Camp Staff

Joe Carbone, Ohio Baseball Head Coach Joe Carbone enters his 21st season as one of the most distinguished coaches in Ohio history. Carbone has won over 500 games during his tenure at Ohio and is the all-time leader in wins at the school in any sport. In the process, Carbone has returned the Bobcats to perennial championship contenders. In addition, Carbone has been named MAC Coach of the Year twice (1991, 1997), also earning Mid-east Region Coach of the Year in 1997. Working directly with the hitters and defense, Carbone has been instrumental in the breaking of 49 individual regular season and career records as well as 49 single season team marks. Coach Carbone is a veteran of many years of camp work and is a frequent speaker at clinics throughout Ohio, the United States and Canada. During his 20 years at Ohio he has led the team to six top-three finishes in the Mid-American Conference.

Scott Malinowski, Ohio Assistant Coach, enters his 6th season as a member of the Bobcat coaching staff. Malinowski was a member of the Bobcats as a player from 1995-1998. He was a Second Team All-MAC selection and Ohio's defensive player of the year in 1997 and 1998 as well as the Bobcat's team captain in 1998. Malinowski then went on to play infield in the New York Mets organization in 1999 and 2000.

Andrew See, is currently in his third season as pitching coach for the Bobcats. See has served as an assistant coach at Appalachian State in 2005 and 2006 and was an assistant during the 2004 season at North Carolina-Greensboro. As a player for the Bobcats, See earned Mid-east Region and Mid-American Conference First Team honors as a senior in 2001. See then played professionally for the Chillicothe Paints of the independent Frontier League helping them to Eastern Division titles in 2001 and 2003 and leading them in saves in 2003 while also serving as the team's bullpen coach.

In addition to the above-mentioned coaches, the remainder of the instructional staff will be composed of successful and experienced coaches and scouts from collegiate and professional baseball.

Camp Costs and Registration

To assure a spot at camp, pre-registration is encouraged. To pre-register, either simply mail a completed registration form accompanied by full payment or you may register on-line. The fee for the prospect camp is \$205. **If cancellation of your registration is necessary, you will receive a \$75 refund if we are notified at least two weeks before the camp. If cancellation occurs less than two weeks before the camp you are entitled to no refund.** Each athlete will be provided lunch and one numbered T-shirt.

Prospect Camp

(2009, 2010, & 2011 High School Grads Only)

The prospect camp is restricted to 2009, 2010, & 2011 high school graduates. A maximum of 72 prospective student-athletes will be admitted (18 per team). When each defensive position fills up, we will no longer continue registration for that particular position. Players need to pick a primary position where they will participate during the game. If an individual desires to be evaluated at a secondary position, they can do so during the defensive evaluations. The Ohio University baseball staff, college coaches from all divisions, and professional scouts from Ohio and surrounding states will be in attendance. In recent years, both college coaches and professional scouts have relied heavily on prospect camps and showcases to see and evaluate players. **Nine of the eleven scholarship student/athletes in the 2004 and seven of twelve in the 2005 recruiting classes for Ohio University Baseball have attended one of our previous Prospect/Showcase Camps.** All baseball instructions, evaluations, games, and workouts will be conducted at **Bob Wren Stadium**. The strength and conditioning instruction will take place in the Carin Center, the Ohio strength training facility in Peden Stadium.
