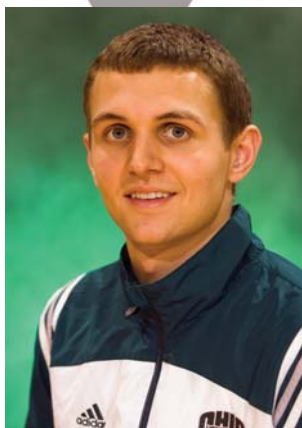

### Eastern Michigan Men Named 2006 Cross Country Preseason Favorites for Second Consecutive Year

**Cleveland, Ohio-** The Mid American Conference released its 2006 preseason poll on Wednesday, August 16. The preseason poll, voted on by the head coaches, named Eastern Michigan men's cross country team as the winner of both the regular season and the MAC Championship for the second year in a row.

The Eagles, who are the MAC 2005 defending champions, placed fifth at the 2005 NCAA Great Lake Regionals and 24th at the NCAA championships. Head coach John Goodridge, tabbed coach of the year for 2005, returns first team All-MAC selections **Corey Nowitzke** (Sr.), who placed second (24:25) overall in last year's MAC championship, and **Josh Karanja** (So.), who placed sixth (24:47) overall in last year's MAC championship. Also returning are second team All-MAC selections **Kyle Mena** (So.) and **Alan Walker** (Sr.).

Miami University was tabbed to finish second for the 2006 regular season. Warren Mandrell, Miami's head coach, will return 10 starters from the '05 season and will welcome three freshmen for the '06 season. The RedHawks, who finished second in the MAC Championship and placed 22nd at the NCAA Pre-Invitational last year, look forward to another great season.

Central Michigan University, who placed 13th at the NCAA Regional Championship last year was voted to finish third by the MAC head coaches. The Chippewas will return 10 starters this season. **Matt Loiselle** (Jr.), finished 92nd (30:56) in the 2005 NCAA Championships, **Jeff Powers** (Sr.) finished 27th (32:02) and **Andrew Manning** (Jr.) finished 87th (33:41.3) in the 2005 NCAA Regional Championships. Seniors **Tom Ruddy** and **Frank Therrian** will also round out the top returners for CMU.

Kent State University was selected to finish fourth for the upcoming season. Finishing in fourth place in 2005, Kent State looks to move up under the direction of first year coach Mark Croghan. The Golden Flashes, who finished 15th at the NCAA Regional Championship, will return five seniors. All-MAC second team selection **Seth Hutchinson** is one of five veteran starters for the Flashes. **Ben Weitmanschen** (Sr.), **Mike Inge** (Sr.), **Ray Armstrong** (Sr.) and **Ryan Spellman** (Sr.) conclude the list.

Ohio University and the University at Buffalo round out the top six finishers for the 2006 preseason poll. Ohio, who is ranked number five, placed third in the MAC championships and 11th at NCAA Regionals last year. Ohio will welcome back three seniors, two juniors and seven sophomores. The Bulls were picked to finish in sixth place. Buffalo finished their '05 season with a seventh place finish in the MAC and 11th place finish at the NCAA Northeast Regional. The Bulls welcome back four seniors, four juniors and two sophomores. Following behind Buffalo is Akron University at number seven who finished sixth in the MAC Championships and 16th in the NCAA Regional Championships last year. The Zips look forward to the return of **David Howard** who was named to the All-MAC second team and placed 10th (25:06) in the MAC Championships. Bowling Green State University holds the eighth position for the 2006 poll. The Falcons finished eighth at the MAC Championships and 27th at the NCAA Regional Championships. Coach Wells will welcome back three top runners. The University of Toledo concludes the 2006 preseason poll at number nine. The Rockets will welcome back six senior runners as they look to a successful '06 season.

The University at Buffalo will host the 2006 Mid American Conference Cross Country Championships on Saturday, October 28 in Buffalo, N.Y.

### University of Toledo Women Voted Number One for '06 Season

**Cleveland, Ohio-** The league office released the 2006 women's cross country preseason poll today. The preseason poll voted on by the MAC cross country head coaches, tagged Toledo women's cross country team as the winner of both the regular season and the MAC Championship.

The Rockets were the 2005 MAC runner up team and won their sixth top eight finish at the NCAA Regional Championships, giving them the highest finish by a MAC school. Coach Kevin Hadsell will return nine key runners from the 2005 season. Sophomore **Dagmara Handzlik** became the 3rd MAC female to qualify individually for a NCAA Championship, placed second in last year's MAC championship and was named to the 2005 All-MAC first team and the First Team NCAA All-Region. Also returning are seniors **Judit Kocsis, Candance Cromley, Erica Moriarty** and **Sierra Smith** along with Juniors **Nicole Camp, Alison Tittle, Jennifer Spieldenner** and **Emilia Dimitriu**.

Ohio University was tabbed to finish second for the 2006 regular season. The Bobcats ended their 2005 season at fourth place in the MAC championship and 10th at the NCAA Regional Championship. Coach Clay Calkin will welcome back seven starters. Among those seven starters are **Carime Reinhart** (Jr.), All-MAC First Team and Academic All-MAC team selection. Reinhart placed fourth in the MAC Championships with a time of 17:49 and was named the fourth person to have the highest GPA in the NCAA (3.972). **Andrea Maas** (Sr.), another returning starter, was named to the 2005 All-MAC second team and finished in 13th place at the MAC championship last year.

Miami University was voted to finish third by the MAC head coaches. The RedHawks finished at number five during the 2005 MAC Championship and went on to take the 13th position at the NCAA Regional Championships. Head coach Dr. Richard Ceronie welcomes back four juniors and four sophomores. **Jennie Stoll** (Jr.) was the only RedHawk to receive all conference honors as she was named to the All-MAC second team after placing ninth in the MAC championships.

Western Michigan University were selected to finish fourth for the upcoming season. The Broncos who finished sixth overall in the MAC Championships and 21st in the NCAA Regionals will welcome back four seniors for the 2006 season. **Nicole Blake** (Sr.), **Rachel Bumann** (Sr.), **Katie Kelel** (Sr.) and **Christi Valanty** (Sr.) will return with hopes of clinching a MAC Championship title.

Ball State University and Bowling Green State University round out the top six finishers for the 2006 preseason poll. Ball State took third place in the MAC Championship and 12th at the NCAA Regional Championships last year. The Cardinals welcome back five letterwinners for the 2006 season. Bowling Green finished their '05 season with a tenth place finish in the MAC and 22nd in the NCAA Regional Championship. The Falcons will welcome back seven starters. Following Bowling Green State is the University of Akron at number seven. The Zips were the 2005 MAC champions and placed 11th at the NCAA Regional Championships. Coach Scott Jones was named Coach of the Year for '05. Akron University named three runners on the All-MAC First Team and one Runner on the All-MAC Second Team. **Beata Rudzinskz** will return this year coming off a NCAA individual title (17:24) in the 2005 post season. In at number eight is Kent State University who finished their '05 season tied at number seven in the MAC and 15th at the NCAA Regional Championship. The Golden Flashes will return seven veteran runners. The University at Buffalo clinched the ninth position on the poll. Buffalo finished ninth in the MAC and 16th at the NCAA Regional Championships. The Bulls will welcome six seniors back including **Jennifer Jezorski** who was named to the Academic All-MAC Team for 2005. Central Michigan University concludes the top ten teams for the 2006 preseason poll. Central Michigan who tied with Kent State for a seventh place finish in the MAC ended their season with a 24th place at the NCAA Regional Championship. The Chippewas return Sophomore **Jackie Rivard**. Concluding the 2006 preseason poll are Eastern Michigan University at number eleven and Northern Illinois at number twelve.

The University at Buffalo will host the 2006 Mid American Conference Cross Country Championships on Saturday, October 28 in Buffalo, N.Y.
