## GRIFFIN NAMED NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior middle blocker Melissa Griffin was named AVCA National Player of the Week and MAC Player of the Week for her exceptional play the week of Sept. 24. Griffin is the second Ohio player to ever capture the national honor, joining former Bobcat Laura Hageman. This is the sixth time in her career she has received the conference's weekly award. The Whitehall, Mich. native had an outstanding first weekend in MAC play, leading the 19th-ranked Bobcats to two three-game sweeps against Buffalo (30-19, 30-18, 30-22) and Akron (30-11, 30-14, 30-23). Griffin opened the week with 14 kills on a .480 hitting percentage against Buffalo and then had an incredibly efficient match at Akron. Against the Zips, Griffin collected 18 kills on 22 attack attempts and committed just two attacking errors for a .727 hitting percentage. She landed seven of eight attack attempts in the first game of the match and all six of her attacks in the second game. For the week Griffin averaged 5.33 kills per game and a .596 hitting percentage.

## PROTECT THIS HOUSE

The Bobcats enter the week with a 47-match home-winning streak, the second longest active winning streak in all of Division I, trailing only No. 1 Nebraska's 61-match streak. Ohio's streak at home is the 13th longest in Division I history. If the 'Cats win both matches this weekend they will move into a tie for 12th all-time.

## RETURN OF THE MAC

After defeating Buffalo and Akron in straight games, Ohio has won 52-straight regular season MAC matches, the fourth longest active winning streak in conference play in the nation. The streak includes three straight undefeated seasons in conference play. Their last loss to a MAC opponent was at Akron on Nov. 8, 2003. Over the last four seasons the Bobcats are 77-1 against conference foes, 65-1 in regular season play and 12-0 in the MAC Tournament.

## DOUBLE TROUBLE

Senior Stephanie Blackburn collected two more double-doubles over the weekend and has now recorded a double-double in six of the last seven Bobcat matches. She has seven double-doubles on the season.

## BOBCATS IN MAC STATS

Melissa Griffin enters the weekend with the second best hitting percentage in the MAC. Griffin has a .317 hitting percentage this season, trailing only Kent State's Anne Zakelj's .402 hitting percentage. Ellen Herman is second in the conference and 26th in the nation in kills per game, entering the week averaging 4.76 per game. Michelle Jantsch and Jill DeArmond are ranked eighth and ninth in assists per game, with Jantsch averaging 10.23 and DeArmond averaging 9.25 a game.

## THAT'S A WRAP

Ohio wrapped up the tournament portion of its schedule with a 2-1 record at the Denver Pioneer Classic (Sept. 14-15). Ohio won the first two matches of the tournament against Denver and Washington State, and then fell to Long Beach State in the championship match. The Bobcats played in four tournaments this season, posting a mark of 8-3 and capturing two tournament titles. Ohio played host and won the Hampton Inn Volleyball Challenge to begin the season and then went on to capture the Shamrock Invitational, hosted by Notre Dame. In the Diet Coke Classic in Minneapolis, Minn. the Bobcats went 2-1 against one of the strongest tournament fields of the season. The Bobcats began the tournament by defeating No. 9 Minnesota and No. 12 San Diego, before losing to No. 2 Stanford in the championship match. Ohio's tournament schedule pitted them against six schools that appeared in the CSTV/AVCA Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll.

## SCOUTING MIAMI

Miami enters the week with a record of 4-7 overall and 1-1 mark in the MAC. The Red Hawks are led by Head Coach Carolyn Condit, who is in her 24th season at the helm. Condit has compiled a 417-318 record at Miami. Junior outside hitter Emily Schroeder leads the Miami attack, averaging 3.21 kills per game on a .245 hitting percentage and 2.52 digs per game. The Red Hawks' roster includes four players that Ohio senior Stephanie Blackburn should be familiar with. Melissa Zenz, Catherine Wolfe, Jeanna Staun and Carli Reihman all played at powerhouse Ursuline Academy with Blackburn.

### All-Time Series

Miami holds a 17-40 advantage over the Bobcats in the all-time series. Last year, Ohio defeated Miami 3-0 (30-22, 30-20, 30-26) in Oxford and 3-1 (30-20, 26-30, 30-22, 30-23) at the Convocation Center. In the first meeting, Stephanie Blackburn reached the 1,000 kills plateau, after connecting on a team-high 15 kills in the match to bring her career total to 1,012. Melissa Griffin had 13 kills on a team-best .385 hitting percentage. In the second meeting at the Convocation Center the Bobcats were tied 1-1 with the Red Hawks, but won the next two games in front of a crowd of 1,722. Amanda Andersen led the way with 17 kills, while Ellen Herman had 16 kills.

## SCOUTING BOWLING GREEN

Bowling Green enters this week's action with an overall record of 10-5 and a conference record of 2-0. The Falcons are led by Denise Van De Walle, who in her 25 season at the helm of the program has a 451-308 record. Bowling Green has all but one player returning from last year's 26-6 (13-3 MAC) team. Corey Domek leads the Falcon attack, averaging 3.41 kills per game on a .272 hitting percentage. Stephanie Swiger is another key player for Bowling Green. She enters this week with a .316 hitting percentage, the third best in the conference.

### All-Time Series

Ohio is 19-40 all-time against Bowling Green. Last year Bowling Green was one of two MAC teams to push Ohio to five games, losing to the Bobcats 3-2 (30-26, 30-23, 26-30, 25-30, 15-10) in their first meeting in Bowling Green. Ohio's Melissa Griffin reached the 1,000 kill milestone in the match, recording 22 kills on a team-best .362 hitting percentage. Stephanie Swiger led the Falcons with 19 kills. The Bobcats swept Bowling Green in the next two meetings, winning 30-19, 30-26, 30-18 at the Convocation Center and 30-19, 30-25, 30-21 in the championship match of the MAC Tournament.

## BOBCATS TABBED TO WIN MAC

The Bobcats were chosen by the MAC coaches as the favorites to win the regular season and MAC Tournament titles. Ohio received 11 first place votes to win the regular season and 10 votes from the league coaches to win the tournament title. The Bobcats will be looking to become the first MAC school to win five consecutive regular season and tournament titles since Western Michigan in 1987.

# 4X Defending MAC Champions

## OHIO IN THE RANKINGS

Ohio was ranked No. 13, its highest national ranking ever in the Sept. 3 CSTV/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll. The Bobcats' previous high in the poll was No. 14 in the final poll of 2005, following their run to the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen. This week Ohio is ranked No. 17 and Ohio has now been ranked in the top 25 poll for a program-record 33 consecutive weeks, dating back to Oct. 3, 2005, when they entered the poll at No. 24. The Bobcats' first ever ranking in the poll came on Nov. 29, 2004. The Bobcats were ranked No. 25 in the preseason poll.

## TWO FOR ONE UPSET SPECIAL

At the Diet Coke Classic in Minneapolis, Minn. the Bobcats defeated their highest ranked opponent in program history, twice. Entering the tournament the highest ranked opponent the Bobcats had defeated was No. 16 Tennessee during the 2005 season. Ohio topped that on the first day, with a win over No. 9 Minnesota and then topped it again with a victory against No. 12 San Diego. Both matches were five-game thrillers, as the Bobcats defeated host Minnesota 3-2 (24-30, 31-29, 18-30, 30-27, 15-13) and downed San Diego 3-2 (30-28, 25-30, 22-30, 30-26, 15-12). The run against ranked opponents came to an end in the final match of the tournament, when 2006 national runner-up, No. 2 Stanford handed the 'Cats their first loss (15-30, 25-30, 23-30) of the season. Ohio is now 6-9 against ranked teams under Head Coach Geoff Carlston.

## 'CAT WINS AWARD AGAIN

Sophomore outside hitter Ellen Herman was named Mid-American Conference East Division Volleyball Player of the Week for a second consecutive week for her outstanding play the week of Sept. 3. Herman was instrumental in leading the Bobcats to two of their biggest wins over Minnesota and San Diego during the week at the Diet Coke Classic, collecting a team-high 61 kills (4.69 per game) and 24 digs (1.85 per game), while connecting on a .270 hitting percentage. She also added seven total blocks, four service aces and four assists en route to being named to the Diet Coke Classic All-Tournament Team. In the first week of the season Herman earned the MAC East Division Player of the Week award (Aug. 27) after being named tournament MVP of the Hampton Inn Volleyball Challenge. For her career she has claimed the weekly honor three times, as she was selected last season as a freshman.

## BOBCATS SET MATCH RECORD

In the Bobcats' straight games victory over Rutgers (Aug. 26) they posted a new school record for team hitting percentage. Ohio tallied 55 kills on 93 attack attempts and only committed eight attacking errors for a .505 hitting percentage, topping the previous program record of .473 set Nov. 3, 2004 against Northern Illinois.

## BOBCAT ENTERS RECORD BOOK

Junior middle blocker Amanda Andersen had an incredibly efficient offensive match against Rutgers Aug. 26 and in doing so she etched her name into the record book at Ohio for attack percentage. Andersen finished the match with 11 kills on 15 attack attempts, for a .733 hitting percentage, which is the fifth-best match attack percentage (minimum 10 kills) in Ohio history. Teammate Melissa Griffin occupies the next three best marks for match hitting percentage at Ohio, with .773, .778 and .778, while former Bobcat Briana Adamovsky holds the match record at .875 set Nov. 8, 2003.

## STRIVE FOR FIVE

After another outstanding season in 2006, the 2007 slogan for the Bobcats has a catchy ring to it...Strive for Five. Ohio, in its fifth season under Head Coach Geoff Carlston, will be looking to extend several notable streaks to five. The 'Cats will be looking to win their fifth straight MAC regular season title, fifth straight MAC tournament title, and make their fifth consecutive appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Ohio is the third school in the history of the MAC to win four straight tournament titles. Ball State was the last to do it when they won four titles from 1992-95. Prior to Carlston's arrival the Bobcats had only advanced to the MAC Tournament three times and they had never made it past the semifinals. There has been only one team in the history of the conference to win five straight regular season titles. Western Michigan won the MAC regular season six consecutive years from 1983-88.

## GIVE ME FIVE

This year the Bobcats have already played in five five-game matches, more than they played in all of last season. Ohio has gone 3-2 in those five-game matches, with all but one match coming against teams that appeared in the CSTV/AVCA Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll. Last year, Ohio played in a total of four five-game matches, going 2-2.

## HEAD COACH GEOFF CARLSTON (128-19 AT OHIO)

Head Coach Geoff Carlston is in just his fifth season at the helm of the Ohio volleyball program, but in his short stay he has already recorded the most wins in the program's history. Carlston's record at Ohio stands at an outstanding 128-19 overall and his MAC record is even more impressive. Under his lead Ohio has won four straight MAC regular season and tournament titles. Against MAC

teams Carlston's Bobcats have gone 77-1 over the last five seasons, including a 12-0 MAC Tournament record. The only blemish came in his first season on the Ohio sidelines on Nov. 8, 2003 at Akron. His .984 conference winning percentage is the highest in the history of the MAC. He has been named MAC Coach of the Year in all four seasons as Ohio, sharing the award last season with Northern Illinois Head Coach Ray Gooden.

In his first season with Ohio, Carlston went an astounding 15-1 in conference play and 28-5 overall, capturing the regular season and conference tournament championship, to set the benchmark for success at Ohio. His immediate success earned him the

2003 Mideast Region Coach of the Year award. In his second season at the helm, the Bobcats improved on that record, going 29-3 overall and 16-0 in the MAC. At the end of the 2004 season Carlston's Bobcats finally jumped onto the national radar. Ohio received its first ever national ranking when they entered the CSTV/AVCA Coaches Poll at No. 25 on Nov. 29, 2004.

In 2005, Carlston received national recognition of his own, leading the Bobcats to a school-record 33 victories and the school's first ever trip to the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen. To go along with another MAC Coach of the Year award, Carlston also was named Collegiate Volleyball Update Coach of the Year Honorable Mention, Mideast Region Coach of the Year and Tachikara/AVCA National Coach of the Year Honorable Mention.

Prior to joining the Bobcats, Carlston coached at Concordia University-St. Paul (Minn.), where he compiled a 49-42 record. Carlston resurrected Concordia's program that was 0-18 in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference the season before he arrived. In his final season with the Golden Bears he led them to a 24-9 record and the program's first ever national ranking.

## REWRITING THE RECORD BOOK

Senior outside hitter Stephanie Blackburn and senior middle hitter Melissa Griffin are etching their names and Bobcat careers into the record books. Last year the two surpassed the 1,000 kills mark for their careers, becoming just the eighth and ninth players in Ohio history to reach 1,000 kills. The seniors rank among the top ten in several other career categories as well. Blackburn has already amassed 1,257 kills and 1,410 digs for her career, ranking sixth and third respectively in Bobcat history. She is the third Ohio player ever to record 1,000 kills and digs. Blackburn is also fourth on the career list in attack attempts (3,190), fifth in service aces (135) and seventh in points (1,475.5).

Griffin has a chance to finish her career as the all-time kills leader and at the top of the all-time attack percentage list. She entered the season at No. 1 all-time with a .348 hitting percentage, which is significantly greater than second place and former teammate Julia Winkfield's .314 attack percentage. Griffin is also fourth in career kills (1,382), fourth in block assists (302), fifth in total blocks (370) and fifth in points (1,642).

## NO CUPCAKES HERE

Ohio played one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the country this season. During the preseason the Bobcats took the court against six schools that were included in the CSTV/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll. The 'Cats have faced preseason No. 2 Stanford, No. 9 Minnesota, No. 12 San Diego, No. 19 Long Beach State and Alabama and Notre Dame, who were among the schools also receiving votes in the poll. On senior night (Nov. 24) the Bobcats will play Louisville, who was also among the other schools receiving votes in the preseason poll.

## CROWD CONTROL

A huge reason why the Convocation Center has become one of the toughest places to play in the country is the support from the fans. Last year, Ohio set attendance records on two separate occasions. A crowd of 1,804 fans filled the Convocation Center on Sept. 30 to set a single-match record and that record was broke less than two weeks later when a crowd of 2,036 Bobcat fans packed the Convo on Nov. 11. Ohio ended the season ranked in the top 25 in the nation in attendance for the first season ever, placing No. 23 at seasons end. The tremendous support has helped lead the 'Cats to the second longest home match winning-streak in the nation at 47 matches.

## FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Bobcat sophomore outside hitter Ellen Herman is the reigning MAC Freshman of the Year. Herman was also named to the All-MAC Freshman Team, first-team All-MAC, and to the MAC All-Tournament Team after finishing fourth in the conference in hitting percentage (.327) and kills per game (4.27).

She totaled 482 kills for the year which led the team and is second all-time on the Bobcat single season list and the most ever by a freshman. She recorded double-digit kills in 33 of the 35 matches, setting a team season-high with 27 kills against Eastern Michigan. Herman was the second consecutive Ohio player to capture the conference freshman of the year award, following Amanda Andersen in 2005.

## NCAA TOURNEY

Ohio's 2006 trip to the NCAA Tournament marked their fourth straight appearance. The Bobcats lost a nail-biter to Kentucky in the opening round, as they won two of the first three games, but then proceeded to drop the final two games to fall to the Wildcats in five. Ohio made its first ever trip to the NCAA in Head Coach Geoff Carlston's first season in 2003. In 2004 they advanced to the second round, but were ousted by rival Ohio State and in 2005 Ohio made their best run ever, reaching the Sweet Sixteen for the first time in program history. Arizona narrowly defeated Ohio in five games, ending the Bobcats magical run. Ohio is 3-4 all-time in the NCAA Tourney.

## VERSUS UNRANKED TEAMS

Last season, unranked San Diego defeated the Bobcats in the University of San Diego Invitational (Sept. 15, 2006), ending the Bobcats' 66-match winning streak against unranked opponents. Ohio got right back on the winning track against unranked foes,

putting together a 21-game winning-streak after the loss to San Diego. That streak came to an end in their final two matches of the 2006 season, a regular season loss at Louisville and a defeat at the hands of Kentucky in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

## AMONG THE NATIONS BEST

At the end of the 2006 season the Bobcats were ranked among the NCAA leaders in several key statistical categories. Ohio finished second in the nation in kills per game (17.29), third in the nation in assists per game (15.87) and sixth in the country in hitting percentage (.287). Senior middle blocker Melissa Griffin ended the year with a .379 hitting percentage, the 22nd best in the country, while former Bobcat setter Savannah Parra finished the year 10th in assists per game at 13.47.

## BIG SHOES TO FILL

The Bobcats will be looking to replace three seniors from a year ago, including the school's most decorated libero in Michaele Blackburn and one of the nation's top setters, Savannah Parra. Blackburn served as the Bobcats' libero for the past four seasons and in doing so, played her way into the record books. Blackburn finished her career as the all-time leader in digs for a career with 2,091. Based on the most recent NCAA statistics, that places her 11th all-time in the history of women's volleyball in career digs. Her 4.60 digs per game average ranks 15th all-time in the NCAA. Blackburn is also tied for first all-time in matches played at Ohio with 134. Parra on the other hand was regarded as one of the top setters in the country and she had the numbers to back it up. Parra is third in program history in career assists with 3,219, eighth all-time in attack percentage (.277) and ninth in career digs (972). She also holds the top two spots at Ohio in assists for a season, recording 1,704 in 2005 and 1,455 in 2006.

## NEWCOMERS

The Bobcats added five new faces to their roster in the off-season, four freshmen and a transfer. The four freshmen, Michelle Jantsch, Melissa Szkutnik, Meryl Bender and Sue Jacobi, make up the most heralded class in Ohio volleyball history. PrepVolleyball.com ranked the Bobcats' incoming class the 16th best in the nation. Also joining the Bobcats this year is Meghan Simons, a sophomore transfer from Ohio State.

Jantsch, a setter from St. Teresa's Academy, was named Missouri Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior and was a member of the inaugural AVCA High School Senior All-America Team. She was ranked one of the top 50 incoming freshmen in the country by PrepVolleyball.com.

Skutnik was also a highly sought after recruit, as she was ranked No. 54 by PrepVolleyball.com and was a member of Volleyball Magazine's Fab 50 list of incoming freshmen. The 6-1 freshman was an outside hitter in high school and could become a huge factor for the Bobcats.

Jacobi, yet another nationally ranked prospect, comes to Ohio as the No. 93 ranked recruit (PrepVolleyball.com). The 6-0 outside hitter from Presentation Academy in Louisville, Ky.,

was voted the fifth-best female athlete in Louisville by "Best of Louisville Magazine."

The fourth freshman in the 2007 class is Bender. Bender is a defensive specialist from Yorktown High in Munice, Ind., who was an all-county, all-conference and all-state honorable mention as a senior.

Simons joins Ohio after playing a season for Ohio State. The 6-3 middle blocker played in 11 matches for the Buckeyes, totaling 31 kills and a .433 hitting percentage. Coming out of high school Simons was a 2006 Volleyball Girls Fab 50 selection.

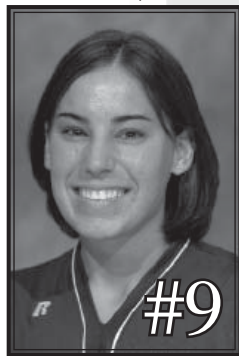
