This Week's Top Stories

- Villanova tied for first place at the NCAA Mid-Atlantic Regional last Saturday to gain at least a share of the regional title for the third consecutive season. Led by individual champion **Sheila Reid (Newmarket, Ont.)** and third place finisher **Bogdana Mimic (Pancevo, Serbia)** the Wildcats finished with a team score of 57 points to tie Georgetown at the top of the standings.
- Head coach **Gina Procaccio** and senior **Sheila Reid (Newmarket, Ont.)** repeated as the Coach of the Year and the Athlete of the Year, respectively, in the Mid-Atlantic Region. Awards were announced on Wednesday by the United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association, based on voting by Division I coaches.
- Seniors **Sheila Reid (Newmarket, Ont.)** and **Bogdana Mimic (Pancevo, Serbia)**, as well as sophomores **Nicky Akande (Lawrenceville, Ga.)** and **Emily Lipari (Greenvale, N.Y.)** each received All-Mid Atlantic Region accolades for finishing in the top 25 at the Mid-Atlantic Regional last weekend. Reid was the individual champion for the third consecutive season, while Mimic finished third, Akande came in 10th and Lipari was 16th overall.
- Villanova has won each of the last two national championships and the team's nine national titles all-time are the most of any program in women's cross country. The Wildcats won six consecutive titles from 1989-94 and also won the 1998 national title.
- Last year **Sheila Reid (Newmarket, Ont.)** became the eighth individual champion from Villanova and the first from the program to win since 1997. No other program has had more than three individual national champions. Reid has won seven consecutive races since last year and 11 of her last 13 starts since the start of the 2009 season.

2011 SEASON NEWS AND NOTES

November 16: Reid and Procaccio Repeat as Top Regional Athlete and Coach
 In voting conducted among all Division I coaches Villanova senior **Sheila Reid (Newmarket, Ont.)** and head coach **Gina Procaccio** were named the Mid-Atlantic Region Athlete of the Year and Coach of the Year, respectively. For both Reid and Procaccio this marks the third consecutive year that they have earned top honors in the region.

Reid was the individual champion at the NCAA Mid-Atlantic Regional race last weekend, where she came in first out of 199 runners and helped the Wildcats claim a share of the team title. Reid has been the individual champion on three years running and has won seven consecutive races overall dating back to last season.

At the Mid-Atlantic regional race on the UMES Cross Country Course last Saturday afternoon Reid crossed the finish line in 21:32.7 in an original 6K race that included an extra 465 meters due to a reroute on the course. Reid also captured her third consecutive BIG EAST individual crown earlier this year and was the individual champion at the Wisconsin adidas Invitational last month.

Procaccio repeats as Coach of the Year in the Mid-Atlantic Region after leading Villanova to its fourth consecutive BIG EAST title as well as a tie for first place in the team standings at the Mid-Atlantic Regional meet. The conference championship is the 14th team title in cross country for the Wildcats, who extended their record of having won the most championships of any BIG EAST program.

Villanova also turned in a strong performance at the Mid-Atlantic Regional as Reid, senior Bogdana Mimic (Pancevo, Serbia) and sophomores Nicky Akande (Lawrenceville, Ga.) and Emily Lipari (Greenvale, N.Y.) all received All-Mid Atlantic Region honors.

Procaccio led the Wildcats to consecutive national championships in 2009 and 2010 and Villanova has been ranked in the top five in the nation throughout this season, including a current No. 2 national ranking entering the NCAA Championships meet this coming Monday afternoon.

Since the start of the 2008 season Procaccio has now won nine coaching awards just in cross country. Her list of honors includes four BIG EAST Coach of the Year awards, three straight Mid-Atlantic Region Coach of the Year honors as well as being the 2009 and 2010 National Coach of the Year.

Note: A Villanova athlete has been named the Mid-Atlantic Region Athlete of the Year in each of the past four seasons ... Prior to the current three-year run that Reid is on, Frances Koons earned top athlete honors during the 2008 season.

November 3: Cross Country Teams Recognized in Times Square Display
 One week after sweeping the men's and women's team titles at the BIG EAST Championships the Wildcats had congratulatory ads in their honor appear on the American Eagle Outfitters building in New York's world famous Times Square from November 4-6. The ads were seen at 1551-1555 Broadway on the corner of 46th Street in the heart of Manhattan.

American Eagle Outfitters (AEO) is a BIG EAST sponsor and for the second consecutive year will recognize each of the league's team champions during the year with congratulatory ads in Times Square. The display on the AEO building is more than 30 stories high.

Separate ads ran for both the men's and women's teams. The congratulatory banners were a part of the playlist of ads on the AEO building for 48 hours, starting on Friday, November 4 and continuing through Sunday, November 6. The ads appeared once per hour and could be viewed for 15 seconds each time they were displayed.



November 1: Wildcats Ranked No. 2 in the Nation

After winning its fourth consecutive BIG EAST Championship three days earlier Villanova was ranked No. 2 in the nation in the Top 30 poll released by the United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCCA). The Wildcats had been ranked No. 4 for two weeks prior to the conference meet and were ranked No. 1 for two weeks earlier in the year.

Villanova finished with 54 points at the BIG EAST Championships to beat out Providence and Georgetown for the team title. Senior **Sheila Reid (Newmarket, Ont.)** was the individual champion at the conference meet for the third straight year and the top three runners for the Wildcats all received All-BIG EAST honors. Reid was followed in second place by senior **Bogdana Mimic (Pancevo, Serbia)**, while sophomore **Nicky Akande (Lawrenceville, Ga.)** placed 12th.

October 18: Reid Named BIG EAST Female Athlete of the Week

Senior **Sheila Reid (Newmarket, Ont.)** was named the BIG EAST Female Cross Country Athlete of the Week in an announcement by the conference office. Reid competed for the first time this season and was the individual winner at the Wisconsin adidas Invitational.

This is the third time in Reid's career that she has received weekly cross country honors from the league. She won the 6,000 meter women's race at Wisconsin in a time of 20:00 to register the second-fastest 6K cross country time of her collegiate career. Reid came in first out of 305 runners on the Thomas Zimmer Championship Cross Country Course.

Reid's victory was her fifth consecutive first place finish and her ninth win in 11 starts going back to the beginning of the 2009 season. In her first race of the 2011 campaign she emerged as the winner of an event that featured seven of the nation's top-10 ranked teams and a total of 19 nationally-ranked squads overall.

Villanova came in fourth out of 44 teams at the Wisconsin meet.

NOTE: The other times Reid was named BIG EAST Female Cross Country Athlete of the Week came on October 5, 2009 and October 18, 2010.

2011 SEASON NEWS AND NOTES

October 4: Wildcats Move Up to No. 1 in National Rankings

In the new national poll released by the United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCCA) on October 4, Villanova was ranked No. 1 in the nation for the first time this season. The Wildcats were one of three BIG EAST squads ranked in the top five and one of six conference teams in the top 30 of the rankings.

Villanova competed in its first scored meet of the season on September 30 at the Paul Short Run and finished second out of 45 teams in the Women's Gold race. Senior **Bogdana Mimic (Pancevo, Serbia)** was the individual champion.

In addition to ascending to the top of the national rankings the Wildcats also moved up to the top spot of the Mid-Atlantic Region poll, after being No. 2 in the region each week since the preseason. The team had also been ranked No. 5 in the national polls since the preseason.

The other BIG EAST teams in the top 30 poll included Providence (No. 2), Georgetown (No. 5), Syracuse (No. 8), West Virginia (No. 19) and Notre Dame (No. 25).

October 4: Bogdana Mimic Named BIG EAST Female Athlete of the Week

Senior **Bogdana Mimic (Pancevo, Serbia)** was named the BIG EAST Female Cross Country Athlete of the Week for the period of September 26-October 2. In her first race of the season Mimic was the individual champion of the Women's Gold race at the Paul Short Run.

Mimic covered the 6K course at Lehigh in a time of 20:10 and won the race by nine seconds on a sunny and hot day. Her winning time was the second-fastest of her collegiate career on a 6K course and marked Mimic's first individual victory in cross country.

Thanks to her first place finish Villanova placed second out of 45 teams in the Women's Gold race in the team's first scored meet of the season. The strong result helped the Wildcats move up one spot to No. 1 in the USTFCCCA Mid-Atlantic Region rankings, the first time this season that Villanova reached the top spot.

During her Wildcat cross country and track career Mimic is a four-time All-American, including twice in cross country (2009, 2010) while helping lead Villanova to national championships in each of the last two seasons. In cross country she is also a three-time All-BIG EAST and three-time All-Mid Atlantic Region selection.

August 30: Wildcats Begin Season Ranked Fifth in the Nation

When the 2011 season began Villanova was ranked No. 5 in the nation and No. 2 in the Mid-Atlantic Region by the USTFCCCA, which released its preseason polls in late August. The Wildcats were one of five BIG EAST squads to earn a preseason national ranking.

Villanova returns three of its top five runners from last year's national title squad, including seniors **Sheila Reid** and **Bogdana Mimic** and sophomore **Emily Lipari**.

Also among the returning runners for Villanova are junior **Ariann Neutts (Succasunna, N.J.)** and senior **Callie Hogan (Bay Shore, N.Y.)**. Sophomore **Nicky Akande (Lawrenceville, Ga.)** is also among the returnees who figure to contribute to the team during the season.

In all, the Wildcats roster includes 11 returning student-athletes and six incoming freshmen.

The freshman class includes **Amanda Borroughs (Saratoga Springs, N.Y.)**, **Courtney Chapman (Fayetteville, N.Y.)**, **Sydney Harris (Colorado Springs, Colo.)**, **Stephanie Schappert (Delray Beach, Fla.)**, **Leanne Tucker (Tewksbury, Mass.)** and **Megan Venables (Laurel Springs, N.J.)**.
