ATHENS, Ohio – The Ohio softball team begins a six-game homestand on Friday with a doubleheader against Central Michigan at 1 p.m. The Bobcats play single games against Eastern Michigan on Saturday and Sunday before closing out the season with a doubleheader against Dayton on Monday.

The 2007 Mid-American Conference Softball Tournament is next week, May 9-12, at Currie Stadium in Midland, Mich. The top eight teams in the conference will participate.

Currently, the Bobcats are fourth in the MAC East Division with a 22-26 overall and 9-9 MAC record.

Sunday is Senior Day at the Ohio Softball Field. All six Bobcat seniors will be recognized before the game starts and the whole team will be available for an autograph session after the game. Sunday is also Youth Day and Strikeout Cancer Day. Admission is free for those ages 3-18, while half of all ticket proceeds go to Relay for Life, supported by Ohio Relay for Life and Colleges Against Cancer.

A LOOK AT THE 'CATS

Ohio leads the MAC with a .286 team batting average, which is 75th overall in the NCAA Division I rankings. The Bobcats are also top-30 in the nation in stolen bases per game (24th), triples per game (28th) and double plays per game (28th).

Debbie Szalejko's (Beavercreek, Ohio) .399 batting average is second-best in the MAC and 68th in the NCAA. Szalejko leads the MAC with a 1.27 hits per game average and 26 total hits in conference games only, she's second in the MAC with 61 overall hits on the season. Szalejko has been at bat 153 times and has hit a team-best five triples. She's scored 18 runs and has 14 RBI.

Kelly Rodriguez (Miami, Fla.) has a .347 batting average and leads the team with five home runs. Rodriguez totals 50 hits, including a team-high eight doubles. Her 31 RBI is top-10 on both Ohio's all-time career list and single-season list.

Shalene Petrich (Chehalis, Wash.) bats .333 and has scored a team-high 24 runs. She also leads the team with 24 stolen bases in 28 attempts, which places her fourth in the MAC with a 0.50 steals per game average.

Deanna Hartsough (Santa Ana, Calif.) and Allie Farrington (Wilton, NH) also bat above .300 on the season. Hartsough has a .364 batting average after hitting four of the 11 times she's been at bat. Farrington bats .341, going 14-for-24 on the season, including being second on the team with two home runs.

Candace Saucedo (Ontario, Calif.) has a team-best 2.24 ERA with a 4-4 record. Saucedo has pitched 65.2 innings, including four complete games and two shutouts. Michelle Sauter (Chehalis, Wash.) has a 2.33 ERA and leads the MAC with 15 wins. Sauter has pitched 147.1 innings, including 12 complete and five shutout games.

The Mid-American Conference will bring eight (8) teams (top three from each division plus the next two teams with the best overall winning percentage regardless of division) to Midland's Currie Stadium. This year's softball tournament will begin Wednesday, May 9th and will conclude Saturday, May 12th.

Currie Stadium is unofficially the "World Softball Capital", Midland is a continual host of state, national and international softball tournaments. In 1999, Midland was the site of the final qualifier for the 2000 Olympics' USA Women's Softball Team.

This year will mark the second year that Currie Stadium located in Midland, Mich. will host the Mid-American Conference Softball Championship. The Kent State Golden Flashes are the 2006 MAC Softball Champions.

***** Divisional Champions / Regular-Season Champion

1. To qualify as the MAC divisional champion, a team must play at least 14 conference games.
2. The divisional championship will be decided on overall conference winning percentage. A tie game shall count as a half-game won and a half-game lost. If two teams are tied for the championship, they shall be considered co-champions.
3. The team with the best overall conference winning percentage shall be declared the MAC Champion. If two or more teams are tied for the championship, they shall be considered co-champions.

***** Tournament Seeding. The No. 1 seed shall be the team with the highest overall conference winning percentage, with the No. 2 seed being the other divisional champion. The No. 3-8 seeds will be based on overall conference winning percentage, regardless of division. Ties in the conference standings shall be broken as follows:

- a. Head-to-head competition
- b. Winning percentage* vs. ranked conference teams (top to bottom, regardless of division; versus common opponents, regardless of the number of times played)
- c. Overall winning percentage vs. common MAC opponents
- d. If tied teams have played each other, average of runs scored against; if tied teams have not played each other, average of runs scored against vs. all common MAC opponents
- e. Coin flip

* Winning percentage is used instead of record because of situations where teams do not play each other the same number of times. Therefore, a team that is 1-0 (1.000) would win the tiebreaker over a team that is 1-1 (.500).
