## PAW PRINTS

- This will be the 68th meeting between these two teams with the Bobcats holding a 42-25 advantage in the all-time series
- The Bobcats are 27-8 against the Chippewas in Athens, having won the last five meetings and 16 of the last 17 dating back to 1990. 11 of those 16 wins were by double digits
- The Bobcats are 17-8 against MAC West teams since John Groce took over as head coach prior to the 2008-09 season
- Ohio has won its last eight home games against MAC West foes and 14 of its last 15, dating back to 2006-07
- The Bobcats are 11-1 at home this season and are bating opponents by an average of 10.6 points per game
- Ohio has now totaled 26 seasons of 10 or more wins since the Roundhouse on Richland started hosting games. Over the last seven+ seasons, the Bobcats are an impressive 83-20 (.806)
- Walter Offutt matched his career-high with 19 points in the win over Northern Illinois. The junior also set a career mark at the free-throw line, going a perfect 9-for-9
- Ivo Baltic, despite not scoring a single field goal for the first time this season, did grab seven rebounds and hand out a season-best six assists in the win over the Huskies. He scored a career-best 31 against NIU last season
- Nick Kellogg scored 12 points, all on three-pointers, as he reached double figures for the fourth time in MAC play. It was the first time the sophomore had scored in double figures since the win over Kent State
- Stevie Taylor finished with eight points, his best total since December 23, going a perfect 3-for-3 from the field
- Reggie Keely matched his best scoring total for the season in MAC play with 13 points
- Jon Smith led the team in rebounding at NIU with eight. He ranks second in MAC play with an average of 3.0 offensive rebounds per outing
- Ohio limited NIU to just 29 percent shooting from beyond the arc (6-21) and the Bobcats have now limited their opponents to fewer than 37 percent shooting from the field over the last three games
- Ohio also capitalized at the charity stripe, going 20-of-26 at the line, one shy of the season high for makes. Offutt alone was a perfect 9-for-9.
- In his career against CMU, D.J. Cooper is averaging 24.5 ppg, 5.0 apg, 4.5 rpg and 3.5 spg. He scored 30 against the Chippewas in Mt. Pleasant last season
- Cooper was one of 20 finalists for the 2012 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award and ranks eighth in the nation in steals per game with an average of 2.6.
- The Bobcats are sixth in the nation in turnover margin (+5.4) and 10th in the nation in steals per contest (9.2)
- The Bobcats are one of the top teams in the nation when it comes to guarding the perimeter, ranking 20th in the nation (29.2%)
- Ohio is also excelling in turning its opponents over, ranking No. 1 in the nation in turnover percentage according to KenPom's national standings (27.4%)
- Ohio has three players averaging in double figures with Cooper leading the way at 13.5 points per game. Offutt is averaging 11.8 points per game and Baltic is chipping in 10.9 points per game for the Bobcats
- Overall, the record for the Bobcats under Coach Groce when they are able to hold their opponents under 70 points is 55-17 (.764)
- Cooper is second all-time with 602 assists and holds the two best single-season marks (263 in 2010-11, 218 in 2009-10). He only trails Dennis Whitaker's (1987-90) career total of 651.

## A LOOK AT THE OPPONENT

CMU is led by Trey Zeigler who is averaging 16.1 points per game. He also ranks among the rebounding leaders in the conference and was a preseason All-MAC selection. The Chippewas are looking to snap a six-game losing skid, which ties as the longest in the last six seasons.

The Chippewas are averaging 17.7 offensive rebounds per game over the last three contests. Central's rebounding margin over the three-game span is +4.7, but overall on the season, CMU is last in the league with a -4.7 rebounding margin.

Freshman point guard Austin McBroom is making a bid for MAC Freshman of the Year honors. In MAC play only, the California native ranks second among freshmen in scoring (12.6) and second in assists (2.5). Among all league players in conference action, McBroom ranks second in 3-pointers made (2.8), third in free throw percentage (.905) and fourth in 3-point percentage (.468). His overall scoring average of 10.9 points per game ranks second among league freshmen.

## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Ken Pomeroy's recent study on Ohio's home-court advantage shows that it has been the sixth best in the nation. By taking results back to the 1999-2000 season and comparing scores of home-and-home series, the Bobcats had a home scoring margin of +513 in 69 games. The Bobcats actual home-court advantage is 6.58 points.

The MAC as a conference ranks third in home-court advantage factor, behind the Big 12 and the Big Ten.

## CONVO SUCCESS

The Convocation Center opened with the beginning of the 1968-69 season and has been home to the Bobcats ever since. Over that time frame, the Bobcats have amassed a record of 429-135 (.761).

After opening The Convo on Dec. 3, 1968, with an 80-70 win over Indiana, the Bobcats won 35 of their first 37 games at the arena. Ohio had a 13-game home winning streak this season, at the time the 17th-longest in the nation. The run of success was the longest since the 2005-06 and 2006-07 teams ran together a string of 14-consecutive victories.

Ohio also holds the MAC attendance record set on Feb. 28, 1970, when 14,102 fans witnessed the Bobcats clinch the league title with a win over Bowling Green. In a home game against Miami this season, the Bobcats registered 13,011 fans in attendance, the most at The Convo since 1997.

## SHAQ OF THE MAC HONORED

Ohio University Athletics will honor the career accomplishments of Gary Trent (1993-95) during halftime of the Bobcats' matchup with Miami. Trent will be honored throughout the game culminating with a presentation where his No. 20 jersey will be unveiled in the rafters of the Convocation Center.

Nicknamed "The Shaq of the MAC", Trent is the only three-time MAC Player of the Year in the history of the league. He was a three-time MAC scoring champion, two-time rebounding leader and one of just three players in league history with at least 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds.

Trent completed his Ohio career with 2,108 points and 1,050 rebounds. He was selected in the first round as the 11th overall pick in the 1995 NBA Draft by the Milwaukee Bucks where he would go on to enjoy an 11-year NBA career.

### GROCE STACKING UP WITH OHIO GREATS

Head Coach John Groce won 56 games in his first three seasons as leader of the Bobcats. That win total is seven more than the previous best three-year start to a coaching career in Athens (Dutch Trautwein, 49 wins, 1938-41).

"Gentleman" Jim Snyder is the all-time wins leader among Ohio head coaches with 355 to his credit. He coached the Bobcats from 1947 to 1974, a span of 25 seasons. Currently, Groce is eighth all-time in career wins with the Green & White.

### CAREER MARKS

Two current players are moving up the Ohio charts. Despite only beginning their junior seasons, D.J. Cooper and Reggie Keely have both made an imprint on Ohio Bobcat basketball.

Cooper is one of 33 1,000-point scorers in Ohio history. His 294 points this season have seen him move past former teammates DeVaughn Washington and Tommy Freeman, as well as Fred Moore, Lewis Geter, Frankie Baumholtz, John Canine, Bunk Adams, Jerry Jackson, Don Hilt, Sonny Troutman, Kirk Lehman, Gerald McKee and Vic Alexander with 1,344 career points.

His 229 steals currently rank him second all-time as he passed former 'Cats Paul Graham and Dennis Whitaker these last two weeks. Cooper now trails only all-time leader Sonny Troutman's Ohio record, 259. Cooper also owns the single-season mark in that category (93 in 2009-10).

Keely cracked the top-10 list for career blocks last season and recently moved past Paul Graham for ninth place with 75 rejections.

### ROAD WARRIORS

Ohio's success on the hardwood is not simply due to racking up home victories as the Bobcats have more than held their own on the road. Last year, the Green & White achieved their first winning record in true road games since 2002. Over their last 31 road/neutral contests, the Bobcats own a record of 19-12.

### NICK OFF THE OLD BLOCK

Sophomore Nick Kellogg currently ranks among the national leaders in three-point shooting percentage. The sophomore has made a three-pointer in every game this season except for the contest at nationally-ranked Louisville.

Last season, Kellogg was named to the All-MAC Freshman Team after leading the league in three-point field goal percentage last season at 45.3 percent. He shot 49 percent from beyond the arc in conference play and finished 10th in the league in three-pointers made.

The son of Clark Kellogg, scored a career-high 23 points on 8-of-12 shooting, hitting a career-high six three-pointers, in a win at MAC Tournament champion Akron last season.

He was also one of the team and league's best free-throw shooters, connecting on 78 percent of his tries at the charity stripe.

### **BALTIC NAMED MAC PLAYER OF WEEK**

Ohio's Ivo Baltic was named the Mid-American Conference's East Player of the Week for the first time on Dec. 26 after averaging 17.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in wins at Northern Iowa and against North Carolina A&T.

The Kansas City native started the week going 10-of-14 for a season-high 22 points at Northern Iowa last Tuesday evening. He surpassed his season-high in the first half with 16 points as the Bobcats won by double-digits against one of the best mid-major programs in the country.

Baltic finished one board shy of a double-double, which would have been the second of his career, as he scored 11 points and grabbed nine rebounds in the home win over the Aggies on Friday. He has led the team in rebounding five times this season, tops among the Green & White, and finished the week shooting 70 percent from the floor.

Baltic was also named College Sports Madness' National High-Major Men's Basketball Player of the Week for his outstanding performances

### **MID-MAJOR POLLS**

After cracking the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 four weeks ago, Ohio moved up to No. 18 following wins over Oakland and Portland. A victory over Wright State propelled the Bobcats up to No.12 in the nation. A win at Northern Iowa bumped the Green & White into the top10 and eventually, Ohio hit its highest point at No. 5.

Ohio currently sits at No. 16 after four-consecutive wins in Mid-American Conference play. Fellow MAC teams Akron (No. 21) and Kent State (No. 22) are also ranked while Bobcat opponents Northern Iowa and Robert Morris are receiving votes.

### **HANGING WITH MR. COOPER**

Since 1999-00, only eight other NCAA Division I players have averaged even 5.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists in the same season. Of those eight, only three—Damitrius Coleman of Mercer (2004-05), Pepe Sanchez of Temple (1999-00), and Eddie Gill of Weber State (1999-00)—have also collected at least 2.0 steals per game. And of those three, only one, Eddie Gill, has also put up 15.0+ points per outing (16.3).

This means that in the last 12 seasons, only Eddie Gill and D.J. Cooper have averaged 15.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 7.0 assists, and 2.0 steals over an entire season. Jason Kidd with Cal in 1993-94 (16.7 pts, 6.9 reb, 9.1 ast, 3.1 stl) helps put Mr. Cooper in some pretty good company.

Even in the NBA only eight different players have hit the four averages in one year; Clyde Drexler, LeBron James, Magic Johnson, Kidd, Fat Lever, Chris Paul, Micheal Ray Richardson, and Dwyane Wade. And if we adjust these numbers to account for the fact that NBA guys play 48 minutes a night, the list is reduced to just Magic, who averaged 18.6 points, 9.6 rebounds, 9.5 assists, and 2.7 steals for the Lakers in 1981-82.

### PRESEASON PICK

Ohio was selected to finish third in the East Division as the Mid-American Conference released its 2011-12 Preseason Poll. Junior guard D.J. Cooper was named to the East Division's Preseason All-MAC Team after being a First Team selection last season. He is averaging 14.6 points, 6.7 assists, 5.2 rebounds and 2.4 steals for his career after ranking third nationally in assists last year with 7.5 per game.

### 2010-11 REWIND

Last year, The Bobcats advanced to their third postseason appearance in four years and became only the third team in the nation to play in all four postseason tournaments (NCAA, NIT, CBI, and CIT). The 65-64 victory over Marshall in the first round of the CIT was the 11th win in postseason history for the Bobcats, most of any team from the Mid-American Conference.

This also marked the first time in Ohio history that the Bobcats had earned wins in consecutive postseasons, and has now earned a win in three of the last four postseasons. Ohio's 41 wins over the past two seasons are its most since the 94-95 campaigns, and the Bobcats are one of three MAC teams to have one or fewer losing seasons since 2004.

### SHOTS TO THE HEART RAISING AWARENESS

Head Coach John Groce and Assistant Coach Ramon Williams are taking part in the Second Annual 'Shots from the Heart' tournament, presented by Collegelsider.com. The event will benefit the Skip Prosser Foundation. Groce and Williams are competing against Division I coaches from across the nation in the free-throw shooting contest to help raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease.

"The idea was to create awareness for heart disease through competition," says Collegelsider.com co-founder Angela Lento. "We wanted to create something that coaches could have fun with. The fun but competitive nature of this event is something that I am sure coach Prosser would have enjoyed." The American Heart Association is also part of the event and is one of the beneficiaries of the Skip Prosser Foundation, which was established in 2011.

### OHIO ADDS LEVERT

Ohio Men's Basketball announced the signing of Caris LeVert, a 6-5 shooting guard from Pickerington Central, for the 2012-13 season. The addition of LeVert is a great boost for the Bobcats, given the in-state recruit is currently ranked at No. 8 overall

A pure shooter and scorer with deep range and a quick release, LeVert uses his long frame to get shots off over defenders. He has proven to be a slashing scorer as well that can use the bounce to create shots. LeVert has the athleticism and the length to make up for his thin, yet wiry, frame. LeVert joins current Bobcats Jon Smith, Nick Kellogg, Nick Goff, David McKinley and Stevie Taylor as local products that have

There is a fire that burns inside John Groce, a determination to succeed at the highest levels. In more than a decade working for some of the titans of the college basketball world, he earned a reputation that included traits such as passionate, driven, tireless and bright.

The work that Groce has put in over the last 18 years has given him an ample taste of that success. He has reached the postseason 16 times in his 18 years on the collegiate sidelines, helping guide teams to a Final Four, two Elite Eights, a National Invitation Tournament championship and numerous conference titles.

As he enters his fourth season as head coach at Ohio University, Groce has wasted no time instilling that same fire into every facet of the Bobcat program. In 2010, he became the fifth coach to lead Ohio to the NCAA Tournament in its 104-year history. A stirring run through the Mid-American Conference Tournament featured an overtime win on the road in the first round, a toppling of regular-season champion Kent State in the quarterfinals, a victory over archrival Miami in the semifinals and capped with another overtime victory against the defending conference champs, Akron.

The historic season did not end in Cleveland as Ohio advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005 and third time in the last 20 years. The 13-seeded Bobcats faced 4-seeded Georgetown and knocked off the Hoyas, 97-83. It was Ohio's first win against a nationally-ranked program since 1998 and advanced them into the NCAA Second Round for the first time since 1983. The win was also the fifth all-time for the Green & White in the Big Dance.

Ohio led the league in scoring by averaging 74.7 points per game and had five players average 10.5 points or more for their 2009-10 campaigns. The 2,763 points scored last year were the most by any Bobcat team, breaking the previous mark of 2,668 set during the 1993-94 season. The Green & White also finished second in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.366), three-point field goal percentage defense (.312), rebounding offense (37.1), assists (14.16), turnover margin (+2.51) and three-point field goals made (7.51).

While Groce's attacking style of play undoubtedly leads to results on the court, it also benefits the Ohio players when it comes time to collect hardware. Last year, D.J. Cooper was named the 2009-10 MAC Freshman of the Year after an outstanding season. The guard was one of just two players in the nation to rank in the top 15 in both steals and assists which also helped him land a spot on the 2010 Colleg Insider.com Freshmen All-America Team. Armon Bassett was an honorable mention All-MAC performer after leading Ohio with 17.1 points per game and finishing fourth in the league in scoring. Bassett was named the MAC Tournament MVP after averaging 29 points per game and setting a MAC record with 116 points scored.

Already known as one of the premier recruiters in the college game, Groce and his staff enjoyed an off-court success of a different kind during the 2008-09 season as their five-player 2009 recruiting class was regarded as the 10th-best in the country among mid-majors and one of the top-70 in the nation overall by Hoop Scoop Online. Two members of the class were named the best incoming players at their position in the MAC by Rivals.com, while all five were nominated for McDonald's High School All-America status during their final prep campaigns. For this upcoming season, Groce has brought in even more talent with the addition of four freshmen and two transfers.

Since his first day on the job, Groce, a former teacher, has also placed great importance on the academic success of the Ohio program. Groce's first three quarters on the job saw the Bobcats post team grade-point averages that ranked among the five-best in the 15 academic quarters since the beginning of the 2004-05 school year. Under his tutelage, 14 Ohio players have earned an individual GPA of 3.00 or better for a quarter a combined 22 times.

Prior to his arrival in Athens, Groce spent four seasons on staff at Ohio State, the final two as associate head coach. During his tenure, he helped the Buckeyes to 105 victories, including a school-record 35 wins in 2006-07, a pair of outright Big Ten regular-season titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, a berth in the 2007 NCAA National Championship game and the 2008 NIT title. Groce was also heavily involved in recruiting at Ohio State and played a vital role in bringing future first-round NBA draft-picks Greg Oden, Mike Conley, Jr., and Daequan Cook to Columbus, earning him the title of Rivals.com Recruiter of the Year in 2006. His 2007 class at OSU, which featured a five-star prospect and two four-star recruits, was also ranked sixth in the nation.

The Danville, Ind., native began his coaching career in 1993 as an assistant at his alma mater, Taylor University, in Upland, Ind. During that time, Taylor posted a 71-28 record and earned a pair of trips to the NAIA national tournament. He helped the Trojans to a 29-5 record and a No. 1 national ranking in 1994.

Groce broke into Division I basketball as a member of Herb Sendek's staff at NC State in 1996, ultimately serving as an assistant with the Wolfpack from 1996-00. NCSU earned postseason bids in each of his four years on the sidelines, including a trip to the 2000 NIT semifinals. With his hiring at Ohio, Groce became the eighth former Sendek assistant to ascend to the Division I head coaching ranks.

In 2000-01, Groce moved on to Butler, where he joined Thad Matta's staff for the first of his eight years working with the current Ohio State head coach. With Groce on the bench, the Bulldogs captured both the Midwestern College Conference regular-season and tournament crowns, and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Groce accompanied Matta to Xavier in 2001, helping lead the Musketeers to a 78-23 overall record and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in each of his three seasons on staff. The crown jewel of Groce's time in Cincinnati was a berth in the 2004 NCAA Elite Eight.

After starring for current Iowa head coach Todd Lickliter at Danville High School, Groce played basketball for three years at Taylor, helping the Trojans to a composite 86-18 record and three trips to the NAIA Tournament, including an NAIA Final Four bid in 1991. He earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics from Taylor in 1994.

Born on Sept. 7, 1971, in Muncie, Ind., Groce and his wife, Allison, have two sons, Conner and Camden.
