The Stars at Night, Are Big and Bright: In The NCAA Tourney

The Preview

Northwestern begins the 2012 NCAA Tournament under 11th-year head coach **Kate Drohan** May 18-20 at the Austin Regional—the same location Drohan led the Wildcats in their first NCAA berth under her direction in 2003.

In the time that has passed between postseason trips to Austin, NU has qualified for eight NCAA fields, won four Regionals and advanced to the semifinals of two Women's College World Series. The 'Cats begin their next quest for Oklahoma City at 4 p.m. CT Friday, May 17, in their opener against the host and No. 6 overall seed Longhorns.

Auburn and Houston complete the four-team, double-elimination Regional field, starting the action at 1 p.m. CT Friday prior to NU's game. Houston won the Austin Regional a year ago with a 3-0 record, marking the second-straight year Texas has hosted a Regional but failed to advance out of it.

Northwestern earned its way into the 2012 field courtesy of the nation's No. 1 ranked nonconference strength of schedule and an 8-1 record in its final nine games, sweeping a Big Ten road series at Michigan State and its home regular season finale against then-top 50 RPI team Illinois.

The Wildcats have been buoyed all year by a prolific lineup featuring 40-run scorers in **Emily Allard**, **Mari Majam** and **Marisa Bast** along with RBI producers Bast and **Adrienne Monka**, who have combined to drive in 115 runs on the year. With just one regular senior starter on the field (Monka), NU's youth has stepped up in a big way. **Olivia Duehr**, **Amy Letourneau** and **Anna Edwards** all were B1G Freshman of the Week at some point this season.

Northwestern's pitching and defense have matured as the season has worn on, with junior **Meghan Lamberth** emerging as a leader in the circle and NU's defense committing just one error during NU's six-game season-ending winning streak.

Auburn Tigers (33-21)

SEC Conference, At-Large Bid

The Series: NU leads, 1-0. The two teams last met in the 2003 season opener in Tampa, Fla., in a game Northwestern won, 6-1.

Scouting Report: Auburn finished third in the regular season in the SEC West standings before falling in the first round of the SEC Tournament, 2-1 to Tennessee. Auburn boasts a 1.92 team ERA , 25th in the NCAA. In the circle, Lauren Schmalz claims the team's lowest ERA at 1.57 and is ranked 11th in the SEC in strikeouts with 147. Auburn uses a true three-member staff, also getting over 100 innings from Angel Bunner (13-4, 2.18 ERA) and Jenee Loree (11-9, 1.91 ERA). Lauren Guzman leads the hit parade with 61 hits and a .347 average while Elizabeth Eisterhold has a team-best 12 homers and a .553 slugging percentage. As a team, the Tigers only have a .244 average.

Houston Cougars (34-22)

Conference USA, At-Large Bid

The Series: Northwestern and Houston never have met.

Scouting Report: Houston finished the season tied for thid with Marshall and Central Florida in Conference USA before falling in the semifinals of the C-USA Tournament to eventual champion Tulsa. Houston is making its second-straight NCAA postseason appearance and its fifth overall; the Cougars went a perfect 3-0 at the Austin Regional in 2011, defeating No. 6 Texas and Louisiana-Lafayette twice to advance to the Super Regionals. Houston boasts a team batting average of .312 with seven regular players owning better than .300 averages. Haley Outon has a whopping 22 home runs and 63 RBIs in 56 games played while Holly Anderson has a team-best .374 average with 10 homers, 42 RBIs and 19 stolen bases. The Cougars like to run, owning 109 stolen bases in 134 attempts. In the circle, Bailey Watts (15-8), Diedre Outon (10-6) and Summer Groholski (8-6) have shared much of the pitching duties. Watts has the most innings with 153.2, earning a 15-8 record while allowing opponents to bat .229.

No. 6 seed Texas Longhorns (42-10)

Big XII Conference, At-Large Bid

The Series: Series tied, 1-1. Northwestern and Texas previously met in 2006 and 2008. In 2006, Cat Osterman no-hit the Wildcats at the season-opening Kajikawa Classic before both teams would go on to make the Women's College World Series, where NU finished second and Texas took fifth. In 2008, Northwestern topped Texas, 5-4, at the Cathedral City Classic.

Scouting Report: Texas is the No. 6 national seed after tying for third in the Big XII Conference with Texas A&M, one game behind Missouri and one spot in the standings above Texas Tech (all three of which are teams Northwestern defeated during the regular season). Texas has a .335 team batting average, blasting 58 home runs while notching 84 stolen bases. Lexy Bennett leads the Longhorn attack with a .393 average, 10 home runs and 52 RBIs. Taylor Hoagland has a .331 average with a team-high 53 runs and 16 homers while stealing 17 bases. In the circle, Blaire Luna is the ace, compiling an 18-4 record in 150.2 innings of work, fanning 219 and allowing an opponent's batting average of .195 with an ERA of 2.37. Rachel Fox (13-1; 2.24 ERA) also has been strong in the circle.

Northwestern Returns to the NCAA Tourney After Two-Year Hiatus

Northwestern is making its 13th overall NCAA postseason appearance and its eighth in the 11-year tenure of **Kate** and **Caryl Drohan**. The Wildcats first qualified for the NCAA Tournament under the Drohans in their second season at the helm, 2003, before earning a berth for seven-straight years prior to missing out on the 2010 and 2011 events. Following are a couple of notes about NU's NCAA history:

- NU has a great track record of advancing to the Women's College World Series, making it five times in its previous 12 attempts (42 percent). NU has won its Regional four times (2005-08) since the tournament moved to its current Regional—Super Regional—Women's College World Series format in 2005. NU moved on to fall to DePaul in a 2005 Super Regional before defeating Massachusetts in 2006 and South Carolina in 2007. Northwestern then fell to eventual national champion Arizona State in its 2008 Super.
- NU is hitting the road for its Regional for the fifth time under Drohan, returning to the scene of the Wildcats' first NCAA Regional in the Drohan era in 2003. Northwestern qualified for the then eight-team Austin Regional in 2003, winning its opening game before bowing out with losses to Southwest Texas (now Texas State) and Hawaii. Northwestern hosted its Regional in Evanston in 2006, 2007 and 2008.
- This season marks the first time since 2004 that Northwestern has qualified for the NCAA Tournament and not been one of the nation's top 16 seeds. NU was the No. 9 overall seed in 2005, the No. 4 seed in 2006, the No. 2 seed in 2007, the No. 11 seed in 2008 and the No. 12 seed in 2009.
- In Northwestern's previous 12 appearances in the NCAA Tournament, it has won its opening game 10 times. It's only losses came in 2000—after which it promptly won its next two games—and in 2009, the only year the Wildcats have made the NCAA field and failed to secure at least one win.
- Northwestern's NCAA Tournament history includes a chapter of domination in the mid 1980s when three-time All-American and former USA National Team pitcher Lisa Ishikawa occupied the circle from 1984-87. NU qualified for the NCAA tourney in all four of her seasons, advancing to the Women's College World Series three times. The Wildcats finished third in the country in 1984, fifth in 1985 and seventh in 1986. The only time NU failed to advance was in 1987 after falling in the 11th inning of the third game of a best two-of-three series against Central Michigan. Ishikawa fanned an NCAA-record 469 batters in 1984, a single-season Division I mark which stood for nearly a decade.
- Northwestern's four 1980s NCAA appearances and its return in 2000 came under the direction of NFCA Hall of Fame head coach Sharon J. Drysdale, for whom NU's home ballpark is named. Current head coach Kate Drohan served as an assistant coach under Drysdale on that 2000 team which won a pair of games in its Regional before being eliminated by Oregon State.

The Long and Winding Road to the 2012 NCAA Tournament

Northwestern earned its 2012 NCAA Tournament berth by facing the nation's No. 1 ranked strength of schedule during its early nonconference portion of the season before mounting a furious rally at the end of the year to achieve a .500 record and postseason eligibility. The Wildcats faced seven of the tourney's 16 seeded teams in the first four weekends of the year, picking up huge wins over Texas A&M and Missouri along the way. While NU, which fields just a single senior and seven freshmen or sophomores among its regulars starters, endured early season struggles to gain experience, it continued to fight to pick up big RPI wins against the likes of Texas Tech and Massachusetts while dropping narrow one run losses to teams such as Stanford, South Florida and Florida State.

The beginning of Big Ten play saw NU start 0-4 with 13 errors in those four contests. Northwestern began to turn the corner hard after that conference kickoff, winning B1G series over Wisconsin and Iowa, two teams which would finish second and third in the league. Still, NU found its back against the wall following a series-opening loss to Ohio State that dropped it to 19-26. The Wildcats rebounded to win the final two games against the Buckeyes before sweeping three-game series at Michigan State and versus Illinois to finish the year at 27-27.

Strength of schedule always has been a hallmark of Northwestern's schedule and it has paid dividends both this year and in the high seeds NU has received in past NCAA fields.

NU TOURNAMENT RECORD

The Wildcats have made 12 previous visits to the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 37-28 (25-17 under Kate Drohan) record. NU has made five Women's College World Series appearances (1984, 85, 86, 2006-07), with its best finish being 2006's runner-up performance. This appearance is NU's eighth in the last 11 years and its first since 2009 after NU made it every year from 2003-09. Following are NU's all-time NCAA Tournament results:

HEAD COACH KATE DROHAN

Kate Drohan is in her 11th season at Northwestern's helm after building the program into one of the nation's best. She has led the Wildcats to back-to-back Women's College World Series semifinal appearances in 2006-07 and Big Ten Championships in 2006 and 2008. Drohan took over the 'Cats after serving as an assistant under legendary head coach Sharon Drysdale for four years.

After 10 seasons, Drohan's career record of 357-177-1 gives her a .668 winning percentage. In the five-year stretch from 2005-09, NU compiled a combined record of 215-77, reaching the Super Regional round of the NCAA Tournament four times and becoming the first private school in NCAA history to advance to the WCWS semifinals in consecutive years.

Drohan already has cemented her status as one of the best coaches in Big Ten history, joining three other conference coaches (including Drysdale) as the only coaches to ever take Big Ten schools to the WCWS. Drohan is one of two coaches to make the final pairing in Oklahoma City.

Drohan took over a squad that finished 20-25 in 2001, and led it to a 24-18-1 record in her first season in 2002. Building on its over .500 mark, NU qualified for seven-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2003-09.

Postseason success has become a hallmark of Drohan's teams. Northwestern is 25-17 in the NCAA Tournament since 2003, including a 5-4 mark at the Women's College World Series. Since the advent of Super Regional play in 2005, the Wildcats have won their Regional and advanced to the final 16 in the nation on four different occasions.

Northwestern has earned national respect from the pollsters as well. The Wildcats were ranked in 76-consecutive NFCA coaches polls and 78-straight USA Softball polls dating from March of 2005 until March of 2010. NU spent 27 of those weeks in the top 10 of the NFCA rankings, and earned the program's first No. 1 vote in 2008 after defeating then-No. 1 Arizona and then-No. 3 Texas A&M to begin the year.

Big Ten dominance also has become one of Drohan's hallmarks. After finishing tied for fifth in the conference in her first year, the 'Cats improved to top-four finishes in each of the next six seasons, including capturing Big Ten titles in 2006 and 2008. Northwestern also won the Big Ten Tournament title in 2008 after advancing to the championship game of the event in four of the previous six years. Drohan's career conference record is 126-61 with a .93-.37 mark in the last seven years. NU led the Big Ten in total league victories in four-straight seasons from 2005-08.

In 2006, Northwestern's Big Ten title was its first since 1987, and the Wildcats qualified for the WCWS for the first time in 20 years. In Oklahoma City, the Wildcats made an exciting and perfect 3-0 run through bracket play to the championship series. NU's finish at the WCWS and in the polls—No. 2—both marked program bests. The 'Cats also reached the 50-win plateau for the first time in school history and for the first of two-consecutive seasons.

Northwestern's Incredible Schedule Yields RPI Results

In 2012, Northwestern had a 27-27 overall record, but the incredible strength of the Wildcats' opponents earned NU the nation's No. 1 ranked nonconference strength of schedule, which ultimately got the 'Cats a bid into the NCAA Tournament. NU played 16 games against the most-recent RPI top-30 (all out of conference games), earning wins against No. 8 Texas A&M, No. 14 Missouri and No. 23 Texas Tech—all Big XII foes like the Wildcats' first NCAA Regional opponent, Texas.

Head coach Kate Drohan's philosophy always has been to play the best in the nation. To wit, NU has played 168 games against opponents ranked in the top-25 at the time of those games, winning 73 times (.435) during Drohan's 11-year tenure. The Wildcats' best season against ranked foes under Drohan came in 2007 when Northwestern went 17-7. This season NU played 12 games against opponents ranked at the time of the game.

Against the Pac-12 Conference

The Big Ten and Pac-12 Conferences recently reached an agreement to increase scheduling in all sports between the two entities' member institutions in future years. Playing the Pac-12, which long has been regarded as softball's power conference, is nothing new for NU under current head coach Kate Drohan. Since Drohan took over in 2002, NU has a 35-38 record against the Pac-12. NU has a winning or .500 mark under Drohan against four of the eight original teams in the Pac-12 (NU also is 2-0 against the newest ninth member, Utah):

- 8-3 vs. Oregon State
- 9-4 vs. California
- 6-4 vs. Stanford
- 2-2 vs. Oregon
- 4-5 vs. Arizona State
- 2-5 vs. Washington
- 2-7 vs. UCLA

Northwestern is 2-8 against Arizona, winning two of its last three with the Pac-12 foe.

Northwestern had six games against six different members of the Pac-12 this year, beginning with No. 1 Arizona State and No. 12 Washington at the Kajikawa Classic. NU fell to No. 19 Oregon February 25 at the Cathedral City Classic before taking on a trio of league foes at the March 2-4 DeMarini Invitational hosted by Cal State Fullerton. There, Northwestern faced No. 11 Stanford, Oregon State and No. 2 California.

Drohan Named USA Softball Coach

Northwestern head coach **Kate Drohan** was one of 14 coaches chosen by the Amateur Softball Association of America (ASA) and USA Softball to be part of the 2009-2012 quadrennium. Drohan served as the head coach of the USA Softball Futures Team during the summer of 2010, and remains in the coaching pool for the next two summers. In 2011, she was scheduled to lead the Women's National Team at the Japan Cup before the tournament was canceled following that country's devastating earthquake and tsunami.

Emily Allard, Adrienne Monka Named to Player of the Year Watch List

Senior **Adrienne Monka** and junior **Emily Allard** were named to the 2012 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year watch list. Northwestern has quite a history with the list, earning at least two spots on the 50-member compilation in six of the last seven years. Though neither was selected as a top-25 finalist (Marisa Bast, enjoying a breakout sophomore season ranking first in the B1G in RBIs (63), batting (.414) and total bases (114) while ranking second in home runs (13), slugging (.750) and on-base percentage (.526) also was snubbed), Allard was a top-25 finalist in 2011.

Monka—also a preseason ESPN.com first-team All-America choice at first base—has had another strong season and is ending her career at a torrid pace. The senior is batting .517 over NU’s last 11 games, crushing five home runs and driving in 18 for a 1.138 slugging percentage and a .659 on-base percentage during that time.

Allard has three double-digit hitting streaks this year, a 12-gamer, a 17-game and a current 11-gamer. She led the Big Ten with 78 hits and 35 stolen bases in 54 games. Allard has 19 multi-hit games in 2012, including nine games with three or more base knocks.

Adrienne Monka Named Lowe’s Senior CLASS Award Candidate



Northwestern All-American Adrienne Monka has been named one of 30 candidates for the 2012 Lowe’s Senior CLASS Award, which honors senior student-athletes who excel both on and off the field. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence—community, classroom, character and competition. Though Monka was not one of the 10 chosen finalists this season, Northwestern softball has a long history of success with this award, earning top-10 finalist honors in 2007 (Garland Cooper), 2009 (Tammy Williams) and 2010 (Nicole Pauly).

Some Notes on Northwestern’s Pitching Staff

2012 is the first season where four Wildcats have thrown pitches since 1999. Even more interesting? All four of those pitchers also have hit home runs this season! Some notes:

- Junior **Meghan Lamberth** has been NU’s go-to in the circle this year. Her early highlight came at the Cathedral City Classic when she shut down No. 11 Missouri, allowing only a seventh-inning run on a double play ball in a 7-1 win. Lamberth also has been stuck with some tough losses, falling to No. 11 Stanford, 1-0, No. 21 Florida State, 1-0, and No. 24 South Florida, 2-1. On March 18 versus LIU Brooklyn, Lamberth entered the game in relief in the fifth inning with a tie score and the bases loaded with no outs. She escaped the jam unscathed, then immediately hit a go-ahead homer to lead off the next frame in an eventual 4-3 win. Lamberth pulled off a similar feat March 31 at Wisconsin, entering in the seventh with the bases loaded and getting two forces at home to send the game to extras. She has thrown Big Ten shutouts this year against Minnesota (April 14) and at Michigan State (May 6).

- Freshman **Amy Letourneau** had a strong start to her career, going 2-1 at the season-opening Kajikawa Classic. After fanning 10 batters in her first-career outing, a 6.0-inning complete game win over Texas Tech, Letourneau struck out nine and took a one-hitter into the seventh of an eventual extra-inning victory against No. 17 Texas A&M. Letourneau also broke that game open at the plate with a three-run eighth-inning homer. She tossed her first-career shutout on March 20 versus Hartford, allowing just two hits in five innings. During an April 7 doubleheader against Iowa, Letourneau entered the first game in relief and threw 5.1 scoreless, hitless innings. She then got the start in game two, eventually running that hitless innings streak to a full 8.0 between the two games. Letourneau won B1G Freshman of the Week after hitting a homer and two double and driving seven in game one of a doubleheader at Michigan State before throwing a complete-game four-hitter in game two (May 5-6).

- Sophomore **Sammy Albanese** has done her best work out of the bullpen. Entering games with Oregon State and No. 2 California in relief, Albanese threw 4.0 and 5.0 innings, respectively, allowing just a single run twice. She then earned a save with 2.0 perfect frames versus East Carolina before winning with 4.1 innings against Southern Miss. She hit her first-career home run March 28 versus UIC before entering the circle to nail down the game in the seventh. She has stepped up her game at the plate in recent days, currently batting .474 in NU’s last eight games.

- Sophomore **Jenny Tyler** worked sparingly early in the year, making three relief appearances prior to earning her first-career start at Loyola (Chicago), where she took a hard-luck loss after allowing just one unearned run in 3.2 innings of work. She came back the very next day to throw 3.0 scoreless innings of relief at Northern Illinois, earning a save by giving up just two hits and fanning two.

Northwestern Offense Blends Power and Speed

For a team known as a power program in the late 2000s (NU hit a school-record 85 home runs in 2007), the Wildcats built their offense around speed in 2010-11 before taking a much more balanced approach in 2012. Despite facing the nation's toughest schedule this season, Northwestern ranks 38th in the NCAA in home runs runs per game at 0.93 and 18th in stolen bases per game at 1.67 to rank 21st in runs per game with 5.50. On May 11 against Illinois, NU set a program single-game record with eight steals.

To put NU's power numbers in perspective compared to 2011, consider that four Wildcats combined to hit all 25 of Northwestern's home runs a year ago. On the first *day* of the 2012 season, five different Wildcats hit home runs. Now through 54 games in 2012, NU has 50 home runs, averaging nearly one home run per contest. Nine different 'Cats (more than double the 2011 total) have combined to hit those homers.

Emily Allard Has All-America Ability, Speed

After junior **Emily Allard** set the NU school record by batting .491 last year, she began the 2012 season with hits in NU's first nine games, earning a 12-game hitting streak dating to May 8, 2011. She then had a 17-game hitting streak from March 3 to April 4 before her current 11-game streak began April 25. Allard has hits in 49 of Northwestern's 54 games this season, including 19 multi-hit games and nine games with three or more base knocks. Over the past two seasons, Allard has gone hitless in just 10 of Northwestern's 97 games. She led the Big Ten this year with 78 hits, 14 more than anyone else.

After she was one steal shy of the NU single-season record with 45 last year while being named the 2011 NFCA Golden Shoes Award winner, Allard has 35 swipes in 2012 to make her the third Wildcat to ever reach triple-digit career steals; she currently has 114 and needs just four more to shatter NU's all-time record of 118 in just three years time.

The career prep outfielder has started all but three games in her NU career at shortstop, continuing a strong NU pedigree at the position. From 2005-09, NU's shortstop earned All-America honors each year (Stephanie Churchwell in 2005; Tammy Williams from 2006-09).

Adrienne Monka Aiming for Third All-America Award

Senior first baseman **Adrienne Monka** has endured multiple surgeries during her career, playing through pain while not letting it limit her performance on the diamond. Now healthy after yet another procedure last offseason, Monka is closing her career in style, winning two of the last three B1G Player of the Week awards. In NU's last 11 games, Monka is hitting .517 with five home runs and 18 RBIs for a 1.138 slugging percentage and a .659 on-base percentage during that time.

Monka currently ranks first all-time at NU in slugging (.758), on-base percentage (.557) and walks (189), second in RBIs (194), third in home runs (54) and fourth in batting (.360) and total bases (358).

Some incredible Monka numbers:

- While starting every game at first base in the last three seasons, Adrienne Monka did not commit an error between May 8, 2009 and Feb. 11, 2012—a string of 97 games and 622 chances. She is a career .992 fielder (1,198 putouts, 56 assists, 10 errors).
- Monka has hit double-digit homers in each of her four years at NU, earning so much respect for her power that she currently ranks eighth in NCAA history with 189 walks.
- Monka led the nation in 2011 with a .707 on-base percentage and 1.53 walks per game; both numbers rank second all-time in NCAA Division I single-season history.
- Monka reached base in 25-straight plate appearances from April 16 to May 4, 2011. She was a *Sports Illustrated* Face in the Crowd in the May 30, 2011, issue for the streak.

Mari Majam's New Swing

Sophomore **Mari Majam** comes from a softball family. Her oldest sister, Allison, played at Colorado State from 2007-10 while the middle sister, Kelly, led the NCAA with 30 home runs as a freshman at Hawaii in 2010. Mari showed a flash of the family power as a Northwestern freshman in 2011 with 37 percent of her hits going for extra bases, but speed and getting on base are her weapons of choice. Partway through the early portion of the 2012 season, Majam transitioned to become a full-time slapper, immediately seeing her batting average rise .165 points from Feb. 26 to now. Her overall productivity has soared, as well: In NU's last 33 games, Majam has scored 36 runs to rank third in the Big Ten with 45 total runs scored this year. Crazy stat? She has eight more runs than hits (37) this year! And just when you thought it was safe to creep in on the newly-minted slapper? She also unleashed a booming home run April 7 against Iowa.

Marisa Bast, Northwestern's Rifle Arm, Flashes Cannon of a Bat

After an All-Big Ten freshman season in which she started 42 of Northwestern's 43 games at second base, sophomore **Marisa Bast** has moved across the diamond to take over third-base duties for the Wildcats in 2012. Traditionally a position of stability for Northwestern, Bast will become just the third full-time starter at the hot corner since 2005, following in the footsteps of Darcy Sengewald (2005-08) and Robin Thompson (2008-11). The moves makes sense when considering not only Bast's athleticism, but her rifle of an arm.

At the plate, Bast's weapon of choice is the cannon shield wields as a bat, using it to punish opponents who chose to walk two-time All-American Adrienne Monka. Hitting behind Monka, Bast ranks ninth in the entire nation with 1.17 RBIs per game while leading the Big Ten Conference with 63 total RBIs, a .414 batting average and 114 total bases. She ranks second in the B1G with her .750 slugging, .526 OBP and 13 home runs.

Freshmen Wildcats Clawing Competition

Northwestern's freshman class has made a quick impact on the 2012 season, especially given the Wildcats' young roster featuring just a single senior seeing regular playing time. How deep is the class? Three different members have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors this year. Outfielder **Olivia Duehr** was the first on Feb. 27 after batting .417 with two home runs and eight RBIs at the Cathedral City Classic. On March 20, she lit up Massachusetts for a career-best six RBIs in a two home run performance, first hitting a fourth-inning grand slam in a 4-4 tie, then hitting a game-ending two-run shot in the fifth. On April 7, she became the fifth member of the elite Sharon J. Drysdale Field Roof Club—see the note in the gray box on page six of these notes for more.

Amy Letourneau is 11-9 in the circle while driving in 33 at the plate. Her two-pronged game was showcased early in February during an 8.0-inning complete-game win over No. 17 Texas A&M in which she also hit a three-run homer in the eighth inning. Letourneau has been a force in B1G play, batting .348 with 18 RBIs and a .761 slugging percentage. She won B1G Freshman of the Week after driving in seven on two doubles and a grand slam in the first game of a doubleheader at Michigan State. She then had a complete-game four-hitter in game two. Earlier in the season, she threw a combined 8.0-straight no-hit innings between both ends of a doubleheader with Iowa 7.

Second baseman **Anna Edwards** was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week last week after helping NU to a sweep of Illinois to cap the regular season, clubbing a double, triple and home run in the series, the latter of which tied the series opener in its late stages. **Andrea DiPrima** has nine starts to her name, earning the starting DP job for a spell and hitting .364 in those games. **Julia Kuhn** also has a start and notched her first-career hit in a win over Fairfield on March 16. All told, NU's six-member freshman class has a combined 155 starts and 186 appearances.

Welcome Home, Rivy!

Northwestern's volunteer assistant coach for the 2012 season is former Northwestern volunteer assistant coach **Amanda Rivera**, whose last stay in Evanston coincided (and not by coincidence) with the Wildcats' back-to-back semifinal appearances at the Women's College World Series in 2006-07. With Rivera's help, NU set school single-season records with 85 home runs, 350 runs scored and 326 RBIs in 2007. Rivera left to make coaching stops at N.C. State (2008) and Indiana (2009-11) before returning to her Chicago roots. A 2004 graduate of UIC and a longtime private hitting instructor in the Chicago area, Rivera also coached club ball as the head coach of the Oak Park Windmills from 2002-07. While with the Windmills, Rivera coached eventual three-time All-Big Ten NU slugger Michelle Batts.

Chicago's B1G Ten Team

The Wildcats have never been more popular in the Chicagoland area. On the eve of the 2012 season, Northwestern hosted a Feb. 4 open practice. Buses from the area and even different states filled the parking lots, unloading more than 400 coaches and players taking in NU's workout. The 'Cats spent more than 30 minutes signing autographs for all comers.

Northwestern's Defense Picking Up the Pace

With new starters at four spots on the diamond, NU's defense suffered early in the year. That trend was especially noticeable in the first four Big Ten games of the year when NU combined to make 13 total errors. As the season has progressed, NU fielders have become much more comfortable and proficient, committing just four errors the Wildcats' last 11 Big Ten games—including just one during their six-game winning streak to end the season.

THE ROOF CLUB

Few clubs in sports are as small or exclusive as Northwestern's Sharon J. Drysdale Field Roof Club. On April 7 against Iowa, freshman **Olivia Duehr** became just the fifth member when she crushed a three-run home run down the left-field line that landed just over the gutters and on the roof of McGaw Hall, which houses Northwestern's Welsh-Ryan Arena and borders NU's softball park beyond left field. On April 29 against Ohio State, **Adrienne Monka** also found the roof, becoming the first person to ever hit two homers up there in a single career. In the 30-year history of Sharon J. Drysdale Field, only six fair home runs balls have reached the roof of the building—and all six of those blasts have come since 2007 off the bats of NU players:
