



VILLANOVA WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY



TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE

Villanova is the most successful women's cross country program in the nation, with a record nine national championships to its credit as well as nine individual national champions. The program's legacy includes six consecutive national titles from 1989-94 and the Wildcats have continued to maintain their position of national prominence, most recently winning back-to-back titles in 2009 and 2010. Villanova made its debut at the NCAA Championships in 1983 and has made 29 appearances overall at the national meet. The Wildcats have had 55 All-Americans over the years.

The success of the program also includes 14 NCAA regional titles and 22 individual regional champions. Villanova has also won 15 BIG EAST team titles, including six straight championships from 1989-94 and four consecutive titles from 2008-11. The Wildcats have also had 16 individual conference champions.
