The first round of MAC East play wraps up for Ohio as it heads to Oxford to battle rival Miami Tuesday night at 7 p.m. in Millet Hall. The 'Cats are hunting for their first conference win of the season and will look to return the favor from a close loss in Oxford last year.

ON THE AIR

The game will be broadcast live on WOUB AM 1340 or at OhioBobcats.com. Caleb Troop and former Bobcat Allie LaForce will have the call from Millet Hall.

BETWEEN THE LINES

- Tuesday's game will mark the 71st meeting in the all-time series between the two rival schools.
- The two split the two games last year with each squad winning on its home floor.
- Ohio has won five of the last eight games in the series.
- Coming into this game, the 'Cats are 2-1 this year in Tuesday games.
- Ohio has won the last two meetings of the series inside the Convo.
- Ohio is 2-2 against the RedHawks under Semeka Randall.
- According to available records, this is Ohio's 484th MAC game all-time. The 'Cats are 228-255 in conference play.

LAST TIME OUT

Shavon Robinson scored a career-high 16 points and nine rebounds and Tenishia Benson added 17 points and eight rebounds, but Buffalo's Kourtney Brown scored a game-high 31 points and 16 rebounds to lead the visiting Bulls past Ohio, 65-51, Saturday in the Convo.

A big Bull run midway through the second half proved to be the deciding factor as it broke open a tight game and gave the Green and White a hole it was unable to dig out of. The 'Cats (4-13, 0-4 MAC) pulled down a season-best 23 offensive boards en route to 44 on the game, but Buffalo's (9-8, 2-2 MAC) outside shooting made the Green and White pay as the Bulls knocked down eight treys while shooting 34.8 percent from beyond the arc. They finished the game shooting 44 percent overall.

Benson also chipped in four assists and three steals to add to her solid line. Kamille Buckner pulled down a season-best 13 rebounds to go with five points, and Alesia Howard chipped in seven points and five rebounds.

ABOUT MIAMI

Miami enters the week an even 2-2 in conference play and 10-7 overall on the year. After dropping their first two league games, the RedHawks have won their last two, topping Buffalo and Akron. Head coach Maria Fantanarosa is in her 13 year at the helm of the program.

SCOUTING THE REDHAWKS

Miami enters play averaging over 73 ppg. on the year and 69.0 ppg. in conference play, while shooting .418 from the field and .369 from behind the arc overall. Defensively, the opposition is scoring 74.7 ppg. on .406 shooting for the season, while scoring 79.5 ppg. on .455 shooting in MAC games.

Sophomore Courtney Osborn, the reigning MAC Freshman of the Year, leads three RedHawks in double figures at 17.2 ppg. and 4.9 apg. on the year, while junior Maggie Boyer is chipping in 13.2 ppg. Kirsten Olowinski ranks third in the MAC in rebounding at 10.9 rpg. while chipping in 11.6 ppg. overall. She leads the team in scoring in MAC play, however, at 18.8 ppg. and 11.3 rpg.

OHIO VS. MIAMI

According to available records, Tuesday's contest will mark the 71st meeting all-time between the two schools. Miami leads the series 47-23, with each side winning on their home floor to split the two games last year. Ohio has won five of the last eight games in the series overall, including a sweep during the 2008-09 season. The 'Cats, however, have dropped 11 of their last 12 games in Millett Hall.

RECAPPING THE LAST OHIO-MIAMI MEETING

Ohio snapped a five-game losing streak with a 69-56 win over Miami, the Bobcats' first home win in February. With the win, Ohio split the season series with the RedHawks and won its sixth-straight home game in the series.

Kamille Buckner led the Green & White with her third career double-double with a season-high 15 points and 11 rebounds, while Jennifer Bushby added 15 points. Carolyn Barnett chipped in 14 points off the bench, her fourth-straight game in double figures, and Thia Gholson scored eight points and grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds while also dishing out a career-best four assists.

The 'Cats did a great job crashing the glass, outrebounding Miami 45-31 overall, including 18 on the offensive glass, which resulted in 20 second-chance points. The Green and White also turned in a strong defensive effort, recording its 13th outing where it has held the opposition under 60 points. In addition, the 'Cats held Miami's leading scorer, Courtney Osborn to just six points on the night.

REACHING A MILESTONE

With her 17 points against Buffalo, Tenishia Benson surpassed the 500-point mark for her collegiate career, including her two years at the University of Cincinnati.

GETTING DEFENSIVE IN THE MAC

Through four games of conference play, Ohio is holding teams to just 60.0 ppg., the fourth-best mark in the conference in league play. The 'Cats also rank second in the league in rebounding defense, allowing just 34.2 rpg.

KEEPING THE HOME GLASS CLEAN

Ohio pulled down 23 offensive rebounds against Buffalo, its highest total this season and the most since grabbing 25 offensive boards against Navy on Nov. 16, 2009.

PICKING UP STEAM

After scoring in double digits just twice the first 12 games of the season, Alesia Howard has reached double figures in three of the last five games.

UNDER 60

Ohio has held eight of its opponents to 60 points or less this season. The 'Cats are 4-4 when doing so.

GETTING DEFENSIVE ON THE FALCONS

Ohio held defending-MAC Champion Bowling Green to just 32 percent shooting from the field in the first half and just 66 points, 10 points below the Falcons' season average.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

The 'Cats are averaging 40.6 rpg. and are outrebounding the opposition by seven rebounds per game over their last eight games, winning the rebounding battle in each game. They pulled down a season-high 46 rebounds against Cleveland State, marking the most

MILLIE MOVES UP

Kamille Buckner (nicknamed Millie) currently ranks fourth place on the MAC's all-time blocks list with 167. She also holds four of the program's all-time best single-season totals in school history. She and is now chasing Liz Honneger (Bowling Green) in third place at 188.

LYLES LOVIN THE TAR HEEL STATE

Sophomore Symone Lyles enjoyed the best game of her career at UNCW, scoring a career-high 12 points, all of which came in the second half, and grabbing nine rebounds on 6-of-11 shooting in just 27 minutes of play.

TRIO OF DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Tenishia Benson tallied double-doubles in three consecutive games against Duquesne, Presbyterian and Cleveland State, becoming the first Ohio player since Rachel Frederick in 2006 to notch three straight double-doubles.

BENSON NAMED MAC EAST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Benson was named MAC East Player of the Week for Dec. 20, tallying a pair of double-doubles and career highs while averaging 21.5 points, 10.5 rebs., 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game. She also converted on 15-of-18 from the charity stripe. She finished the week shooting at a 41.9 percent clip from the field and 40 percent from beyond the arc. After tallying 16 points and a career-best 11 rebs. against Duquesne, the junior followed it up with 27 points and 10 rebounds against Presbyterian.

TENISHIA TIDBITS:

Items of note on junior guard Tenishia Benson:

- She has scored in double figures in all but three games this season and has eight games with at least 16 points.
- She has pulled down double-digit rebounds in four of her last six games, notching a career-best 11 on three occasions.
- She scored a career-best 27 points against Presbyterian.
- Her double-doubles against Duquesne, Presbyterian and CSU marked the first time in her career she has had double-doubles in three straight games.
- She has four double-doubles on the season

and seven for her career.

• Including her two years at Cincinnati, she has scored in double digits 26 times during her career.

GHOLSON GIVES AND GATHERS

Senior Thia Gholson tied her career-high four assists and notched a season-best six rebounds in 23 minutes against Duquesne.

SEASON HIGHS

Gholson notched a season-best 10 points against the Patriots, while freshman Shavon Robinson picked up a season- and career-best eight. Alesia Howard grabbed both a season- and career-high eight boards as well.

TURNING OVER THE RAIDERS

Ohio forced Wright State into 28 turnovers, the most by an opponent this season, and the most since the 'Cats forced Akron into 35 back on Feb. 15, 2005.

BENSON RAIDS RAIDERS

Tenishia Benson nabbed a career-best nine steals against Wright State, tying Marti Heckman's single-game record from Jan. 19, 1985. In addition to tying a school record, Benson's nine steals is the second most by a MAC player thus far this season and is tied the third-most in the nation. In addition, the Akron, Ohio, product scored 16 points, grabbed nine rebounds and dished out five assists, just missing a rare triple-double.

3-POINT UPSTART

Coming into the Wright State game, forward Alesia Howard had never made a 3-pointer during her collegiate career and had attempted just three. She finished 3-for-4 from distance against the Raiders.

IRON WOMAN

Kamille Buckner has played in every possible Ohio game during her three-plus years in Athens, a streak that now stands at 111 games. She also tallied a string of 67 straight starts during this time.

BUCKNER'S BLOCKS

Items of note on senior Kamille Buckner's block numbers:

- With her 167 career rejections, she is Ohio's all-time leader in the category, having shattered the previous record held by Bobcat great Holly Skeen (115).
- She holds Ohio's single-season record with

Combine talent, determination and passion, and you have what embodies one of the most well-known women's basketball names in the state of Ohio, Semeka Randall. The Cleveland, Ohio, native and former Tennessee All-American enters her third year at the helm of Ohio women's basketball during the 2010-11 campaign.

Randall has certainly left her mark on the Bobcats since her introduction as the head coach in 2008. Ohio has become one of the top defensive squads in the Mid-American Conference and established itself as a gritty and determined squad with a fighting attitude. Under her guidance, two players have garnered three All-MAC honors in the past two years. Guard Jennifer Bushby captured her second all-conference nod last season, while forward Kamille Buckner shattered the school's all-time blocks record and continues to move up the conference blocks list. Bushby also became just the second player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points, 300 career assists and 300 career steals last season.

Inheriting a young team and perhaps the most challenging schedule in the program's history in her first year, Randall treated the potentially-intimidating situation like any other challenge she had during her career. She attacked it head on with grit, determination and a fighting attitude. All of which rubbed off onto her pupils during the season. The 'Cats took on such programs as Syracuse, Clemson, South Carolina and nationally-ranked teams Florida and Bowling Green, and battled each of them right down to the very last second, serving notice that the 'Cats were indeed ready to carry on the strong tradition of success that had been set at Ohio.

Under Randall's tutelage in year one, the 'Cats established themselves as a strong defensive unit, ranking second in the MAC in scoring defense and blocked shots, and first in field goal percentage defense and rebounding defense. Ohio also led the conference in shooting on the year. Individually, Lauren Hmiel and Bushby were both named to All-MAC teams under her watch. She also saw Bushby lead the conference in assists and Buckner shatter the school's single-season blocks record while also leading the league in the category. Randall didn't waste any time in showing her ability on the recruiting trails either as the 'Cats landed the second-best recruiting class in the MAC, building even more excitement for the future of the program.

The former Tennessee All-American and four-year WNBA veteran, who was inducted into the Ohio Basketball Hall of Fame on May 17, 2008, came to Ohio University on May 9, 2008, after spending a year as an assistant coach at West Virginia. Prior to that, Randall was an assistant coach at Michigan State from 2005-07. During her tenure at MSU, the Spartans played for the national championship in 2005, advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2006 and made it to the NCAA second round in 2007. Prior to her tenure at Michigan State, Randall served as an assistant coach at Cleveland State from 2002-03.

A standout guard for the Lady Vols from 1998-2001, Randall earned Kodak All-America First Team honors in 1999 and 2000. She was an integral part of Tennessee's 1998 NCAA Championship team that went 39-0, averaging 15.9 points a game while earning honorable mention All-America recognition.

In addition to her All-America honors, she was named Women's Basketball Journal's Defensive Player of the Year in 1999 and 2000, first-team All-Southeastern Conference in 1999 and 2000, second-team All-SEC and SEC All-Freshman Team in 1998, and was on the NCAA Mid-east Regional All-Tournament team in 1998 and 2000.

"Semeka has enjoyed success at all levels -- as a player at Tennessee, in the WNBA, and as a valued assistant at schools in the Big Ten and the BIG EAST," said Tennessee head coach Pat Summitt. "I know she is going to take the same energy, passion and drive that she exhibited as a player and transfer it into her new role as the head coach at Ohio."

Randall scored 1,915 points during her career at Tennessee (13.7 ppg) and added 716 rebounds (5.1 rpg), 286 steals and 236 assists. She ranks fifth on the Lady Vols' career charts in both points and steals, and third in free throws made (439). Tennessee posted a record of 134-10 during her four-year career, including championship appearances in 1998 and 2000. During the summer of 1998, Randall was the leading scorer for the gold medal-winning USA Jones Cup team.

Randall was the first player chosen in the second round (17th overall) of the 2001 WNBA draft by the Seattle Storm. She started 30 of 32 games as a rookie, averaging a career-best 9.4 points. She averaged 5.8 points during her 123-game WNBA career, including 55 starts.

In 2001-02, Randall started all 16 games at point guard and averaged 19 points while playing for the Israeli Professional Basketball League. She played in the Greek Professional Basketball League in 2002-03, again starting all 16 games for her squad. In 2003, she was a member of the Tennessee Fury of the National Women's Basketball League, averaging 12.2 points as a shooting guard.

In 2004, she completed her four-year WNBA career which included stops in Seattle (2001-02), Utah (2002) and San Antonio (2003-04). She also played in the National Women's Basketball League and in professional leagues in Israel (2001-02) and Greece (2002-03).

Prior to her exemplary playing career at Tennessee and in the professional ranks, Randall was an accomplished basketball player in high school. She was Parade Magazine's Player of the Year and a first-team All-American in 1997 while starring at Trinity High School in Garfield Heights, Ohio. She was Ohio's Miss Basketball in 1996 and 1997, a member of the 1996 and 1997 USA Junior World Championship Qualifying Teams, the MVP of the Ohio state basketball tournament in 1994 and 1996 and the Gatorade Circle of Champions Midwest Player of the Year in 1997.

Randall graduated from Tennessee in December of 2000 with a Bachelor's degree in speech communications.
