John Musachio is in his third year as Head Baseball Coach at Oakland University, following two years as the top assistant coach at OU. In two years as OU's Head Coach, Musachio has led the program to 37 wins, including victories over Notre Dame and Oral Roberts during the 2009 season. OU's 22 victories in 2009 marked the second highest total in the school's DI era.

Assisting Coach Musachio on the camp staff will be the Oakland University assistant coaches as well as members of the 2009-2010 Golden Grizzlies baseball team.

This camp is designed for the grades school and junior high aged pitcher looking to polish and refine skills as well as learn the basic fundamentals of pitching mechanics. We will meet on four consecutive Sundays, September 13- October 4. Each session will be an hour in duration (1015-1115am) Coach Musachio will be working with this small group, covering every facet of pitching development.

DIRECTIONS TO OAKLAND UNIVERSITY

From I-75 South or Detroit Metro Airport:
I-94 East to I-75 North. Exit I-75 at exit 79, University Drive. At the University Drive exit ramp make a right onto University Drive. Maintain your direction in the far two right lanes and Oakland University is a mile ahead. Upon approaching OU stay to your right and upon entering campus you will approach a traffic circle. At this circle, make a right onto Meadow Brook Drive. When you come to the end of Meadow Brook Drive make a left onto Pioneer Drive. Follow Pioneer Drive to the parking structure on the right. Park in lower level of garage and walk down to baseball field.

From I-75 North:
I-75 South to exit 79, University Drive. At the University Drive exit ramp make a left onto University Drive. For further directions, see above.
