Important Camp Information

NEW FOR 2007: We will be sponsoring a tournament on the final day of camp. Weigh-ins and 4 full length matches are guaranteed. Call us for further details.

Age Groups: 8 – 18 years of age. We will be splitting the camp into age group and ability levels as needed.

Check-in times: Registration is held between 9:30 AM and 10 AM on the first day of each technique camp.

- The camp will begin at 10 AM daily.
- Upon receipt of application, detailed information (regarding practice venues, updates, etc.) will be sent to each and camper.

Supervision: Every precaution will be used to prevent accidents. We do not, however, assume any responsibility for medical, dental, or expenses incurred as a result of accidents. A parent or guardian must sign the application before a wrestler will be accepted into the camp.

What to bring: a towel, headgear if possible, personal toiletries, changes of work-out gear, wrestling shoes, kneepads, etc.

Eligibility: In accordance with NCAA rules, graduating high school seniors are eligible to attend.

The Camp Director Profile



Drew Pariano is an Assistant Wrestling Coach at Northwestern University. He was a three time Ohio state champion from Fairview Park High School and a two-time Outstanding Wrestler at the state tournament. Among his many high school honors were Asics, USA Wrestling and Amateur Wrestling News High School All-American awards.

Following his successful high school career, Pariano would become a three-time NCAA Division I National Qualifier and Midlands Tournament place-winner while at Northwestern University.

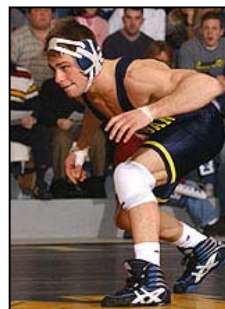
In the spring and summer of 2006, Pariano remained active by coaching at the World Team Trials. He also served as the director for the FILA Cadet and University Nationals. Finally, Pariano served as a coach for the Ohio Junior National Dual team that took 3rd in the nation.

Prior to accepting his position at NU, Pariano spent two seasons as the head wrestling coach at Cornell College (Iowa). In just two seasons, Pariano rebuilt the Cornell Rams and earned his team an invitation to the NWCA National Duals for the first time in school history where his former team placed 6th in the nation.

Pariano also served as an assistant wrestling coach at John Carroll University for head coach Kerry Volkman (2000-2003).

Ryan Bertin: Assistant Coach at Northwestern University...two-time NCAA 157-pound champion (2003, '05) and four-time NCAA All-American ... 2005 Big Ten Wrestler of the Year ... ranks fifth on U of M's all-time wins list with 142-21 career mark ... three-time NWCA All-Academic ... three-time Academic All-Big Ten ... two-time team captain...he was a state champion for St.Eds and won a National Title as a high school senior.

Ryan Lang: 2007 NCAA Runner-up at 141... Midlands Tournament Champion...Big Ten Champion... 2006 NCAA All-American (4th)...Currently ranked #1 in the nation...Big Ten Tournament Finalist...the first ever 4X State Champion at St. Edward H.S./Asics Dream Team Member...Junior National Champion, was the number one recruit in the nation at his weight class.

Jake Herbert: 2007 NCAA Champion...Big Ten Tournament Champion...Outstanding Wrestler at the Big Ten Tournament...Has finished 2nd and 3rd in the country. He is currently ranked #1 at 184. Was 3rd in the nation as a freshman and finished the tournament with a 7-1 record (3 falls)...Big Ten Champion and was the first NU wrestler to win a Midlands tournament title since 1990 and has now won 2 titles in two attempts...2006 University National Freestyle Champion...2006 3rd in the World at the University Games ...2003 State Champion in Pennsylvania for North Allegheny High School.



Rob Eiter: Head Asst. Coach at the University of Pennsylvania...former Northwestern University Assistant Coach... 1996 Olympian...1993 and 1995 World Championship team member...5 time U.S. Open National Champion...2 time World Cup silver medallist... assistant coach at Clarion University for five -years...coached Sheldon Thomas to an NCAA title...wrestled for Arizona State

Dustin Fox: 3rd in the NCAA at 285...Big Ten 3rd place finisher... Midlands Tournament Runner-up...3X NCAA Qualifier and a top 12 finisher as a freshman...two-time Ohio state champion ... three-time state qualifier ... fourth-place at NHSCA Senior Nationals...compiled a 132-14 record during high school career ... 2003 national champion and 2004 national champion in Freestyle

Matt Delguvd: 2005 Big Ten Champion at 197 and NCAA Qualifier... was a top 12 finisher...13-2 in duals... Posted 2-2 mark in his second-consecutive trip to the NCAA Championships, winning his first two matches to advance to the quarterfinals before falling to No. 1 seed Jon Trence ... notched career-high 30 victories ... was a two-time state runner-up for Mayfield High School.
