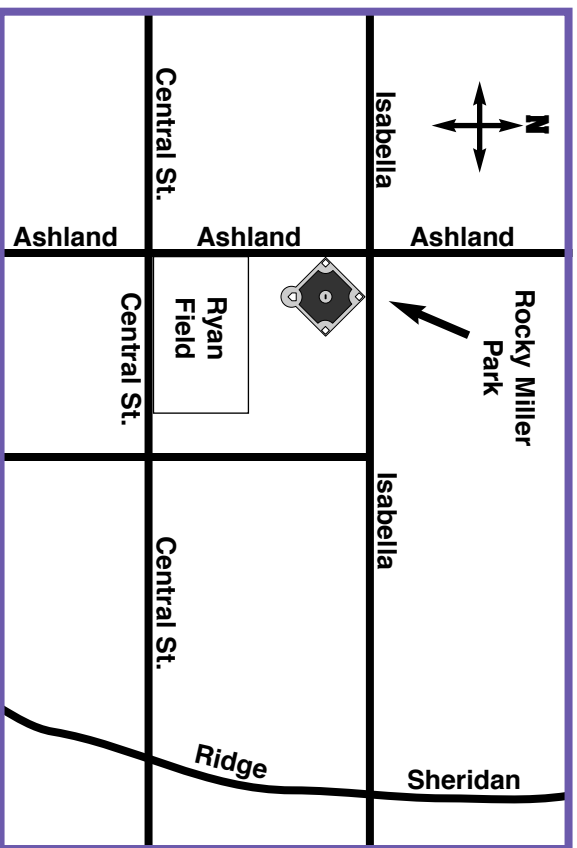

CLASSIC CAMPS

Classic Camps are for ages 8-13 (non-high school). The emphasis is set to improve all phases of the game with concentration on defense and hitting techniques. Games are played so that campers will be able to test these newly learned skills. Camps run Monday through Friday; 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

LIL' SLUGGERS

Lil' Sluggers camp is for ages 5-7. This morning camp (9:00 - 12:00) is designed to begin developing your son or daughter's most basic baseball/softball skills through games and competition. Camps run Monday through Friday.

STAFF

Campers will be instructed by the Northwestern University coaching staff as well as top college and high school coaches from the Chicagoland area. The camper-to-coach ratio will be no greater than 10:1, allowing every camper the opportunity for extensive personal instruction.

MEALS

Lunch should be brought by the camper. We will supply Gatorade during the day.

EQUIPMENT

Campers should wear a T-shirt, shorts or baseball pants (preferred), and cleats or athletic shoes. Every camper should have a baseball cap and sunscreen. Campers will need their own glove and may bring their own bat. Please be sure to have all equipment clearly marked. Camp T-shirts will be provided to each baseball camper.
