### OHIO FACES FIRST PLACE MIAMI

Coming off a Mid-American Conference series win last weekend at Akron, the Ohio baseball team looks to continue its recent winning ways in the conference Friday when the Bobcats kick off a three-game series against Miami. The RedHawks are 13-6 in conference action, good for first place in the East Division.

### THE COACHES

Ohio's **Joe Carbone** is in his 19th season at Ohio and has posted a 553-463-2 record. Carbone is second all-time in the MAC in both overall and conference wins. He passed Stan Sanders for second place on the MAC all-time wins list March 3 with a win over Otterbein. Miami's **Dan Simonds** is in his second season with the RedHawks and has led them to a 59-43 record heading into play Friday.

### QUICK HITS

- Ohio is 38-36 all-time against Miami since Carbone became head coach in 1989.

- Miami took two of three from Ohio last season in Oxford. The Bobcats won game one 7-4 but then fell 11-5 and 6-2.

- Ohio has not won a season series against Miami since taking three of four in 2002.

- Matt Stiffler is now in sole possession of 3rd place on Ohio's single season walks list with 41. Stiffler will tie Jeff Rook for second on the list with his next free pass.

- Ohio has recorded at least 10 hits in each of the last seven games. The Bobcats are hitting .410 during that span.

### RECENT BOBCAT ACTION

Ohio was last in action on Wednesday in a 6-4, non-conference road loss at West Virginia. The Bobcats allowed four runs in the first inning and could not claw back. Ohio was also in action Tuesday when the Bobcat bats exploded for a season-best 20 runs in a 20-3 home victory against Dayton. A total of 13 different Bobcats collected at least one hit while 11 Bobcats tallied at least one RBI and 10 scored at least one run.

The Bobcats were last in MAC action last weekend and took two of three from East Division foe Akron. Ohio put on its hitting shoes with 54 hits and 32 runs scored in the series. The Bobcats took the opener 13-6, erasing an early 3-0 deficit.

Ohio dropped game two of the series by a score of 15-7 but rebounded with a 12-8 win in the rubber match. Ohio led by as much as 8-0 but Akron climbed to within a run before Ohio tacked on some insurance with a two-run home run from Chris Klimko in the eighth inning.

### STIFFLER LOOKS FOR BIG SERIES

Junior outfielder Matt Stiffler, who was named MAC East Player of the Week on Monday, was held hitless in Wednesday's loss but has been red hot over the past 14 games. Stiffler is 29-for-61 (.475) with three home runs, 16 RBI and 20 runs scored in the last 14 games. He has also tallied four doubles and four triples to make 11 of his hits count for extra bases. Stiffler has walked 11 times against just seven strikeouts in the last 14 contests for a .562 on-base percentage. His batting average has risen from .306 to .362 since April 20, good for second on the team.

### RIGO SET TO DUEL WITH ELY

Sophomore Chris Rigo will make his seventh start of the season Friday and has a tall task as he is set to face Miami ace John Ely. Rigo has a 1-3 record and a 5.97 ERA in his six starts this season. He has made five starts in MAC play with a 6.54 ERA. Rigo's best start came April 13 at Eastern Michigan, when he allowed two runs in an eight-inning, complete game loss.

Ely has been lights out again for Miami after earning All-MAC First Team honors last season. He is 7-2 with a 2.83 ERA on the year. Ely defeated Ohio last season as he limited the Bobcats to one earned run on three hits in seven innings.

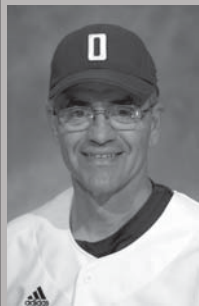

# Ohio Baseball Series Notes: vs. Miami - May 11, 2007

## Head Coach Joe Carbone



**Ohio, '70**  
**553-463-2 at Ohio**  
**553-463-2 career**  
**19th season**

Currently in his 19th season in the Ohio dugout, Bobcat Head Baseball Coach Joe Carbone continues to build on his status as the institution's winningest coach.

Carbone has compiled a 553-463-2 overall record in his 19th season as head coach of his alma mater, more than any coach in any sport at Ohio, and has joined a list of only three other coaches in Mid-American Conference history to reach the 500-win plateau. Carbone's 533 total wins at the end of the 2006 campaign placed him third all-time in MAC history behind only Fred Decker (791) and Stan Sanders (534). He has since passed Sanders on that list. His 288 conference wins heading into 2007 was second all-time behind only Decker's 401 victories.

Carbone gained his 500th career win on April 15, 2005 with a 12-3 decision over Marshall and a 9-4 victory over Cleveland State on March 29, 2004 saw him overtake Bob Wren to become the all-time leader in wins at the school. During his tenure, the Bobcats have won two Mid-American Conference titles, the most recent coming in 1997. That 1997 season also produced the most wins ever by an Ohio baseball team in one season with 43.

During the Carbone era, Bobcat teams have almost completely rewritten Ohio's record books. Working directly with the hitters and defense, he has been instrumental in the breaking of 49 individual regular-season and career records as well as 49 single-season team marks. In 2001, 12 individual and 19 team records were set when the Bobcats led the NCAA in home runs as a team (122). In 2002, outfielder Mike Arbinger was the first Ohio player to bat over .400 since 1985. In addition, Carbone has been named MAC Coach of the Year twice (1991, 1997), also earning Mid-East Region Coach of the Year in 1997.

Over the course of his coaching career, 37 players have signed professional baseball contracts. Carbone has coached 35 first-team All-MAC and 28 All-Mideast Region performers during his time at Ohio.

Carbone's success is not limited to his coaching career as he was a talented player for Ohio as well. In three seasons as a starter (1968-70), he proved himself versatile and saw time at second base, shortstop, third base and in the outfield. He captained the 1970 Ohio team that advanced to the College World Series.

His playing days did not end after the completion of his Bobcat career. After signing with Kansas City following the 1970 season, Carbone played for Kingsport and Waterloo in the Royals' organization. He then traveled to Italy, acting as a player/coach for Edipen.

Carbone is a member of three halls of fame. He is a member of the Tioga County Athletics Hall of Fame and was a charter member of the Great Lakes League Hall of Fame. This January, he was inducted into the George Whitfield Baseball Clinic Hall of Fame.

### WALKER DRIVING THEM IN

Senior outfielder Willie Walker became the first Bobcat with five hits in a game this season when he went 5-for-6 with four RBI singles Tuesday. The five hits was also a career-best for Walker. Despite a no-RBI performance Wednesday, Walker has collected 14 RBI over the last six games and has 38 RBI on the season, third on the team and one shy of the leaders at 39. Walker has gone 18-for-29 (.586) over the past six games with 14 RBI and six runs scored. He has raised his season average from .286 to .339 in that span.

### STIFFLER THIRD ON WALKS LIST

Junior Matt Stiffler drew another walk Tuesday and is now in sole possession of third place on Ohio's single season walks list. Stiffler has 41 walks on the season and will move into a second-place tie with Jeff Rook with his next free pass. The Ohio record for walks in a single season is 46, set by Matt Engleka in 1995.

### OFFENSE RUNNING IN HIGH GEAR

The Ohio bats have been as hot as any team in the nation over the past seven games as the Bobcats have posted a 5-2 record and a team batting average of .410 over that span. The Bobcats have scored 73 runs in the last seven games with eight home runs as a team and 67 RBI. Ohio has tallied at least 10 hits in each of those games. The team has 17 or more hits four times in the last seven games and has raised its season average from .274 to .296 in that time.

### HARTLE HITS IN NINTH STRAIGHT

Junior Zach Hartle, who has played in every game since shortstop Hayden Johnston was lost for the season on April 17, went 2-for-4 Wednesday and has now hit in nine-straight contests. Hartle began playing full-time April 18 against West Virginia and carried a .156 average at that point. He has really turned it on during the streak as he is 16-for-37 (.432) with six RBI and 10 runs scored from the lower part of the lineup. The nine-game streak is the third longest by a Bobcat this season. Brandon Besl's 13-game streak was the longest.

### SCOUTING THE REDHAWKS

The RedHawks enter play this weekend with an overall record of 26-18 and are in first place in the MAC East Division with a 13-6 conference mark. Miami has been spectacular at home with a 14-3 record but has gone just 8-14 when on the road this season.

The RedHawks are coming off a 7-2 loss to Cincinnati on Wednesday but have won seven of their last nine games overall. Miami defeated Big Ten Conference member Purdue by a score of 9-4 on Tuesday and took two of three from MAC East member Buffalo last weekend. The RedHawks took the first two games of the series by scores of 3-2 (10 innings) and 7-0 before dropping the finale to the Bulls, 12-8.

Miami's offense has been solid this season and enters play with a .294 team batting average, just two points lower than Ohio's. Jordan Petraitis leads the squad with a .341 clip and is second on the team with 30 RBI. He is tied with Eric Darlage for the team lead with four home runs. Darlage has added a .326 average and 27 RBI to the Miami lineup while Chris Nadeau leads the team with 34 RBI. He is hitting .321 on the season.

The RedHawk pitching staff has been very good this year and has compiled a 4.32 team ERA. Ely leads the starting rotation with seven wins and a 2.83 ERA and has rung up 78 hitters in his staff-best 82.2 innings pitched. Connor Graham has been solid in 10 starts with a 4.19 ERA in 62.1 innings pitched.

The Miami bullpen has been anchored by both Bobby Oberschlake and Bailey Pratt. Pratt has seen time as the team's closer and is tied for the team lead with four saves. He has a 1.67 ERA in 21 appearances. Oberschlake has also appeared in 21 contests and leads the team with a 1.08 ERA. Reece Asbury has also been a threat in the Miami 'pen with an even 3.00 ERA in 17 relief appearances. He has also saved four games this season and has tossed 33.0 innings.

### MORE OHIO NOTES:

#### KRAUSS ON WATCH LIST, NCBWA BALLOT

Ohio's Marc Krauss has been garnering some prestigious honors in his freshman season. Earlier this week, Krauss' name appeared on the NCBWA's All-American Team second ballot. Matt Stiffler joined Krauss on the first All-America ballot issued by the NCBWA but did not make the second ballot. Krauss has also been named to the revised Wallace Watch list for the 2007 Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award. Krauss joined CMU's Tyler Stovall as the only two players from the MAC on the list of 112 players, which will be narrowed to 30 players at the end of May.

#### KRAUSS, BESL CRACK DOUBLES LIST

Marc Krauss and Brandon Besl each collected their 17th doubles of the season last weekend in a series at Akron and have now cracked Ohio's top 10 single season doubles list. The pair are tied with five former Bobcats for sixth place. With the next double, Krauss or Besl will tie former Bobcats Adam Fox and Jason Graham for fourth place on the list. Each has a shot at second place on the list, which is currently held by both Fox and Scott Malinowski with 21 doubles. Ryan Kyes is Ohio's single season doubles leader with 32.

#### BESL WITH CAREER DAY AT AKRON

Sophomore Brandon Besl had a career day last Sunday in a 12-8 Bobcat win at Akron. Besl finished 3-for-6 with two home runs and a career-high four RBI. It was the first multi-home run game for the sophomore third baseman. Besl also tied his career-high with three runs scored. He has now scored three runs on four occasions this season. His previous career-high for RBI in a game was three, which he set April 17 at Cincinnati.

#### SHORTSTOP JOHNSTON OUT FOR YEAR

Sophomore Hayden Johnston has been officially announced out for the remainder of the season after suffering a wrist injury April 17 at Cincinnati. Johnston hit .254 in 33 games this season and will be replaced by junior Zach Hartle. Hartle is in his first season with Ohio after transferring last year.

#### KRAUSS WINS MAC AWARD

Freshman first baseman Marc Krauss earned MAC East Division Player of the Week honors for the first time in his career on April 9. He went 11-for-22 (.500) with five extra-base hits, seven RBI and eight runs scored in five games. The rookie slugger tallied three doubles, a triple and a home run while slugging .864 for the week with 19 total bases.

#### ISAACS NAMED PITCHER OF WEEK

Senior Zeke Isaacs earned MAC East Pitcher of the Week honors April 9 after going 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA. He pitched 7.0 innings and struck out 10 hitters while allowing just two earned runs. He earned the win with two scoreless innings of relief against Marshall and started game three of the Ball State series. He gave Ohio five innings and tied his career-high with seven K's.

#### KRAUSS GARNERS NAT'L HONOR

After going 7-for-17 (.412) with five home runs, nine RBI and six runs scored in four games against Youngstown State and Toledo, Marc Krauss was named to the College Baseball Foundation's weekly National Honor Roll on April 3. Krauss became the first Bobcat in more than four years to homer three times in one game when he did so March 27 against Youngstown State. He slugged 1.294 last week and posted an on-base percentage of .524.

#### CARBONE PASSES SANDERS

With a win over Otterbein on March 3, Ohio Head Coach Joe Carbone passed former Toledo

Head Coach Stan Sanders for second place on the MAC all-time wins list with his 535th career victory. He is now second only to Fred Decker's 791 wins.

#### BOBCATS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The Bobcats were picked to finish in third place in the Mid-American Conference East Division in the MAC preseason coaches poll released Feb. 8. Coaches selected Miami as the team to beat in the East followed by Kent State, Ohio, Bowling Green, Akron, and Buffalo. Central Michigan was the favorite in the West Division followed by Ball State, Eastern Michigan, Western Michigan, Northern Illinois, and Toledo. Ohio was also selected to finish in third place by *Baseball America*.

#### WALKER, STIFFLER EARN HONOR

Bobcat outfielders Willie Walker and Matt Stiffler received preseason all-conference recognition from *Baseball America* in the publication's annual college preview issue. The pair were listed along with Kent State's Jared Bartholomew to fill the three spots on the All-MAC squad. The Bobcats were picked to finish third in the MAC East by the publication.
