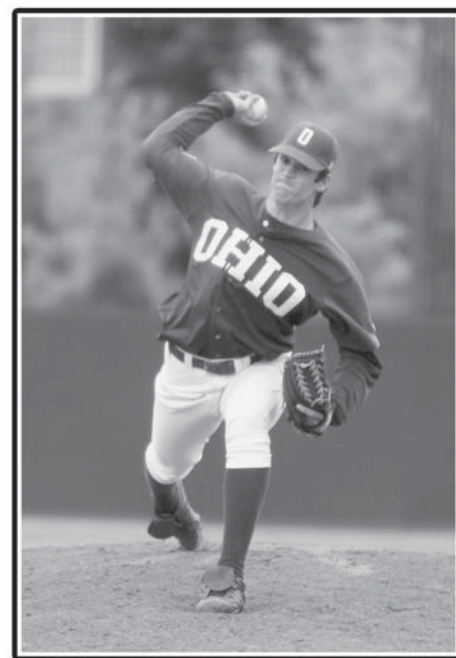

# SEASON OUTLOOK

With eight of nine regular positional starters returning from last season, the 2007 Ohio baseball team and Head Coach Joe Carbone look to improve on last season's 22-25 overall record and third-place finish in the Mid-American Conference East Division.

The 2006 Bobcats finished 14-13 in the MAC and took third place in the East Division but fell just short of qualifying for the MAC Tournament. This year's team returns a total of 18 letterwinners from last year and loses just three. The three will not be easy to replace, however, as they are All-American double-threat Anthony Gressick and starting pitchers Derek Witt and Yale Silverman. Gressick was the third regular starting pitcher for the Bobcats last season, leaving the team the entire weekend rotation to fill.

## Starting on the Mound

The starting pitching could be the key to the 2007 season for Ohio after losing its top three starters. The Bobcats will look to incoming transfer **Matt Smith** for a dependable arm in the rotation in 2007. The junior adds a solid left arm to the rotation after going 13-1 with a 3.37 ERA at Allegany Community College in Maryland last season. Smith was named the team's most valuable pitcher and led Allegany to a fourth-place finish at the Division II Junior College World Series.

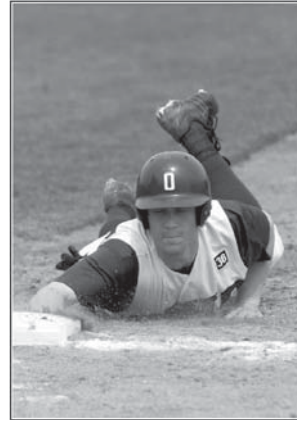
The rest of the starting spots are up for grab amongst a variety of Bobcat pitchers. Sophomore **Adam Goodpasture** is one candidate after his freshman season in which he led the team with a 2.55 ERA in 17.2 innings pitched. The left-hander made 17 appearances last year but all were in relief. Seniors **Zeke Isaacs** and **Dan Weiss** are also in the mix for a starting job. Each made one start last season but primarily worked out of the bullpen. Weiss went 2-1 in 12 appearances with a 6.92 ERA, while Isaacs was 0-1 in six appearances with a 6.97 ERA. Sophomores **Kurt Smith** and **Matt Schlarb** will also compete for a spot in the rotation. Smith went 0-4 last season making three starts, while Schlarb threw nine innings last season and made one start.

## In Relief

The bullpen roles will remain somewhat unsettled until the starting rotation has been filled. Sophomore **Chris Rigo** served as the team's closer last season but could see a move to the rotation this year if he is needed. Rigo posted six saves last season with a 4.50 ERA.

He performed well in summer league play in 2006, earning All-Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League (GLSCL) Second Team honors. Rigo went 2-3 with a 1.59 ERA in nine appearances and struck out 20 hitters in 28.1 innings while limiting opposing batters to a .206 average.

Sophomore **Zach Elmer** posted the third-best ERA in the Bobcat bullpen last season, but an injury will keep him out to start the season. A trio of upper classmen also returns to the bullpen in juniors **Cody Neyman** and **Andrew Shisila** and senior **Daniel Utts**. Neyman made five appearances last season with a 6.35 ERA while Shisila posted an 8.68 ERA in 9.1 innings. Utts appeared seven times in relief last season. **Sophomore Kevin Mementowski** will also work out of the bullpen after making eight relief appearances last season.



percentage. He also scored 20 times, smacked 12 doubles and swiped nine bags for the Southern Ohio Copperheads.

Seniors **J.T. Osburn** and **Jared Willis**, sophomore **Kirk Payne** and true freshman **Marc Krauss** will also vie for time in the Bobcat

outfield this season. Osburn played in 26 games last season, starting the last seven, and hit .277 with five doubles. Willis, who is a three-time letterwinner, hit .209 in 67 at-bats last year and hit two home runs, one of inside-the-park variety. Payne played in 35 games and hit .250 with two home runs and 16 RBI a season ago. Krauss was a three-time all-conference selection and career .481 hitter at Patrick Henry High School. Redshirt freshman **Chris Pitts** and true freshman **Zach Roll** could also see time in the outfield this year, along with walk-on freshman **Jeremie Rehak**. Rehak showed good speed and won a spot on the roster with his performance in fall competition.

## Around the Horn

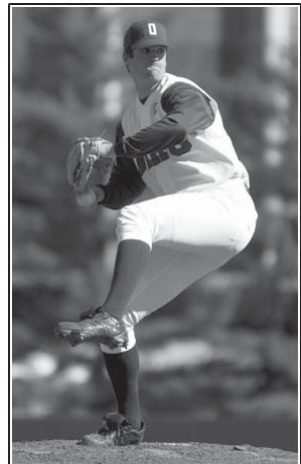
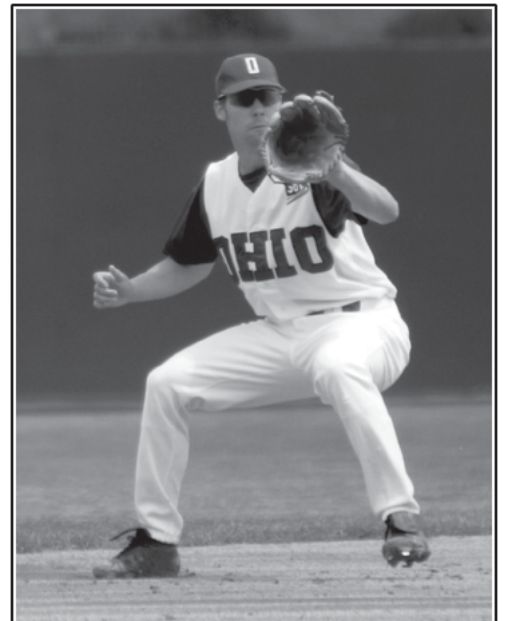
The infield also returns a few key contributors from last season, including senior middle infielder **Bryant Witt**. Witt finished third on the team last season with a .349 average while tallying 36 runs scored and 27 RBI. He struck out just 12 times in 166 at-bats. Witt spent most of the season at shortstop, but will see time at both second base and shortstop this season.



## In the Outfield

The Bobcat outfield looks strong in 2007. Returning is 2006 All-MAC Second Team centerfielder **Willie Walker**, who led the MAC with a .377 batting average last season. Walker, a senior, finished second on the team with four home runs and 39 RBI last season and drew 20 walks against just 21 strikeouts. He is also a defensive asset for the Bobcats in centerfield and made just one error all of last season.

Joining Walker in the outfield is junior rightfielder **Matt Stiffler**, who batted an even .300 with three home runs and 28 RBI last year. Stiffler played in the Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League last summer and was named the ninth best prospect in the league by *Baseball America*. Stiffler was named a Ron Miller Co-Top Position Prospect in the GLSCL after hitting .367 in 35 games played and driving in 20 runs on the season. He slugged .500 while posting a .447 on-base





Incoming transfer **Zach Hartle** will start the season at third base after transferring to Ohio from Glen Oaks Community College. Hartle hit .344 with 12 doubles and 23 RBI last season and was the Region XII Defensive Player of the Year. He will also bring some speed to the Bobcat lineup as he swiped 22 bases last year. Playing along side Hartle on the left side of the infield will be sophomore shortstop **Hayden Johnston**. Johnston, the team's third baseman last season, was the only Bobcat to start all 47 games last season and hit .290 for the year. He scored 36 times last year and drove in 25 runs.

Also returning to the infield are senior **Jon Vondrell** and sophomore **Brandon Besl**. Both could see time as the team's first baseman or designate hitter. Vondrell finished the 2006 season hitting at a .289 clip in 97 at-bats. He went deep two times with 18 RBI. Besl also hit two home runs while driving in 24 and hitting .238 in 130 at-bats. Krauss and fellow freshman **Jerod Yakubik** may also see time at first base this season. Yakubik was an All-Eastern District First Team selection two times at Zanesville Bishop Rosecrans and hit

.492 with 19 RBI and 21 runs scored last year in his final season of high school competition.

#### Behind the Plate

Ohio has a trio of catchers that will see time in 2007 in sophomore **Chris Klimko**, junior **Jason Selhorst** and freshman **Kris McDonough**. The team lost Matt Gault for the season due to injury. Klimko is the team's projected early-season starter and saw the majority of the time behind the dish last season. He hit .214 in 103 at-bats with two home runs and 16 RBI and drew 11 walks against nine strikeouts. Selhorst played in 23 games, hitting .264 and driving in nine runs. McDonough batted .452 with nine home runs and 30 RBI in his senior season at Upper St. Clair High School. He was named to the *Pittsburgh Post-Gazette* All-Section Team three times in his high school career.

#### Designated Hitter

The designated hitter could change day-to-day depending on the opposing pitcher. The left-handed hitting **Dusty Hammond** will likely see most of the at-bats against right-handed starting pitching. Hammond was a

regular in the Bobcat infield last season but will move to the designated hitter role this year. He was fourth on the Bobcat roster last season with a .335 average and also posted 26 runs scored and 18 RBI. Hammond showed good plate discipline as he drew 17 walks on the year while striking out only 19 times in 182 at-bats. Vondrell could serve as the team's primary designated hitter against left-handed starting pitching, while others may step into the role depending on the opposing team's starter.

### Season Tickets & All-Sport Pass

If you plan on attending numerous home games, season tickets or an all-sport pass could be your best value. For just \$20 you receive one ticket for every home baseball game in 2007. Season tickets are just \$10 for youths ages 3-18. An all-sport pass costs \$40 for adults and \$20 for youths and provides admission to all baseball and softball games as well as all remaining women's basketball games.
