Tournament Information

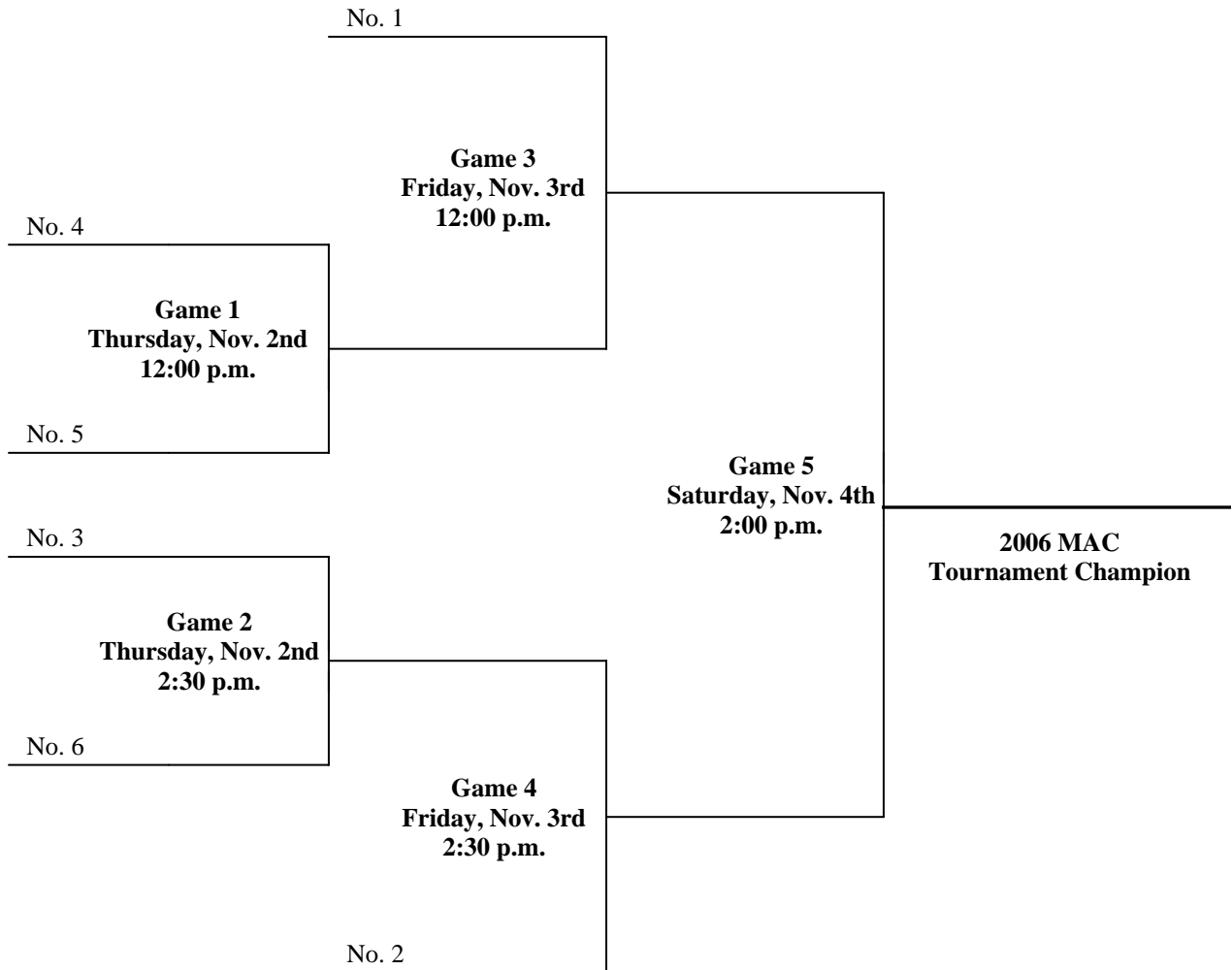
- Ticket Prices:** Tournament tickets will be sold at the game prior to each contest. Advance tickets will not be sold
- Team Admissions:** Members of the official travel party (coaches, players, trainers, etc.) will be admitted for contests in which they are not participating in at the main entrance into the complex
- Media Requests:** Credentials for all media should be obtained, in advance, by contacting Michael Hill at 740. 593-0054. Space for print media will be assigned on an availability basis.
- Team Parking:** Lot 141 to the North of Pruitt Field. Team drop off will be at the West Gate of the complex, facing the soccer field.
- Public Parking:** Parking for general public will be available (without charge) in Lot 125, 111, and 112
- Video:** Teams will only be permitted to film from the video deck during the contest in which they are participating. One camera and one photographer per team.
- Scouting:** Seats will be provided upon availability to each team for scouting purposes in or above the press box
- Uniforms:** The higher seeded team will wear the light uniform.
- Bench Assignments:** The higher seed team shall be the home team and will be seated on the north bench
- Ball:** The official ball shall be the ball of the NCAA Championship
- Warm-Up Music:** Music shall be played in 25-minute increments, beginning at the 50-minute mark. The higher seeded team will have their choice of playing its music first or second. Teams should provide Nate Wills with their CD's when they arrive at the field for each of their contests. CD's should be labeled with your team name. No explicit language or references will be allowed.

Tournament Information (Cont.)

- Stick Barrel:** A stick barrel will be in place in front of each team bench. Sticks should remain in the barrel when not being used in warm-ups or during the game.
- Ball Personnel:** Ball chasers will be arranged through and provided by Ohio University
- Athletic Training:** Please contact Scott Gardner at 740.593-1194 with all athletic training related questions.
- Laundry:** Laundry Services will be available. Please contact Ryan McFann at 740.593-1205 to make arrangements.
- Locker Rooms:** Locker rooms will only be provided only for those teams that are departing after their game.
- Officials:** Officials will be determined closer to tournament time. You will be notified by mail when the officials are chosen.
- Rosters:** Upon arrival for your first practice, please present Evan Holmes, with a list of your travel party. This should include players, coaches, trainers, administrators, etc.
- Bench Supplies:** There shall be available at each team's bench, an adequate supply of ice, cups and water
- Coaches Meeting:** The coaches meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 1st, 2006 at 7:00pm. This meeting will be held at the Convocation Center's Phillips Auditorium.
- Hospitality Tent:** The hospitality tent is restricted to each team's staff (coaches, trainers, sports information staff), working press and officials.
- Passes:** Each participating institution will receive eight (8) passes for coaches, trainers, sports information and administrators good for hospitality tent and game entrance. Twenty-two player passes for game entrance will be distributed. Please contact Nate Wills at 740.593-4491 if more passes are needed. These passes are non-transferable. Media should contact Michael Hill at 740.593-0054 to receive their credentials
- Pass List:** Players should be put on the pass list provided in the packet. Given to Nate Wills or Evan Holmes upon arrival
