TIP IN CLUB — HISTORY

The University of Oklahoma Tip In Club began in 1971 and its members have been passionate supporters of the University of Oklahoma men's basketball program from the beginning.

Tip in Club members support Coach Capel's efforts in many ways including major capital gifts for the Legacy Court at the Lloyd Noble Center, the LNC concourse-level trophy/display cases, the basketball court surface itself, the renovation of the Head Coach's office and many other projects designed to enhance and improve the home of Sooner Basketball.

In addition, the Tip In Club has funded and supported volunteer projects including scholarships, reunions, banquets, and golf tournaments. Today, Tip In Club members enjoy the annual golf tournament in August, the Tip Off Banquet in October, and the annual awards banquet in April. Members also enjoy pre-game parties located inside the Clinton Lounge before conference games as well as reserved parking for each game.

ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT PROGRAM

In 2006, the Tip In Club generously stepped forward with a \$250,000 pledge to fund the first endowed men's basketball scholarship for the program. A top priority of the Athletics Department, endowments are established to offset the costs of tuition, room and board, books and other student services. The Tip In Club endowment campaign gives OU supporters the opportunity to support both the players and the teams all while leaving a legacy for its donors.

Each endowed scholarship is attached to a former letterman, connecting the past to the present. The foundation player for the Tip In Club Men's Basketball Scholarship is 1975 Big Eight player of the year and consensus All-American, Alvan Adams.

The goal of 13 endowed scholarships will allow for funds to be freed up and applied to other needs throughout the department. Complete support of the scholarship endowments will allow our programs to maintain the success and tradition of the past.

LEGACY COURT

In celebration of 100 years of Sooner Basketball, the Tip In Club graciously donated a \$250,000 capital gift towards the design and construction of the Tip In Club Legacy Court.

Located in the lobby between the basketball offices, the Tip In Club Legacy Court features various display cases, banners, timelines, interactive activities, photographs and TV monitors showcasing the best teams, players and coaches from the past century.
