Important Camp Information

Age Groups: 7 – 18 years of age. We will be splitting the camp into age group and ability levels as needed.

Check-in times: Registration is held between 9:30 AM and 10 AM on the first day of each technique camp.

Camp Director



Drew Pariano - Associate Head Wrestling Coach at Northwestern University: Pariano was recently named the NWCA Division I National Assistant Coach of The Year. In four years at NU, Pariano has coached 23 NCAA Qualifiers, 11 NCAA All-Americans, 6 Big Ten Champions, 5 NCAA Finalists, and 3 NCAA Champions (Jake Herbert 2X and Dustin Fox). Pariano helped the Wildcats earn the 4th place trophy at the 2007 NCAA Championships.

He was a three time Ohio state champion from Fairview Park High School and a two-time Outstanding Wrestler at the state tournament. Among his many high school honors were Asics, USA Wrestling and Amateur Wrestling News High School All-American awards. Following his successful high school career, Pariano would become a three-time NCAA Division I National Qualifier, AWN All-Rookie Team Member and Midlands Tournament place-winner while at Northwestern University.

In the spring and summers of 2006, 2007 and 2008, Pariano coached at the World Team Trials. He also served as the director for the 2006 FILA Cadet and University Nationals. Pariano (2006) was a coach for the Ohio Junior National Dual team that took 3rd in the nation.

Prior to accepting his position at NU, Pariano spent two seasons as the head wrestling coach at Cornell College (Iowa). In just two seasons, Pariano rebuilt the Cornell Rams and earned his team an invitation to the NWCA National Duals for the first time in school history. Pariano also served as an assistant wrestling coach at John Carroll University for head coach Kerry Volkmann (2000-2003).

Northwestern Head Coach

Tim Cysewski: Coming off back to back back NCAA Champions, Tim enters his 20th season as Northwestern's head wrestling coach. In 2007, the squad took 4th in the NCAA. Under Cysewski's direction, 29 Wildcats have earned All-American honors and 89 wrestlers have qualified for the NCAA Championships ...has produced four national champions and twelve Big Ten champions...in his rookie year as head coach he led Northwestern to a fourth-place finish at the NCAA Championships...Wrestled for U of Iowa...4X National Freestyle Champion...2X Outstanding Wrestler...5X Midlands Champion...2X World Team coach...he was also selected at the 2006 NWCA All-Star coach
