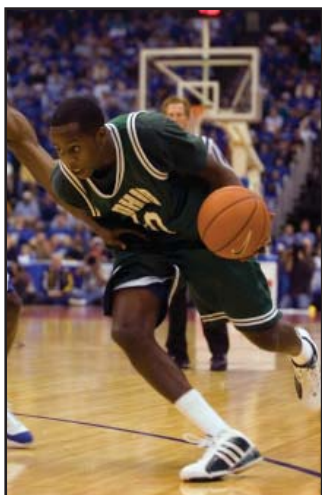

Ohio Men's Basketball

Season Outlook



100th Anniversary

Ohio will celebrate its 100th season of basketball in 2006-07. The program started with a 46-9 victory over Parkersburg (W.Va.) YMCA in 1907 and has turned in 67 winning seasons since. The Bobcats have captured nine regular season Mid-American Conference championships and four league tournament titles. A number of events will

surround the centennial celebration throughout the season.

Schedule

The 2006-07 schedule will bring a new set of challenges for the Ohio program. The Bobcats will participate in two tournaments this year after not having one on the schedule a year ago. Ohio will play in the NABC Classic, hosted by Louisville Dec. 8-10, and will also participate in the Arizona State Holiday Tournament, Dec. 21-22. The Bobcats will also face a number of other non-conference tests before the Mid-American Conference schedule kicks in. This year's MAC slate will be scaled back to 16 games from the 18-contest schedule that the league had employed since 1992.

Personnel

Point: Antonio Chatman took over the starting role for Ohio midway through the 2005-06 season and quickly became one of the more efficient point guards in the MAC. Unlike last year, the Bobcats won't start the season with two true point guards on the roster, but Sonny Troutman and Whitney Davis could both spell Chatman if needed.

Wing: The wing positions could be considered the strength of the Ohio roster entering the 2006-07 campaign. Troutman, a three-

year starter, and Davis, Ohio's spark off the bench last season, are expected to take on the bulk of the mid-range and perimeter scoring. Returning reserves Johnnie Jackson and Stephen King will contribute while Akron transfer Bubba Walther and incoming freshman Aswon Sayles could find an immediate role within the rotation.

Post: The depth of the post could be the area of greatest improvement from last year. Leon Williams, one of the league's premier big men and an All-MAC Honorable Mention pick in each of his first two seasons at Ohio, will return to anchor the Bobcats' low-post. 2005-06 MAC All-Freshman Team member Jerome Tillman is expected to join the starting lineup after providing quality minutes off the bench last year while fellow returning reserves Ken Ottrix and Matt Annen have made strides in the offseason. With his combination of size and experience on the European scene, the recruitment of Kenneth van Kempen from The Netherlands could also have an impact.

2004-05 Review

The 2005-06 Bobcats finished with a record of 19-11 after bowing out of the MAC Tournament in the semifinals to eventual champion Kent State. Ohio garnered impressive road victories at Rhode Island, Marist and Toledo last year and took care of business at home



against the likes of St. Francis, Detroit, Akron, Ball State and Samford in the ESPN Bracketbusters game. Mychal Green and Leon Williams garnered All-MAC Honorable Mention honors for Ohio, which lost Green, Jeff Halbert, Cliff McGowen and Seth Bauman to graduation.

Ohio Men's Basketball

Head Coach Tim O'Shea



Tim O'Shea came to Athens on March 29, 2001 and vowed to take the Ohio men's basketball program to the next level. After the 2004-05 season marked one of the most memorable runs in school history - including a Mid-American Conference Tournament crown and a scare of Southeastern Conference champ Florida in the NCAA Tournament in 2005 - Bobcat fans found out exactly what that next level is all about.

In just five years, O'Shea has become the architect of an Ohio program that has made an impact within the MAC and on a national level. The last two seasons alone, O'Shea's Bobcats have compiled 40 wins, captured a MAC title and been named college basketball's "It" team by ESPN.Com.

O'Shea's first season on the sidelines at Ohio was highlighted by victories over DePaul and powerhouse North Carolina in Chapel Hill on national television. Then, in his second season at the helm, O'Shea led the Bobcats to a regular season victory over Virginia and a spot in the MAC Tournament semifinals and a 12-6 conference record.

Following the 2002-03 season, standout forward Brandon Hunter became the first Bobcat selected in the NBA draft since 1995 when the Boston Celtics nabbed the Ohio big man in the second round. A year later, O'Shea faced the daunting task of replacing Hunter, leading sixth-man Sonny Johnson and three-point sharpshooter Steve Esterkamp. The 2003-04 Bobcats slipped to a 10-20 record, but bounced

back the in 2004-05 for their memorable run to the NCAA Tournament.

The 2004-05 Bobcats captured significant non-conference victories against San Francisco, Butler, and Detroit, then won 11 of their last 15 contests down the stretch. O'Shea kept the troops on task as they carried that momentum over to a four-game sweep of the competition in the MAC Tournament. The run ended in the first round of the NCAA Tournament against Florida, but the 'Cats didn't go down without a fight, as they nearly overcame a 20-point second-half deficit.

Ohio opened the 2005-06 as with the moniker of collegiate hoops' "It" team and compiled 19 victories before falling to eventual league champion Kent State in the MAC Tournament semifinals. The Bobcats registered impressive victories at Marist, Rhode Island and Toledo, against Akron and Samford at home, and took Kentucky to the wire in Cincinnati.

The players O'Shea has coached at Ohio have proven to become winners in the classroom, as well. Seventeen of the 18 student-athletes who have completed their eligibility under O'Shea during their senior seasons have graduated.

His commitment to excellence on and off the floor is a product of the lessons he learned at several other Division I institutions. O'Shea's head coaching career began after extensive experience as an assistant in the Ivy League, Atlantic 10 and Big East.

O'Shea began his work on the bench as a graduate assistant at the University of Rhode Island and Boston College. His first full-time appointment came later that year at Yale, where he spent the next two seasons.

The next stop for O'Shea was a spot on Al Skinner's staff at Rhode Island. He spent nine seasons at URI, playing a key role in the Rams' earning two NIT and two NCAA Tournament berths. A notable recruit during this stint was current NBA star Cuttino Mobely.

In the spring of 1997, O'Shea returned to his alma mater. In four seasons at Boston College, O'Shea helped build the Eagles into the 2000-01 Big East regular-season and tournament champions. BC posted a 27-5 record and earned a No. 3 seed for the NCAA East Regional and finished with a No. 9 ranking in the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) just two years after being ranked 246.

O'Shea was no stranger to success in the BC locker room. After earning All-American accolades at Wayland (Mass.) High School, O'Shea played for some of the most successful squads in Boston College history. The Eagles won two Big East regular-season titles and earned four postseason tournament berths during his career. In his four years, BC advanced twice to the NCAA Tournament's "Sweet 16" and once to the "Elite Eight".

O'Shea earned a bachelor's degree in communications with a minor in English from Boston College in 1984, then added a master's degree in counseling/psychology from BC two years later.

He and his wife, Elizabeth, have an eight-year-old daughter, Madeleine.

John Rhodes • Associate Head Coach • Ohio '88

John Rhodes is no stranger to Ohio basketball with a combined 12 years of experience in the program as a player and coach. The 2005-06 season will be the third in which Rhodes carries the title of associate head coach.

Rhodes is in his eighth year on the Ohio staff and sixth in the Tim O'Shea era. In fact, one of the first decisions made by O'Shea was to retain the services of Rhodes to maintain continuity with players, administrators and fans.

His primary responsibilities include recruiting, scheduling, game preparation and on-court teaching. He works specifically with post players and coordinates special projects.

The Milwaukee, Wis., native graduated from Ohio in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in journalism/public relations. He and his wife Jackie (Ohio '88) have a 10-year-old daughter, Alexis, and a seven-year-old son, Kristopher.



Kevin Kuwik • Assistant Coach • Notre Dame '96

Kevin Kuwik is set for his fifth season on the Ohio sidelines after coming to Athens with O'Shea in 2001.

After spending three seasons on Ohio's coaching staff, Kuwik missed the entire 2004-05 season when he went on a leave of absence to fulfill an 18-month mission as an Army engineer captain. He reported for active military duty on Oct. 23, 2004 and was primarily stationed in Iraq. He rejoined the team in January, 2006.

As a Bobcat assistant basketball coach, Kuwik concentrated on recruiting, film breakdown, game preparation and academic monitoring. On the floor, he worked with the guards.

Kuwik graduated summa cum laude from Notre Dame in 1996 with a mechanical engineering degree. A Distinguished Military Graduate in Notre Dame's Army ROTC program, he also served as senior class president. Upon graduation, Kuwik was commissioned a lieutenant in the Army and served for two years as an engineer platoon leader stationed at Fort Lewis, Wash.



Brian Townsend • Assistant Coach • Michigan '91

Brian Townsend, a former University of Michigan and NFL linebacker, begins his fourth season on the Bobcat sideline after joining the Ohio men's basketball staff as an assistant coach on May 21, 2003.

Townsend's roles in the Bobcat program include overseeing the defense, player development and offseason conditioning. In addition to his responsibilities in recruiting, he brings enthusiasm, mental toughness and a winning attitude to the team.
