals just 24 seconds apart. Her other career hat trick also came against Robert Morris, as she scored the first three goals of the game in a 5-0 victory last season.

Mabery had been the only Villanova player in the last five years to have a hat trick in a game until sophomore **Erin Byrnes (Sayville, N.Y.)** had three goals in a win over St. Peter's on September 11.

2007 Season

**September 16 - Wildcats Celebrate First Annual Alumnae Day**

On Sunday, September 16, in conjunction with that day's game against Temple, the Villanova women's soccer team celebrated its first annual Alumnae Day. Following the game a reception was held on campus for the former players and their families who were in attendance. The current team, coaches and staff from the athletic department joined in the celebration, which was a huge success. Villanova began its women's soccer program as a club sport in 1976 and the team elevated to varsity status in 1983. In its first 24 years as a varsity sport, the program registered 16 winning seasons, 16 years with at least 10 victories and eight postseason tournament appearances (five NCAA berths, three ECAC bids).

**September 17 - Byrnes Rewarded After Career Day against St. Peter's**

For the first time in five years, a Villanova player received BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Week honors. It took a special day from sophomore **Erin Byrnes (Sayville, N.Y.)** for the Wildcat forward to earn the award. In an 11-0 win over St. Peter's, Byrnes tallied a career-high nine points with three goals and three assists in the blowout win. She came off the bench to score once late in the first half and twice in the second half to register her first career hat trick. Byrnes was also named the ECAC Offensive Player of the Week for her efforts.

The nine points remain tied for the most by a player in a single game this season. Aside from the game against St. Peter's, Byrnes has recorded just one other point the entire season, with that coming on an assist in the second game of the season against Virginia Commonwealth.

**September 21 - Loyden Sets Career Shutout Record**

When senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** took over in goal for Villanova in 2004, big things were expected of her. In fact, she redshirted her true freshman season in 2003 so that she would have four years of eligibility once she took over in a starting role. All she has done in her time with the Wildcats is post more career games in which she has not allowed a goal (39) than games in which she has (33). With a 1-0 victory over Georgetown on September 21, Loyden posted her 30th career solo shutout to set a new Villanova career record. She surpassed the mark of 29 shutouts held by Chrissy Dolan (2000-03) and currently has 32 career solo shutouts to her credit. Loyden is the current BIG EAST leader in career solo shutouts and is moving up the all-time list of shutouts by BIG EAST goalkeepers.

**September 21 - The .600 Club**

The current run of success for the Villanova women's soccer team, which began with the program's first-ever NCAA appearance in 2001, is without question the longest and most significant in the program's history. However, success on the field is nothing new for the team, which has enjoyed 16 winning seasons and 16 years with at least 10 victories in its first 24 seasons as a varsity sport (since 1983).

On September 21 the Wildcats defeated Georgetown 1-0 for their sixth win of the season, and improved the overall program record to 265-169-49. That marks a winning percentage of **.600** in program history, making Villanova one of just five BIG EAST programs with an all-time record of at least .600.

Entering play this week, the Wildcats own an all-time record of 266-169-51 and remain at exactly .600 for an all-time winning percentage. Since the arrival of head coach **Ann Clifton** in 1997, Villanova's record is 131-61-29 (.658).

**September 24 - Eagan Receives Player of the Week Honors**

After the Wildcats posted a pair of shutout wins over Georgetown and Penn, sophomore defender **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** received numerous weekly awards for her play in the two games. Eagan was named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week and was chosen to the Soccer Buzz Magazine Elite Feet Team of the Week, while also being named the Top Drawer Soccer Division I Player of the Week.

Eagan scored her fourth career game-winning goal to account for the lone score in a 1-0 victory over Georgetown in the conference opener on September 21. She also led a defensive effort that allowed just nine total shots on goal in the two games.

In addition to the recognition for Eagan, senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** was also named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll. It was an outstanding week for Loyden, who set a new school record for career shutouts with her 30th in the win over Georgetown. Against Penn, Loyden added to her new record with another shutout and also recorded her second career point when she assisted on the final goal of the game.

**October 1 - Eagan Continues Steady Play**

Sophomore defender **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** was named to the weekly honor roll by the BIG EAST Conference. Eagan continued her stellar defensive play in the two games last week, as she helped the Wildcats extend their shutout defensive streak to more than 487 minutes before a goal by Seton Hall in the second half of Sunday's game. Eagan marked highly-regarded forwards from Rutgers and Seton Hall in the two games while also being involved in every one of the team's offensive set pieces.

**Game 1: Villanova 3, Lafayette 0**  
August 31 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior midfielder **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)** scored her third career goal in the game and the first since her freshman season. After the first game of the year, Hartung has three career goals and nine assists for 15 points. She missed part of her sophomore season due to an injury suffered midway through the year.

Villanova is 12-11-2 in season openers, including 7-6 in season openers at home. Since the arrival of head coach Ann Clifton in 1997, the Wildcats are 8-3-0 in season openers, including 6-0-0 at home. Villanova has won its season opener each year since 2001 and the streak of seven straight victories is a program best. The Wildcats have now opened the season with a shutout win in three straight seasons.

The Wildcats lead the all-time series with Lafayette by a 5-0-0 count, although this year's meeting was the first since 1993. Villanova has outscored the Leopards by a 24-3 margin in the five meetings.

The game marked the first time since 2003 that Villanova had no freshmen in the opening game starting lineup. Head coach **Ann Clifton** has seven seniors on her roster this season, which is the most since her initial Wildcat squad in 1997. All seven seniors were in the starting lineup for the game along with three juniors and one sophomore.

**Game 2: Villanova 3, Virginia Commonwealth 0**  
September 2 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** earned her 40th career win in today's game to set a new career record at Villanova. The old record of 39 was set by Janel Schillig (1998-01).

Villanova showed off its improved depth in its first two games of the season, as all six of the teams goals were scored by a different player.

Sophomore **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** registered her third career goal in the game. It was also the third career game-winning goal for Eagan, who twice last season had the only goal in 1-0 Wildcat victories.

The Wildcats have an all-time record of 37-32-5 (.534) during regular season tournament play. That includes a 17-6-1 (.729) mark under head coach **Ann Clifton** and a 9-1 (.900) record in regular season tournament homes games. The only loss for Villanova in a home regular season tournament game came to Holy Cross on October 11, 1986 (lost 4-2).

**Game 3: Villanova 0, Princeton 0**  
September 7 ~ Princeton, N.J.

Since **Ann Clifton** became head coach in 1997, the Wildcats are 5-5-6 in games played in the state of New Jersey.

Villanova is also 10-3-3 (.719) against teams from the Ivy League since 1997.

**Game 4: Villanova 3, Robert Morris 1**  
September 9 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** recorded her second career hat trick by scoring all three Villanova goals in the game. Her other hat trick also came against Robert Morris, in a 5-0 win last season.

The goal by Robert Morris in the 27th minute ended the Wildcats shutout streak to start the season at 316:37. Villanova had posted shutouts in its first three games. The last time the Wildcats had a longer shutout streak to start a season was in 2003, when the team posted four straight shutouts to start the year and did not allow a goal for the first 378:01 of play.

Villanova set a school record by taking 19 corner kicks in the game. That came close to the NCAA record for a single game. The record is 22, set 12 years ago on September 7, 1995 by UNC-Wilmington against Chowan.

**Game 5: Villanova 11, St. Peter's 0**  
September 11 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Villanova scored double-digit goals for the sixth time in team history and the first since an 11-0 win over Howard on October 27, 2002. The school record for goals in a game is 13, set against La Salle on September 17, 1986.

Sophomore **Erin Byrnes (Sayville, N.Y.)** scored a career-high nine points by notching three goals and three assists in the game. She had registered only one points on an assist through the first four games before totaling the nine points today. Byrnes came off the bench to score once late in the first half and then added the first two goals of the second half. It was the first career hat trick for Byrnes, who scored five goals and had one assist as a freshman last season.

**UPDATE #1 (10/1):** Byrnes and senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** are the only Villanova players to record a hat trick in the last five years, since Janessa Jeltema did it against Howard in an 11-0 win on October 27, 2002. Mabery's two career hat tricks came both came against Robert Morris in games played last season and this season.

**UPDATE #2 (10/1):** The 11 goals scored by Villanova and the nine points for Byrnes are tied for the most in the nation by a team or a player in a single game this season.

Freshman **Justine Wollner (Downingtown, Pa.)** scored the first two goals of her collegiate career. Wollner had previously recorded her first career point with an assist in a 3-1 victory over Robert Morris. Freshman **Rachel Schuyler (Cheshire, Conn.)** also recorded the first goal of her collegiate career.

The two goals for senior **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)** made this game the first multi-goal game of her collegiate career. It was the second career game with multiple goals for sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)**, who scored both goals in a 2-0 victory over Pittsburgh last season.

**Game 6: Villanova 1, Lehigh 1**  
September 14 ~ Bethlehem, Pa.

Villanova allowed the opposition to score the first goal of the game for the first time this season. However, the Wildcats tied the game late in regulation and ended a streak of five straight losses in games where the opponent scored first. The stretch of five losses dated to the end of the 2005 season.

Although Villanova is 6-1-1 all-time against Lehigh, it is just 0-1-1 in the last two meetings. The Mountain Hawks defeated the Wildcats for the first time ever in 2005, winning 1-0 at the West Campus Soccer Complex.

**Game 7: Villanova 1, Temple 0**  
September 16 ~ Villanova, Pa.

The Wildcats are 34-2-4 (.900) all-time against other Philadelphia Big Five teams. The losses came to La Salle in 2000 and Saint Joseph's in 2005.

Villanova celebrated its First Annual Alumnae Day with a reception after the game for the many former players who were in attendance. The University first fielded a women's soccer team as a club sport in 1976, and the program elevated to varsity status in 1983.

**Game 8: Villanova 1, Georgetown 0**

September 21 ~ Washington, D.C.

Villanova is 5-0-1 in its first BIG EAST game since 2002 and have now opened conference play against Georgetown in each of the last three seasons. Villanova claimed a 2-0 victory against the Hoyas last season at the West Campus Soccer Complex after playing to a 1-1 tie in 2005 at North Kehoe Field.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** set the Villanova career shutout record with her 30th career shutout in today's game. Loyden surpassed the mark of 29 shutouts held by Chrissy Dolan (2000-03).

Sophomore **Kelly Eagan (St. James, N.Y.)** scored her fourth career goal and fourth career game-winner in the game. Three of her four goals have come late in the second half of 1-0 Villanova victories to account for the game's lone score.

The goal in the 72nd minute of today's game was the latest in a game the first goal has been scored by the Wildcats or their opposition this season.

**Game 9: Villanova 4, Penn 0**

September 23 ~ Villanova, Pa.

The shutout in the game was the 100th for the Wildcats since the arrival of head coach **Ann Clifton** in 1997. The 100 shutouts in that time period rank fourth among all BIG EAST schools. Only Notre Dame, Connecticut and Marquette have had at least 100 shutouts since 1997.

Senior goalkeeper **Jillian Loyden (Vineland, N.J.)** registered her second career point with an assist on the final goal of the game. Her long punt down field was played by sophomore **Jessica Carnevale (Princeton, N.J.)** and then kicked into the left side of the net by senior **Stacia Hartung (Rochester, N.Y.)**. Loyden also had an assist on a goal in a 5-0 win over Robert Morris last season.

Senior **Nikki Mabery (Phoenix, Ariz.)** scored her 29th career goal in the game and moved into sole possession of fifth place on the school's career list.

Villanova is 35-2-4 (.902) all-time against other Philadelphia Big Five schools.

**Game 10: Villanova 0, Rutgers 0**

September 28 ~ Villanova, Pa.

Villanova played to its second scoreless tie of the year, with the other coming against Princeton earlier in the month. The last time the Wildcats had more than two scoreless ties in a season came in 2003, when the team tied an NCAA record with four scoreless ties. Two of those games came in the NCAA Tournament against Virginia and BYU.

Wildcat senior **Kaley Guthrie (Ogdensburg, N.J.)** played against her sister Erin, the goalkeeper for Rutgers, for the second time in their collegiate careers. The sisters first went against each other last season when the Wildcats and Scarlet Knights played to a 1-1 tie.

Villanova posted its fourth consecutive shutout in the game.

**Game 11: Villanova 1, Seton Hall 1**

September 30 ~ South Orange, N.J.

The Seton Hall goal marked the first time the Pirates have scored against the Wildcats since 2002. Villanova had posted four straight 1-0 victories (including two in overtime) each year between 2003-06. Seton Hall had not scored on the Wildcats in nearly 464 minutes of play.

The Wildcats also saw a shutout streak of 487:14 end with the Pirates goal. Villanova was last scored on by Lehigh in the second half of its sixth game of the season. The Wildcats had posted four straight shutouts since then.

The 1-1 tie with Lehigh was the only other time this season that Villanova saw the opposition net the first goal of the game. Since 1997, the Wildcats are just 13-55-9 (.227) when the opponent scores the first goal.

The BIG EAST record for corner kicks in a conference game is 16, set by Notre Dame against Seton Hall on October 24, 1997.
