MILESTONE WATCH

Senior middle blocker Melissa Griffin continued climbing the all-time kills list this past weekend, posting a combined 21 kills against Akron and Buffalo to move to within 12 kills of setting a new Ohio record. Griffin currently has 1,528 career kills. Below is a list of Ohio's all-time career kills leaders.

LOOKING FOR PAYBACK

Prior to Ohio's match with Miami on Sept. 28, not a single player on the Bobcat roster had ever lost a match to a MAC opponent. Ohio Head Coach Geoff Carlston had only lost one conference match during his five years at Ohio (vs. Akron, Nov. 8, 2003) prior to the match and the Bobcats had won 47 straight at home. All of those streaks came to an end with the 3-1 loss to Miami. While the long-running streaks are over, Ohio's record remains incredibly impressive under Carlston. In his five years with Ohio the Bobcats are 86-2 against MAC opponents, including a 12-0 mark in the MAC Tournament. Through 12 MAC matches this year, Ohio has lost just four games, three of those coming in the Miami loss.

ROLLING AGAIN

Ohio quickly regrouped from the Miami loss and has been rolling ever since. The Bobcats have won nine consecutive matches and have swept all but one of those matches, winning 27 of the last 28 games. During the streak the Bobcats have out-killed their opponents 17.7 to 12.5 per game, led by senior Melissa Griffin's 4.7 kills per game and .458 hitting percentage over that span. Senior Stephanie Blackburn has also played well over that span, averaging 3.7 kills (.304) and 3.7 digs per game. Sophomore Jane Sytsma is heading Ohio's front-line defense during the streak, averaging 1.14 blocks per game to go with 2.2 kills per game.

ALLOW ME TO INTRODUCE MYSELF

Freshman Melissa Szkutnik became the fourth Bobcat this season to lead the team in kills, slamming a match-high 12 on 18 swings with no errors for a .667 hitting percentage against Buffalo. Her kill total and hitting percentage were both season-highs for the frosh.

TRY AND HIT THIS

For the season Ohio is hitting .274, compared to their opponents .171 percentage. In MAC play Ohio's attack has been even more efficient. The Bobcats enter the week hitting .344 in conference action and are holding conference foes to a .155 percentage. Through the first 12 conference matches, Ohio is leading the conference in hitting by almost .100 points, as Miami is second with a .254 hitting percentage.

SMOKING ACES

Senior Stephanie Blackburn is at the top of numerous all-time statistical categories at Ohio, including career service aces. Blackburn combined for three aces over the weekend, raising her season total to a team-high 39 and her career total to 149, which is currently 4th on the all-time list at Ohio.

SCOUTING MIAMI

Miami enters the week with a record of 13-8 overall and a 10-3 mark in the MAC, tied for second in the East Division. Miami had won nine straight matches before losing at Bowling Green this past Wednesday. The Red Hawks are led by Head Coach Carolyn Condit, who is in her 24th season at the helm. Condit has compiled a 426-319 record at Miami. Junior outside hitter Emily Schroeder leads the Miami attack, averaging 3.34 kills per game on a .241 hitting percentage and 2.48 digs per game. The Red Hawks' roster includes four players that Ohio senior Stephanie Blackburn should be familiar with. Melissa Zenz, Catherine Wolfe, Jeanna Staun and Carli Reihman all played at powerhouse Ursuline Academy with Blackburn.

All-Time Series

Miami holds a 41-17 advantage over the Bobcats in the all-time series. In their first meeting this season, Miami defeated the Bobcats 3-1 (30-23, 29-31, 28-30, 27-30), ending Ohio's 64-match winning streak against MAC opponents that stretched over four seasons. The loss also ended Ohio's 47-match home winning streak, the second-longest active home winning streak in the nation at the time and the 13th-longest in Division I history. The Bobcats out-hit Miami .349 to .293, but at the net Miami totaled 21 blocks to Ohio's 11. Senior Stephanie Blackburn led Ohio with a match-high 23 kills (.410) and 14 digs and senior Melissa Griffin added 15 kills (.333) and five blocks. Miami used a total team effort to earn the victory, as four players recorded double-digit kills in the victory.

SCOUTING BOWLING GREEN

Bowling Green enters this week's action with an overall record of 18-8 and a conference record of 9-3. The Falcons are led by Head Coach Denise Van De Walle. Van De Walle has compiled a record of 459-311 with the Falcons. Corey Domek leads the Falcon attack, averaging 3.54 kills per game on a .261 hitting percentage. Stephanie Swiger is another key player for Bowling Green. Swiger begins the week with a .393 hitting percentage and is averaging 3.12 kills per game.

All-Time Series

Ohio is 20-40 all-time against Bowling Green. Earlier this season Ohio swept Bowling Green (30-21, 30-18, 30-20) at the Convocation Center in front of a crowd of 3,689, the largest crowd in Ohio's history. Senior Stephanie Blackburn led the Bobcats with 12 kills (.385) and 11 digs and senior Melissa Griffin had 11 kills and four total blocks. Ohio out-hit the Falcons .340 to .074 in the match.

MAC STANDINGS

Ohio's two wins, coupled with a Miami loss last week, moved the Bobcats back into sole possession of first place in the MAC East Division standings with a record of 11-1. Miami is now tied with Kent State at 10-2 for second in the division, followed by Bowling Green with a 9-3 mark. In the West Division, Western Michigan holds a two match lead in first place with a record of 9-3.

4X Defending MAC Champions

I CAN MATCH THAT

Nearly all season junior Jill DeArmond and freshman Michelle Jantsch have been splitting time at setter for the Bobcats. In Saturday's victory against Buffalo the two split time once again and their stats showed it. Both setters finished with the exact same stat lines, totaling 17 assists and nine digs each. For the season, DeArmond has 534 assists (7.7 per game) and Jantsch has 540 (9.3 per game).

NEVER BEEN DONE

Senior Stephanie Blackburn is the first player in Ohio history to record 1,300 kills and 1,500 digs for a career. Blackburn has amassed 1,380 kills (5th all-time) and 1,524 digs (3rd all-time) in her career. Throughout her Ohio career she has been one of the most versatile Bobcats ever, collecting 58 double-doubles, including 12 this season.

TOPPING THE CHARTS

Through 12 conference matches, Ohio enters the week leading the MAC in eight team statistical categories. Ohio tops the conference in hitting percentage (.344), assists (16.6), kills (17.8), hitting percentage by opponents (.155), kills by opponents (12.2), assists by opponents (11.2), service aces by opponents (0.79) and digs by opponents (11.2).

CROWD CONTROL

Ohio set a new school attendance mark against Bowling Green (Sept. 29) with a crowd of 3,689. The mark tops the previous record of 2,036 set Nov. 11 of last year. Ohio is currently ranked 19th in the country in attendance, as an average of 1,567 people are packing the Convo ever time the 'Cats take the court at the Convo this year. Ohio finished last season ranked in the top 25 in the nation in attendance for the first time ever, ending the season ranked No. 23 with an average crowd of 1,411.

I'LL DO ONE

Getting off to a quick start in the first game of matches has become common practice for the Bobcats. Since 2004 Ohio has won the first game in 58 of 60 MAC matches. During that span Ohio's record in first games against all opponents is 110-15. The Bobcats are 6-9 in matches where they have dropped the opening game over that period.

UNLUCKY SEPT. 28

The Bobcats had the second longest active home match winning streak in the nation at 47 snapped with a 3-1 (30-23, 29-31, 28-30, 27-30) loss to Miami on Sept. 28. Ironically, Ohio's last home loss came five years to the day on Sept. 28, 2002. Ohio's streak at home goes down as the 13th longest in Division I history.

MAC STREAK ENDS AT 64

Ohio's loss to Miami also marked the end of an incredible 64-match winning streak against MAC opponents. Ohio had won 52-straight regular season MAC matches and was 12-0 in the conference tournament over that span. The streak included three straight undefeated seasons in conference play. Prior to the loss, Ohio's last defeat to a MAC opponent was at Akron on Nov. 8, 2003. Over the past five seasons the Bobcats are 78-2 against conference foes, 66-2 in regular season play and 12-0 in the MAC Tournament.

DOUBLE-DIGITS

In Ohio's win against Eastern Michigan (Oct. 6) four Bobcats recorded double-digit kills. Melissa Griffin led the way with 16 kills, Stephanie Blackburn and Ellen Herman had 13 apiece and Jane Sytsma had 10. It was the second time this season four Ohio players reached double-digit kills, as the same four players registered double-digit kills in a win against Charleston (Sept. 8).

OHIO IN THE RANKINGS

The Bobcats jumped three spots to No. 16 in the most recent CSTV/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll, increasing their consecutive ranked streak to 38 weeks. The streak began over two years ago, when Ohio entered the rankings at No. 24 on Oct. 3, 2005. Earlier this season Ohio was ranked No. 13 (Sept. 3 poll), the programs highest ever ranking. Ohio's previous high in the poll was No. 14 in the final poll of 2005. Ohio's first ever ranking in the national poll came on Nov. 29, 2004. Ohio began 2007 ranked No. 25 in the preseason poll.

COUNT US IN COACH

Melissa Griffin and Stephanie Blackburn have been incredibly reliable for Head Coach Geoff Carlston during their Bobcat careers. Since stepping foot on campus in 2004, both have played in every match for the Bobcats. Going into this weekend's action the senior co-captains have played in all 124 matches of their Bobcat careers which ranks them tied for 7th in Ohio history.

NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior middle blocker Melissa Griffin was named AVCA National Player of the Week and MAC Player of the Week for her exceptional play the week of Sept. 24. Griffin is the second Ohio player to ever capture the national honor, joining former Bobcat Laura Hageman. This is the sixth time in her career she has received the conference's weekly award. The Whitehall, Mich. native had an outstanding first weekend in MAC play, leading the then 19th-ranked Bobcats to two three-game sweeps against Buffalo and Akron. Griffin opened the week with 14 kills on a .480 hitting percentage against Buffalo and then

HEAD COACH GEOFF CARLSTON (137-20 AT OHIO)

Head Coach Geoff Carlston is in just his fifth season at the helm of the Ohio volleyball program, but in his short stay he has already recorded the most wins in the program's history. Carlston's record at Ohio stands at an outstanding 137-20 overall and his MAC record is even more impressive. Under his lead Ohio has won four straight MAC regular season and tournament titles. Against MAC

teams Carlston's Bobcats have gone 86-2 over the last five seasons, including a 12-0 MAC Tournament record. His .974 conference winning percentage is the highest in the history of the MAC. He has been named MAC Coach of the Year in all four seasons as Ohio, sharing the award last season with Northern Illinois Head Coach Ray Gooden.

In his first season with Ohio, Carlston went an astounding 15-1 in conference play and 28-5 overall, capturing the regular season and conference tournament championship, to set the benchmark for success at Ohio. His immediate success earned him the 2003 Mideast Region Coach of the Year award.

In his second season at the helm, the Bobcats improved on that record, going 29-3 overall and 16-0 in the MAC. At the end of the 2004 season Carlston's Bobcats finally jumped onto the national radar. Ohio received its first ever national ranking when they entered the CSTV/AVCA Coaches Poll at No. 25 on Nov. 29, 2004.

In 2005, Carlston received national recognition of his own, leading the Bobcats to a school-record 33 victories and the school's first ever trip to the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen. To go along with another MAC Coach of the Year award, Carlston also was named Collegiate Volleyball Update Coach of the Year Honorable Mention, Mideast Region Coach of the Year and Tachikara/AVCA National Coach of the Year Honorable Mention.

Prior to joining the Bobcats, Carlston coached at Concordia University-St. Paul (Minn.), where he compiled a 49-42 record. Carlston resurrected Concordia's program that was 0-18 in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference the season before he arrived. In his final season with the Golden Bears he led them to a 24-9 record and the program's first ever national ranking.

had an incredibly efficient match at Akron. Against the Zips, Griffin collected 18 kills on 22 attack attempts and committed just two attacking errors for a .727 hitting percentage. For the week Griffin averaged 5.33 kills per game and a .596 hitting percentage.

THAT'S A WRAP

Ohio wrapped up the tournament portion of its schedule with a 2-1 record at the Denver Pioneer Classic (Sept. 14-15). Ohio won the first two matches of the tournament against Denver and Washington State, and then fell to Long Beach State in the championship match. The Bobcats played in four tournaments this season, posting a mark of 8-3 and capturing two tournament titles. Ohio played host and won the Hampton Inn Volleyball Challenge to begin the season and then went on to capture the Shamrock Invitational, hosted by Notre Dame. In the Diet Coke Classic in Minneapolis, Minn. the Bobcats went 2-1 against one of the strongest tournament fields of the season. The Bobcats began the tournament by defeating No. 9 Minnesota and No. 12 San Diego, before losing to No. 2 Stanford in the championship match. Ohio's tournament schedule pitted them against six schools that appeared in the CSTV/AVCA Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll.

JANTSCH'S FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Freshman setter Michelle Jantsch posted the first double-double of her young collegiate career against Miami (Sept. 28). Jantsch collected a team-high 30 assists and added a career-high 10 digs against the RedHawks. She is the fourth Bobcat this season to record a double-double, joining Stephanie Blackburn (11), Ellen Herman (4) and Jill DeArmond (2).

BOBCATS TABBED TO WIN MAC

The Bobcats were chosen by the MAC coaches as the favorites to win the regular season and MAC Tournament titles. Ohio received 11 first place votes to win the regular season and 10 votes from the league coaches to win the tournament title. The Bobcats will be looking to become the first MAC school to win five consecutive regular season and tournament titles since Western Michigan in 1987.

TWO FOR ONE UPSET SPECIAL

At the Diet Coke Classic in Minneapolis, Minn. the Bobcats defeated their highest ranked opponent in program history, twice. Entering the tournament the highest ranked opponent the Bobcats had defeated was No. 16 Tennessee during the 2005 season. Ohio topped that on the first day, with a win over No. 9 Minnesota and then topped it again with a victory against No. 12 San Diego. Both matches were five-game thrillers, as the Bobcats defeated host Minnesota 3-2 (24-30, 31-29, 18-30, 30-27, 15-13) and downed San Diego 3-2 (30-28, 25-30, 22-30, 30-26, 15-12). The run against ranked opponents came to an end in the final match of the tournament, when 2006 national runner-up, No. 2 Stanford handed the 'Cats their first loss (15-30, 25-30,

23-30) of the season. Ohio is now 6-9 against ranked teams under Head Coach Geoff Carlston.

'CAT WINS AWARD AGAIN

Sophomore outside hitter Ellen Herman was named Mid-American Conference East Division Volleyball Player of the Week for two straight weeks earlier this season. Herman claimed the award Sept. 3 after she instrumental in leading the Bobcats to two of their biggest wins over Minnesota and San Diego during the week at the Diet Coke Classic, collecting a team-high 61 kills (4.69 per game) and 24 digs (1.85 per game), while connecting on a .270 hitting percentage. She also added seven total blocks, four service aces and four assists en route to being named to the Diet Coke Classic All-Tournament Team. In the first week of the season Herman earned the MAC East Division Player of the Week award (Aug. 27) after being named tournament MVP of the Hampton Inn Volleyball Challenge. For her career she has claimed the weekly honor three times, as she was selected last season as a freshman.

BOBCATS SET MATCH RECORD

In the Bobcats' straight games victory over Rutgers (Aug. 26) they posted a new school record for team hitting percentage. Ohio tallied 55 kills on 93 attack attempts and only committed eight attacking errors for a .505 hitting percentage, topping the previous program record of .473 set Nov. 3, 2004 against Northern Illinois.

BOBCAT ENTERS RECORD BOOK

Junior middle blocker Amanda Andersen had an incredibly efficient offensive match against Rutgers (Aug. 26) and in doing so she etched her name into the record book at Ohio for attack percentage. Andersen finished the match with 11 kills on 15 attack attempts, for a .733 hitting percentage, which is the fifth-best match attack percentage (minimum 10 kills) in Ohio history. Teammate Melissa Griffin occupies the next three best marks for match hitting percentage at Ohio, with .773, .778 and .778, while former Bobcat Briana Adamovsky holds the match record at .875 set Nov. 8, 2003.

STRIVE FOR FIVE

After another outstanding season in 2006, the 2007 slogan for the Bobcats has a catchy ring to it...Strive for Five. Ohio, in its fifth season under Head Coach Geoff Carlston, is looking to extend several notable streaks to five. The 'Cats are looking to win their fifth straight MAC regular season title, fifth straight MAC Tournament title, and make their fifth consecutive appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Ohio is the third school in the history of the MAC to win four straight tournament titles. Ball State was the last to do it when they won four titles from 1992-95. Prior to Carlston's arrival the Bobcats had only advanced to the MAC Tournament three times and they had never made it past the semifinals. There has been only one team in the history of the conference to win five straight regular season titles. Western Michigan won the MAC regular season six consecutive years from 1983-88.

NO CUPCAKES HERE

Ohio played one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the country this season. During the preseason the Bobcats took the court against six schools that were included in the CSTV/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll. The 'Cats have faced preseason No. 2 Stanford, No. 9 Minnesota, No. 12 San Diego, No. 19 Long Beach State and Alabama and Notre Dame, who were among the schools also receiving votes in the poll. On senior night (Nov. 24) the Bobcats will play Louisville, who was also among the other schools receiving votes in the preseason poll.

FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Bobcat sophomore outside hitter Ellen Herman is the reigning MAC Freshman of the Year. Herman was also named to the All-MAC Freshman Team, first-team All-MAC, and to the MAC All-Tournament Team after finishing fourth in the conference in hitting percentage (.327) and kills per game (4.27).

She totaled 482 kills for the year which led the team and is second all-time on the Bobcat single season list and the most ever by a freshman. She recorded double-digit kills in 33 of the 35 matches, setting a team season-high with 27 kills against Eastern Michigan. Herman was the second consecutive Ohio player to capture the conference freshman of the year award, following Amanda Andersen in 2005.

NCAA TOURNEY

Ohio's 2006 trip to the NCAA Tournament marked their fourth straight appearance. The Bobcats lost a nail-biter to Kentucky in the opening round, as they won two of the first three games, but then proceeded to drop the final two games to fall to the Wildcats in five. Ohio made its first ever trip to the NCAA in Head Coach Geoff Carlston's first season in 2003. In 2004 they advanced to the second round, but were ousted by rival Ohio State and in 2005 Ohio made their best run ever, reaching the Sweet Sixteen for the first time in program history. Arizona narrowly defeated Ohio in five games, ending the Bobcats magical run. Ohio is 3-4 all-time in the NCAA Tourney.

AMONG THE NATIONS BEST

At the end of the 2006 season the Bobcats were ranked among the NCAA leaders in several key statistical categories. Ohio finished second in the nation in kills per game (17.29), third in the nation in assists per game (15.87) and sixth in the country in hitting percentage (.287). Senior middle blocker Melissa Griffin ended the year with a .379 hitting percentage, the 22nd best in the country, while former Bobcat setter Savannah Parra finished the year 10th in assists per game at 13.47.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

The Bobcats lost two key players from last year's team, including the school's most decorated libero in Michael Blackburn and one of the nation's top setters, Savannah Parra. Blackburn served as the Bobcats' libero for the past four seasons and in doing so, played her way into the record books. Blackburn finished her career as the all-time leader in digs for a career with 2,091. Based on the most recent NCAA statistics, that places her 11th all-time in the history of women's volleyball in career digs. Her 4.60 digs per game average ranks 15th all-time in the NCAA. Blackburn is also tied for first all-time in matches played at Ohio with 134. Parra on the other hand was regarded as one of the top setters in the country and she had the numbers to back it up. Parra is third in program history in career assists with 3,219, eighth all-time in attack percentage (.277) and ninth in career digs (972). She also holds the top two spots at Ohio in assists for a season, recording 1,704 in 2005 and 1,455 in 2006.

NEWCOMERS

The Bobcats added five new faces to their roster in the off-season, four freshmen and a transfer. The four freshmen, Michelle Jantsch, Melissa Szkutnik, Meryl Bender and Sue Jacobi, make up the most heralded class in Ohio volleyball history. PrepVolleyball.com ranked the Bobcats' incoming class the 16th best in the nation. Also joining the Bobcats this year is Meghan Simons, a sophomore transfer from Ohio State.

Jantsch, a setter from St. Teresa's Academy, was named Missouri Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior and was a member of the inaugural AVCA High School Senior All-America Team. She was ranked one of the top 50 incoming freshmen in the country by PrepVolleyball.com.

Szkutnik was also a highly sought after recruit, as she was ranked No. 54 by PrepVolleyball.com and was a member of Volleyball Magazine's Fab 50 list of incoming freshmen. The 6-1 freshman was an outside hitter in high school and could become a huge factor for the Bobcats.

Jacobi, yet another nationally ranked prospect, comes to Ohio as the No. 93 ranked recruit (PrepVolleyball.com). The 6-0 outside hitter from Presentation Academy in Louisville, Ky., was voted the fifth-best female athlete in Louisville by "Best of Louisville Magazine."

The fourth freshman in the 2007 class is Bender. Bender is a defensive specialist from Yorktown High in Munice, Ind., who was an all-county, all-conference and all-state honorable mention as a senior.

Simons joins Ohio after playing a season for Ohio State. The 6-3 middle blocker played in 11 matches for the Buckeyes, totaling 31 kills and a .433 hitting percentage. Coming out of high school Simons was a 2006 Volleyball Girls Fab 50 selection.
